UNLV OPEN SEASON SATURDAY AGAINST TITANS...

- ◆ UNLV is 10-1 in season openers under head coach Kathy Olivier, with the lone loss coming a year ago against Wright State in the Cox Pavilion.
- ◆ This will make the ninth straight year UNLV is playing its season opener in Las Vegas, and sixth in the last seven years in the Thomas & Mack Center. The Lady Rebels won the first five season-openers in the TMC.
- ◆ Traditionally the Lady Rebels have dominated their former Big West rivals, as UNLV is 34-8 all-time against Cal State Fullerton, including 22-1 in Las Vegas, though the last meeting was in the 2008-09 season during Olivier's first year on the UNLV bench
- ◆ The 2019-20 UNLV Lady Rebel squad will be one of the youngest and least experienced teams in the Mountain West this season after graduating four senior starters. UNLV will have 10 underclassmen on this year's squad, with seven freshmen and three sophomores, while the four-member senior class has a total of two career starts (as a Lady Rebel).
- ◆ Saturday is the first of four games at home for UNLV in the month of November, with the lone road contest coming Tuesday, Nov. 19 at Southern Utah. UNLV will also play a pair of home games in the first three days of December before hitting the road for three straight.

HEAD COACH KATHY OLIVIER

When UNLV was searching for its next women's basketball coach -- a person that could return the proud program to its place among the nation's best -- it didn't have to look far. The school turned to one of its own by hiring former Lady Rebel All-American Kathy Olivier as the eighth full-time head coach in UNLV women's basketball history on April 22, 2008.

The Lady Rebels immediately showed their renewed enthusiasm for their new coach, and the team was the talk of the conference after an inspiring run to the Mountain West Conference Tournament semifinals as the seven-seed. Olivier's first recruit to the program, Jamie Smith, would 10 months later become the first-ever Lady Rebel to be named MWC Freshman of the Year.

In 2009-10 the Lady Rebels continued their climb back to prominence under Olivier, and posted several impressive upsets, including road wins at Utah and New Mexico and a home victory over eventual Sweet 16 participant San Diego State. Olivier's best season would come in 2011-12, as UNLV finished the campaign with a 22-10 record, an 11-win improvement over the previous year that ranked as the sixth-best in the nation, and the Lady Rebels returned to the postseason for the first time since 2005-06 with a trip to the WNIT.

The 2015-18 seasons were the best stretch of her time on the UNLV bench, as the Lady Rebels averaged 20 wins per season over the three years, played in back-to-back WNIT Tournaments, and won their first-ever Mountain West regular season championship title thanks to a 14-4 mark (19-12 overall).

Olivier came to UNLV after serving as head coach at UCLA for 15 years (from May 3, 1993, to March 11, 2008). While head coach of the Bruins she helped produce two Pac-10 Players of the Year, three Pac-10 Freshmen of the Year, a Pac-10 team championship, a Pac-10 Tournament Championship and a trip to the 1999 Elite Eight.

The former Kathy Ricks, Olivier was a standout player at Cal State Fullerton and then at UNLV, where she earned All-America honors while averaging a team-high 16.3 points and 5.7 rebounds in the 1979-80 season. She still ranks on several all-time lists at UNLV, as her career 18.1 ppg average is the second-highest in team history.

UNLV VERSUS CAL STATE FULLERTON...

UNLV has dominated the all-time series against the Titans, their former Big West conference rivals. The Lady Rebels have won 34 of the 42 all-time meetings, and that includes a 21-2 all-time mark in Las Vegas. This will be the first meeting between the teams since Nov. 29, 2008, when during Kathy Olivier's first year as head coach at her alma mater the Lady Rebels claimed a 76-65 win in the consolation game of the Lady Rebel Round-Up.

PLAYERS TO WATCH...

UNLV is bringing back a pair of All-Mountain West honorees from this past season, beginning with 6th Player of the Year **Rodjanae Wade**, a senior center who averaged career-highs of 8.1 points and 5.9 rebounds per game coming off the bench. She's joined by junior guard **Bailey Thomas**, who earned Mountain West All-Defensive Team honors.

LEARNING ON THE JOB...

There's going to be a lot of learning on the court for the UNLV players this year, as only four current Lady Rebels have started a game at UNLV, with their total combined starts equalling 37 (Bailey Thomas - 23, Rodjanae Wade - 11, Latecia Smith - 2, Kavionnia Brown - 1)..

That is by far the least experienced in terms of combined career starts in Head Coach Kathy Olivier's 12 years at the school, as last year's team in comparison had a combined 232 starts just in the starting lineup alone.

ON THE ROAD TO 800...

UNLV enters the season with 794 all-time wins, which is the 59th most in NCAA history, while the team's .602 all-time winning percentage is tied for 57th in the nation. Both marks easily are the best in the Mountain West.

This year's scholarship freshmen class, which was ranked as a top-60 overall recruiting class, includes: **Melanie Isbell** (Las Vegas), **Jacinta Buckley** (Spokane, Washington), **Anna Blount** (Stockton, California), **Keyana Wilfred** (Mitchell, Nebraska), **Tianna Carter** (Tucson, Arizona) and **Isis Beh** (Murray, Utah). All six freshmen are from six different states.

KEEPING THEM HOME...

UNLV has three players from perennial national-25 Centennial High School (Las Vegas) on this year's team in **Melanie Isbell**, **Justice Ethridge** and **Bailey Thomas**.

ago. That's highlighted by a potential second-meeting in three years with SEC power Mississippi State, who reached the NCAA Elite Eight in 2019 after back-to-back national championship runner-up finishes.

Among the challenges for the Lady Rebels are a home game against the Duke Blue Devils in the Thomas & Mack Center on Nov. 14, the first of three games against Power 5 teams for the Lady Rebels (Dec. 14 at USC, Dec. 20 vs Virginia).

CONFERENCE PLAY ALREADY?...

UNLV will have the earliest conference start in program history when it faces Mountain West rival Fresno State Dec. 3 in the Cox Pavilion. That will also be the only conference game until the new year, as the Lady Rebels' first league bye of the season will also be in that first week. The MW schedule is starting earlier this season due to the conference tournament being moved back a week.

WATCHING THE LADY REBELS...

UNLV is scheduled to have 15 of its 16 home games live streamed this season. Ten of the games will be on the Mountain West Network, available at UNLVRebels.com. Three more games, including the Duke game on Nov. 14, will be available through YouTube. The Lady Rebels will have a new broadcast team for the home video streams, as Ben Wilson will handle play-by-play while former Lady Rebel standout Amie Callaway will serve as color.

FloSports will carry all four games of December's Duel In The Desert event, hosted by UNLV from Dec. 19-21. That includes UNLV's game against Virginia (Dec. 20) and the Dec. 21 contest against either Mississippi State or USF.

UNLV ON THE RADIO...

All Lady Rebel games will have a live radio broadcast this season, featuring the radio call of **Wyatt Tomchek** (play-by-play). **Caleb Herring** will serve as color analyst on home broadcasts, while **Mark Wasik** will fill the role on road games. This year's games can be heard through the UNLV Gameday App, available on the App Store from Apple and Google Play, as well as through a link on UNLVRebels.com.

Five games this season will also be carried live by KBAD 920 AM: Duke on Nov. 14, Virginia on Dec. 20, Boise State on Jan. 8, New Mexico on Feb. 15 and San Diego State on Feb. 22.
