- What's Next:** Boise State plays a two-game series, Feb. 10-11 at UNLV to start a stretch of four-straight contests away from home.
- On Deck:** The Broncos travel to Logan, Utah for a pair of games at Utah State, Feb. 18/20.

THE LATEST

- This season, Bronco Head Coach Gordy Presnell has coached his 1,000th-career game (season opener), won his 300th game at Boise State (Jan. 2), and won his 700th-career game (Feb. 5).
- Boise State has won 19-straight games when scoring 65 or more points...last loss was 85-80 to Fresno State at home, Jan. 25, 2020.
- Boise State leads the Mountain West in blocked shots per game (6.4) and ranks seventh nationally...Broncos' 96 blocks are the most in the Mountain West and 11th in the NCAA...on pace for 140, seven shy of the school record...Broncos lead the conference in field-goal percentage defense (38.2).
- Mallory McGwire is second in the Mountain West in blocked shots per game (1.54) and third in rebounds per game (7.7)...has 978 points in her NCAA career (Oregon and Boise State combined).
- Abby Muse is second in the conference in blocks (23) and third in blocks per game (1.53).
- Jade Loville is third in the Mountain West in scoring (15.1 points per game).
- Four Broncos have recorded at least one double-double this season...Mallory McGwire leads the way with three...Rachel Bowers has notched two and Abby Muse and Chinma Njoku have one each.

BOISE STATE TENURE (2005-present)

Sixteen years ago Gordy Presnell returned to his home state to become the sixth head coach in Boise State University's women's basketball program history. He brought with him a mild and laid-back demeanor, 18 years of head-coaching experience and a long record of success. Presnell currently ranks first in Bronco history for victories by a coach with a record of 295-181 (.619) overall. The 2020-21 season marks his 34th as a collegiate head coach with a career record of 691-308 (.692).

Presnell will coach the 1,000th game of his illustrious career in the 2020-21 season opener, and, with 691 career victories through the 2019-20 campaign, currently sits 41st on the all-time victories list of NCAA (all levels) and NAIA women's basketball head coaches, and 21st among active head coaches. He recorded his 600th career win Dec. 18, 2017, as Boise State defeated Portland, 74-60, at Taco Bell Arena.

Presnell's Bronco teams have qualified the NCAA Tournament on six occasions (2007, 2015, 2017-20) and eight times have qualified for the postseason. Under his watch, Boise State has also won four regular-season titles (2007-08 WAC; 2018-19 Mountain West) and six conference tournament titles (2007 WAC; 2015, 2017-20 Mountain West).

The Broncos are currently in dynasty mode under Presnell's watch, having qualified for the NCAA Tournament in five of the past six seasons (2015, 2017-20), and establishing the program as the Mountain West's standard-bearer, capturing five conference tournament crowns and two regular-season titles since 2015. Boise State cemented this status with by winning the Mountain West double (regular-season and tournament titles) in two-straight campaigns (2018-19).

Boise State's 80-76 overtime win over Fresno State in the 2020 Mountain West Basketball Championship Game made the Broncos the first program in conference history to win four-straight tournaments (2017-20), and, with five tournament titles (2015, 2017-20), tied the Broncos with New Mexico for the most all-time.

Presnell, the 2018-19 Mountain West Coach of the Year, has overseen a history-making run over the past four seasons as he has taken the Broncos to a combined 97 wins, including 67 (regular season and conference tournament) against Mountain West competition. After setting the program record for wins in a season with 25 in 2016-17, Presnell guided the Broncos to 23 wins in 2017-18 before establishing the new benchmark with 28 victories in 2018-19. The Broncos followed that with the program's fourth-straight 20-win season in 2019-20, going 24-9.

The program's current run began in 2013-14, as the Broncos won 19 games and went to the Women's Basketball Invitational (WBI), the team's first postseason appearance since 2008. Since 2013-14, the Broncos have won at least 19 games every season, including five 20-win campaigns.

The first of those 20-win seasons came in 2014-15, when Presnell led the Broncos to a 22-11 mark, the Mountain West Tournament title, and the program's first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2007. In the first round, the Broncos, a 15-seed, fought valiantly at No. 2 Tennessee, trailing the Lady Volunteers by just five with under three minutes to play before falling.

Over this span, Presnell's players have earned 16 All-Mountain West selections, including 11 first-team honors.

They have stepped up even more when the lights

shine brightest, as Brooke Pahukoa (2015, 2017), Riley Lupfer (2018), Braydey Hodgins (2019), and A'Shanti Coleman (2020) have combined to capture five Mountain West Tournament MVPs over the past five tournaments.

Since Boise State joined the Mountain West in 2011-12, the Broncos, under Presnell, lead all conference schools with five NCAA Tournament bids.

The Broncos have recorded 11 winning seasons over Presnell's 15-year tenure. After going 15-15 in his first season (2005-06), the Broncos recorded four-consecutive winning seasons, including a then-school-record 24 wins in both the 2006-07 (24-9) and 2007-08 (24-8) campaigns. Boise State currently has an active streak of seven-straight winning seasons with six national postseason bids over that stretch. Presnell's teams have gone 151-101 (.599) in conference games and an impressive 171-61 (.737) at home in Boise, including a perfect 14-0 mark in 2007-08.

Over the course of his tenure Presnell's Broncos have pushed the tempo of the game. His teams are routinely ranked among the top scoring and rebounding teams in the conference and have set numerous school records along the way. Presnell coached teams have set the school record for points in a season four times: in 2006-07 (2,275), 2007-08 (2,330), 2014-15 (2,331), and 2018-19 (2,478). His Bronco teams have also recorded nine of the top-10 season totals all-time (50 years). In rebounding the Broncos have turned in the top nine totals all-time and have set the record three times: in 2005-06 (1,252), 2006-07 (1,330), and 2007-08 (1,335).

They have seven of the top-10 scoring averages in program history, eight of the top-10 season marks for field goals made, and all of the top-10 season tallies in 3-point field goals made.

In 2006-07, Presnell led the Broncos to the program's first postseason appearance under his watch, and first since 1998. Boise State went 24-9 overall, winning the WAC regular-season and tournament titles to advance to the NCAA Tournament for just the second time in program history, and to the postseason for the first time since making the 1998 WNIT. For his coaching performance he was named the WAC and WBCA Division I Regional Coach of the Year.

In addition to the regular-season and conference tournament titles, and NCAA Tournament appearances, program honors during Presnell's tenure at Boise State include: advancing to the second round in both the 2008 Women's National Invitation Tournament and the 2014 Women's Basketball Invitational; one WBCA All-Region and one Honorable Mention All-America honors; 21 all-conference honors, eight conference all-freshmen team members, two conference newcomers of the year, two freshmen of the year, four conference all-defensive team honors, nine conference all-tournament team honors with six tournament MVPs, six CoSIDA Academic All-District selections and a combined 89 academic all-conference honors.

In 33 years as a collegiate head coach Presnell has experienced 29 winning seasons and one at .500. His teams have won a combined 11 regular-season titles, seven at SPU and four at Boise State. In addition, he has guided 21 of his 33 squads to postseason national-tournament bids.

Presnell, a Lapwai, Idaho, native, graduated from Northwest Nazarene in 1983 with a B.A. in physical education. He earned a master's degree from Seattle Pacific in 1989. He and his wife, former SPU gymnast Susan Nolte, have two children, a daughter, Jacquelyn, and a son, Ryder.

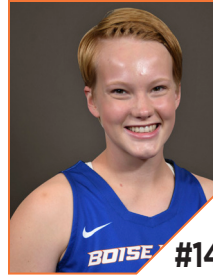

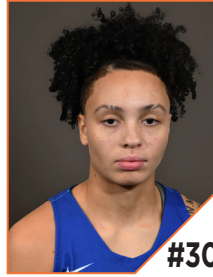

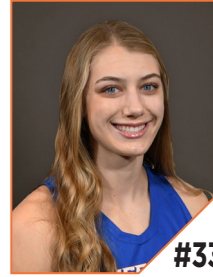
