**New Orleans Head Coach  
Mark Slessinger**

The 2016-17 season will be the sixth at the helm of the New Orleans Privateers men's basketball program for Mark Slessinger. "Sless" as he is affectionately known around campus, became the 12th head coach in Privateers history on June 28 2011.



Assuming duties when UNO was transitioning back to Division I status, Slessinger has led the Privateers to a combined 60 wins, including a 10-20 mark last season.

During Slessinger's first season, a school-record 13 players topped double-figures at least once in 2011-12, as the team posted a solid 17-15 mark with 13 of those coming in Lakefront Arena. Since joining the Southland Conference prior to the 2013-14 campaign, two Privateers have claimed all-league honors on three occasions as forward Cory Dixon was third-team All-SLC in 2013-14 while guard Christavious Gill garnered honorable-mention recognition in 2014-15 and third-team distinction in 2015-16.

Off the court, the Privateers remain visible on campus and in the community. The team's presence parlayed into an increase in attendance with some of the larger student crowds during the 2013-14 season since the team returned to Lakefront Arena in 2008.

Slessinger graduated from Aurora University with a bachelor's degree in physical education. He then coached at his alma mater as an assistant basketball coach during the 1995-96 season before moving on to Central Michigan, where he served as an assistant during the 1996-97 campaign.

From there, Slessinger spent three years at Northland Pioneer College (Ariz.), the last two as head coach. His teams posted a 36-25 record with eight players signing on at the Division I level before he departed to take the top assistant and recruiting coordinator position at Northwestern State.

In 11 years at NSU, Slessinger helped the Demons win three Southland Conference titles, earned two trips to the NCAA Tournament and posted signature victories over Oklahoma State, Mississippi State, Oregon State and Iowa.

A native of Bloomington, Indiana, resides in New Orleans with his wife, the former Toni Purvis of Williamston, N.C. The couple has two children, Nola and Holden.

**About The Privateers**

The Privateers heads to Pullman, Wash., 3-3 on the young season and riding the crest of a two-game winning streak after using a strong second half to defeat Florida College 90-63 on Nov. 25 and posting a coast-to-coast, 74-59 win over Tulane on Nov. 29. Both of those games were played in Lakefront Arena.

As a team, New Orleans is averaging 76.8 points, 37.8 rebounds, 16.8 assists, 9.2 steals and 3.5 blocks per game. Senior forward Erik Thomas leads the Privateers offensively with 21.7 points per game, followed by senior guards Christavious Gill with an average of 13.8 and Tevin Broyles with a mark of 8.5. Thomas also paces the team with 7.0 rebounds a night with Gill leading the way with 4.0 assists and 1.8 steals per outing. Junior forward Makur Puou headlines the defense with 1.8 blocked shots per contest.

New Orleans is connecting at a .455 clip from the field, hitting 162-of-356 shots from the floor and 31-of-92 tries from beyond the 3-point arc (.337), while allowing opponents to shoot .449 overall (170-of-379) and .346 from 3-point land (46-of-133). Privateer foes are averaging 78.5 points, 36.2 rebounds, 14.2 assists, 9.7 steals and 4.0 blocks so far in 2016-17.

**About The Cougars**

Washington State enters the ballgame 4-3 on the season and looking build on the momentum of an 83-76 win over Utah Valley on Wednesday night in Beasley Coliseum. The Cougars have been especially sharp at home, going 3-1 to date with their only loss being an 88-76 defeat at the hands of San Jose State on Nov. 27.

As a team, the Wazzu is averaging 78.9 points, 38.9 rebounds, 13.4 assists, 3.1 steals and 4.1 blocks per game. Josh Hawkins leads a balanced Washington State offense with 17.0 points per game while Malachi Flynn, Conor Clifford and Ike Iroegbu follow with respective scoring averages of 13.4, 11.0 and 10.9. Hawkins also paces the team with 12.4 rebounds and 1.4 blocks per game, and shares team-high steal honors with Charles Callison at 0.7 thefts per outing apiece. Iroegbu leads the Cougars in assists with 3.1 dimes per outing.

Washington State is hitting 47.3 percent of its shots from the field, connecting on 185-of-391 field goal attempts, including a 38-of-109 showing from beyond the 3-point line (.349). The Cougar defense has allowed opponents to post a 41.4 shooting percentage (202-of-488) and a 33.7 clip from 3-point land (67-of-199) and their foes are averaging 79.9 points, 38.0 rebounds, 14.7 assists, 5.0 steals and 1.7 blocks per game.

**Series History**

Saturday's game between New Orleans and Washington State marks the first-ever meeting between the two teams on the hardwood. The Cougars are the second Pac 12 program the Privateers face this season and UNO will be looking for its first win against the league in 2016-17 after dropping an 88-54 decision at Southern Cal on Nov. 22.

The Privateers are now 4-11 against team's currently in the Pac-12 Conference, including a 2-8 mark when playing that league's opponents on their own court. In addition to a now 1-1 showing against USC, UNO is 1-1 vs Colorado, 1-2 vs Arizona State, 1-4 vs Oregon State and 0-3 vs Arizona.

**First-Time Foes**

Saturday's game at Washington State is the last of four games the Privateers will play this season against a program it has never faced before. UNO is 2-1 in those games so far with a 103-67 victory over LaGrange College on Nov. 11 in Lakefront Arena, a 77-68 loss at Tulsa on Nov. 19 and a 90-63 home win over Florida College on Nov. 25.

The Cougars will officially become the 273rd team to take on New Orleans in basketball and the Privateers now sport a 187-85 record when taking on an opponent for the very first time.

**UNO On The Tube**

Of the Privateers' 29 regular-season games, 11 will be carried into homes around the world as the University of New Orleans men's basketball team will be broadcast on six different networks during the 2016-17 season, including Saturday's road game against Washington State on the Pac 12 Networks.

The Privateers have already played four televised games and are looking to improve on a 1-3 mark in a broadcast contest as UNO posted a 74-59 home win over Tulane on Tuesday night in a game carried on Cox Sports Television while falling 117-72 at Oklahoma State on Nov. 16 in a game carried by Fox Sports Southwest Plus, 77-68 at Tulsa on Nov. 19 in a game aired on ESPN3 and 88-54 at Southern California on Nov. 22 in a showdown televised on the Pac-12 Networks.

In addition, the Privateers will play four times on ESPN3 during road games at Lamar on Jan. 5, at Stephen F. Austin on Jan. 28 and at Southeastern Louisiana on Feb. 11, in addition to Nov. 19's game at Tulsa, and will play on Cox Sports Television on Dec. 17 when they host Louisiana-Lafayette in Lakefront Arena. Other networks that will carry the Privateers this year are the Big Ten Network (Dec. 11 at Northwestern) and Mountain West Network (Dec. 19 at Utah State).

**Opening 3-0 At Home**

With wins over LaGrange, Florida College and Tulane so far in Lakefront Arena, New Orleans opened is 3-0 at home to open the year for the third-consecutive season and the 24th time in program history. The Privateers have won their first three home games four times under head coach Mark Slessinger, including a 4-0 start in 2014-15. UNO has twice won every home game, going 16-0 in both 1970-71 and 1986-87.



**What's The Difference**

Through the early portion of the 2016-17 season, the biggest difference between wins and losses has been location as UNO is 3-0 at home and 0-3 on the road. A closer look at the statistics, however, reveal a very large disparity in production at nearly every level between victories and defeats.

The biggest difference statistically, obviously, comes in the overall point total as the Privateers are averaging 24.3 more points in the three wins while allowing 31.0 less points in those games. In fact, UNO has improved stats in all but three categories in the wins vs losses as New Orleans has a slightly lower 3-point and free throw percentage while also averaging 1.0 fewer blocks per game in wins than losses. **Thibodeaux On A Tear**

Junior forward Travin Thibodeaux has been at his best over the last two games as the 6-9 native of Plaquemine, La., is averaging 12.0 points, 9.0 rebounds, 8.0 assists, 3.5 steals and 0.5 blocks per game while shooting 60.0 percent from the field with nine makes in 15 attempts.

During UNO's 90-63 win over Florida College on Nov. 25, he posted a triple-double with 10 points, 10 rebounds and 11 assists to go with six steals and a block. For an encore, Thibodeaux tallied 14 oints, eight rebounds, five dimes and a theft.

Thibodeaux's triple-double against the Falcons was just the third in UNO history and the first since Dec. 5, 2009, when Carl Blair had 13 points, 10 rebounds and 11 assists against Houston Baptist. The only other 3-dub in the program's annals belongs to All-American Ervin Johnson, who had 16 points, 10 rebounds and 12 blocks against Texas A&M on Dec. 29, 1992.

**The 20-Point Plateau**

Over the first five seasons under head coach Mark Slessinger, New Orleans had individual players score 20-plus points in a single contest on 42 total occasions for an average of 8.4 per season.

Through six games so far in 2016-17, the Privateers have done so a half dozen times already thanks to four 20-plus-point performances by senior forward Erik Thomas and two by senior guard Christavious Gill.

During his initial Division I campaign, Thomas never cracked the 20-point mark, but broke out in a big way with a career-high (all levels) 31 points in the season opener vs LaGrange College on Nov. 11. In addition, Thomas scored 20 both at Tulsa on Nov. 18 and at Southern California on Nov. 22 while adding 23 vs Florida College on Nov. 25. The only games he has not score 20 in this season was at Oklahoma State on Nov. 16 and at home vs Tulane on Nov. 29 when he fell one bucket shy of the feat with 18 in both outings. Gill, who now has 11 career games with 20 or more points, had a season-best 23 at Tulsa and added 20 against Florida College.

**Going On A Run**

The 2016-17 New Orleans squad has shown the ability to go on sizeable runs as the Privateers score 10-plus points in a row on six occasions during the first five games of the season. The biggest runs were 12-0 performances against both LaGrange College (Nov. 11) and Florida College (Nov. 25) while the longest in terms of time was a 3:13 stretch against LaGrange.

Twice, UNO's double-digit runs broke tied ballgames as the boys in royal blue and silver used a 10-0 streak to take a 36-26 lead in the season opener vs LaGrange and broke a 42-all deadlock against Florida College on Friday night with a 12-0 run. The Privateers have enjoyed a large luxury in each of the last two games as New Orleans never trailed in its wins over both Florida College and Tulane. During UNO's 90-63 victory over the Falcons on Nov. 25, the game was tied just once - at 42-42 with 15:18 left to play - only to see the Privateers go on a 12-0 run en route to a lopsided win. On Tuesday night against Tulane, New Orleans scored the first five points and 14 of the first 16 and never looked back.

**NEW ORLEANS**—Four Privateers posted double-digit scoring totals – including a 14-point, eight-round, five-assist effort by Travin Thibodeaux – as New Orleans rolled past cross-town rival Tulane, 74-59, in Lakefront Arena.

As a team, UNO shot 47.8 percent from the field (22-of-46), including a 12-of-22 performance (.545) in the second half while holding the Green Wave to a .364 clip (24-of-66). The win was the Privateers second in a row and the third in as many as home contests so far on the young season to even their record at 3-3.

New Orleans held a commanding 41-27 rebounding advantage and shot 34 free throws with 27 makes (.794) to Tulane's 11. The Privateers managed just three 3-pointers, but held the Green Wave to a 26.3 percent showing from beyond the arc (5-of-19). The win snapped a three-game, head-to-head skid vs. Tulane and marked UNO's first victory in the series since a 51-50 decision on Dec. 2, 2009, across town in Devlin Fieldhouse.

Erik Thomas led the Privateers with 18 points, followed by Thibodeaux and Christavious Gill with 14 apiece. Michael Zeno provided a spark off the bench for UNO with 11 points, after sinking 3-of-4 field goals and all five free throw tries, and shared the team lead in rebounding with eight boards of his own. Thibodeaux paced the Privateers in assists while Gill tallied four dimes to go with a team-leading five steals. Makur Puou led all players defensively with three blocked shots.

The Privateers came out of the gates on fire, draining five of their first seven shots and holding the Green Wave to a 1-for-8 showing from the field over the first five-plus minutes to race out to a 12-2 lead. Tulane whittled the lead down to five at 16-11 with 8:11 to play in the first half, but UNO responded with an 11-1 run over the next 3:46 to go ahead by 15. The Privateers' first-half leads swelled to as many as 18 at 33-15 with 1:31 remaining in the stanza and the home team went into the locker room at the break on top, 34-17.

Tulane opened the second half with a 9-5 run to get to within 13, but UNO answered with five straight points and the led never dipped below 16 until the waning seconds of the contest. The Privateers extended the lead to 20 on a 3-pointer by Cameron Reed to make it 57-37 with 7:48 to play and the advantage got to as many as 27 at 66-39 at the 5:59 mark. Tulane actually outscored New Orleans 10-8 the rest of the way, but the game had long since been decided.

**UNO In The Arena**

Through the first six games of the 2016-17 season, the Privateers have lived by the memorable line of Dorothy Gale in The Wizard of Oz as there really has been no place like home. At 3-3 to date, all three of UNO's wins have come in Lakefront Arena and the team has now won four straight in the facility dating back to a 97-86 victory over Northwestern State on March 5, 2016, in last year's regular-season finale.

Since the completion of Lakefront Arena for the 1983-84 season, New Orleans is now 307-99 on its home court. Under sixth-year head coach Mark Slessinger, UNO is 43-20 in the facility.

**Puou In The Post**

In his first season in a Privateer uniform, junior forward Makur Puou has had his ups and downs on the offensive end and on the glass, but one thing he has done from day one has been a rim protector. Through six games so far in 2016-17, the 6-9 native of Rumbek, South Sudan, leads the team with 11 blocks. His swat total ranks 90th in the nation and his 1.8 blocks per game sits 77th among NCAA Division I student-athletes.

He has three multiple-block performances to date, including a season-best five at Oklahoma State on Nov. 16. His performance against the Cowboys stands as the most blocks by a UNO student-athlete since Kevin Hill had seven at Texas A&M-Corpus Christi on Jan. 25, 2014, and ranks as the tied for the 11th most in UNO single-game history.

Prior to joining the Privateers, Puou posted 25 blocked shots at Vincennes University as a freshman in 2014-15 and followed that up with a 76-stuff effort as a sophomore last season en route to claiming honorable-mention NJCAA All-America honors. He now has 112 blocks for his career.

**Gill Hits Scoring Milestone**

While senior guard Christavious Gill's accomplishments have been well documented during his time on the Lakefront, the 2013 graduate of Alexandria (La.) High School entered rare air during the season-opening 103-67 win vs LaGrange College with 13 point join the University of New Orleans' 1,000-Point Club.

Gill is now the 22nd player in UNO men's basketball history to reach four digits offensively and is the first Privateer to reach 1,000 points since Bo McCalebb (2,679 from 2003-08). McCalebb reached the 1,000-point plateau as a sophomore in 2004-05 after scoring 406 points as a true freshman and 679 the following season. With 70 points over the last five games, Gill currently ranks 18th in UNO history with 1,070 points. At his current pace, Gill would complete the 2016-17 regular season with 1,387 career points - a number that would rank sixth in the Privateer record book.

**Don't Forget About Me**

Christavious Gill may be the University of New Orleans' most recent member of the 1,000-Point club, but fellow senior Erik Thomas did the same for his career during UNO's Nov. 16 contest at Oklahoma State. With 130 points so far this season, he has now scored 1,095 points during his collegiate career - 471 of which have come in a Privateer uniform.

A native of Wesley Chapel, Fla., Thomas is in his second season with the Privateers after playing at East Georgia State in 2013-14 and at Baton Rouge Community College in 2014-15.

As a rookie he scored 124 points in 29 games (4.3 ppg) before enjoying a breakout campaign as a sophomore when he scored 500 in 28 contests (17.9 ppg). During his inaugural Division I season last year, Thomas finished second on the squad with 341 points in 29 outings (11.8 ppg) to bring his career total to 965. In six games so far in what will be his final collegiate campaign, Thomas leads the team with a 21.7 scoring average.

**The 100-Point Plateau**

The Privateers have been on both sides of a 100-point performance so far this season as New Orleans opened the 2016-17 year with a 103-67 win over LaGrange College on Nov. 11 in Lakefront Arena before falling at Oklahoma State, 117-72, on Nov. 16 in Stillwater, Okla.

The 100-point plateau has been key to the Privateers and their opponents alike since the inception of the program in 1969-70. The win over LaGrange marked the 69th time the University of New Orleans men's basketball team scored at least 100 points in a contest and is 65-4 when that happens.

While the Privateers sport a 94.2 winning percentage when hitting triple digits, UNO foes are 26-2 (.929) when scoring 100. The only two games the squad from the Lakefront won when the opponent scored 100 or more points came when the Privateers did the same: 130-109 vs Chicago State on Dec. 31, 1973 and 110-100 in triple overtime vs Louisiana Tech on Feb. 3, 1990.

Under sixth-year head coach Mark Slessinger, UNO is 6-0 when scoring 100 points and 0-6 when giving up the century mark.

## Preseason Prognostications

The Privateers will enter the 2016-17 season looking to prove some people wrong as the University of New Orleans was picked in the lower half of both preseason polls released by the Southland Conference on Oct. 27. In the coaches poll, UNO was picked to finish ninth in the 13-team league with 63 total points while the conference's sports information directors have the Privateers slated for a 10th-place showing courtesy of 62 points.

Sam Houston State was picked to win the conference in both polls, edging four-time defending SLC champion Stephen F. Austin by a combined three points in the voting. Below is a complete look at both the coach's and sports information director's preseason polls:

## Gill Claims Preseason Honors

In what has been a career highlighted by program firsts, rising senior guard Christavious Gill became the first Privateer since the University of New Orleans joined the Southland Conference prior to the 2013-14 season to claim a spot on the Preseason All-SLC Team as the native of Alexandria, La., was tabbed second-team all-conference on a vote of league head coaches.

An honorable-mention selection as a sophomore and third-team honoree as a junior, Gill paced the Privateers in points (444), points per game (14.8), field goals made (140), 3-point baskets (64), steals (57), free throw percentage (.833), minutes played (907) and minutes per game (30.2) last season while ranking second in assists (83) and free throws made (100), and fourth in 3-point percentage (.346) to go with 2.5 rebounds per game.

## Coming Soon To A Gym Near You

While the 2016-17 season is barely underway, the University of New Orleans men's basketball team added four players for next year as guards Lamont Berzat and Damion Rosser, wing Tyren Harrison and post Bol Reik inked National Letters of Intent with the program during the NCAA's 2016 Early Signing Period. Below is a quick breakdown of each signee:

### Lamont Berzat (5-6 • 150 • New Orleans, La. • Landry Walker HS)

- In three seasons to date at Landry-Walker, helped the team post a combined 77-25 overall record, three consecutive District 8-5A titles and a trio of trips to the playoffs – including state championships as a freshman and sophomore
- As a junior last season, claimed honorable-mention all-state and All-Metro honors after averaging 13.2 points, 3.1 rebounds, 5.1 assists and 3.1 steals per game

### Tyren Harrison (6-6 • 195 • St. Albans, N.Y. • Western Oklahoma State College)

- Following a stellar prep career at Queens and Riverside Christian Academy, averaged 11.4 points, 5.6 rebounds and 0.7 blocks per game as a true freshman in 2014-15
- As a sophomore last season, earned honorable-mention NJCAA All-America, first-team All-Region II and first-team all-conference recognition after logging 485 points (18.7 ppg), 221 rebounds (8.5 rpg), 37 assists (1.4 apg), 34 steals (1.3 spg) and 28 blocks (1.1 bpg)

### Bol Reik (7-3 • 219 • Bentiu, South Sudan • Mooseheart [Ill.] HS)

- Has not played at the prep level as the Illinois High School Athletic Association restricted eligibility of international students
- Last summer with Indiana Elite, scored 64 points (4.6 ppg), pulled down 70 rebounds (5.0 rpg), handed out nine assists (0.6 apg) and blocked eight shots (0.6 bpg) in 14 games – 12 in Gauntlet Series action and two at the Summer Championship level

### Damion Rosser (6-4 • 190 • McDonough, Ga. • Henry County HS)

- Rated the No. 31 shooting guard in Georgia by HoopSeen.com and was named an "Under The Radar Senior" by SanysSpeil.com prior to the 2016-17 campaign
- As a junior last season, claimed first-team All-Region 4-4A, first-team all-county and honorable-mention All-Southside recognition after averaging 20.2 points, 7.9 rebounds, 7.5 assists and 1.7 blocks per game.

**UNO Rolls Past LaGrange In 17-Opener**

Privateers pick up first road win in 64-51 victory over Braves

**NEW ORLEANS**—Erik Thomas posted a double-double with 10 rebounds to accompany a career-high 31 points as New Orleans posted a resounding season-opening 103-67 victory over LaGrange College in Lakefront Arena.

The two teams sat deadlocked at 26-all with 7:51 to play in the first half before Thomas rattled off 10-consecutive points to stake the Privateers to a 36-26 advantage they would not relinquish. The victory marked the first time a New Orleans team reached triple digits in a season opener since 2005-06 when the program posted a 103-69 victory over Belhaven on Nov. 19, 2005, in a game played in UT-Tyler's Patriot Center in the aftermath of Hurricane Katrina.

Neither team could establish control of the game early on as the first 12-plus minutes featured four ties and five lead changes before Thomas' 10-point rally, which included three baskets after turnovers he forced and another bucket after pulling down an offensive rebound. LaGrange got to within six twice in the latter portions of the stanza but the Privateers closed out the half on an 8-2 run capped by a Danny Cohen 3-pointer with 11 seconds to go before the break.

That basket sparked a 12-0 UNO run that spanned the two periods and 13-2 run midway through the frame to go ahead by as many as 40 at 90-50 with 6:07 to play. A big reason for the surge was the team's effort from beyond the 3-point arc as the Privateers went 6-of-11 from downtown after intermission with Christavious Gill going 2-for-2 and Coleman Edwards sinking two of his three tries from deep. The Panthers actually outscored the home team 17-13 the rest of the way, but the game had long since been decided.

**Privateers Can't Slow Oklahoma State**

New Orleans falls in Stillwater, 117-72; bench scores 46 points

**STILLWATER, Okla.**—New Orleans got off to a slow start and had a hard time slowing time a red-hot Oklahoma State squad as the Privateers dropped a 117-72 decision to the homestanding Cowboys in Gallagher-Iba Arena.

OSU scored the game's first six points, 14 of the first 20, and 20 of the first 30 as the advantage simply swelled as the game progressed. Things got better for the Privateers in the second half, but the early deficit proved to be too much to overcome.

As a team, the Privateers shot 43.3 percent from the field (26-of-60) and 35.7 percent from beyond the 3-point arc (5-of-14), but 23 turnovers proved costly as the Cowboys turned those miscues into 31 points. The Cowboys, however, held a 47-29 rebounding advantage and turned 15 offensive boards into 20 second-chance points.

The Privateers missed their first five shots before Christavious Gill converted a layup to make it 6-2 just under three minutes into the contest. Oklahoma State claimed a double-digit lead at 18-8 with 15:13 to play, and following a basket by Travin Thibodeaux the next time down the floor, the Cowboys used runs of 9-2 and 13-4 to establish the tone for the rest of game.

Trailing 68-36 at the break, UNO had a more efficient performance in the second half but could not find a way to slow down the Cowboys' attack. Oklahoma State's lead grew to as many as 48 twice in the final minutes of the ballgame before Venjie Wallis connected on a free throw and A.J. Cheeseman scored on a put-back layup over the final 53 seconds to account for the final score.

**New Orleans Falls At Tulsa, 77-68**

Christavious Gill scores 23, Erik Thomas adds 20 in the loss

**TULSA, Okla.**—Christavious Gill and Erik Thomas combined for 43 points and the Privateers scored 21 points off 18 Golden Hurricane turnovers, but it was not enough as New Orleans dropped a 77-68 decision at Tulsa in the Donald W. Reynolds Center.

With the score knotted at 34-all at the end of the first half, UNO scored the first points of the final stanza on a Travin Thibodeaux bucket only to see Tulsa go on an 8-2 run to take a 42-36 lead it would not relinquish. The Golden Hurricane advantage swelled to as many as 15 at 59-44 with 8:39 left to play and the Privateers were able to whittle the deficit down to five twice down the stretch. Tulsa's Sterling Taplin, however, buried a 3-pointer each time to keep New Orleans at arms' reach the rest of the way.

The Privateers opened the game on an 8-0 run and led by as many as 12 following a Gill trey to make it 23-11 with 11:15 to play before the break. From there, Tulsa went on a 7-0 run to cut the lead to five and got it down to one at 27-26 on a Pat Birt bucket with 3:57 on the clock and tied the game just before the break on a Taplin as the horn sounded to signal the break.

After Thibodeaux's jumper to open the second half, the Privateers missed 12 of their next 14 shots and committed seven turnovers over the next 10-plus minutes to aid in Tulsa's game-deciding run. Down by 15, UNO got four consecutive points by Thomas and a layup from Gill to get it down to nine at the 6:51 mark. The two teams traded points over the next two and a half minutes before a Gill 3-pointer and a layup by Michael Zeno made it 68-63 with 3:09 to play.

Taplin's first rally-answering trey was matched by another Gill 3-pointer, but Tulsa quieted any talks of UNO coming all the way back with a free throw by T.K. Edogi, another Taplin 3 and a Jaleel Wheeler free throw to stretch the lead back to double figures with 46 seconds remaining.

**LOS ANGELES**—Erik Thomas scored 20 points with eight field goals and a perfect 4-of-4 performance from the free throw line, but Southern California countered with a balanced, efficient attack as New Orleans dropped an 88-54 decision to the host Trojans at the Galen Center.

UNO hung tough early on and trailed by one at 12-11 just over five minutes into the contest before USC scored 15 unanswered to take control of the game. The Trojans entered the game hitting just 38.0 percent of their field goals and 25.7 percent of their 3-pointers, but enjoyed a breakout performance against the Privateers with a .492 overall clip (31-of-63) and a .440 showing from downtown (11-of-25).

The two teams traded the first eight points of the ballgame before USC used an 8-4 run to go by four 4:48 into the ballgame. A 3-pointer by Jorge Rosa cut the deficit to one before the Privateers went without a point over the next six-plus minutes. During that stretch, the Trojans went 6-of-9 from the field, including a pair of 3-pointers and a free throw, to take a 27-11 advantage.

A Thomas basket ended the UNO drought but, while the Privateers connected on five of their next nine shots, Southern Cal continued to build on its lead and held a 19-point edge at 42-23 to set up another Thomas bucket to make it 42-25 at halftime.

It was more of the same in the second half as a Thomas layup cut the deficit to 15 before the Trojans went on a 20-5 run to take a commanding 61-34 lead. USC continued to stretch its lead as the game progressed and were up by as many as 35 at 88-53 with 1:02 left to play and allowed just a free throw by Rosa the rest of the way to account for the final score.

**Thibodeaux Leads UNO Past Falcons**  
Forward posts triple-double in 90-63 win over Florida College

**NEW ORLEANS**—Travin Thibodeaux posted a triple-double with 10 points, 10 rebounds and a career-high 11 assists as New Orleans defeated Florida College, 90-63, in Lakefront Arena.

The Privateers never trailed at any point during the ballgame, but the Falcons rallied from 10-point deficits to cut the UNO lead to five twice late in the first half. Florida College came all the way back to tie the score at 42-41:08 into the final stanza, but New Orleans settled down to rattle off 12 in a row and extended the lead as the game progressed.

The Privateers got off to a good start as UNO hit layups the first three times down the court to go up 6-0. The Falcons hung tough and later turned a nine-point deficit into a three-point ballgame at 13-10 with 12:44 to play. New Orleans used a 16-9 run over the next 7:45 to go ahead by double figures and the lead remained 10 at 31-21 with 4:18 to go before the break. Florida College refused to go away and whittled the deficit down to five twice and the UNO clung to a 38-31 halftime lead.

Including a 3-pointer by Darian Dunham with 45 seconds to play in the first half, Florida College used a 14-4 to tie the game at 42-42 at the first media timeout of the second stanza. From there, however, Thibodeaux sparked UNO's game-deciding run with an assist on a Thomas bucket and connected on 3-of-4 free throws to stake the Privateers to a five-point lead they would not relinquish.

A trey by Eddie Moralobo cut the UNO lead to nine, but that was the last time the score got to within single digits as UNO scored the next four points. The two teams traded buckets the next three times up and down the court, but Puou sparked a 15-2 UNO run over the next four-plus minutes to make it a 25-point ballgame and the Falcons never got closer than 22 the rest of the way.

**New Orleans Downs Tulane, 74-59**  
Four Privateers score in double figures; improve to 3-0 at home

**NEW ORLEANS**—Four Privateers posted double-digit scoring totals – including a 14-point, eight-round, five-assist effort by Travin Thibodeaux – as New Orleans rolled past cross-town rival Tulane, 74-59, in Lakefront Arena.

New Orleans held a commanding 41-27 rebounding advantage and shot 34 free throws with 27 makes (.794) to Tulane's 11. The Privateers managed just three 3-pointers, but held the Green Wave to a 26.3 percent showing from beyond the arc (5-of-19). The win snapped a three-game, head-to-head skid against Tulane and marked UNO's first victory in the series since a 51-50 decision on Dec. 2, 2009, across town in Devlin Fieldhouse.

The Privateers came out of the gates on fire, draining five of their first seven shots and holding the Green Wave to a 1-for-8 showing from the field over the first five-plus minutes to race out to a 12-2 lead. Tulane whittled the lead down to five at 16-11 with 8:11 to play in the first half, but UNO responded with an 11-1 run over the next 3:46 to go ahead by 15. The Privateers' first-half leads swelled to as many as 18 at 33-15 with 1:31 remaining in the stanza and the home team went into the locker room at the break on top, 34-17.

Tulane opened the second half with a 9-5 run to get to within 13, but UNO answered with five straight points and the lead never dipped below 16 until the waning seconds of the contest. The Privateers extended the lead to 20 on a 3-pointer by sophomore guard Cameron Reed to make it 57-37 with 7:48 to play and the advantage got to as many as 27 at 66-39 at the 5:59 mark. Tulane actually outscored New Orleans 10-8 the rest of the way, but the game had long since been decided.

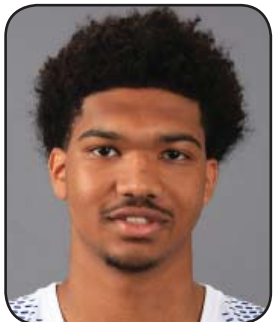
