FIRST PITCH

- Chris Turpin struck out 14 batters in the Privateers' lone win against McNeese and won Southland Pitcher of the Week honors. It was the most strikeouts by a UNO pitcher since 3/30/18 (Bryan Warzek-16).
- The Privateers have drawn 10 or more walks three times this season with the latest occurrence against Tulane on Apr. 16. New Orleans has won all three of those games.
- New Orleans has not lost a Tuesday game this season (6-0).
- Head Coach Blake Dean secured his 100th win at New Orleans against the Ragin' Cajuns on 3/2. Five of those wins have come against nationally ranked schools.
- Collin Morrill became the first Privateer to hit a grand slam this season on 4/16. The last UNO grand slam was against Tulane on 3/6/18 (Jay Robinson).
- With the win in the middle game of the series, the Privateers broke a 17-game losing streak against the Cowboys.
- The Privateers are 9-2 this season when they collect more hits than an opponent.

TURN OUT THE LIGHTS

Reeves Martin locked down his tenth save of the season against Tulane. Martin has 38 strikeouts to six walks in 22.0 innings worked. His saves total ranked fifth in the country heading into the weekend.

HOME RUN BINGE

The Privateers have hit 16 home runs since Mar. 26 (14 games). In the first 23 games of the season, New Orleans had just nine home runs. Pearce Howard has hit four homers in that stretch and leads the team with five for the year.

BALLINBAILEY

Bailey Holstein has been on a roll of late on the mound. The redshirt junior held McNeese scoreless over 5.2 innings in his last outing. Holstein has thrown 11.0 straight scoreless innings entering the week. In that stretch, he's lowered his ERA from 6.11 to 4.42.

SHOW ME

New Orleans is 14-7 all time against schools from the Show Me State. The Privateers' record against Missouri schools are as follows: Missouri-St. Louis (5-0), Missouri (5-2), Culver-Stockton (2-0), Central Missouri State (1-0), Saint Louis (1-0), SEMO (0-4), Missouri State (0-1).

NO BLANKS

It's been 107 games since the Privateers were last shut out (May 13, 2017 against Nicholls). That is currently the third longest streak without getting shut out in program history. The top five streaks (with start and end dates) are as follows:

MAY I ASSIST YOU

Two outfielders have at least five outfield assists this season: Luther Woullard leads the team with six while Tresten Kennard has added five outfield helpers this season. The Privateers are also tied for second in the conference in double plays turned with 29.

THIS NOTE BROUGHT TO YOU BY THE NUMBER 18

The state of Missouri is the 18th most populous state in the U.S. Louisiana was the 18th state admitted to the union. The Privateers come into this weekend with a total of 18 wins. The series will begin on the 18th of April.

PRIVATEERS IN THE PROS

Bryan Warzek and Kyle Arjona became the latest former Privateers to play professionally. The two join Shawn Semple who was drafted in 2017 and is currently in the Yankees' system. Warzek was drafted by the Dodgers in the sixth round in 2018 while Arjona signed a contract with the Phillies in late July.

TEAMMATES AGAIN

A new look outfield also brings two new Privateers from the same place. Tresten Kennard and Wade Raburn were teammates at Odessa Junior College before transferring to New Orleans. Kennard hit .394 with 15 homers and 74 RBI last year. Raburn swung a hot bat as well for Odessa, checking in with a .384 batting average.

AWARDS A PLENTY

Since Blake Dean assumed the head coaching job in 2016, the Privateers have had multiple players represented on the All-Southland list each year. New Orleans has had 11 selections to the Southland Postseason Team and seven more honorable mentions. Two players have earned All-Region Honors and seven have earned recognition from the Louisiana Sports Writers Association.

BREW CREW

Ryan Brewer is in his second year as a student assistant with the Privateers. Brewer is one of two coaches on the staff (Rudy Darrow) who had prior Southland experience before coming to the Lakefront. Brewer started his collegiate career at Nicholls. The Norco native also coached the New Orleans Boosters to the AAABA Championship in 2017.

YOU MUST BE NEW HERE

This season's schedule featured four opponents whom the Privateers played for the first time in program history. Michigan State, Yale, Butler, and Rutgers have never played New Orleans in the 48-year history of the program. The Privateers went 5-3 in those games.

INTERNATIONAL FLAVOR

Jorge Tejeda (Villa Clara, Cuba) becomes the first international student-athlete in the Blake Dean era. The Privateers have not had a player on the roster with a hometown outside the U.S. since 2013 (Cameron Glendinning).

HERE'S JOHNNY

Johnny Giavotella joins the Privateers' coaching staff for the 2019 season. The former Privateer standout played professionally for a decade. He played at the Major League level for three different teams: Royals, Angels, Orioles. Giavotella ranks in the top ten in program history in nine offensive categories.

RUDY RUDY RUDY

Pitching coach Rudy Darrow guided the Privateers to a single season high in strikeouts in 2018 (580). The Oklahoma native has also spent time as a pitching coach at Nicholls and Oklahoma. Darrow was drafted in 2006 and went on to pitch in 113 games in his professional career.

CLOSE TO HOME

Of the Privateers' 56 games in 2019, 44 will take place in the state of Louisiana. New Orleans' longest trip this year will be 679 miles when they travel to Missouri State from April 18-20.

FALL TUNE UP

The Privateers played two exhibition games against LSU in the fall. The first was a scheduled 14-inning game with a pitch limit per inning. The Privateers won that game 8-7. The second at Maestri Field was a nine-inning affair that finished in a 3-3 tie. Luther Woullard homered in the first game in Baton Rouge and had two hits in the second game.

HIGH REGARD

Bryan Warzek was drafted in the sixth round with the 194th overall pick by the Los Angeles Dodgers. It was the third highest spot a Privateer has been drafted in since 1994. Johnny Giavotella was a second round selection (2008) and Thomas Diamond was picked in the first round (2004). After etching his name in the Privateer record books in strikeouts, Warzek struck out 38 batters in 22.1 innings during his first professional season.

SUP BRO

While Pearce Howard was busy tearing the cover off the ball in his first season as a Privateer, his brother, Corey is also in the Division I baseball ranks. Corey is entering his senior year with Gardner-Webb in 2019. Corey hit .290 last season in 35 games played. He came out of high school as the second ranked pitcher in Maryland by Perfect Game.

SCOUTING THE COMPETITION

MISSOURI STATE

- Keith Guttin has obtained legendary status in Springfield. Guttin is in his 37th season at the helm of the Bears and has 1,270 wins to date. Heading into this season, Guttin was fifth among active head coaches in career victories behind Mike Martin (Florida State), Mike Fox (North Carolina), Paul Mainieri (LSU), and John Anderson (Minnesota). He has been part of the program in some capacity for 41 years.

- The Bears are coming off their most recent NCAA Regional appearance, the 11th in school history, last season after winning 40 games. They went to Oxford, Miss. where they went 1-2, getting eliminated by Tennessee Tech. Missouri State won the regular season and postseason Missouri Valley title.

- Missouri State's back-to-back regional appearances garnered attention in June as well. Nine players have been drafted the last two years with two going in the top two rounds. Jake Burger was a first round selection of the Chicago White Sox (2017) while Jeremy Eierman was picked in the second round by the Oakland Athletics. Dylan Coleman was selected in the fourth round of last summer's draft by the San Diego Padres.

- It has been a tough road for the Bears this season who come in at 11-25. They have played seven games against nationally ranked opponents (Cal St. Fullerton, UC Irvine, UCSB, and Arkansas). The Bears are 0-7 in those games. They have also played only 10 games at home before this weekend.

- Missouri State beat the Privateers in the only meeting between the two sides. The Bears won 7-2 on Mar. 21 of that season. The only current Bears who were in the starting lineup that night are Drew Millas, Logan Geha, and Jack Duffy. On the Privateers side, only one starter from that night (Darren Willis) played against Missouri State.

- Currently, the Bears sit in sixth out of the eight-team MVC at 4-5 in conference play. Missouri State is ahead of Southern Illinois and Valparaiso. Their next conference series will be against Bradley who sits in fifth place. Illinois State and Evansville are tied for the league lead.

- Dakota Kotowski has only started 21 of the Bears' 36 games but he leads the team in home runs with seven. He has 10 RBI on the year and is hitting .286. He and Jack Duffy are the only two Bears with a batting average above .250.

- Jake Lochner will get the ball to start the series on Thursday. Lochner is two starts removed from an 11-strikeout performance against Southern Illinois. He has 23 strikeouts in 23.2 innings since being moved into a starting role in late March.

- Connor Sechler has all three of the team's saves this season. Sechler has allowed just 22 hits in 34.0 innings and opponents are hitting only .188 off him. He also has 42 strikeouts and has allowed just three extra base hits (two doubles, one home run).

COACH'S CORNER

Missouri State

"Bailey has done pretty well. We started him off in the bullpen and it's something where we think he throws strikes and gives us a chance. We felt it was time especially out of conference to see what he can do and maybe help change this season for us."

"Missouri State has had some big time players come through the past few years and Coach Guttin has been there a long time. To be anywhere for a long time means you have to have some success. Two of their weekend arms have been hurt and it just changes the dynamic of a team."

"We know what our bullpen can do. I just want to see some consistency. I'm curious to see what our starting arms can do and see if we can win a few games in a row."

HEAD COACH BLAKE DEAN

Blake Dean was named the University of New Orleans' seventh head coach in its 48 year history during the summer of 2015 following a brief stint as the school's interim head coach.

After taking over for Ron Maestri who retired following his second stint as Privateers head coach, Dean has continued the rebuild. In 2018, New Orleans reached their first conference championship game in 10 years and they did it as the lowest seed (8) in the Southland Tournament.

Three Privateers were named to the All-Tournament Team: Beau Bratton, Orynn Veillon, and Kyle Arjona. In his first three seasons, New Orleans has seen 11 players named to the All-Southland postseason team. Seven more have earned honorable mention.

Last year was also a breakout season for the pitching staff. The 580 strikeouts was the most in a single season in program history, smashing the previous record of 511 (set in 2002).

In 2017, the Privateers won 30 games and qualified for the Southland Tournament for the second consecutive season. New Orleans was one of the last four teams remaining before being eliminated by eventual champion, Sam Houston State.

In 2016, the Privateers' 31-26 record marked the first winning record for the baseball program since 2008 and qualified for the Southland Conference for the first time since joining the league prior to the 2013-14 academic year. In his first season at the helm, UNO saw a 17-game turnaround, the eighth-best in Division I in 2016, while the team was one of 17 to increase their winning percentage by .200, boasting the fourth-highest improvement.

The Privateers set eight-year highs in batting average (.300), total hits (600), doubles (77), on base percentage (.368) and fielding percentage (.966) saves (15), and strikeouts (400) in that span.

Nationally, UNO finished eighth in triples per game with a 0.44 average and 10th in total triples with 25 while Dakota Dean cracked the top 25 individually with six on the season, the 22nd-most. UNO's resurrected offense led the Southland Conference in triples, while finishing second in in hits, batting average, third in RBI, fewest batters struck out (328) and fourth in slugging percentage (.416).

During his time on the Lakefront, Dean was instrumental in Capielano and Randolph claiming Freshman All-America status in 2014 while helping several Privateer hitters improve their production at the plate.

Highlights on the diamond, however, are nothing new for Dean as the native of Crestview, Florida, has experienced success at every stop of his baseball career to date.

As a prepster at Crestview High, Dean was a four-year all-state honoree and was a member of the USA Baseball Youth National Team. Following his senior season, he claimed Louisville Slugger All-America recognition and was named to Baseball America's Top 300 High School Players of 2006.

From there, he packed his bags for Baton Rouge where he helped LSU post a combined 175 wins, three trips to the NCAA Super Regionals and a pair of berths in the College World Series – including a National Championship in 2009. As they had done during his high school career, honors came in by the handful for Dean in college. As a rookie, he was named Freshman All-SEC, Louisiana Freshman of the Year and Collegiate Baseball Freshman All-American.

One year later, Dean was tabbed first-team All-American by Baseball America, second-team All-South Region by the American Baseball Coaches Association and Louisiana Hitter of the Year by the Louisiana Sports Writers Association. He also claimed SEC Tournament MVP and Baton Rouge Regional Most Outstanding Player recognition during the Tigers' march to Omaha.

Dean claimed first-team all-state honors in each of his final three collegiate seasons, was tabbed first-team All-SEC as a junior and was a candidate for the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award in 2010. Along the way, he finished second in school history in hits (332), RBI (260) and total bases (575), fourth in home runs (56) and fifth in runs scored (223).

Dean completed his bachelor's degree in sports administration from LSU in 2013.
