WHAT TO WATCH FOR

The Lindenwood men's basketball team travels East this weekend for a Multi-Team Event (MTE) at Robert Morris. This marks the second consecutive season that the Lions will compete in an MTE. Last season, Lindenwood went 2-1 at the Air Force MTE.

Starting on Thursday, Nov. 14th the Lions will take on New Orleans in the opening round game before taking on the host school Robert Morris on Friday at 6:00 p.m. CT inside the UPMC Events Center. After a day off, Lindenwood will take on Stonehill on Sunday who is also in the NCAA Transition period.

Last Thursday saw the Lions dominant in their home opener against UHSP by a final score of 98-30. It marked the least amount of points given up by a Lindenwood team since the 2004-05 season. Multiple Lions impressed in their home debut including Jadis Jones who took home OVC Freshman of the Week for his performance.

Coming into the 2024-25 season, head coach Kyle Gerdeman has brought in a lot of new faces to the Lindenwood Lions program. LU has 10 new players to the roster including Division I transfer Markeith Browning II. Browning is coming off a 14-point performance at OU where he shot 7-18 from the field and 11-points against UHSP.

Lindenwood still returns some key pieces to their 2024-25 roster including Jeremiah Talton and Jaylon McDaniel. Talton and McDaniel both return to St. Charles, Mo. leading the returning Lions after they both averaged 7.0 points during the 2023-24 season.

Lindenwood was picked to finish in 9th place in the Ohio Valley Conference during the 2024-25 season after posting a 9-22 record last season. Despite the ranking, it marked the highest ranking for LU in the OVC Preseason Poll.

LINDENWOOD NOTES

RETURNING STATISTICS

■ On both sides of the ball, Lindenwood loses a lot of its key pieces from the previous season. Offensively, Lindenwood returns just 32.4% of their scoring (655 of 2019 points) including 213 points from Jeremiah Talton. Their two leading scorers from the previous season graduated (Keenon Cole - 18.1 ppg/ Darius Beane - 12.3 ppg). Lindenwood also averaged just 8.0 assists per game. Colin Ruffin returns with the most assists from last season with 49.

■ Defensively, Lindenwood returns just 35.1% of their rebounding (345 of 983 rebounds). No returning Lion to the 2024-25 roster averaged more than 4.0 rebounds per game. Ruffin (3.5) and Talton (2.8) return as the leads defensively. Ruffin led the team as well in steals with 37 for an average of over 1.0 per game.

NEWCOMERS

■ Freshman guard Jadis Jones comes to St. Charles, Mo. with big shoes to fill after being named the Missouri High School Men's Basketball Gatorade Player of the Year. He attend New Madrid County Central High School where he guided his team to a state championship. During his time he eclipsed 2,000 points and 1,000 rebounds while averaging 27.1 ppg and 12.2 rpg during his senior season. At the State Championship game, Jones was one steal shy of a triple-double (22 points, 11 rebounds and 9 steals).

■ Markeith Browning II played 54 games at Wisconsin-Milwaukee while starting 29 of those. Over his three seasons, Browning averaged 8.0 ppg while shooting 44.8% from the field. He scored a career-high 25 points at Green Bay in 2023. His best season came during his junior season where he started 20 of 29 games while scoring 9.6 ppg.

■ Reggie Bass is no stranger to Division I experience after spending the last two seasons split between Kent State and Central Michigan. Bass played for Kent State during the 2023-24 season averaging 8.4 ppg while playing in 29 games (13 starts). Durng his freshman season, Bass was the MAC Freshman of the Year at CMU after averaging 12.4 ppg making 28 starts. The Muncie, Ind. native scored a career-high 40 points vs. Northern Illinois on 2/25/23.

■ St. Louis native Anias Futrell joins the Lindenwood men's basketball program after spending last season at Division II Christian Brothers University. Futrell, a McCluer High School graduate, averaged 17.6 points at CBU while averaging 6.4 rebounds. He scored in double-digits in all but two games and scored a career-high 31 points against LeMayne-Owen. He also attended St. Louis Community College for two seasons where he earned All-Midwest CCAC honors and First-Teamm all-region.

NOTES VS. UHSP

■ Lindenwood controlled the game last Thursday against UHSP after shooting 69.4% from the floor, their highest in the NCAA era (post 2012-13 season). The previous high was 68.3% during the 2014-15 season. Lindenwood's 43 made field-goals were also the most since the 2017-18 season. All 12 Lions scored in the win.

■ Jadis Jones led the way last week with 14-point against the Eutectics as he was one of five players in double-figures. Jones went a perfect 7-7 from the field, the most field goals made without missing since Anthony Christian during the 2019-20 season.

■ Jaylon McDaniel and Nathan Johnson Jr. both added 13 points including a perfect 5-5 from McDaniel. Anias Futrell chipped in 12 while Browning added 11. It marked the first time since Feb. 22nd of last season that five Lions scored in double figures.

■ Lindenwood's defense turned into offense as the Lions scored 48-points off of UHSP's 26 turnovers. The Lions posted 19 steals which was the most in the Division I era by a Lindenwood squad.

■ After only getting five assists against Oklahoma, the Lions posted 23 last Thursday including six from Colin Ruffin. Ruffin ended the game with eight points, six assists, three rebounds and a team-high four steals.

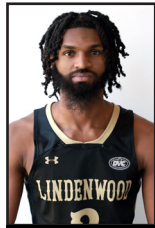

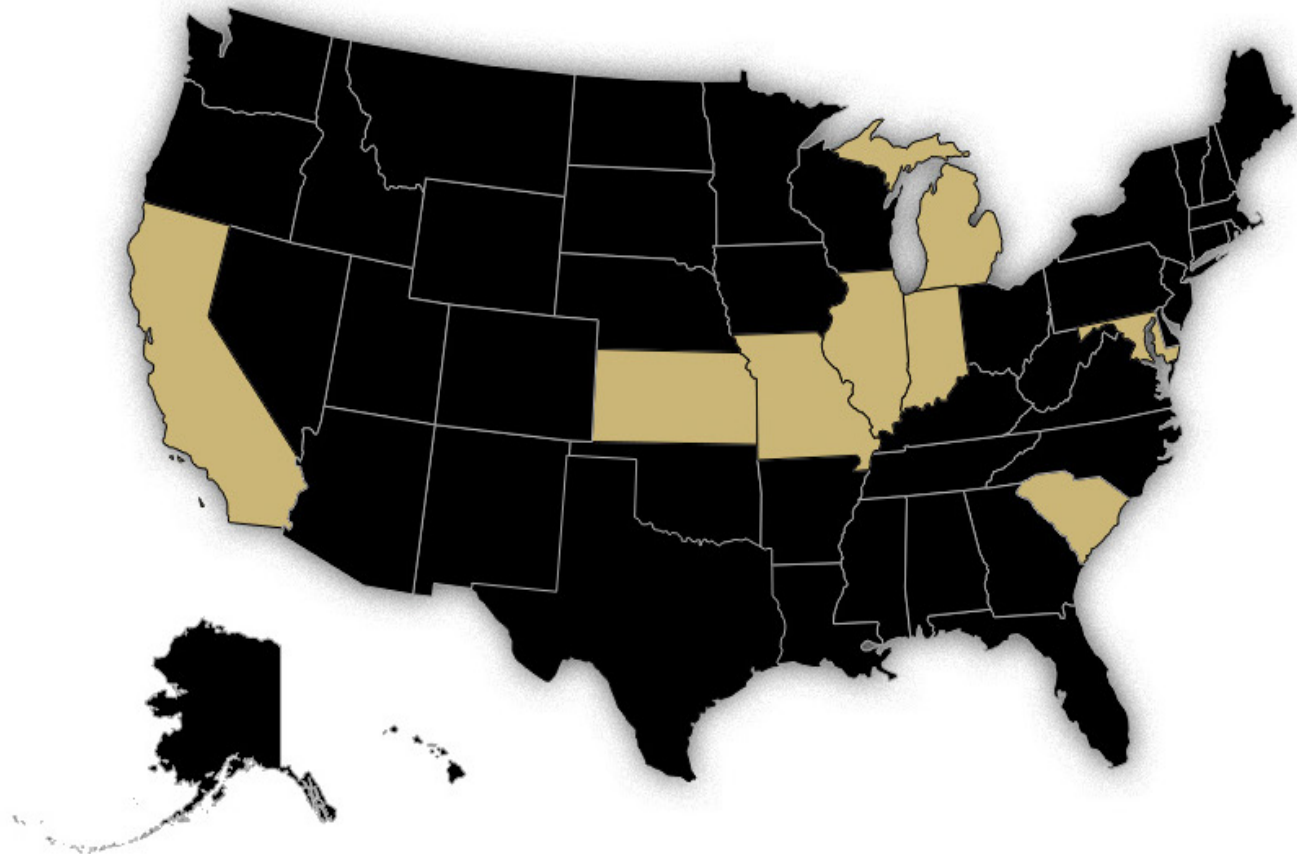

LIONS BY STATE




KYLE GERDEMAN | HEAD COACH | FIFTH SEASON


Kyle Gerdeman is entering his sixth year at the helm of the Lindenwood men's basketball program in 2024-25. During the 2023-24 season, Gerdeman coached Keenon Cole to second team all-conference honors. The Stremwood, Ill. native averaged 18.1 points per game, which ranked fourth in the OVC. Cole poured in a career-high 42 points in a 74-68 road win over SEMO on January 11. For his performance, Cole was tabbed the OVC Player of the Week as well as being recognized as one of the Oscar Robertson National Players of the Week.

In 2022-23, Lindenwood earned a spot in the OVC Championship tournament after a wild ending to the year. The Lions took down in-state rival Southeast Missouri State in double-overtime to keep their postseason hopes alive. In the final game of the regular season, Lindenwood needed a win, and Kevin Caldwell Jr. answered the call with a game-winning bucket in overtime. Lindenwood led the OVC in free-throw percentage (75.6), and was second in the OVC in three-point percentage (39.1). Chris Childs held the top spot in the league with a free-throw percentage of 92.7, while Keenon Cole was atop the OVC with a three-point percentage of 51.0 percent. The Lions clawed their way to three overtime wins on the season. Lindenwood also posted two comeback victories from 20 points down, and another 17-point comeback during OVC play.

In Gerdeman's fourth season during the 2021-22 season, his team finished with a 12-17 record, making it to the GLVC Tournament for the second-consecutive season. Jacoby Ross garnered second-team all-GLVC accolades, as he led the team with 19.3 points per game. Kevin Caldwell Jr. averaged 14.0 points and 4.0 rebounds per night, as he was named the James R. Spalding Sportsmanship nominee.

The 2020-21 season was shortened due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Lions went 10-10 on the season, including a 10-9 mark in the GLVC. After playing all conference games during the regular season, the Lions finished fifth in the GLVC. Lindenwood led the league with an average of 81.9 points per game, with the help of a conference-leading free throw percentage of 80.1. The Lions played tight defensively, registering 7.05 steals per game with a turnover margin of +2.55, second-best in the GLVC.

The Lions were led by TJ Crockett who led the GLVC by more than eight points per game with is 27.5 average per contest. Crockett was named a O2CCA All-American as he was one of the nation's leading scorers across all levels of collegiate basketball. Crockett was recognized as an NABC all-district performer, as he was third in the nation with his 550 points at the time he received the award. Crockett was a unanimous first-team all-GLVC selection, as he added four GLVC Player of the Week honors.

In his first year as head coach of the team in 2019-20, Gerdeman guided the Lions to a 12-16 record, including a 6-14 mark within the GLVC. Under Gerdeman, the Lions played some of their best basketball at home, finishing 9-6 within the friendly confines of Hyland Arena during the season. Lindenwood was known for its high-powered offense, as the team was ranked second in the GLVC in points per game as a unit, putting up 81.2 points per game. The team also was one of the better squads at limiting turnovers, as the team finished fourth in the conference with a +2.54 turnover margin. The Lions closed out the season with wins in three of their final four games, all of which came at home. TJ Crockett set career-highs in nearly every offensive category en route to a spot on the second-team All-Conference team for Lindenwood.

Gerdeman became the program's 20th head coach in program history and led the Lions into their first season as members of the Great Lakes Valley Conference (GLVC) in the 2019-20 season. Gerdeman came to Lindenwood after spending seven seasons at Central Michigan, playing an integral part in the Chippewas success on and off the court. The Chippewas reached the Mid-American Conference Tournament semifinals in 2018-19, finishing the season with a 23-12 record. Over the last five years, the team never had a losing season, including three seasons with at least 20 wins. Over his seven seasons at Central Michigan, the Chippewas posted a 121-108 record (.528).

Off the court, Gerdeman oversaw the program's academic success, which took major strides under his direction. During his tenure at Central Michigan, 19 Chippewas earned Academic All-MAC honors and from 2014-16 the program placed more student-athletes on the academic honor roll than any other institution in the conference. Prior to his arrival at Central Michigan, Gerdeman spent three years as an assistant coach at Southeast Missouri State, which was preceded by three years as the head coach at Moberly Area Community College (Mo.). Gerdeman, a native of Wright City, Mo. totaled a combined nine seasons serving as an assistant coach at Mineral (Mo.) Area College, at Moberly, and at East Central College (Mo.). Gerdeman holds an undergraduate degree from Southeast Missouri State University and a master's degree in education from Central Methodist University.

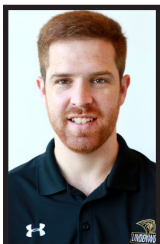

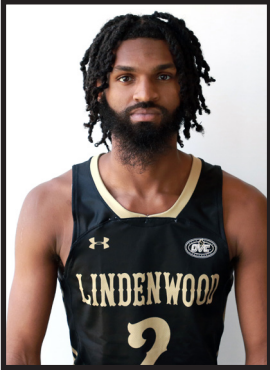

With her husband, George Sibley, pioneer educator Mary Sibley founded Lindenwood as a school for young women in 1832. Lindenwood was committed to combining professional issues with academic pursuits, the social with the intellectual, and the spiritual with the physical. In short, Mary Sibley brought holistic higher education to the American frontier.

Lindenwood became a Presbyterian college in 1853 and still maintains a historical relationship with the Presbyterian Church. In 1918, Lindenwood became a four-year college, and in 1969, Lindenwood attempted to strengthen its financial base by becoming co-ed. The school altered its name in 1974. The Lindenwood Colleges referred to the school's individual operations for men and women and also to its accelerated evening program, the Lindenwood College for Individualized Education, and its graduate programs.

During the '70s and '80s, the school struggled with a changing economy and accumulated substantial indebtedness. Enrollments began to decline, and by the spring of 1989, the number of day students had dropped below 1,000. As well, institutional change during those decades had led to some loss of clarity of mission. In view of



these fiscal and cultural challenges, the Board of Directors resolved to "refound" the school by returning to the fundamental precepts of individualized, holistic, values-oriented higher education that combines the practical with the academic. A president experienced in financial management and organizational revitalization was hired to lead the whole Lindenwood community in its collective renewal initiative. The result was a period of rapid growth and innovation that enabled the college to become the higher-education leader that it is today.

At the height of its revival, Lindenwood College became Lindenwood University in 1997. Enrollment burgeoned, and new construction arrived in late 1997 with the Hyland Performance Arena. By 1998-99, the annual enrollment approached 9,500, the faculty was growing, and the school balanced its budgets and increased revenues.

In 2000, Lindenwood dedicated the first of eight new residence halls to be constructed over the next decade—the first such construction in more than 30 years. In 2002, Lindenwood built the beautiful new Spellmann Campus Center. The 136,000-square-foot J. Scheidegger Center for the Arts opened in 2008.

The growth has not slowed. Additional construction has included expansion and renovation of Harmon Hall, now the home of the Robert W. Plaster School of Business and Entrepreneurship, and the 120,000-square-foot Evans Commons opened to great fanfare in 2011. A new athletics building was added in 2012 adjacent to Harlen Hunter Stadium, corresponding with Lindenwood's transition to the NCAA Division II.

Lindenwood opened in 2017 a 100,000-square-foot Library and Academic Resources Center at the front of the campus. The building serves as a hub for student services and academics.

Academically, Lindenwood has grown as well with extension of its longstanding general accreditation, the addition of numerous specialized accreditations for individual programs, and the addition of a number of degree programs, including the school's first doctoral degrees in the School of Education.

Mary Sibley ran a tightly managed school with a resourceful spirit and a clear purpose. She would have been proud of today's Lindenwood.
