KEY STORYLINES

AT A GLANCE

Oregon heads to the East Coast to compete in non-conference play against Delaware on Wednesday, March 27, at 12:00 p.m.. This is the first time the Ducks have faced the Fightin' Blue Hens since 2010.

GOLDEN GOALIE

Goalkeeper **RACHEL HALL** has captured national attention with her performance in the net. The freshman leads the nation in saves with 132 saves through 10 games. Her 13.20 saves per game rank second in the NCAA and first in the Pac-12 Conference. Hall has registered double-digit saves in seven of Oregon's 10 games this season and has a .502 that stands at second in the Pac-12.

Hall has already broken two Oregon program records this season. She set a new single-game record with 19 saves at California on March 10, replacing Anna Poponyak's previous record of 18 saves vs. Virginia Tech on April 11, 2009. The Texas native is also the Ducks' reigning all-time leader in save percentage at .502 with 132 saves and 131 goals allowed over 10 games.

GOING FOR 150

After becoming Oregon's all-time leading goal scorer, senior attacker **SHANNON WILLIAMS** is just one goal shy of reaching 150 career goals. There are only 13 active Division I players with 150 or more career goals, and Williams ranks 14th with 149 career goals over 62 games.

RECORD-SETTING SENIOR

Senior attacker **SHANNON WILLIAMS** became Oregon's all-time leader in points and goals this season. The senior captain broke Shannon Propst's record for career points (219 points; 2011-14) with her 220th point at California on March 8. Her current 235 career points rank ninth among active Division I players.

Williams broke Jana Drummond's record for career goals (146 goals; 2009-12) the following week with her 147th goal vs. Southern California on March 17. She also holds UO's all-time program records in points per game (3.79) and goals per game (2.40) and set two single-season records with 74 points in 2018 and 4.24 points per game in 2017.

DYNAMIC DUO

Attacker **CHARLIE LEACH** and midfielder **JAMIE LEVEL** have combined for 22 goals this season. The freshman duo follows senior **SHANNON WILLIAMS** as Oregon's second and third-highest scorers this season. Leach has scored 19 points off 16 goals and three assists in 10 games, while Level has registered 15 points off 10 goals and five assists.

BALLING AND DRAWING

Freshman midfielder **JAMIE LEVEL** has led Oregon on the draw this season with 39 draw controls over 10 games. Her 3.90 draw controls per game rank fourth in the Pac-12 Conference. Meanwhile, senior **MADLINE REECE** and has led the Ducks in ground balls. Reece's 30 ground balls rank seventh in the Pac-12 Conference.

150 Williams is one goal away from reaching **150 career goals**. There are only 13 active Division I players with 150+ career goals.

Williams has made **62 consecutive starts** since joining the program in 2016 and has scored a point in 59 of those games. **62**

56 Williams has a goal in **56 career games**. She had a streak of 20 consecutive games with a goal from 2017-18.

Williams has scored at least one point in **47 consecutive games** and 59 of 62 career contests. **47**

27 Williams has **27 career hat tricks**, including 23 over the last 43 games. The senior has registered five hat tricks in 2019.

HEAD COACH CHELSEA GAMBLE



Chelsea Gamble was named the third head coach in Oregon lacrosse history on August 1, 2018, after a highly successful four-year stint as an assistant coach at Pac-12 rival Stanford.

The offensive coordinator for the Cardinal from 2015 to 2018, Gamble helped lead Stanford to a pair of conference championships, including the inaugural Pac-12 Tournament title in 2018, and three NCAA appearances. Stanford had reached the NCAA Tournament just five times prior to Gamble's arrival.

Under Gamble's guidance, the Cardinal offense led the Pac-12 in points per game (21.25), goals per game (15.15) and assists per game (6.10) in 2018, while also pacing the league in ground balls (21.55) and draw controls per game (15.00). Nationally, Stanford tied for 14th in goals per game and was 10th in scoring margin (5.75). The Cardinal also thrived academically in 2018, leading the nation with 10 student-athletes on the IWLLCA academic honor roll.

The Stanford offense ranked among the top 15 in the nation in scoring every year under Gamble's direction, highlighted by a 2015 season that saw Gamble orchestrate the nation's top scoring offense (16.00 goals per game) as 11 Cardinal scored 10 or more goals. Stanford also led the nation in draw controls that year (15.28 per game) en route to a perfect 9-0 conference record, an MPSF Conference title and an NCAA Tournament appearance.

Gamble arrived at Stanford from Connecticut, where she was an assistant the previous three seasons (2012-14). The Huskies enjoyed unprecedented success during her tenure, setting consecutive school records for victories in 2012 and 2013 and advancing to the program's first NCAA Tournament in 2013.

As a freshman midfielder at George Mason, Gamble played under current Stanford head coach Amy Bokker and was named to the Colonial Athletic Association All-Rookie team. Gamble was named captain as a sophomore and held that post for three seasons, earning All-CAA honors along the way.
