KEY STORYLINES

AT A GLANCE

Oregon travels to the U.S. Lacrosse Headquarters in Sparks, Maryland, to face Ohio State on Saturday, March 30, at 9:00 a.m.

GOLDEN GOALIE

Goalkeeper **RACHEL HALL** has captured national attention with her performance in the net this season. The freshman leads the nation in saves with 141 saves through 11 games. Her 12.82 saves per game ranks second in the NCAA and first in the Pac-12 Conference. Hall has registered double-digit saves in seven of Oregon's 11 games this season and has a .486 save percentage that stands at fourth in the Pac-12.

Hall has already broken two Oregon program records this season. She set a new single-game record with 19 saves at California on March 10, replacing Anna Poponyak's previous record of 18 saves vs. Virginia Tech on April 11, 2009. The Texas native is also the Ducks' reigning all-time leader in save percentage at .486 with 141 saves and 149 goals allowed over 11 games.

RECORD-SETTING SENIOR

Senior attacker **SHANNON WILLIAMS** surpassed the 150 career goals mark with a hat trick against Delaware on March 27. Her 152 career goals over 63 games ranks 13th among active Division I players. Williams became Oregon's all-time leader in points and goals this season. The senior captain broke Shannon Propst's record for career points (219 points; 2011-14) with her 220th point at California on March 8. Her current 239 career points rank ninth among active Division I players.

Williams broke Jana Drummond's record for career goals (146 goals; 2009-12) the following week with her 147th goal vs. Southern California on March 17. She also holds UO's all-time program records in points per game (3.79) and goals per game (2.41) and set two single-season records with 74 points in 2018 and 4.24 points per game in 2017.

FRESHMAN LEADERS

Attacker **CARLIE LEACH** and midfielder **JAMIE LEVEL** have combined for for 35 points and 27 goals this season. The freshman duo follows senior **SHANNON WILLIAMS** as Oregon's second and third-highest scorers this season. Leach has scored 20 points off 17 goals and three assists in 11 games, while Level has registered 15 points off 10 goals and five assists.

Level has led Oregon on the draw this season with 41 draw controls over 11 games. Her 41 draw controls rank fourth in the Pac-12 Conference. Meanwhile, Leach's shot percentage of 54.8 percent stands at fourth in the Pac-12 Conference.

IMPACTFUL PLAYERS

Senior **JULIA TAYLOR** and sophomore **CLAIRE DOMSHICK** have played an important role on the Ducks' offense this season. The pair have put up 10 goals each for Oregon and recorded hat tricks in the Ducks' home opener against Mercer on Feb. 9, while Taylor added another hat trick at Delaware on March 27.

Meanwhile, senior **MADLINE REECE** and junior **GRAYCYN ELLIOTT** have played an important role on the Ducks' defense. Reece leads the Ducks with 24 grounds balls and 11 caused turnovers and has registered 29 draw controls this season. She stands at No. 5 for ground balls in the Pac-12 Conference. Elliott follows Reece with 21 draw controls and 21 ground balls this season.

Chelsea Gamble was named the third head coach in Oregon lacrosse history on August 1, 2018, after a highly successful four-year stint as an assistant coach at Pac-12 rival Stanford.

The offensive coordinator for the Cardinal from 2015 to 2018, Gamble helped lead Stanford to a pair of conference championships, including the inaugural Pac-12 Tournament title in 2018, and three NCAA appearances.

Under Gamble's guidance, the Cardinal offense led the Pac-12 in points per game (21.25), goals per game (15.15) and assists per game (6.10) in 2018, while also pacing the league in ground balls (21.55) and draw controls per game (15.00).

The Stanford offense ranked among the top 15 in the nation in scoring every year under Gamble's direction, highlighted by a 2015 season that saw Gamble orchestrate the nation's top scoring offense (16.00 goals per game) as 11 Cardinal scored 10 or more goals.

Gamble arrived at Stanford from Connecticut, where she was an assistant the previous three seasons (2012-14). The Huskies enjoyed unprecedented success during her tenure, setting consecutive school records for victories in 2012 and 2013 and advancing to the program's first NCAA Tournament in 2013.

As a freshman midfielder at George Mason, Gamble played under current Stanford head coach Amy Bokker and was named to the Colonial Athletic Association All-Rookie team. Gamble was named captain as a sophomore and held that post for three seasons, earning All-CAA honors along the way.
