KEY STORYLINES

AT A GLANCE

Oregon has two conference road games scheduled this weekend that will be featured on the Pac-12 Network. The Ducks travel to Arizona State on Friday, April 5, at 3:00 p.m., before heading to No. 14 Southern California on Sunday, April 7, at 1:00 p.m.

GOLDEN GOALIE

Goalkeeper **RACHEL HALL** has captured national attention with her performance in the net this season. The freshman leads the nation in saves and saves per game with 141 saves through 12 games for an average of 13.42 saves per game. Hall has registered double-digit saves in eight of Oregon's 12 games this season and leads the Pac-12 Conference with a .502 save percentage that ranks No. 13 in the NCAA.

Hall has already broken two Oregon program records this season. She broke Oregon's single-game saves record for the second time this season with 20 stops against Ohio State on March 30, replacing her previous record of 19 saves at California on March 8. Oregon's previous single-game saves record holder was Anna Poponyak with 18 saves vs. Virginia Tech on April 11, 2009. The Texas native is also the Ducks' reigning all-time leader in save percentage at .502 with 161 saves and 160 goals allowed over 12 games.

GOING FOR 50 STRAIGHT

Senior attacker **SHANNON WILLIAMS** is going her 50th consecutive game with her next point scored. Williams has registered at least one point in 49 consecutive games dating back to 2016. The senior captain leads the Pac-12 Conference with 51 points this season on 30 goals and 21 assists. Her 51 points this season also stand at No. 23 in the NCAA. Williams has registered 240 career points over 64 games to rank ninth among active Division I players.

RECORD-SETTING SENIOR

Senior **SHANNON WILLIAMS** became Oregon's all-time leader in points and goals this season. The senior captain broke Shannon Propst's record for career points (219 points; 2011-14) with her 220th point at California on March 8. Williams broke Jana Drummond's record for career goals (146 goals; 2009-12) the following week with her 147th goal vs. Southern California on March 17. She also holds UO's all-time program records in points per game (3.75) and goals per game (2.38) and set two single-season records with 74 points in 2018 and 4.24 points per game in 2017.

FRESHMAN LEADERS

Attacker **CARLIE LEACH** and midfielder **JAMIE LEVEL** have combined for for 36 points and 28 goals this season. The freshman duo follows senior **SHANNON WILLIAMS** as Oregon's second and third-highest scorers this season. Leach has scored 21 points on 18 goals and three assists, while Level has registered 15 points on 10 goals and five assists. Level has led Oregon on the draw this season with 41 draw controls. Her 41 draw controls rank fifth in the Pac-12 Conference. Meanwhile, Leach's shot percentage of 56.3 percent stands third in the Pac-12 Conference.

IMPACTFUL PLAYERS

Senior **JULIA TAYLOR** and sophomore **CLAIRE DOMSHICK** have played an important role on the Ducks' offense this season with 11 points each. Domshick has registered 11 points on 10 goals and one assist, while Taylor has scored 11 goals. Meanwhile, senior **MADELINE REECE** has played an important role on the Ducks' defense. Reece leads the Ducks with 25 grounds balls and 12 caused turnovers and has recorded 29 draw controls this season. Her 25 ground balls rank sixth in the Pac-12 Conference.

Chelsea Gamble was named the third head coach in Oregon lacrosse history on August 1, 2018, after a highly successful four-year stint as an assistant coach at Pac-12 rival Stanford.

The offensive coordinator for the Cardinal from 2015 to 2018, Gamble helped lead Stanford to a pair of conference championships, including the inaugural Pac-12 Tournament title in 2018, and three NCAA appearances.

Under Gamble's guidance, the Cardinal offense led the Pac-12 in points per game (21.25), goals per game (15.15) and assists per game (6.10) in 2018, while also pacing the league in ground balls (21.55) and draw controls per game (15.00).

The Stanford offense ranked among the top 15 in the nation in scoring every year under Gamble's direction, highlighted by a 2015 season that saw Gamble orchestrate the nation's top scoring offense (16.00 goals per game) as 11 Cardinal scored 10 or more goals.

Gamble arrived at Stanford from Connecticut, where she was an assistant the previous three seasons (2012-14). The Huskies enjoyed unprecedented success during her tenure, setting consecutive school records for victories in 2012 and 2013 and advancing to the program's first NCAA Tournament in 2013.

As a freshman midfielder at George Mason, Gamble played under current Stanford head coach Amy Bokker and was named to the Colonial Athletic Association All-Rookie team. Gamble was named captain as a sophomore and held that post for three seasons, earning All-CAA honors along the way.
