THE GAME'S THEME For the first time in five weeks, Oregon does not face an unbeaten team. But the Ducks do have to contend with a squad good enough to be ranked among the nation's top 20 a week ago. Oregon celebrates Homecoming with its next-to-last Autzen Stadium appearance, not to return home for four Saturday. The Ducks' Chris Miller and John Paye of Stanford perform on the same field for the last time as collegians.

THE COACHES Oregon's Rich Brooks and Jack Elway of Stanford match coaching strategies for the fourth time and second since Elway took over the Cardinal in 1984. Brooks brings a 37-64-4 record into his sixth meeting against Stanford. Elway is 68-45-2 in 11 seasons as a head coach, including a five-year record of 35-20-1 at San Jose State where he first coached against Oregon teams. Brooks is 3-3 vs. Stanford, including last year's 45-28 triumph in Eugene. It was Elway's first loss to Oregon after 1982-83 victories while at San Jose.

OREGON'S SEASON The Ducks were victimized by the over-all strength of their fourth straight ranked opponent last Saturday in a 37-17 loss to Arizona State. The 15th-rated Sun Devils scored with 28 seconds left in the first half and struck again after 1:12 of the second half to magnify what had been a precarious 14-10 margin into 27-10 security. Oregon had dropped a 41-17 decision to No. 17 Arizona, relinquished a 48-14 verdict at No. 4 Nebraska and were a 35-21 victim at No. 9 USC. The Ducks opened with a 21-14 victory at current PCAA leader San Jose State and posted a last-play 32-30 victory over Colorado. Stanford was ranked 18th by Associated Press and No. 17 by United Press International last week before a 24-14 loss to Washington, Oregon's foe a week from Saturday in Seattle. The 12th-rated Huskies entertain Bowling Green State this week.

CONFERENCE CALL Coach Rich Brooks will be available to any interested news media member each Wednesday via conference telephone call. Just notify the Oregon sports information office by 4:30 p.m. Tuesday and we'll place the call to you at approximately 10:30 a.m. for print media and 11:00 a.m. for broadcast members. There is no time limit, Coach Brooks will stay on the line until all questions are answered. Brooks is available in person at practice at other times.

GREEN GREEN Back in 1984, Oregon's football coaches spotted Rod Green at Foothill College in Los Altos, Calif., where he was catching 29 passes for 329 yards. It turned out that Rod had finished high in high hurdle races the previous spring and the Ducks' track coaches shared Oregon's interest. Green joined Oregon's track team the next spring and finished sixth in the Pac-10 meet with a best of 14.43 seconds. When a football scholarship became available the next fall, Green was with the football team, but did not see action. Rod was fairly impressive last spring, showing he had running ability after making the reception. In fall camp, Green was the most dependable during competitive situations and opened the season as the Ducks' top back-up receiver. That all changed when J.J. Birden suffered a broken left arm at Nebraska and Green began slowly in his first collegiate start at USC. He caught three passes for 45 yards against the Trojans, all in the fourth quarter, and continued his development against Arizona State with seven catches for a season-high 139 yards. He fielded passes of nine, 15, 17, 17, 22, 28 and 31 yards against the Sun Devils. He caught more passes last Saturday than he had total in Oregon's first five games and his averaging 17.8 yards on his 13 catches. Green was born in Stanford, Calif., and played at Palo Alto High School. He only ran in his first year at Foothill, but tried football the following fall. Green plans to rejoin the track team this spring for his junior year in that sport.

SPEAKING LATIN Freshman tailback Latin Berry is regaining full healthy after suffering a rib injury in the Ducks' opener. Latin had only been in the San Jose State game seven plays when he was leveled just after cradling a screen pass. His ribs bothered him the next week, but he played. Then, he hurt them again lifting weights the next week and was idled for two weeks when Oregon played Arizona and Nebraska. He returned to action at USC and started, finishing with 52 yards in 11 carries. Berry also was the Ducks' leading rusher against Arizona State with 55 yards in eight attempts, including a one-yard touchdown that was the first of his career. Berry also is among Oregon's top receivers with 18 catches for 144 yards in just four games.

STAT LEADERS Senior quarterback Chris Miller leads the Pacific-10 Conference in total offense and ranks 13th in the nation with a 243.2 average. He's also No. 11 in completions with 20.8 per contest. Punter Mike Preacher returned to the league lead with a 43.1-yard average and stands 15th nationally. As a team, Oregon is No. 12 in the U.S. in passing offense with a 263.7 mark.

BROOKS SAYS "We had some chances in the (Arizona State) game, but we certainly didn't take advantage of them. In fact, we killed ourselves with some inappropriate penalties, a couple of turnovers early in the game. We wanted to get them in passing situations and maybe that was our biggest mistake. We even got better pressure on the quarterback, but we did not cover well. We had some busted coverages and we had other coverages where we just got beat physically. If we're going to win in the immediate future, we're going to have to start playing better defense, assess what we're doing wrong and get it corrected."

COACH COMMENTS "Stanford is playing outstanding football. Their defense has made tremendous improvement in one year. I think (David) Wyman's return at linebacker has really given them a leader, somebody to rally around. Any game that features the first and second-team all-league quarterbacks and two guys that are having quite a year certainly is going to be an entertaining football game. The difference in the game probably is going to depend on which defensive unit does the best job. Stanford has made marked improvement on defense and they look like they have the edge in that category. I'm just hopeful we can iron out some of the mistakes we've been making and play a very good defensive game against Stanford."

The Last Details Oregon vs Stanford

LAST YEAR Oregon and Stanford will have to go a long ways to match last year's contest in which they combined for 1,074 yards and 73 points, the highest scoring total in the history of the series. In the game, Tony Cherry rushed for a career-high 227 yards and three touchdowns for Oregon, Stanford's John Paye passed for a career-best 408 yards and the Ducks' Chris Miller also had an outstanding day, completing 20 of 33 passes for 266 yards and accounting for three touchdowns as well. Stanford had 560 yards total offense and Oregon chipped in with 514 yards.

YEAR LATER After six games a year ago, Oregon also was 2-4. The Ducks won their next two to even out at 4-4 with victories at San Diego State and against San Jose State. Here's a breakdown of several interesting statistics concerning the last two years of Oregon football:

STARTER FACTS Oregon initiates four new starters for today's game with Stanford. Three are on defense and true freshman tailback Derek Loville receives his first start of his career. The first-time defensive starters this season are linebacker Scott Kozak and redshirt freshmen David Cusano at tackle and Jon Eichinger at end. The list of players that have started on defense this season for the Ducks grows to 23 with this lineup. Oregon has started at least three different players at six positions through seven games. That includes four separate starters at middle linebacker. Oddly, four different players also have started at tailback this season (junior James Harper, senior Alan Jackson, redshirt freshman Latin Berry and Loville). On offense, Oregon has changed starters at only four positions and only the shifting between seniors Kevin Willhite and Jackson has not been injury related, although it was apparent that Loville would take over as the starter sometime during the year. Eleven players have started all seven games. On defense, it only has been tackle Rollin Putzier, linebacker Dan Devaney, strong safety Anthony Newman and Ed Hulbert, who has started at both free safety and cornerback.

RATINGS GAME A week ago, six Oregon opponents were ranked in the Associated Press' top 20 teams. Stanford, indiscriminately dropped after its loss to Washington, was 18th. This week, the Ducks' foes are third (Nebraska), ninth (Washington), 10th (Arizona State), 15th (USC) and 16th (Arizona).
