The Last Details  
Oregon vs Washington

HERMAN RETURNS . . . . . Senior tight end Doug Herman (Renton) is the only Oregon player who hails from the state of Washington starting today for the Ducks who opened the 1982 game in Seattle. There are five Washingtonians on the Oregon team today and only Herman and senior defensive end Dale Dorning (Federal Way) are starters. The others are junior back-up defensive back Ron Johnson (Garfield), reserve center Jeff Stefanick (Tyee), non-starting defensive tackle Tony Grossi (Mercer Island).

OTHER SQUAD NOTES . . . . . Oregon is represented by six states and two other countries on its 60-man traveling squad. In addition to the five players from Washington, Oregon's party is dominated by players from California (25) and Oregon (24). There are one each from Idaho, Illinois and Colorado, two Canadians and a South African.

INJURY UPDATE . . . . . Three players who were in uniform last Saturday for the USC game are not on the trip to Washington and a fourth probably won't see action. Defensive tackle Dave Maley had knee surgery Tuesday and is lost for the season and offensive tackle Brent Orick (shoulder) and fullback Kevin Willhite (hamstring) also remained in Eugene. Maley joins free safety Jeff Williams (broken thumb), tight end Rich Gaiser (broken finger) and linebacker Lerry Wilson (head) as players who are likely out the rest of the season. Offensive tackle Steve Jenson (shoulder) is dressed, but not expected to play. Also not likely to see much action are defensive tackles David Culp (knee) and Will Stipanovich (shoulder).

DOWN/ON THE ROAD . . . . . Oregon is back at Autzen Stadium next Saturday to entertain Washington State, which is visiting Stanford today. This is Oregon's third of five Pacific-10 Conference road games. The Ducks won at California, 21-14, and lost at Arizona, 28-14. Oregon still must play at UCLA in two weeks and Oregon State in four.

FACING NO. 1 . . . . . Two years ago when Oregon visited Seattle, Washington was ranked No. 1 and remained that way, although the Ducks momentarily took the lead at 21-17 early in the fourth quarter. Oregon played three No. 1 teams in the 1970s. First, Oklahoma was ranked first when Oregon visited in 1975 (Sept. 13) and the Sooners pounded out a 62-7 triumph. In 1972, USC was rated No. 1 and posted an 18-0 victory over the Ducks (Oct. 28). The previous year, Nebraska was top-ranked when it hosted Oregon (Sept. 11) and posted a 34-7 triumph.

BARNES' STREAK . . . . . Junior flanker Lew Barnes has caught at least one pass in his Oregon career, a streak that has reached 17 games. A week ago, Barnes had two receptions for 34 yards against USC and had a 37-yard touchdown reception called back. It was his lowest total since a one-catch day in Oregon's opener with Long Beach State when Lew played without any previous fall contact and his first game without a touchdown catch in four games. Last year, Barnes caught two passes for 63 yards against Washington. He caught 30 passes last season and has 21 to date this year after six games.

THE MATCHUP . . . . . Oregon sophomore quarterback Chris Miller, who went 96 consecutive passes without interception to open the season, has pitched five into wrong hands in the last two weeks. Washington intercepted Stanford five times last week and has 17 thefts. Today's game is the tenth collegiate appearance for Miller, a 1,000-yard passer this year.

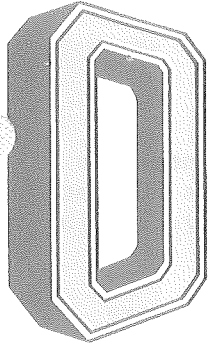

THE GAME'S THEME . . . . Oregon plays Washington in Seattle for the second straight time after the Huskies were expected to be named as the No.1-ranked team in the nation. The Ducks are trying to avoid a three-game losing streak. The Huskies are attempting to match their season-opening winning streak of two years ago. It's the Pac-10 home opener for Washington. Oregon battles a team that ranks among the nation's top 10 in at least one defensive category for the third straight week. And, Oregon plays the conference's three unbeaten teams in league play in succession.

THE SERIES . . . . Washington has dominated the head-to-head meetings with Oregon in the last 10 years, winning nine times. The Huskies' margin stands at 46-26-5, dating back to the 1900 season. Each team has played well on the road in the series. Games in 1973 and '74 speak for what can happen in the heated Northwest rivalry. Oregon won the 1973 contest in Eugene, 58-0, and Washington strolled in the 1974 meeting in Seattle, 66-0. In Oregon's last three meetings at Husky Stadium, the Ducks have been pesky. Washington led all the way in 1978, but nailed down a 20-14 triumph. Two years later, Oregon recorded its resounding 34-10 triumph against the Rose Bowl-bound Huskies. In 1982, the 0-3 Ducks scored early in the fourth period to take a 21-17 lead, but top-ranked Washington retorted to post a 37-21 triumph.

THE COACHES . . . . Oregon's Rich Brooks faces Washington for the eighth time as head coach of the Ducks. He sports a 28-51-4 over-all mark, including 17 Pacific-10 Conference victories. Brooks is 1-6 vs. Washington and the Huskies' Don James, who is coaching his 10th Washington team. His 81-30 mark includes an 8-1 worksheet against Oregon. Brooks is 1-2 at Seattle, James 3-1 at home vs. the Ducks.

THE SEASONS . . . . Oregon: The Ducks opened with a 4-0 record, but fell the last two weeks to two of the Pac-10's top defenses. Oregon used last-quarter surges to surpass Long Beach State (28-17), Colorado (27-20) and California (21-14) and then drilled Pacific (30-14). The Ducks' fourth-period rally at Arizona fell short (28-14) and USC fought off the Ducks in the second half (19-9); Washington: The Huskies' defense has made easy work of six straight opponents. Michigan scored a meaningless late touchdown and Stanford struck twice through the air in the fourth quarter, but only after the Huskies had built a 34-3 lead. They are the only teams to score more than a touchdown against Washington, who polished off Northwestern (26-0), Michigan (20-11), Houston (35-7) and Miami, Ohio (53-7) in the non-conference portion of the schedule before opening the Pac-10 season by winning at Oregon State (19-7) and Stanford (37-15).

NCAA STATISTICS . . . . . Return specialists Lew Barnes and Tony Cherry and punter Mike Preacher possess Oregon's highest NCAA rankings this week. Barnes is No. 16 by averaging 11.3 yards on 11 punt runbacks and Cherry is 18th with a 22.9 worksheet on 10 returns. Preacher has a 43.4 mark for 20th in the U.S. this week and his net punting average of 40.5 puts him at No. 13 in that category. Washington's Jeff Jaeger leads the nation with 17 field goals in 19 attempts and is third in scoring with 11.3 points per game. The Huskies are No. 1 in scoring defense (7.8) and turnover margin (+3.7). Washington has recovered 14 fumbles and made 17 interceptions on defense. Washington also is eighth in pass defense (130.5) and total defense (261.8) and tied for No. 12 in scoring offense at 31.7 per contest.

AROUND THE PAC-10 . . . . . The conference race heats up with Arizona visiting Washington and USC in the next two weeks. Looking ahead, Washington plays at USC during the last two weeks (Nov. 10). UCLA (1-1) is the only other team in the race with only one loss. All teams are again in action. The schedule:

PAC-10 ELECTRONICS . . . . . In addition to its weekly flow of information, the Pacific-10 Conference is feeding electronic media regularly. For television types, the Pac-10's weekly satellite feed can be received each Wednesday at 3:30 p.m. on Telestar 301 and Transponder 12V. Radio personnel can call 415-932-1043 for audio cuts that are changed at noon each day. Both feeds feature preview material for upcoming Pac-10 contests.

OREGON TRAVEL PLANS . . . . . Oregon departs Eugene by bus at 8 a.m. Friday and will arrive in Seattle at 2 p.m. The Ducks will headquarter at the Bellevue Red Lion (206-455-1300). Assistant sports information director Tim Clodjeaux will arrive in Seattle Wednesday evening and should be contacted in advance to arrange interviews Friday with Coach Rich Brooks. Oregon will practice at Husky Stadium at 4 p.m.

WASHINGTON . . . . . While defense has been the watchword at Washington, the Huskies' offense can't be ignored. Washington is averaging 345.0 yards total offense in six games and rolled up 37 points with 321 yards offense at Stanford. Quarterback Hugh Millen, a junior in his first season as the starter, completed 13 of 22 passes for 176 yards and two touchdowns, a 10-yarder to Mark Pattison and a 33-yard strike to Danny Greene. It was Millen and Pattison who hooked up on a 73-yard play that delivered the big punch in the Huskies' victory at Michigan. Greene caught four passes for 89 yards at Stanford and leads Washington receivers this year with 15 catches and Pattison is averaging 23.7 yards on 12 receptions with three touchdowns. Tailback Jacque Robinson is back in full swing with 377 yards and four touchdowns this season. He had 68 yards in 14 attempts at Stanford. Despite allowing Stanford 444 yards total offense, the Cardinal was kept out of the end zone while the game was being decided. The Huskies intercepted five passes, upping their season total to 17, four more thefts than all of 1983. Washington limited Oregon State to 154 yards. Washington has allowed only 20 points in the first three quarters this season.

ACCORDING TO BROOKS . . . . . "The USC game was very physical, we sustained some injuries that certainly won't help us in the next five weeks. I said two weeks ago that we were hitting the crunch of our schedule, but I didn't mean it so literally. In the second half, we just missed too many opportunities on offense. We made some mistakes we just couldn't overcome. It's an honor to play the No. 1 team in the nation and they should be this week, I know I voted for them on the UPI board. It hard to go undefeated this far in the season, that's a testimony to their team strength. Playing Washington's defense after playing Arizona and USC the last two weeks is like waking up from a bad dream. Washington's defense may be the best of all. We'll have our hands full playing in Seattle. Their over-all team speed concerns me."
