GENERAL MEET INFORMATION

UPDATED 5.1.23

ENTRY ELIGIBILITY	Entry into the Oregon Twilight is by invitation only. A limited number of elite unattached/open athletes may be accepted to enhance the collegiate fields. Invited teams and individual athletes will be given access to enter in <i>DirectAthletics</i> . Marks achieved during the 2022 and 2023 seasons are preferred. Speculative marks may be entered with a note for entrants without a mark. All speculative marks will be reviewed by meet management who reserves the right to accept or deny any entry into the Oregon Twilight.
ENTRY DEADLINE & FEES	All entries must be submitted by the deadline and cannot be changed once entry fees are paid. No refunds will be given, even if an athlete is scratched or not accepted into the meet. Entry schedule: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- <i>Friday, April 28, 11:59pm PST: Entries and payment due online at DirectAthletics</i>- <i>Monday, May 1: List of accepted entries sent to coaches and posted online</i>- <i>Wednesday, May 3: Start lists and final meet schedule sent to coaches and posted online.</i> Entry fees for the Oregon Twilight: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- <i>\$45 per athlete</i>- <i>Teams with 14 or more athletes entered: \$600 per team (i.e. \$600 for women, \$600 for men)</i>
ACCEPTED ENTRIES	Meet management reserves the right to accept or deny any entry into the Oregon Twilight. If an event does not have sufficient entries, it may be canceled. Entry into the Oregon Twilight is therefore not guaranteed.
SCRATCH & DECLARATIONS	Coaches are encouraged to send any scratches to the meet director as soon as possible so heats/flights can be seeded accordingly. Final declarations for all events occur at initial check in for each event; athletes are encouraged to scratch from any events they are not competing in at this time.
PRE-MEET PRACTICE	Hayward Field will be available to teams and athletes on Thursday, May 4 th from 4:00-6:00pm. Marshals will be on site to help facilitate safe practice on the infield; please be mindful of other teams/event areas during practice.
PACKET PICKUP	Meet credentials are required to gain access to Hayward Field for practice and competition. Packets will be available for pickup at the Hayward Field ticket office on Thursday, May 4 th from 4:00-6:00pm, and then starting two hours before the first scheduled event on Friday, May 5 th .
FACILITY ACCESS	Hayward Field will be open to athletes and team staff two hours prior to the start of the first event. Athletes and team staff must have the appropriate credentials to enter or else they will be denied entry.
IMPLEMENT INSPECTION	Implement inspection will begin two hours prior to the first event at the south garage of Hayward Field. All implements must be inspected at least 90 minutes before the start of the event and will be impounded until the conclusion of the event.
MEET MEDICAL	Requests for use of modalities through meet medical should be made in advance to ATC Grant Wilson (gwilson2@uoregon.edu , C: 802-734-5193).
SPIKES	All athletes must use only pyramid spikes that are no longer than 1/4-inch (7mm) in length, with the exception of high jump and javelin where 3/8-inch (9mm) or lesser spike may be used. Spikes will be checked and those not meeting the regulations must be replaced by the athletes.
LIVE RESULTS & STREAM	Live results will be provided through AthleticTiming , and a live stream available on RunnerSpace.com .

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PARKING & ATHLETE DROP

No team parking will be provided for the Oregon Twilight. There will be two team athlete entrances: Agate St. (across from the fire station on 17th Ave), and 18th St. south of Hayward Field. Parking around Hayward Field is extremely limited but metered street parking is available on the surrounding streets.

OREGON TWILIGHT MEET PROTOCOLS

ATHLETE PROTOCOLS

- **ENTRY:**
 - Athletes and team staff will enter Hayward Field through one of the designated athlete entrances on Agate St. or 18th St. Team buses/vans will be able to drop and pick-up athletes on Agate St.
 - Gates will open two hours prior to the first event.
- **WARM-UP AREA:**
 - Athletes may warm up on the square track and turf field 3. Only Athletes actively preparing for their event may occupy this field. Pop-up team tents are ok to set up along the edge of the turf field by the tennis courts if there are no tent stakes.
- **ALL EVENTS:**
 - **All competitors must bring their competition shoes to clerking at initial check-in.** In order for marks to be recognized by World Athletics, clerking will randomly spot-check 5-10% of participants in the meet. This includes field events.
- **RUNNING EVENTS:**
 - Athletes in running events will check-in for their event(s) at the Clerk of the Course tent on Field 3 no later than 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start of their event, and must bring their competition shoes. They must then report back to the Clerk's tent 20 minutes prior to the scheduled start of their event to be escorted into the stadium Final Call area and onto the Field of Play (FOP). **Uniforms and bibs must be on before athletes are escorted into final hiping area.** No changing at final hiping.
 - At the completion of each running event, athletes will be escorted off the track through the south tunnel to exit the stadium.
- **FIELD EVENTS:**
 - **Field event athletes should check-in for their event(s) at the Clerk of the Course tent on Field 3 immediately upon arrival to Hayward Field, and no later than 10 minutes prior to the designated report time.** **Final event instructions will be delivered by the head official in the clerk circle as well.**
 - **EVENT-SPECIFIC REPORT TIMES:**
 - **Long Jump & Triple Jump:** Report 50 minutes before the scheduled start of the event to be escorted to the FOP for a 30-minute warm-up period
 - **Pole Vault:** Report 80 minutes before the scheduled start of the event to be escorted to the FOP for a 60-minute warm-up period.
 - **High Jump:** Report 65 minutes before the scheduled start of the event to be escorted to the FOP for a 45-minute warm-up period.
 - **Shot Put, Discus, Hammer:** Report 50 minutes before the scheduled start of the event to be escorted to the FOP for a 30-minute warm-up period
 - **Javelin:** Report 60 minutes before the scheduled start of the event to be escorted to the FOP for a 40-minute warm-up period
 - If an athlete does not advance to the final round of their event, they will be escorted off the track through the south tunnel to exit the stadium. **If there are multiple flights, athletes from the first flight should remain near the Clerk of the Course tent for calls for athletes that advance to the final.**
 - At the completion of each field event, athletes will be escorted off the track through the south tunnel to exit the stadium.
- **SEATING BOWL ACCESS:**
 - Athletes may enter the concourse and seating bowl through the southwest stairs and proceed to the main concourse area. Athletes and team staff may sit in any General Admission section at Hayward Field; refer to enclosed seating map.

SPECTATOR SHUTTLE

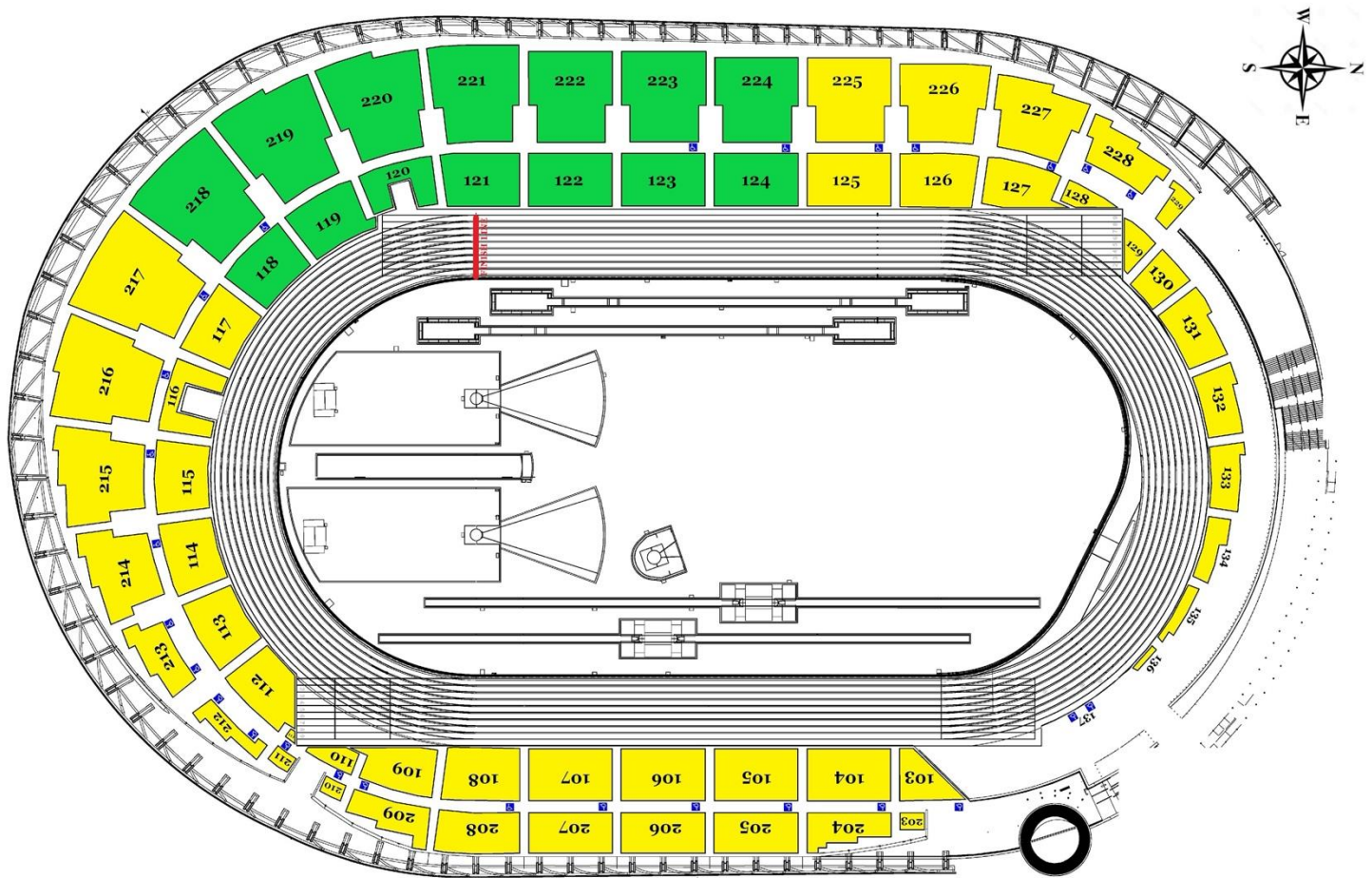

CLEAR BAG POLICY

The University of Oregon has a Clear Bag Policy for all athletics events. Fans may bring in one clear bag no larger than 12"x 6"x 12" or a 1-gallon plastic storage bag. Fans are limited to one clear bag per person. Small clutch bags no larger than 4.5" x 6.5" are allowed. Prohibited bags include, but are not limited to, purses, backpacks (including drawstring backpacks), diaper bags, binocular cases, camera cases, fanny packs, luggage, seat cushions with a zipper, any bag larger than the permissible size, and any bag that is not clear.

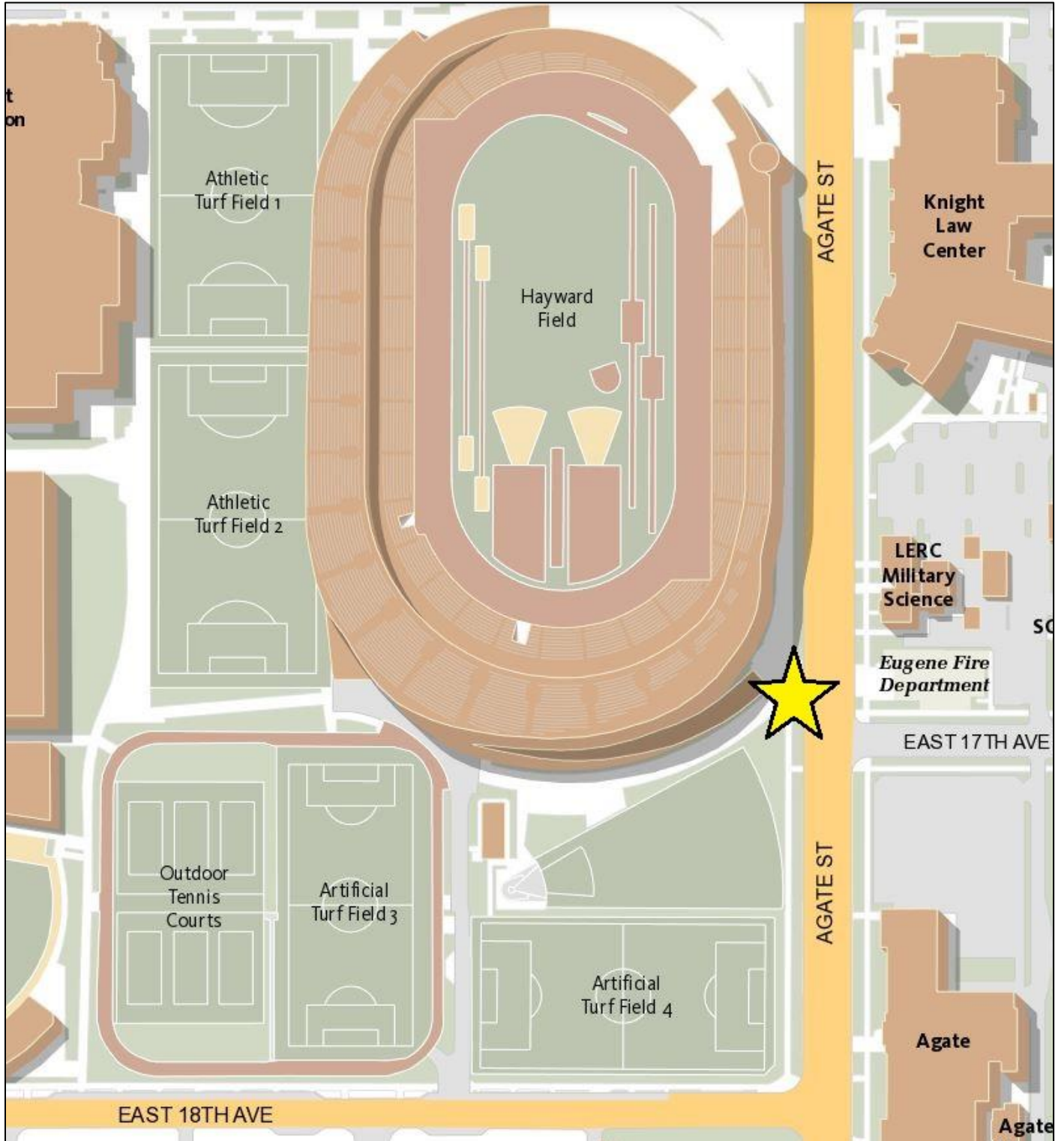
OREGON TWILIGHT SEATING BOWL
