

## 2017 URBANA UNIVERSITY FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

### BLUE KNIGHTS RETURN HOME TO FACE IN-STATE MEC RIVAL NOTRE DAME COLLEGE

➤ UU had its three-game win streak snapped last week. The Blue Knights did not hold a lead in that contest (second time this season - WLU).

#### ➤ UU Football Win Streaks (3 or more)

- 6 - (2011)
- 5 - (2013)
- 4 - (1988, 2005, 2007)

➤ UU allowed a season-high 51 points (4th-most allowed by UU in D2 era) to the Cavs after limiting opponents to 17.8 ppg.

➤ UU will look to win back-to-back home games for the first time in three years. UU is 2-11 at home since 2015.

➤ UU has already matched its win total from last season and another win would give UU its highest win total in four years.

➤ The last time UU started 3-3 it won five straight games to finish with the school's best record ever in 2011 (8-3).

➤ Tre Saunders (28 TDs) needs three touchdown receptions to break the UU all-time career record of 30.

➤ Saunders surpassed 5,000 career all-purpose yards with 152 last week, which included his first career kick return TD for 100 yards (tied UU record - Kelly Carter 100 yards vs. Concord in 2013). Saunders ranks third among active D2 career leaders in all-purpose yards (5,098).

➤ UU holds a 17-3 record when producing 200+ yards on the ground since 2010. The Blue Knights have gone over 200 twice this season (213 at WLU; 250 at WVWC).

➤ Maurice Warren Jr. recorded the longest run by a Blue Knight this season with a 32-yard scamper last week. He leads UU with 496 rushing yards (4.9/carry).

➤ Warren ran for a career-high 173 yards (9th-most by a Blue Knight) on 31 carries and scored his first TD as a Blue Knight at Wesleyan.

➤ Rodell Rahmaan caught a career-high three TDs last week for his second straight outing with at least two TD grabs. He's hauled a TD in five straight outings, including the longest UU passing TD this season. (48 yds at Lake Erie).

➤ Rahmaan is tied for fourth in the nation and tied for the MEC lead with eight TD receptions. Six of his previous 12 catches have been in the end zone.

➤ Rahmaan (8) & Saunders (4) have caught 12 of UU's 14 passing touchdowns.

➤ Redshirt-freshman Philip Dozier hauled his first career TD reception last week.

➤ Andre Cliff recorded a 57-yard gallop on his first career punt return last week.

➤ UU leads the nation in fumbles recovered (13) and is fifth in the nation for team sacks (4.0/gm) with at least two in every game.

➤ Duray Hall leads the defense, ranking among the national leaders in sacks (8th), solo tackles (6th) & tackles for loss (3rd).

➤ UU ranks among the top 25 team leaders in 13 stat categories:

- 1st - fumbles recovered (13)
- 1st - blocked punts (5)
- 1st - punt return defense (-1.14/gm)
- 3rd - blocked kicks (5)
- 5th - sacks by (4.0/gm)
- 6th - turnovers gained (17)
- 7th - team tackles for loss (9.8)
- 15th - net punting (38.9/punt)
- 16th - fourth-down conv. (27.3%)
- 17th - time of possession (33:01)
- 23rd - total defense (308.8/gm)
- 24th - punt returns (15.4/return)
- 25th - rushing defense (107.8)

➤ UU and NDC are even 3-3 in the all-time series. UU won the first three meetings while NDC has the most recent streak of three wins. UU is 2-1 at home against the Falcons

## ABOUT BLUE KNIGHT FOOTBALL

Urbana University (then Urbana College) experimented with football in the 1930's by sponsoring a club team that played against high schools and nearby Cedarville College.

The modern era of Urbana football was launched in 1985, with the first varsity game played against Tiffin University (won, 30-7).

The Blue Knights have featured 13 All-Americans on the field. The most recent All-American was former walk-on D'Gary Wallace ('16) who holds the school & MEC record in tackles (431).

Former star quarterback DJ Mendenhall ('14) is tied for the MEC record for most passing touchdowns in a game. He tossed six TD's at home against West Virginia State in 2013.

The most wins in a season came in back-to-back years in 2011 and 2012 (8-3). UU captured the Great Lakes Football Conference title in 2010 (first year as D2 program) and in 2011.

UU finished 7-2 against league opponents (7-4 overall) and tied for second place in the inaugural MEC season in 2013.

Tyler Haines is the 10th head coach in program history. The previous two coaches are still active in the Division II ranks - Dave Taynor (HC at Lock Haven) & Tim Place (HC at Chowan).

Former UU coach and All-American Dave Taynor ('99) holds the program record for coaching wins (38).

## NOTES CONTINUED ...

➤ Green made his Blue Knight debut against the Falcons two years ago when he came off the bench to throw a pair of 4th-quarter TDs.

➤ Green recorded four passing TDs and one rushing TD last week, marking his second career game with five total TDs. It was his 10th career game with at least two passing TDs and 5th career game with at least one passing TD and one rushing TD.

➤ UU has won the turnover battle in back-to-back games for the first time this season with 12 total takeaways (9 fr, 3 int).

➤ LB Josh Dillard (3 tfl, 2 ff, sack) and kicker Josh Cole (3-5 FGs; 11 pts) earned MEC Player of the Week nods on Oct. 2.

➤ Cole's three made field goals were the most by a UU kicker in a game since Oct. 22, 2005. UU totaled just three combined made FGs in the past two seasons.

➤ Defensive backs Andre Cliff, Roman Sneed, Sherman Watson and Richie Carpenter Jr. each have one interception.

➤ UU won the first night football game in school history on Thursday, Sept. 28 against Charleston, 25-21. UU set a school attendance record of 3,412 on that night.

➤ UU limited Wesleyan to 184 total yards in Week 4, marking the first time UU kept an opponent under 200 total yards since 2012.

➤ UU only allowed five third-down conversions in a three-game stretch (0-11 FSU, 4-14 LEC, 1-14 WVWC).

➤ UU leads the nation in blocked punts with five total, including a school record three in the home opener vs. Fairmont State.

➤ UU scored 16 points on special teams at Lake Erie following a blocked punt and recovery by Chris Richardson, a safety and punt return TD.

➤ Green has rushed for over 400 yards and thrown for over 2,500 in 21 games played at UU.

➤ UU scored a season-high 37 points in the Lake Erie win. That is the second-highest point total during Coach Haines' tenure (54 vs. Cin. Christian in 2016) and highest total scored on the road.

➤ Since the start of 2015, UU has played 11 games decided by less than 10 points (5-6 record).

➤ Coach Haines hired an entire new coaching staff, including former NFL players Jim Cordle (OLine/Run-Game Coordinator) and Stacey Hairston (Defensive Coordinator).

➤ UU will be donning new under armour uniforms this season, featuring white or black tops to pair with blue or grey pants.

➤ UU also made significant upgrades to UU Stadium with the addition of lights and renovated, modern turf surface.

➤ This is the 33rd season of Urbana football, and eighth as a Division II program.

➤ Head coach Tyler Haines is in his third season (6-19) and 10th overall in college football. He previously spent two years as an assistant at IUP and five years as an assistant at Adrian (MI).



**HEAD COACH - TYLER HAINES, 3RD SEASON**



Tyler Haines enters his third year leading the Urbana football program in 2017. Haines is the 10th head coach in school history and has nine years of coaching experience at the NCAA Division II and III levels. A native of nearby

Piqua, Ohio, he has strong ties to the Miami Valley Region and spent a portion of his childhood living in Urbana.

Last fall, Haines led a youthful Blue Knight squad to three wins which included two road victories over Mountain East Conference teams. UU outlasted Concord in Week 3, 21-15, and then moved past Charleston in a Week 8 thriller, 35-34.

Haines recorded a milestone win on October 8, 2016, earning his first home victory at UU Stadium with a 54-7 thrashing of Cincinnati Christian. In that game, UU gained 579 yards on offense - the most since 2013 - while scoring the fourth-most points in school history. Junior Trevon Saunders set school records in the Week 6 triumph with four touchdowns and 232 receiving yards.

In his first season at the helm in 2015, Haines stabilized the program after facing just two short months of preparation leading up to preseason camp. The Blue Knights remained competitive, despite playing without a true quarterback due to injury, and lost four games by less than a touchdown.

Haines picked up his first career win as a head coach in thrilling fashion. Playing on the road against West Virginia State in Week 2 (Sept. 12, 2015), UU scored three times on its final five possessions to prevail by a final score of 30-23. The final touchdown came in the final seconds on a 38-yard strike through the air.

**BEFORE URBANA**

Prior to joining Urbana, Haines coached at Indiana University of Pennsylvania (IUP) where

he was offensive coordinator/quarterbacks coach for two seasons. Under his guidance, the Crimson Hawks offense averaged 31.0 points per game and racked up 396.0 yards per game. Haines helped IUP collect 15 wins during his tenure, including a 9-2 mark and No. 24 national ranking during the 2013 campaign.

Prior to his time at IUP, Haines spent five years at Division III Adrian College in Michigan. There, he directed a high-powered offense as the offensive coordinator for three seasons and also served as the assistant head coach.

Haines was instrumental for the Bulldogs, helping the program win its first outright conference championship since 1983 while setting four single season records in 2012. In 2011, the Bulldogs ranked as high as 16th in the AFCA Division III national poll.

**PLAYING CAREER**

Haines also had a very successful athletic career. A two-time first-team All-Heartland Conference linebacker, he lettered for three years at Defiance College, recording 143 tackles, 39 tackles-for-loss, 9.5 sacks, and four interceptions after transferring from Division II Ashland University.

Haines played a prominent part of a Yellow Jacket defense that finished fourth in the nation in total defense and led the HCAC in rushing defense and total defense in 2005 and 2006. Haines was a team captain in both his junior and senior seasons for Defiance and graduated in December 2006 with a bachelor's degree in integrated social studies.

A 2006 preseason All-American, Haines also garnered ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District honors and was named All-North Region at season's end. Also in 2006, Haines was a semi-finalist for the Draddy Trophy, an award known as the "Academic Heisman". He appeared on the dean's list three times and ended college with a GPA of 3.4.

Haines started his coaching career in 2007 at his alma mater, Piqua High School, where he was a First Team All-Southwest Ohio linebacker and quarterback during his playing days.

Tyler and his wife Logan have three daughters.

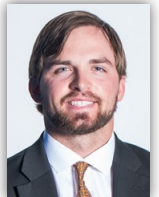

**LAST MEETING -- NOV. 5, 2016 IN SOUTH EUCLID, OHIO**

Urbana scored on the opening drive for the sixth straight game, but couldn't keep up with Notre Dame College in a 35-14 loss at Mueller Field.

After both teams scored on their opening drives for a 7-7 score in the first quarter, Notre Dame scored twice in the second to go ahead 21-7 at halftime. The Blue Knights had a chance to get within a touchdown right before the break, but a shot for the end zone on a first-down play in NDC territory was intercepted at the Falcon five-yard line.

Four different players hauled down at least four receptions for Urbana. Kelly Carter had six grabs for a team-high 77 yards and a touchdown while Trevon Saunders also caught six balls for 44 yards. It was the first game since Week 4 against West Liberty that Saunders was kept out of the end zone.

On defense, Duray Hall secured a career-best 19 total tackles. The redshirt freshman linebacker had nine solo stops and assisted on 10 tackles while recording one tackle behind the line of scrimmage.

### WEEK 6 STANDOUTS

Connor Jessop (Shepherd), Kahzin Daniels (Charleston) and Marquis Hamilton (UVA-Wise) have earned Mountain East Conference Player of the Week honors for their play in the sixth week of the season.

Jessop, a senior from Ashburn, Va., guided the Rams to a 51-14 win over West Liberty on Saturday. He was 23-of-30 passing for 313 yards and four touchdown passes. He has thrown for over 300 yards in four of his first five games and his 20 touchdowns this season are third-most in the country.

Daniels, a junior from Newark, N.J., was a force on defense in a low-scoring affair as the Golden Eagles downed West Virginia Wesleyan, 15-7. He racked up 10 tackles on the day, including two for a loss with a sack, and also recorded a safety against the Bobcats. Daniels became the school's all-time leader for sacks with 21 during the game, and currently ranks fifth in the country in tackles for a loss and eighth in sacks.

Hamilton, a freshman from Washington, D.C., came up with a pair of big plays on special teams as the Cavaliers outlasted Urbana, 51-41. He broke a tie game at the half by returning the opening kickoff in the third quarter 99 yards for a touchdown. He later blocked a point after attempt to help keep UVA-Wise's lead at three, and the team would go on to add a late score for the final margin.

#### Other Top Performances

**Offense:** Austin Ratliff (GSC) led the Pioneers to their first MEC victory of the season after rushing for 156 yards on 12 carries including a 94-yard touchdown run along with five receptions for 39 yards and a score...Brandon Plyler (CU) recorded four catches for 36 yards and two scores...Tajuan Green (UU) combined for five total touchdowns with a season-high four passing and one rushing score while tying his career single-season high of 13 touchdown passes...Call Wilkins (WVU) ran for 98 yards on 14 carries in the Yellow Jackets' win over Kentucky State.

**Defense:** Chad Pinson (WVWC) had a game-high 14 tackles with one tackle for loss against Charleston...Cory Roberts (GSC) notched seven tackles with two for loss and a sack in a 48-28 win over Concord...Marcus Porter (FSU) recorded nine tackles and a sack against Notre Dame...James Gupton (SU) tallied a team-high eight tackles with seven solo stops including a tackle for loss (two yards)...Justin Noble (CU) had five tackles (two for loss) against Glenville State...RJ Goodwin (NDC) intercepted a pass and returned it 22 yards to set up the first score of the game for the Falcons and later forced a fumble at the Notre Dame 26-yard line...Mikal Toliver (UU) paced the Blue Knights with a career-high three tackles for loss and was credited with six defensive stops overall.

**Special Teams:** Tywan Pearce (CU) averaged 28.5 yards per kickoff return on four run backs against Glenville State including a long of 50 yards...Tanner Harding (NDC) hit two timely field goals in a 19-14 win over Fairmont State and averaged 57 yards per kick on five kickoffs with two touchbacks over the course of the contest...Trevon Saunders (UU) tied a school record with his first career kick return touchdown of 100 yards and eclipsed the 5,000 career all-purpose yards mark and ranks third among Division II active career leaders.

### MEC NOTEBOOK

#### Falcons, Rams Tangle On Thursday Night

The seventh week of the season opens on Thursday night as the second-ranked Shepherd Rams take on Fairmont State at Duvall-Rosier Field in Fairmont, W.Va.

Fans can watch the game live in high definition online at WVMetroNews.com/channel or listen across the region on MetroNews affiliate stations. The live video stream will also be available at MountainEast.tv, on the MEC Digital Network Channel on OTT devices (Roku, Amazon Fire, Apple TV and Android TV) and on Facebook Live.

The Rams bring their high-powered offense against one of the league's top defensive units in Fairmont State. Shepherd is second in the country averaging 50.5 points per game and has not scored fewer than 42 in any contest. Quarterback Connor Jessop has thrown at least three touchdown passes in all five games this season, and his 20 TDs are third in Division II.

Fairmont State (4-2) is looking to bounce back after a tough 19-14 loss at Notre Dame last week. The Falcons lead the league in scoring defense allowing just 15.8 points per game, and have 18 takeaways this year with 12 coming on interceptions. FSU has been in several tight games this year with four of its six games decided by less than a touchdown. The Falcons are 2-2 in those games.

#### Saturday State

West Virginia State (3-3) returns to action after a non-conference win over Kentucky State to take on Concord (1-5). The Yellow Jackets are averaging 36.7 points per game, while Concord is coming off its highest point total of the season last week (28 vs. Glenville State).

UVA-Wise (4-2) is looking for its first-ever win at West Virginia Wesleyan (2-4) on Saturday. The Cavs used several big plays to pile up 51 points last week -- the most under second-year head coach Dane Damron. WVWC, meanwhile, has managed just 37 total points in its last four games.

Notre Dame (5-1) will try to push its winning streak to six games against in-state rival Urbana (3-3). The Falcons lead the MEC with 267 yards per game and 17 touchdowns on the ground. The Blue Knights defense is allowing just 117 rushing yards per game, and leads the league in sacks (24) and is seventh in the country in tackles for a loss per game (9.8).

West Liberty (2-4) will try to snap its three-game losing streak at home against Glenville State (2-4). After scoring 24 points in the first week of the season, WLU has been held to fewer than 19 points in each of the last five. The Pioneers are averaging 32.7 points per game, but the opposition is averaging 37.0 points so far this season.

#### Down To The Wire

The MEC continues to treat fans to close games on a weekly basis. In the first six weeks of the season, 37 percent (13-of-35) of the games have been decided by a touchdown or less and 49 percent (17-of-35) have been decided by 10 points or less.

#### Going The Distance

There were several big plays last week in MEC action. Glenville State's Austin Ratliff had the longest rush from scrimmage this season with a 94-yard touchdown (second-longest rush in NCAA D2 this season), and Trevon Saunders (UU) had a 100-yard kickoff return for a touchdown, and Marquis Hamilton (WISE) added a 99-yard kickoff return for a touchdown in the same game.

#### Pick 2

Seven players have two interceptions in a game this season in the MEC. Three different players from Fairmont State have two picks in a game this year.

#### Passing For 300

There have been nine 300-yard passing games this season. Shepherd's Connor Jessop (4) and West Virginia State's Matt Kinnick (3) own seven of those nine games.
