CREDENTIALS

The South Alabama Athletics Media Relations Office will issue credentials to WORKING press only. All credential requests should be made no later than 24 hours prior to the start of the desired contest. Working members of the media who plan to cover South Alabama on the road are encouraged to make credential requests through the South Alabama Athletics Media Relations Office.

WEEKLY LUNCHEON

USA will hold a weekly luncheon with head coach Joey Jones and select players beginning at noon every Monday throughout the season. The luncheon and interviews that follow will take place at the football field house on the west side of campus.

SUN BELT CONFERENCE TELECONFERENCE

The Sun Belt Conference conducts a weekly teleconference with each of the eight head coaches in the league. Coach Jones will be available at 10:58 a.m. CT each week.

PRACTICES

As a general rule, all practices are closed to the media and the general public, although media are allowed to attend the last 30 minutes of most sessions. Please contact Brian Fremund, Assistant Athletic Director for Media Relations, in advance if you are interested in conducting interviews and/or attending a practice session, so an escort can be made available.

INTERVIEWS

In-person interviews with members of the coaching staff and student-athletes can be arranged by calling or e-mailing Fremund. Interviews with student-athletes MUST be arranged in advance through the Athletic Media Relations Office. Coach Jones is generally available 30 minutes before practice, while he and student-athletes are available immediately following practice. Phone interviews are also available, but will be arranged around the student-athletes' class and practice schedules. Student-athletes' phone numbers are not available under any circumstance. All phone interview requests must be made 24 hours prior.

POSTGAME INTERVIEWS

After a 10-minute cooling off period, requested players and coaches will be made available to members of the media. The Jaguar locker room is CLOSED both at home and on the road. Requested players and coaches will be escorted by a South Alabama Athletic Media Relations staff member to the designated interview area in the lobby of the main offices on the West side of Ladd-Pebbles Stadium at home, and will adhere to the host school's policies on the road.

OPENING KICK

► After opening the season with a 10-point victory over Gardner-Webb at Ladd-Peebles Stadium, South Alabama begins a two-game road swing with Saturday's visit to Nebraska.

► This contest will mark the first time that the Jaguars will take on a member of the Big Ten Conference.

► It's the first of two meetings scheduled between the two programs, with another match-up slated for Aug. 31, 2019, in Lincoln.

► The Jags last opened a season 2-0 in 2011 after beating West Alabama and Lamar at home — those were the final two victories in a school-record 19-game win streak that began with the program's debut on Sept. 5, 2009.

► The Jags have won their first road contest of the season each of the last two falls, with victories at Tulane in 2013 and Kent State to begin the '14 campaign.

SOPHOMORE RB HAS SECOND-HALF SURGE

Making his first career start in the Jaguars' season opener against GWU, **Xavier Johnson** set career highs with 121 yards rushing and 177 all-purpose yards while scoring a pair of touchdowns to help lead USA to a 33-23 victory. Both scores came in the second half, with the first — on a 56-yard reception in which he took a pass out of the backfield to the end zone — coming on the Jags' initial snap after falling behind for the only time in the contest in the opening minutes of the third quarter, and the second clinching the game midway through the final period after a school-record 92-yard run. The sophomore — who averaged more than 22 yards per touch — became the first Jaguar to score both a rushing and receiving touchdown in the same game since **Santuan McGee** turned the trick on Nov. 12, 2009, in a 35-0 win over Huntingdon (Ala.) to cap the program's inaugural season.

DEES DOMINATES IN DEBUT

In his first game at South Alabama, Texas Tech transfer **Blake Dees** led all players with 13 total tackles — which included a pair behind the line of scrimmage — and forced a pair of fumbles in USA's 10-point win over Gardner-Webb. Seven of those stops came after the Jaguars took the lead for good with 10-and-a-half minutes left in the third quarter, while the second fumble he forced happened on the opening play of the final period and was recovered by the Jags; it led to a field-goal and a double-digit advantage that USA would not give up. The senior linebacker became just the second individual in program history to post 10 or more tackles in his debut (**B.J. Scott** collected 10 in the 2011 season opener after transferring from Alabama) and is now one of four individuals to have forced a pair of fumbles in the same contest.

SUNANON STILL SCORING

PK **Aleem Sunanon's** nine points were the most recorded by a kicker in the Sun Belt Conference on the opening weekend of the season, as he converted all five tries in the Jaguars' 33-23 victory over Gardner-Webb **to be named the league's special teams player of the week for the second time in his career.** That included extending his streak to 10 consecutive field goals made dating back to last season, the second-longest in program history (he owns the standard after making 12 straight from Oct. 19-Dec. 7, 2013), after he converted from 41 yards out at the end of the third quarter and hit a 28-yard attempt three minutes later to push USA's lead to 10 points. And by connecting on all three extra-point tries, Sunanon became USA's all-time leader in that category as well with 64 in two-plus years.

BIG DAY FOR BUCHANAN IN OPENER

S **Roman Buchanan** matched a career high with nine stops, adding his first interception since the

second game of his collegiate career — a 41-39 USA win at Tulane on Sept. 7, 2013 — against the Runnin' Bulldogs. The junior has now been credited with at least one tackle for loss in three straight contests dating back to last fall's regular-season finale, the longest streak of his career.

CATCHING ON

Of the three transfers from UAB starting at wide receiver or tight end last weekend, it was junior **Gerald Everett** who made the biggest impact in his first outing as a Jag. Everett shared game-high honors after collecting four catches for 76 yards — marking just the third time since the start of last year that a tight end has led USA in receiving yards — that included a 50-yard scoring reception the first time he touched the ball with four-and-a-half minutes left in the opening quarter. He also had a 14-yard reception with the Jags facing second-and-20 early in the fourth quarter that led to Sunanon's second field goal two plays later.

HUGE START TO FINAL SEASON

Coming into the year, senior DL **DeMarion Harper** had been credited with a total of five stops in 12 appearances his first two seasons with the program. He nearly doubled that total on the opening night of the 2015 campaign, recording nine tackles in the GWU win — which included one behind the line — as well as breaking up a fourth-down pass to end a Runnin' Bulldog threat midway through the third quarter with the Jaguars up by just four points at the time. Actually, it's the second time in as many regular-season outings that Harper has posted a career-high total after finishing with multiple stops for the first time against Navy last November.

A BIG NIGHT FOR ALFORD

Harper wasn't the only Jaguar on the defensive line to turn in a career performance in the Gardner-Webb victory; **Tre Alford** matched his total of nine stops, equalling the amount of tackles he posted in 13 outings as a redshirt freshman a year ago. It's the second straight contest that he has collected multiple tackles after not accomplishing the feat in his first 12 appearances, while Alford also broke up a pass for the first time since USA defeated Texas State — their most recent victory before last weekend — on Nov. 15 a season ago.

COMMITTEE APPROACH

In addition to Johnson's efforts, two other Jag running backs contributed as USA averaged more than seven yards per carry in its season-opening win. After sitting out as a redshirt last fall, junior-college transfer **Tyreis Thomas** made his program debut and posted 56 yards on a team-leading nine attempts, while **Terrance Timmons** recorded a career-long 49-yard run on his first touch of the year to give the Jaguars a 7-0 lead less than two minutes into the contest. The team's average of 7.23 yards per rush was its highest ever against an NCAA Division I opponent, surpassing the 6.58 figure USA had in last season's victory over Troy.

EARL-Y RETURNS FROM FREE SAFETY

Devon Earl earned the start at free safety for the Jaguars in the season opener after senior Antonio Carter was sidelined by an injury in practice at the beginning of last week, responding with a career-best eight total stops including a tackle for loss in the 10-point win over GWU. Since returning from an injury that forced him to sit out the Appalachian State game last October, the junior has recorded four or more stops in five of nine contests with USA claiming victory in three of those outings.

NO SLOW START FOR SOPHOMORE "STAR"

After appearing in all 13 contests last fall — his first season at the collegiate level — Reaves made his first start in the Jag secondary against the Runnin' Bulldogs, finishing with five tackles including one behind the line of scrimmage to go along with a forced fumble and his first career interception. That total equalled his career high first set in the 2014 regular season finale against Navy, while it marked the second straight fall that the defensive back has made an impact in USA's season opener; Reaves collected three unassisted stops in his Jaguar debut at Kent State.

EXPLOSIVE OPENING

The Jaguar offense opened the season with three plays of 50 or more yards in the win over the Runnin' Bulldogs — they also had a touchdown run fall one yard shy of that figure — which was the most for the unit since Brandon Bridge and Ross Metheny combined to complete three passes for 50-plus yards at Troy on Oct. 5, 2013. USA averaged 7.29 yards per snap while totalling 408 yards last week, its best figure per play since averaging 7.86 yards in an Oct. 4 victory last fall at Appalachian State.

YOU CAN HAVE IT

The ball, that is — while running just 56 plays last time out, the Jags held the ball for only 21 minutes and seven seconds in picking up the win. That was more than 30 seconds less time of possession for the offense than the previous program low of 21:42, set in an Oct. 31, 2009, victory over Fork Union (Va.) Military Academy; the previous low mark in the category for USA against an NCAA Division I opponent came on Oct. 26, 2013, at Texas State (22:39).
