MEDIA INFORMATION

CREDENTIALS

The South Alabama Athletics Media Relations Office will issue credentials to WORKING press only. All credential requests should be made no later than 24 hours prior to the start of the desired contest. Working members of the media who plan to cover South Alabama on the road are encouraged to make credential requests through the South Alabama Athletics Media Relations Office.

WEEKLY LUNCHEON

USA will hold a weekly luncheon with head coach Joey Jones and select players beginning at noon every Monday throughout the season. The luncheon and interviews that follow will take place at the football field house on the west side of campus.

SUN BELT CONFERENCE TELECONFERENCE

The Sun Belt Conference conducts a weekly teleconference with each of the 11 head coaches in the league. Coach Jones will be available at 10:58 a.m. CT each week.

PRACTICES

As a general rule, all practices are closed to the media and the general public, although media are allowed to attend the last 30 minutes of most sessions. Please contact Brian Fremund, Assistant Athletic Director for Media Relations, in advance if you are interested in conducting interviews and/or attending a practice session, so an escort can be made available.

INTERVIEWS

In-person interviews with members of the coaching staff and student-athletes can be arranged by calling or e-mailing Fremund. Interviews with student-athletes MUST be arranged in advance through the Athletic Media Relations Office. Coach Jones is generally available 30 minutes before practice, while he and student-athletes are available immediately following practice. Phone interviews are also available, but will be arranged around the student-athletes' class and practice schedules. Student-athletes' phone numbers are not available under any circumstance. All phone interview requests must be made 24 hours prior.

POSTGAME INTERVIEWS

After a 10-minute cooling off period, requested players and coaches will be made available to members of the media. The Jaguar locker room is CLOSED both at home and on the road. Requested players and coaches will be escorted by a South Alabama Athletic Media Relations staff member to the designated interview area in the lobby of the main offices on the West side of Ladd-Pebbles Stadium at home, and will adhere to the host school's policies on the road.

OPENING KICK

► This marks the third time the Jaguars will take on the Colonels in the program's seven-plus seasons of play, although it's the first match-up between the two since Sept. 8, 2012.

► It's the first of two straight non-conference home games for South with San Diego State set to visit the Jags on Oct. 1.

► NSU is one of four Louisiana schools on the Jaguars' 2016 schedule, but the only one of those to come to Mobile. In addition to last week's contest at Louisiana-Lafayette, USA has back-to-back games at Louisiana-Monroe and Louisiana State on the docket in November.

► In the first meeting between the Jags and Colonels, Sept. 18, 2010 at Ladd-Peebles Stadium, **Kendall Houston** (12-116) and **Brandon Ross** (19-115) became the first pair in program history to rush for 100-plus yards in the same game.

► Nicholls was South's first NCAA Division I opponent when the two met in 2010, and in that game the Colonels became the first team ever to hold a lead against the Jaguars when they scored a touchdown on their opening drive four-and-a-half minutes into play.

NOTES FROM THE LAST NICHOLLS MEETING

► To this day, the match-up remains the only contest in program history that the Jaguars have won with a single-digit point total.

► The 12 points the teams combined for that afternoon are also the fewest in USA's 80-game history.

► The Jag defense recorded 14 tackles for loss in the game, a school record that still stands (it was matched in a win over Louisiana-Monroe on Nov. 23 the following fall).

► DE/OLB **Pat Moore** led South with 3½ stops behind the line including 2½ sacks, both program game records at the time.

► While the Jaguars managed 279 yards of total offense in the contest, the Colonel's 118 total yards are the fewest an NCAA Division I opponent has gained against the USA defense; that figure currently ranks second in all games in the program's team record books.

EVERETT IN THE END ZONE AGAIN

Senior TE **Gerald Everett** caught an 11-yard touchdown pass with just over three minutes remaining in the game against ULL to help draw the Jaguars within one score, the second time in USA's first three games that he has reached the end zone in the last four minutes of regulation. He became just the fourth individual in program history to achieve a double-digit touchdown reception total, moving into a tie for third on the school's all-time list with **Courtney Smith** (2009-10). While it marked the second time this fall that Everett has led the Jags in catches – he finished the night with seven – it was the first occasion since last year's Nov. 28 visit to Georgia Southern that he has paced the squad in receiving yards after recording 83 against the Ragin' Cajuns.

CAREER NIGHT AGAINST THE CAJUNS

Kalen Jackson posted a contest-high 12 tackles at ULL, tying a career-best total first recorded last season against Arkansas State. In addition to nearly equaling his two-game total coming into the match-up (14), the senior safety also broke up his first pass of the year. Jackson needs just two stops to record 100 since joining the program prior to the start of last season.

BLOWING UP PLAYS IN THE BACKFIELD

Entering the fall, LB **Roman Buchanan** had been credited with a career-high two tackles for loss once in 37 contests. After posting a pair of stops behind the line of scrimmage against the Ragin' Cajuns, the senior has now accomplished the feat in back-to-back outings. Buchanan also broke up a pass in the ULL game, moving up to fourth on South's all-time record list with 13 in his career; he's one shy of equaling the school record in the category.

PASSING FANCY

Sophomore **Dallas Davis** had just one incompleteness in the first half at ULL on Saturday, connecting on 9-of-10 attempts, before going on to throw for 171 yards after the break. Through three games Davis has completed 62.9 percent (66-of-105) of his passes – which is on pace to set the school season record in the category – while with 172 yards through the air this week against Nicholls he would become the first Jaguar quarterback to throw for 1,000 in the first four outings of a season.

REAVES DOES IT ALL AGAINST RAGIN' CAJUNS

After recording his first interception of the season and breaking up another pass in the ULL contest last weekend, **Jeremy Reaves** is tied for the lead in the Sun Belt Conference with 1.33 passes defended per outing. In addition to entering the top 10 at USA with the third pick of his career, the junior became the eighth Jaguar to ever break up 10 or more passes while reaching double digits in tackles for loss as well – he now has 10½ in two-plus years – after making one stop behind the line among his five total.

YARDAGE MARK

Xavier Johnson not only led the Jags in rushing with a season-best 58 yards against the Ragin' Cajuns, he returned four kickoffs for 90 more to post a total of 148 all-purpose yards on the night. With the effort, the junior running back surpassed the 2,000-yard mark in the latter category, making him the fourth individual in program history to accomplish the feat.

STELLAR SECOND HALF

After **Brandon McKee** and **Corliss Waitman** each punted once before the intermission in the ULL game, the former handled those duties the rest of the way. Over the final 30 minutes, the senior averaged 44.75 yards per kick on four attempts, with three of those ending up inside the Ragin' Cajun 20-yard line including a 67-yard effort that was the third-longest in USA history. The three punts inside the opponent's 20-yard line were the most recorded by McKee since he tied the school record with four in the 2014 Raycom Media Camellia Bowl against Bowling Green.

TOUCHDOWN TIME

Last fall, his first with the program, **Tyreis Thomas** didn't reach the end zone until the Jaguars' 10th contest at Georgia State on Nov. 21; he would go on to score again the following week at Georgia Southern, ending the campaign with those two scores. The senior running back has matched that total in just three appearances this season, however, after crossing the goal line from six yards out in the opening minute of the second quarter on a play that would give USA its only lead of the contest.

BALL SECURITY

The Jags were plus one in turnover margin against ULL, marking the fifth game in a row dating back to a Nov. 21 trip to Georgia State that South has finished with the same or fewer miscues than the opposition. In fact, USA has gone 24-8 (75%) all-time with fewer turnovers than its opponent.

Percent success in the red zone for the South offense last time out, the first time the unit has been perfect inside the opposition's 20-yard line since scoring on all four chances in the 2015 season finale against Appalachian State. It was the second time in as many weeks that the Jaguars improved their red zone efficiency after converting on 3-of-5 (60%) occasions in the opener at Mississippi State then taking advantage of 2-of-3 (66.7%) chances when driving deep into Georgia Southern territory in the second outing of the fall.
