MEDIA INFORMATION

CREDENTIALS

The South Alabama Athletics Media Relations Office will issue credentials to WORKING press only. All credential requests should be made no later than 24 hours prior to the start of the desired contest. Working members of the media who plan to cover South Alabama on the road are encouraged to make credential requests through the South Alabama Athletics Media Relations Office.

WEEKLY LUNCHEON

USA will hold a weekly luncheon with head coach Joey Jones and select players beginning at noon every Monday throughout the season. The luncheon and interviews that follow will take place at the football field house on the west side of campus.

SUN BELT CONFERENCE TELECONFERENCE

The Sun Belt Conference conducts a weekly teleconference with each of the 11 head coaches in the league. Coach Jones will be available at 10:58 a.m. CT each week.

PRACTICES

As a general rule, all practices are closed to the media and the general public, although media are allowed to attend the last 30 minutes of most sessions. Please contact Brian Fremund, Assistant Athletic Director for Media Relations, in advance if you are interested in conducting interviews and/or attending a practice session, so an escort can be made available.

INTERVIEWS

In-person interviews with members of the coaching staff and student-athletes can be arranged by calling or e-mailing Fremund. Interviews with student-athletes MUST be arranged in advance through the Athletic Media Relations Office. Coach Jones is generally available 30 minutes before practice, while he and student-athletes are available immediately following practice. Phone interviews are also available, but will be arranged around the student-athletes' class and practice schedules. Student-athletes' phone numbers are not available under any circumstance. All phone interview requests must be made 24 hours prior.

POSTGAME INTERVIEWS

After a 10-minute cooling off period, requested players and coaches will be made available to members of the media. The Jaguar locker room is CLOSED both at home and on the road. Requested players and coaches will be escorted by a South Alabama Athletic Media Relations staff member to the designated interview area in the lobby of the main offices on the West side of Ladd-Pebbles Stadium at home, and will adhere to the host school's policies on the road.

OPENING KICK

- ▶ For the second time in three years, the Jaguars open the home Sun Belt Conference schedule with a match-up against Georgia Southern.
- ▶ This will mark, however, the first time since beginning league play in 2012 that the Jags' first home game of the season will be against a Sun Belt opponent.
- ▶ Last year's 33-23 victory over Gardner-Webb on Sept. 5 marked the first time since 2011 that USA has won its home debut.
- ▶ The Jaguars enter the campaign with an all-time mark of 31-13 (70.5%) at Ladd-Peebles Stadium, which includes a 9-7 record in conference action.
- ▶ While this is the fourth time in five seasons that South will begin SBC play in September, it's the earliest date on the calendar that the Jags will play a league game.

NOTES FROM THE LAST GEORGIA SOUTHERN MEETING

- ▶ The Jaguars held a 14-7 lead midway through the second quarter following **Devon Earl's** 62-yard return of a fumble for a touchdown, but the Eagles scored three touchdowns in the final six-and-a-half minutes of the half to break open the contest.
- ▶ USA was limited to 136 yards of total offense on 55 plays – the fewest snaps in program history – while being held below 100 yards rushing and passing in the same contest for the first time ever.
- ▶ **Tyreis Thomas** opened the scoring for the Jags for the second straight game with a two-yard touchdown run, as he would go on to lead the squad with 37 yards rushing on eight attempts.
- ▶ **Roman Buchanan** and **Kalen Jackson** were among the three Jaguars to share game-high honors after both recorded seven stops (**DeMarrion Harper** was the other).
- ▶ The Eagles set an opponent record with 489 yards on the ground while their 542 yards of total offense were the most South has allowed to a Sun Belt opponent.

0-2 PITCH

Entering last week's season-opening victory at Mississippi State – the Jags' first-ever against a Southeastern Conference opponent – USA held an 0-2 mark in the series with the Bulldogs. The Jaguars will be looking for the same results the next two weeks, first when they play host to a Georgia Southern squad Saturday that has claimed each of the first two match-ups between the two schools then as they search for their first victory in three tries on the road against Louisiana-Lafayette.

OPENING NOTES

Last year South began the season with a 33-23 win over Gardner-Webb at Ladd-Peebles Stadium, ending a streak of three straight defeats in its first home game of the campaign ... The victory last week marked the third year in a row that the Jaguars have begun the season with a win ... USA is 2-2 thus far in Sun Belt Conference openers after beginning league play with a 24-18 defeat of Troy on the road last fall ... One of those two losses came at the hands of the Jags' opponent this week, as Georgia Southern picked up a 28-6 win in Mobile on Sept. 20, 2014.

DAVIS DAZZLES IN DEBUT AS STARTER

Making his first career start at the collegiate level, **Dallas Davis** posted 308 yards of total offense while leading three second-half touchdown drives to help the Jaguars earn a 21-20 victory at Mississippi State – the program's first against a Southeastern Conference school – on Saturday; *for his efforts Davis was named the SBC Offensive Player of the Week*. The redshirt sophomore was 24-of-34 passing for 285 yards, with a 20-yard touchdown pass to **Josh Magee** to get USA on the scoreboard with its opening drive of the third quarter and a four-yard scoring pass to **Gerald Everett** in the final minute to secure the win. In addition to 19 of his 23 rushing yards coming with the Jags facing third-

and-three on the game-winning drive, moving the team to the MSU-8, Davis was 3-of-3 passing on third downs during the march. Davis' 24 completions tied for the third-highest mark in a game in the school's record books while his 285 yards through the air were the fifth most in a contest as he became the first individual in the program to surpass 300 yards of total offense since **Brandon Bridge** accomplished the feat the Jaguars' appearance in the 2014 Raycom Media Camellia Bowl.

LIKING THE CHANGE TO LINEBACKER

LB **Roman Buchanan** was chosen the *SBC Defensive Player of the Week on Monday* after recording a career-high 12 total tackles in the Jaguars' win at Mississippi State; 10 of those were of the solo variety with one for a loss of four yards, and he also broke up a pass to force a three-and-out on the Bulldogs' second possession of the day. The senior was credited with eight stops in the second half to help South overcome a 17-0 deficit as his efforts helped USA limit MSU to 177 yards and just three points after the break. Buchanan's performance – just the second of his career with 10-plus stops – helped him move into fourth on the program's all-time record list, and he also climbed into fifth place with 12 career passes broken up.

MAGEE MAKES MARK IN MISSISSIPPI

Magee led all players with 113 yards on a career-best seven receptions in the win over the Bulldogs, which included four gains of 20 or more yards – that's nearly half the amount 20-plus-yard catches the senior had in 12 games last fall (nine). It was the first time a Jag wideout had 100 or more yards since Magee posted 118 in a win at Troy on Oct. 3 a year ago.

BIG PLAY, BIG DAY

Everett matched a career high with a game-best eight catches against MSU, including a four-yard touchdown reception – his first since a Nov. 12 victory over Louisiana-Lafayette last season – with 57 seconds left in the contest to give the Jaguars the win. He finished the day with 95 yards, surpassing both his reception (six) and yardage (77) totals in the last three games of the 2015 season combined.

ENDS AROUND

Starting defensive ends **Randy Allen** and **Chason Milner** came into the season opener with a total of four tackles between them, but each collected five stops in the win over the Bulldogs. None of those were bigger than Allen's and **Tyree Turner's** combined sack of **Damian Williams** on third-and-10 from the USA-21 with just over six minutes left in the contest, forcing a 46-yard field goal that fell short to keep USA within six points and set up the game-winning drive.

TOP-10 TOTAL

Junior CB **Jeremy Reaves** posted seven stops in the season-opening victory over the Bulldogs, moving into the top 10 in the category on the school's all-time list as he now has 119 in two-plus years of action. Reaves also broke up MSU's first pass attempt of the contest, moving up one spot into a tie for ninth on the program's career record list with a total of eight as well.
