MEDIA INFORMATION

Credentials

The South Alabama Athletics Communications and Digital Media Office will issue credentials to WORKING press only. Passes for spouses, children or friends will not be issued. These credentials are non-transferable and any unauthorized use of a credential will result in the pass being immediately revoked. All credential requests should be made via e-mail to Brian Fremund no later than Tuesday of the week prior to start of the desired contest.

Weekly Press Conference

South Alabama will hold a press conference each Monday prior to a game throughout the 2021 season. Head coach Kane Wommack, coordinators Major Applewhite and Corey Batoon, and select student-athletes will be made available to the media at 12:30 pm (CT) in the team meeting room in the football field house.

Sun Belt Conference Teleconference

The Sun Belt Conference conducts a weekly teleconference with each of the 10 head coaches in the league. Coach Wommack will be available every week at 10:44 a.m. CT.

Practices

During regular game weeks, practices from Monday through Thursday will be open to the media; interviews with coaches and student-athletes will be conducted following the workout. Please contact Fremund in advance if you are interested in conducting interviews and/or attending a practice session, so an escort can be made available.

Interviews

In-person interviews with members of the coaching staff and student-athletes can be arranged by calling or e-mailing Fremund. Interviews with student-athletes MUST be arranged in advance through the Communications and Digital Media Office. Players are generally available after practice on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays, although phone interviews can also be arranged around the student-athletes' class and practice schedules. Student-athletes' phone numbers are not available under any circumstance. All phone interview requests must be made 24 hours prior.

Postgame Interviews

After a 10-minute cooling off period, requested players and coaches will be made available to members of the media. The Jaguar locker room is CLOSED both at home and on the road. Requested players and coaches will be escorted by a Communications and Digital Media staff member to the designated interview area in the northwest corner of Hancock Whitney Stadium.

For road games, USA will adhere to the home team's postgame policies and procedures.

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OPENING KICK

- The Jags play their first road game of the season when they visit Bowling Green Saturday afternoon.
- It's the first time the two programs will meet since facing each other in the 2014 Raycom Media Camellia Bowl.
- The Falcons are scheduled to come to Mobile on Sept. 16, 2028, to complete the home-and-home agreement.
- South makes its first trip to the Buckeye State since defeating Kent State, 23-13, to open the 2014 campaign.
- After taking two of three match-ups from the Golden Flashes, the Jaguars have a 2-2 mark all-time against schools from the Mid-American Conference.
- USA is also slated to take on MAC members Central Michigan (2022 and '23) and Ohio (2024 and '26) in the coming years.

NOTES FROM THE LAST BOWLING GREEN MEETING

- The Jaguars made the first bowl appearance in school history that day.
- South trailed the entire night until scoring with 80 seconds remaining in the contest, only to see the Falcons regain the lead on the first play of the ensuing possession.
- BGSU's 90 plays are still the most run against the Jag defense in the program's record books.
- It was the most passing yards allowed by the unit that season.
- **Maleki Harris'** tackle total set a USA game record at the time that still stands second on the school's all-time list.

NOTES ON WOMMACK'S COACHING/PLAYING CAREER

- Wommack, 34, became the third head coach in program history and youngest at the NCAA Football Bowl Subdivision level when he was hired on Dec. 12 last year.
- He was one of five finalists for the Broyles Award, given to the top NCAA FBS assistant coach in the nation, in 2020 after helping Indiana go 6-2 overall while finishing 12th in the final Associated Press poll.
- In addition to serving as the Hoosiers' defensive coordinator — the youngest in the Power Five — the last two years, Wommack was also defensive coordinator for the Jags in 2016 and '17 as well as at Eastern Illinois for one season prior to his first stint in Mobile.
- The Jaguars allowed over 10 points fewer per outing than the previous campaign his first year on the staff, the fifth-best improvement in the NCAA FBS that fall.
- After beginning his collegiate playing career at Arkansas in 2006, Wommack was a fullback and tight end at Southern Miss for three years — helping the Golden Eagles to a postseason bowl appearance each fall — before receiving his degree from the school in 2009.

"SWARM D" ON DISPLAY

The Jaguar defense recorded four takeaways while limiting Southern Mississippi to just 258 total yards in South's season-opening victory last weekend, a figure that included surrendering only 27 yards in the second quarter as the Jags scored twice to take command of the contest. Not only was it the second time in the last four games going back to last November that USA has forced the opposition into four turnovers, it was the first occasion since their 2019 debut at 24th-ranked Nebraska that the Jaguars have allowed less than 300 yards against an NCAA Football Bowl Subdivision foe. The unit's four sacks were also the most it has finished with since posting four in a defeat of Coastal Carolina in the 2018 finale.

TWO MORE MARKS FOR TOLBERT

WR **Jalen Tolbert** recorded 168 yards — the most in the Sun Belt and the second-highest total in the country the opening week of the season — on just five receptions to help lead South to a 24-point victory over Southern Miss. His first catch of the year went for 49 yards and put the Jaguars on the two-yard line to set up the team's opening

score, while his 27-yard reception on USA's initial possession of the second half led to a touchdown and a 21-7 advantage two plays later. Tolbert began the Jags' next drive with a 47-yard catch to help set up a field goal as well, ending the night with the school's all-time record for receiving yards in a career (he now has 1,834) and also having surpassed 100 receptions in his time with the program. It was the fourth time that he has recorded a 100-yard game as a Jaguar, and the second straight year that he has accomplished the feat in USA's first outing of the season.

BANK ON IT

In his first fall at South, **Yam Banks** was credited with two stops in seven appearances; not only did he surpass that total before the end of the third quarter against the Golden Eagles, posting four tackles in all, he ended the night with a pair of forced fumbles as well. It was the first time that an individual in the program has forced multiple fumbles in the same game since **Jeremy Reaves** — currently a member of the Washington Football Team's practice squad — accomplished the feat on Sept. 23, 2017.

BIG DEBUT FOR BENTLEY

Senior transfer **Jake Bentley** accounted for every touchdown scored by the Jag offense in the USM contest, running for one score and throwing for two others, while passing for 269 yards in his Jaguar debut. In fact, after connecting on 17-of-22 (77.3 percent) passes on the night, the quarterback recorded the fifth-highest completion percentage (minimum 10 attempts) in a contest in the school's record books.

THOMAS' TIME

Not only did redshirt freshman DL **Wy'Kevious Thomas** finish the USM game with the most tackles of his career after recording a total of five, he added his first-ever fumble recovery to end a Golden Eagle drive that had reached the USA 10-yard line early in the final quarter. Thomas posted multiple stops on three occasions last fall, and had been credited with five tackles in South's final four contests combined.

HERE'S LOOKING AT LACY

Caullin Lacy is nearly halfway to his reception total from a year ago after hauling in five balls for 67 yards — both career-best figures — in last weekend's victory over the Golden Eagles. The wideout caught four passes in a pair of contests in 2020, ending his first year in the program with 11 receptions for 98 yards in 11 appearances.

PUNT GAME ON POINT IN OPENER

Sophomore **Jack Brooks** averaged just under 44 yards per punt in the Jaguars' season-opening win, recording three kicks of 50 or more yards while tying a career high with three efforts inside the 20-yard line. It was the first time he has had more than two punts of 50-plus yards since an Oct. 3, 2019, match-up with Georgia Southern, while it was the first occasion he has recorded three kicks inside the opposition's 20-yard line since USA faced the Eagles on Oct. 29 last fall.

JAGUARS BY THE NUMBERS**0**

Points allowed by the defense after the break in the Jags' victory over Southern Miss to begin the year, the first time South has held an NCAA FBS opponent off the scoreboard in a half since turning the trick against Louisiana on Nov. 4, 2017. Prior to Saturday, USA had last shut out the opposition in a half in an Oct. 13, 2018, defeat of Alabama State.

Times, in the last three outings dating back to last season, that **Keith Gallmon Jr.** has paced South in total tackles. The junior safety has now accomplished the feat on six occasions since the start of the 2019 campaign.

Yards on **Davyn Flenord's** interception return for a touchdown that capped the scoring in USA's season-opening win last weekend, the eighth longest in the history of the program. After going 26 games without running back a pick for a score, the Jaguars have now accomplished the feat twice in the last seven outings; **Devin Rockette** (who recovered a fumble in the match-up with USM) had a 95-yard return of an interception in an Oct. 24 win over ULM last fall.

THE NO. 5 JERSEY

On June 13, 2010, the University of South Alabama lost a member of the football program when **Anthony Mostella** passed away near his home of Oneonta, Ala.

Mostella, who would have been a senior in the fall of '10, was loved and respected by all his teammates and coaches, someone whose contributions to the program on the field were exceeded by what he was able to accomplish away from the game. Voted a team captain in the program's inaugural season, Mostella — a running back who came to South Alabama in order to continue his relationship with head coach Joey Jones — displayed his selfless nature with his contributions on special teams and in the locker room while fellow teammates racked up more yardage running the ball.

He came to USA and Mobile after playing for Jones at Birmingham-Southern in 2007, sacrificing a season of collegiate eligibility in order to help build the Jaguar program by taking part in its first-ever spring practice in March and April of 2009. During that time he would establish himself not only as a leader, but as an ambassador for the program as it established its roots in the community.

From 2010-17, the Jaguars honored Mostella each fall as one member of the senior class wore his No. 5 jersey for their final season. This fall, first-year head coach Kane Wommack is bring the tradition back with a twist, issuing the jersey to a selected member of the program each week prior to the contest.

HANCOCK WHITNEY STADIUM

The University of South Alabama Board of Trustees voted on November 10, 2018, to authorize the construction of an on-campus football stadium, paving the way for the Jaguars' first season in the new facility this fall.

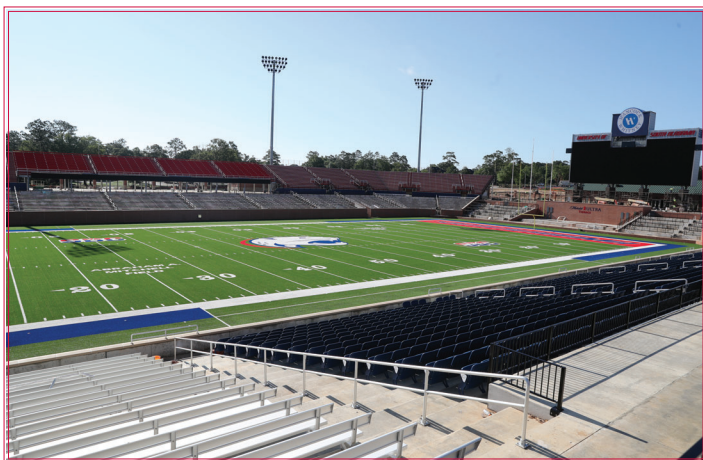
The new 25,000-seat football stadium is located on the west side of campus, adjacent to the Jaguar Training Center, Football Fieldhouse and football practice fields and includes:

- Abraham A. Mitchell Field, named in recognition of a \$5 million commitment from Mitchell structured as a challenge gift — any donation to the stadium project from a minimum of \$500 to a maximum of \$250,000 per donor will be matched on a one-to-one basis — that will facilitate additional donations to Hancock Whitney Stadium
- A state-of-the-art video board — measuring 37 feet high by 100 feet wide with nearly 3,500 square feet of viewing space — and sound system
- The Michelob Ultra Terrace, named in recognition of a \$1 million gift from Budweiser-Busch Distributing Co., Inc.
- 16-seat suites, a club level with 800 seats, and premier chair-back and bench-back seating options

USA and Hancock Whitney announced on January 15, 2019, that the stadium will be named Hancock Whitney Stadium in recognition of a new, comprehensive financial partnership between the two organizations. Under the terms of the 10-year agreement, Hancock Whitney will provide the University of South Alabama with an array of financial and investment services. On September 4 last year the university made an announcement that Hargrove Engineers + Constructors committed \$1.5 million to the project and as a result the club level at the stadium will be named The Hargrove Club.

The stadium's estimated cost was \$74 million. Funding and debt service on bonded indebtedness incurred to construct the stadium will come from a combination of the athletic department, auxiliary enterprises and public/private funding. USA announced a \$2.5 million sponsorship from the Mobile County Commission, which created the Mobile County Center for Academic Success, located within the stadium's administration building behind the north end zone.

Ticket sales for Hancock Whitney Stadium began on Monday, July 8, 2019, and in just over 24 hours all suites and loges were sold out.
