### **ABOUT SOUTH ALABAMA**

- Alabama and South Alabama will meet for the 111th time in series history on Tuesday evening at Stanky Field. The Crimson Tide leads the all-time series, 62-48, but the Jaguars hold the advantage in Mobile, 30-21.
- The two teams last met on Mach 29 of last season with the Tide claiming a 5-4 win in Tuscaloosa. The victory was part of UA's current six-game winning streak over South.
- Alabama's last trip to Mobile came from March 1-2, 2019 for a weekend series. The Crimson Tide swept the Jaguars across the three-game set by scores of 7-3, 10-5 and 6-1.
- Mark Calvi is in his 12th season as a collegiate head coach, all coming with South Alabama. He entered the 2023 season with a career 344-256-1 record. A 1991 graduate of Nova Southeastern (Fla.), Calvi is assisted by Brad Phillips, Nick Magnifico and Corley Reynolds.
- South Alabama finished the 2022 season at 31-23 overall, including a 17-13 mark in Sun Belt play.
- The Jaguars were selected to finish sixth in Sun Belt in the league's preseason poll, as voted on by the conference's head coaches.

### **ABOUT ALABAMA**

- Alabama wrapped up the week at 3-2 overall. The Tide swept midweeks at Samford and against Alabama State before winning one game in the weekend series with Columbia.
- The Crimson Tide paired a hitless start from *Luke Holman* with five home runs to take down Samford, 11-6, on Tuesday evening at Joe Lee Griffin Field.
- Holman was masterful in the start to earn his third win of the season, striking out a career-high and Alabama seasonbest 12 batters while not allowing a hit across his 5.0 innings of work. Holman's start was paired with five total home runs by the Tide offense.
- Leading the offense was *Colby Shelton*, who homered twice on the night and totaled a team-high three RBI. *Dominic Tamez* added a pair of RBI with his two-run shot to go with solo homers from *Jim Jarvis* and *Drew Williamson*.
- Alabama used 15 hits and 10 walks to earn a 21-7 win over Alabama State on Wednesday evening in Tuscaloosa.
- The Tide finished with 21 runs in the seven-inning affair, scoring in five of the six innings, including five-run frames in the second, fourth and sixth.
- Alabama's offense produced multiple home runs for a fifth straight game with the group of **Mac Guscette**, **Tommy Seidl**, **Will Hodo** and Jarvis all recording a roundtripper. Guscette led the Tide in RBI with six as part of a 3-for-3 showing that included a double and a run scored, while Seidl finished a perfect 4-for-4 with four RBI and four runs.
- The Tide came up short in a 10-7 loss to Columbia on Friday evening at Sewell-Thomas Stadium.
- Despite trailing from the second inning on, Alabama never stopped battling. The Crimson Tide traded runs with the Lions all night and headed to the ninth down four.
- UA was able to plate one in the final frame and had the bases loaded with two down, but a difficult over the shoulder catch on the run by the Columbia shortstop went for the last out and the 10-7 final.
- Alabama split a doubleheader with Columbia on Saturday afternoon. The 18th-ranked Crimson Tide came away with a 6-2 win in game one before a 15-3 loss in the nightcap.
- The Tide used a six-run fifth to provide all its offense in game one. The Lions were first on the board with one in the third but a six-run fifth proved more than enough. That fifth included a two-run shot by Shelton and a grand slam from *Ed Johnson*. Columbia was able to add one in the sixth but would get no closer.
- Alabama starter **Ben Hess** was solid in the start, picking up his third win of the season. The sophomore allowed one run on three hits and a walk with seven strikeouts across his 5.0 innings.
- The Crimson Tide fell, 15-3, in game two of the doubleheader. Columbia posted an 11-run fourth inning to put the game out of reach for the series-clinching win.
- Alabama welcomed back 24 letterwinners for the 2023 season. Included in those 24 are eight positional starters and 12 pitchers that returned for the new campaign.

### **BIG-TIME OFFENSE TO START THE SEASON**

Alabama's bats have been red-hot to start the season, maintaining a .352 (196-557) average and totaling 196 hits. The
Tide is averaging 11.5 hits per game and has recorded double-digit hits in 13 of the 17 games so far.
 Below is a look at where the Crimson Tide offense ranks entering the Tuesday contest with South Alabama.

#### SCORING IN OVER HALF THE INNINGS

- The Crimson Tide offense has been producing runs at an impressive clip so far this season.
- Alabama's bats have seen time in the box in 132 total innings and crossed a run in 67 of those for a 50.8 percent mark.
- Of those 67 innings, 41 have been for two-or-more runs with 14 going for five-plus runs.
- UA has scored double-digit runs in 10 of the 17 games with two other games that saw the offense score nine runs.

### **SUPPLYING SOUVENIRS**

- Alabama has hit 38 home runs this season to rank third in Division I, trailing only Florida and South Carolina, who both have 45 to lead the nation and the SEC.
- The Tide has homered in all but one game of the 2023 campaign while producing multiple homers in 12 contests.
- Alabama is averaging 2.24 home runs per game to rank fourth in the conference and seventh in the nation.

#### **FIVE GRAND SLAMS TO START THE SEASON**

- Alabama's high-powered offense has totaled 38 home runs through 17 games. Included in those 38 homers are five grand slams, including four of which came in consecutive games from Feb. 28-March 5.
- The Tide's first grand slam of the season came off the bat of Camden Hayslip against Jacksonville State on Feb. 28.
- Alabama then hit a grand slam three days in a row during the UIC series, first by Tommy Seidl in the series opener on March 3. Colby Shelton followed by hitting a grand slam on both Saturday and Sunday.
- The four-game stretch with a slam set a new UA record with the previous high being two straight games (since 1983).
- Alabama's five grand slams in 2023 are tied for the sixth-most in UA single-season history since grand slams were tracked in 1983. The five grand slams are the most by a Tide team during the 'dead bat era' (since 2011), surpassing the previous total of four by the 2017 team.

#### **'ROCK' SOLID POWER NUMBERS FROM SHELTON**

- Freshman Colby Shelton's collegiate career has started off with a bang.
- Shelton has reached base safely in 15 of his 16 games played and enters the Tuesday matchup at South Alabama as the Tide's leader in home runs (10), RBI (22), runs (19), total bases (52) and slugging (.945) while ranking third in hits (19).
- His impressive power numbers have helped the Lithia, Fla., native rank second in the SEC and third nationally for home runs. Shelton's torrid pace has him averaging 0.62 home runs per game to rank second in the conference and fifth in the country. He also is fourth in the league and 10th in Division I for slugging percentage.

### SHELTON NAMED SEC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - MARCH 6

- Colby Shelton was selected as the Southeastern Conference's Freshman of the Week, the league office announced on March 6. The recognition came after a red-hot week against Jacksonville State and UIC.
- Shelton led Alabama in nearly every offensive statistic during the four-game stretch, including hits (7), home runs (5), RBI (12), runs (7), total bases (23) and slugging percentage (1.533).
- He totaled at least one hit, RBI and run in all four contests while posting three multi-RBI games, three two-run efforts and three two-hit outings.
- Shelton's seven hits included six that went for extra bases. Of those six, one was a double with the other five being home runs two of which were grand slams.
- The freshman homered in all three games of the UIC series, including back-to-back multi-homer performances on Friday and Saturday. He also recorded a grand slam in consecutive contests on Saturday and Sunday.
- Shelton's recognition was the Tide's first from the league in 2023 and the first Freshman of the Week honor since 2020.

### **DUBYA KEEPS ON WALKIN'**

- A five-year starter at first, Drew Williamson accumulated 129 career walks.
- Williamson's 129 walks are the fourth-most free passes on the Alabama career list. He totaled 40 base on balls as a freshman, added 18 in the shortened 2020 campaign, recorded 26 in 2021 and finished with 28 in 2022. So far this season, Williamson has drawn a team-high 17 walks, good for third in the SEC.

#### **PINCKNEY'S HOT START**

- Andrew Pinckney has picked up where he left off a season ago, starting his 2023 campaign on an 11-game hitting streak before being held hitless on Sunday against UIC.
- Across the streak, Pinckney batted .500 (19-38) with a team-high 19 hits, including four doubles, a triple and two home runs. He also added seven RBI and a team-best 13 runs scored to go with five walks a hit-by-pitch.
- The redshirt junior totaled double-digit hits in five of those games, including a team-high four as part of a perfect 4-for-4 afternoon on Opening Day against Richmond.
- Pinckney currently ranks second on the Tide in hits (22) while tying for second in runs scored (18) and ranking third in batting average at .379 (22-58).
- He ended the 2022 season batting .321 (35-109) over his final 28 games. The Georgia native recorded at least one hit in 20 contests during that stretch, including 11 multi-hit efforts.
- His final 18 games (from April 24) were even more impressive. Over that time, Pinckney batted .329 (25-76) with six doubles and three home runs. He also added 15 RBI, 17 runs, five walks, a hit-by-pitch and four stolen bases.
- In the 18-game stretch, Pinckney recorded nine multi-hit games and six multi-RBI efforts. He also scored at least one run in 12 contests.

#### PINCK ON THE BRAGAN WATCH LIST

- Redshirt junior Andrew Pinckney was named to the 2023 Bobby Bragan National Collegiate Slugger Award Watch List, the award announced on Feb. 15. Pinckney was one of 51 players named to the preseason list.
- The winner of the BBNCSA will be announced in June and honored at a gala in the fall at the Fort Worth Club.

### **CALLING ON THE PEN**

- Alabama baseball has gone to the bullpen early and often to start the 2023 season as the Tide's starters continue to extend their outings and pitch counts.
- The UA relievers have stepped up in a big way. UA's bullpen has accounted for 71.1 of the team's 143.0 innings pitched.
- Alabama's relievers own a 3.53 ERA (28 ER) and have claimed the win in four contests. The 13 bullpen arms have struck out 89 compared to 37 walks while limiting opposing hitters to a .234 average.

#### HITT EARNS PRESEASON ALL-AMERICA HONORS

- Junior left-hander Grayson Hitt was selected as a preseason third team All-American by Baseball America, the outlet announced on Jan. 30.
- Hitt took on a weekend starter role for the Tide in 2022 and finished 4-3 across 14 starts. He tossed 60.2 innings, good for third on the UA staff, and ranked second on the team with 68 strikeouts.
- · Baseball America annually polls major league teams to vote for its Preseason All-America squad, asking that they make their selections based on performance, talent and pro potential. Ten of the first 11 college players drafted in 2022 were voted as BA Preseason All-Americans with 27 of the 36 Preseason All-Americans who were draft eligible going on to be selected across the first 101 picks of the 2022 Draft.

### YEAR FIVE UNDER BRAD BOHANNON

- Head coach Brad Bohannon completed his fifth season at the helm of the Crimson Tide baseball program in 2022 after being named the 32nd head coach in Alabama baseball history on June 1, 2017.
- Bohannon brought 14 years of Southeastern Conference coaching experience to Alabama after having served as an assistant at Kentucky from 2004-15 and, most recently, Auburn from 2016-17.
- The 2022 season saw the Crimson Tide finish 31-27 overall and 12-17 in SEC play. UA totaled 30-plus wins for the second time in as many years and the third time in four full seasons under Bohannon's guidance.
- · Alabama also advanced to the SEC Tournament for a second straight year, the first time the Tide reached Hoover in consecutive seasons since 2015-16.
- The 2022 campaign was highlighted by numerous impressive victories. The Tide's wins included a series sweep at then-No. 7 Ole Miss along with series wins over then-No. 5 Arkansas and eventual SEC Western Division Champion Texas A&M. UA was also one of only six teams to hand top-ranked Tennessee a loss during the regular season, defeating the Volunteers 6-3 in the series opener in Knoxville to break UT's 12-game winning streak in conference play.
- In addition to the wins during the regular season, Alabama defeated Georgia and Arkansas in the SEC Tournament.
- Nearly half of Alabama's games in 2022 were decided by two runs or less. The Tide played in 28 such games, including 19 one-run affairs. UA held a 7-12 mark in one-run contests and a 5-4 record in matchups decided by two runs.
- Alabama faced a gauntlet of a schedule that was ranked as the second-toughest in the nation entering the NCAA postseason. The Tide was tasked with navigating the 2022 campaign without its top player in Connor Prielipp. The junior left-hander spent a majority of the season rehabbing after Tommy John surgery before being medically cleared in mid-April. He decided at that time to opt out of the remainder of the season to focus on preparations for the MLB Draft.

#### 2023 EDITION OF THE CRIMSON TIDE

- Alabama entered 2023 with a veteran roster compared to recent years. The Crimson Tide welcomed back 24 letterwinners, including eight positional starters and 12 total pitchers.
- Alabama's 2023 roster features eight positional starters, including Dominic Tamez (C), Drew Williamson (1B), Bryce Eblin (2B), Jim Jarvis (SS), Tommy Seidl (OF), Caden Rose (OF), William Hamiter (OF/DH) and Andrew Pinckney (OF). The Tide's lone loss comes in Zane Denton who transferred to Tennessee following the 2022 campaign.
- On the mound, the Tide returned 12 pitchers, highlighted by all three weekend starters from 2022 in Grayson Hitt, Garrett McMillan and Jacob McNairy. McMillan led all arms with 16 starts while Hitt followed with 14 starts to his name. McNairy matched McMillan in appearances with 16, making four out of the bullpen to go with 12 starts.
- The Tide's biggest loss on the pitching staff came in the bullpen where Alabama is without seasoned reliever Brock Guffey and 2022 closer Dylan Ray. Guffey finished his career ranked eighth on the Tide's career appearances list, including his team-high 20 a season ago, while Ray earned Freshman All-SEC honors and saved eight games to tie for fourth in the SEC at season's end.
- The Crimson Tide is also without veteran left-hander Antoine Jean, who suffered an injury over the summer that required season-ending surgery. Jean has contributed 77.0 innings across 22 appearances and 16 starts across his three-year career at the Capstone. His six starts from 2022 are the only starts not returning for the new campaign.

- Brad Bohannon was hired as Alabama's 32nd head baseball coach on June 1, 2017 and formally introduced on Monday, June 5.
- Arriving at Alabama with a plan to build his program around the total player, Bohannon has placed an equal focus on athletics and academics. During his tenure, the Crimson Tide has signed multiple top-10 recruiting classes, including the most recent group that was ranked as high as No. 10 by Perfect Game USA. Since 2008, all but one of Bohannon's recruiting classes have been ranked in the top-25 by at least one of the four major sites.
- Bohannon and his staff have produced 20 players who have been selected in the MLB Draft while helping a total of 23 players begin their professional career. Not only has Alabama's roster gotten better on the field but also in the classroom as UA has set program-high marks for grade-point average multiple years under Bohannon's watch. He and his staff have also helped 36 players graduate with a total of 38 degrees, including four master's degrees.
- Alabama wrapped up the 2022 season at 31-27 overall and 12-17 in SEC play to advance to the SEC Tournament for a second consecutive season. Included in the Tide's 31 victories was a series sweep at Ole Miss, securing three wins over the eventual national champions during the weekend in Oxford. UA also posted series wins over SEC Western Division Champion Texas A&M and then-No. 5 Arkansas before adding another victory over the Razorbacks in Hoover.
- The 2021 campaign saw Alabama finish 32-26 overall, posting double-digit conference wins and reaching the SEC Tournament for the first time since the 2016 season. The 2021 Tide also advanced to an NCAA Regional marking UA's 25th appearance in the postseason and the first since 2014
- UA's 2020 team went 16-1 before a global pandemic ended the season early. Alabama was set to enter SEC play ranked for the first time since 2010 and finished the year at No. 18 by Collegiate Baseball Newspaper along with a No. 21 ranking in both the NCBWA and the USA Today Coaches polls.
- Alabama finished 30-26 overall in 2019. The Crimson Tide's record was highlighted by a 23-3 mark in non-conference pairings and included a 13-1 record in midweek matchups along with a 14-3 record against schools from the state of Alabama.
- Bohannon immediately made his mark on the Alabama program in 2018. His first season saw the Crimson Tide get off to a perfect 9-0 start, with Bohannon matching Wallace Wade (1924) for the second-best start to an Alabama head coaching career.
- Under his direction in 2018, UA improved by eight wins from the previous year, including three more victories in SEC play, to finish 27-29 and 8-22 in SEC play. The 27 wins were highlighted by six victories over top-25 teams, including a series win over then-No. 7 Kentucky.
- Bohannon came to Tuscaloosa with 14 years of Southeastern Conference coaching experience after having served as an assistant at Kentucky from 2004-15 and Auburn from 2016-17. He played a pivotal role in turning around Kentucky and Auburn within three years on the job. The Wildcats became the first team in SEC history to go from worst to first in only one season, winning 44 games and the program's first SEC title in 2006, while the Tigers won 12 more games in 2017 than in 2016 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament.
- . While at Kentucky, Bohannon served under two SEC Coach of the Year winners in John Cohen and Gary Henderson. Along with winning the school's only league title, Bohannon was a part of a trio of record-breaking win seasons, capped off by the 2012 team that won 45 games to set the UK program mark.
- A combined 69 Wildcat student-athletes were chosen in the Major League Baseball Draft or signed as a free agent during Bohannon's tenure as recruiting coordinator. He was responsible for signing 13 Kentucky Wildcat student-athletes that went on to play in the Major Leagues, including 2014 Golden Spikes Award winner A.J. Reed.
- · Prior to his time at UK, Bohannon worked for two seasons at Wake Forest where the Demon Deacons advanced to the NCAA Tournament twice and captured the ACC title in 2001.
- Bohannon earned an undergraduate degree from Berry College in 1998 and then graduated with a master's from Wake Forest in 2002. He began his collegiate career playing at Vanderbilt and Georgia Tech before ending up at Berry.
- A native of Rome, Ga., Bohannon is married to the former Kim Traylor.
