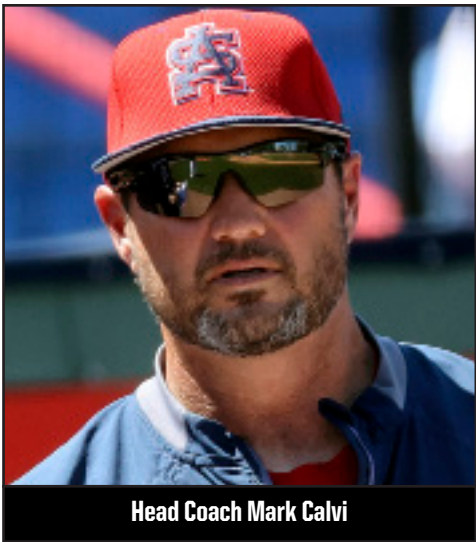

TEAM NOTES	
<p>THE LAST TIME ...</p> <p>The last time South Alabama started the Sun Belt Conference portion of their schedule 1-5 came in 2009.</p> <p>SERIES AGAINST SOUTHEASTERN LOUISIANA</p> <p>South Alabama is 43-24 against Southeastern Louisiana with the first game dating back to 1984. The Lions won the last matchup between the two, 8-6 (April 19, 2022) and South Alabama is 3-7 in the last 10.</p> <p>SERIES AGAINST NICHOLLS</p> <p>South Alabama leads the series 34-18, winning the last game earlier this season 5-4 (February 24, 2023). They have won the last two and are 5-5 in the last 10 matchups.</p> <p>SERIES AGAINST JAMES MADISON</p> <p>This will be the first meeting between the two teams.</p> <p>WILLINGHAM AND PETRACCI TO MISS TIME DUE TO INJURY</p> <p>Zach Willingham will miss time on the mound due to a scary incident on a ball hit up the middle against Georgia Southern on Sunday. The left handed pitcher was in the dugout for the game in Montgomery against Auburn. Robbie Petracci will miss time after being hit by a pitch against Louisiana this weekend.</p> <p>JAGS SET PROGRAM RECORD FOR WALKS</p> <p>South Alabama drew 20 walks in Saturday's 26-6 win over Eastern Kentucky, which set a new program record. The previous record for walks in a game came on April 8, 1979, when the Jags drew 18 walks against Alabama.</p> <p>CAREER HIGHS SET IN RBIs</p> <p>Center fielder Will Turner recorded a career-high five RBIs in last Saturday's 26-6 win over Eastern Kentucky. The Auburn, Ala., native has hit safely in all four games this season, and driven in runs in three of four contests. Catcher Diego Altamirano also set a career high in RBIs against EKU with four in game two of Saturday's doubleheader, bettering his previous high of three which he recorded twice last season.</p> <p>EXTRA BASE HIT PRODUCTION</p> <p>The Jaguars have recorded 62 extra-base hits (31 doubles, 8 triples, 23 home runs) in 25 games this season, which accounts for 30.5 percent of their hit total of 203. They have given up 68 (32 doubles, 6 triples, 30 home runs) as a pitching staff.</p> <p>JAGS PLATE 26 RUNS AGAINST EKU, MOST IN SIX SEASONS</p> <p>South Alabama scored 26 runs in its win over Eastern Kentucky last Saturday at Stanky Field, which marked the most by a Jaguar team since Feb. 18, 2017, when the Jags plated 32 runs in a win over Eastern Illinois. USA scored 11 runs in the seventh inning of the game, which marked the most in an inning since the Jags scored 11 runs against Jackson State on Feb. 21, 2012.</p> <p>SHUT OUT FOR FIRST TIME SINCE NCAA REGIONAL</p> <p>Eastern Kentucky shut out South Alabama 2-0 in game one of last Saturday's doubleheader at Stanky Field, which marked the first time the Jaguars have been shut out since June 4, 2021, when Miami (FL) defeated USA 1-0 in the opening round of the NCAA Gainesville (Fla.) Regional. They have been shutout twice since that game - against Jacksonville State in the first game of a doubleheader and against Alabama at home on March 14.</p> <p>JAGS PICKED TO FINISH SIXTH IN THE SUN BELT PRESEASON POLL</p> <p>The Jaguars were picked to finish sixth in the Sun Belt Conference in a preseason poll voted on by the league's head coaches. Southern Miss was picked to win the conference with 11 of 12 first place votes. Texas State (T-2nd), Louisiana (4th) and Coastal Carolina (5th) each received one first-place vote.</p>	<p>JAGS RETURN 16 LETTERWINNERS, WELCOME 24 NEWCOMERS</p> <p>South Alabama returns 16 letterwinners, two of which redshirted in 2022 (Jeremy Lee and Sam Knowlton), from last season and added 24 newcomers to the 2023 roster. The Jags added six left-handed pitchers to the squad for this season, including Jake Bruning who transferred to USA after a four-year career at Niagara.</p> <p>REYNOLDS JOINS JAGUAR COACHING STAFF</p> <p>South Alabama assistant coach Corley Reynolds joined the staff at the conclusion of the 2022 season following the retirement of Alan Luckie, who spent 16 years with the program as a volunteer assistant coach from 2007-22. Reynolds served as first-base coach for South Alabama for two seasons (2021-22) after two years as an assistant coach at Southwest Mississippi Community College (2019-20) where he began his coaching career.</p> <p>DOUBLE DUTY FOR HEER AND LAWRENCE HEADING INTO THE WEEK WITH FIVE GAMES ON THE SCHEDULE</p> <p>Mitchell Heer and Colson Lawrence have pulled double duty this season, playing their positions in the field and making appearances on the mound. Heer is hitting .208 with a pair of doubles thus far this season, and has also made five appearances (four starts) and has recorded a 6.43 ERA. Meanwhile, Lawrence is the second-leading hitter on the team at .278 with a team-high six home runs. On the mound, he has recorded a 3.18 ERA in five appearances.</p> <p>PILING UP THE STRIKEOUTS AT HOME IN EARLY MARCH</p> <p>South Alabama piled up the strikeout total this weekend after a 17-strikeout performance against Iowa on Saturday. They followed that up with seven against Southern in a win on Sunday.</p> <p>JAGUAR DEFENSE</p> <p>South Alabama has committed at least one error in 23 of its 25 games this season, including a season-high five errors in a 15-3 loss to Nebraska at Stanky Field.</p> <p>TOUGH SCHEDULE TO START</p> <p>South Alabama has not tried to hide early in the season with a tough schedule that has including four games against Big Ten opponents Nebraska (three) and Iowa (one), as well as a game against perennial West Coast Conference power Pepperdine.</p> <p>LAWRENCE SHOWS POWER OFF IN MONTGOMERY</p> <p>Colson Lawrence hit a pair of home runs on Tuesday night against Auburn at Montgomery's Riverwalk Stadium. THE STORY
Mark Calvi became the fifth head coach in South Alabama baseball history at the conclusion of the 2011 season after spending the year as associate head coach/head coach-in-waiting. Calvi has led the Jaguars to three Sun Belt Conference championships and one SBC Tournament title during his tenure at South Alabama.

In just his second season at the helm, Calvi led the Jags to their 14th SBC championship and 25th NCAA Regional appearance after recording the program's first 40-plus win season since 2003 and was named the 2013 Sun Belt Conference Coach of the Year and American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA)/Diamond South Central Region Coach of the Year.

Seven Jags earned all-conference honors in 2013, and Jordan Patterson was named the SBC Player of the Year becoming just the sixth Jaguar in the program's history to earn the honor. Patterson and Kyle Bartsch also earned ABCA South/Central all-region honors. Bartsch, Patterson, Nolan Earley and Dylan Stamey were selected in the 2013 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft. Patterson (4th round, 109th pick) became South Alabama's then-highest draftee since Adam Lind was taken by the Toronto Blue Jays in the third round of the 2004 MLB Draft.

Calvi led USA to its 15th Sun Belt crown in 2015 en route to his second SBC Ron Maestri Coach of the Year award. He was also named the Large College Division-Division I Coach of the Year by the Alabama Baseball Coaches Association.

Right-hander Kevin Hill was named the Sun Belt Conference Pitcher of the Year, and became the program's

27th All-American at the conclusion of the season. Center fielder Cole Billingsley was named first-team all-SBC, and received a 2015 American Baseball Coaches Association/Rawlings Division I Gold Glove Award as one of three outfielders named to the team. Right-hander Ben Taylor also earned first-team all-SBC honors as a relief pitcher, and was selected in the seventh round of the 2015 MLB Draft by the Boston Red Sox.

The Jags led the SBC in batting average (.285), on-base percentage (.376) and sacrifice flies (28).

The South Alabama pitching staff led the conference in ERA (3.22), strikeouts (474), runs allowed (221), earned runs allowed (188) and home runs allowed (22). USA also led the Sun Belt with a .978 fielding percentage, which ranked tied for 10th nationally and broke the program's previous record of .972.

Calvi led the Jaguars to the program's 16th Sun Belt title and 26th NCAA Regional appearance in 2016, and closed the season ranked No. 26 in the final Collegiate Baseball poll. USA went 42-22 and advanced to the NCAA Tallahassee (Fla.) Regional final. The Jags also broke the school's single-season fielding percentage record for the second straight season with a league-leading mark of .979, which also ranked in the top 10 nationally. Calvi was named the 2016 Coach of the Year by the Alabama Baseball Coaches Association, the second time he has earned the honor at USA, following the season.

Hill was named the SBC Pitcher of the Year for the second consecutive season, and was also named the SBC Male Student-Athlete of the Year in addition to earning All-America honors from three different organizations as well as first-team all-region and first-team all-SBC accolades. Billingsley earned his second consecutive Rawlings Gold Glove Award in 2016, in addition to first-team all-SBC and second-team all-region honors after leading the league in stolen bases (31), which ranked 13th nationally, for the second straight year. Outfielder Travis Swaggerty was named a Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American by Collegiate Baseball, and Drew LaBounty earned first-team all-SBC honors at shortstop after leading the league and finishing sixth nationally in walks (59). Both Hill and Billingsley were selected in the 2016 MLB Draft.

In 2017, Calvi helped lead the Jaguars to the program's 12th Sun Belt Conference Tournament title and 27th NCAA Regional after finishing the season 40-21. USA went 22-8 in Sun Belt play before winning three straight games at the SBC Tournament in Statesboro, Ga. The Jags defeated host Georgia Southern in the championship game by rallying for three runs in the final two frames of the game, including an RBI walk-off single by Brendan Donovan in the bottom of the 10th inning, to clinch the championship.

South Alabama finished the season ranked 26th in the final Collegiate Baseball poll. It marked the second straight year the Jags have won 40 or more games, and the 21st time the program has won 40-plus contests. Calvi was named the Alabama Baseball Coaches Association Division I Coach of the Year in 2017, marking the third consecutive year he earned the honor.
