TEAM NOTES

NOT A GOOD WEEK WITH RUNNERS IN SCORING POSITION FOR THE JAGS

South Alabama did not have a good week when it came to runners in scoring position on the road against Southern Miss. The Jags hit just .158 (3-for-19) with runners in scoring position over the weekend, however they hit .750 (3-for-4 with runners at third and less than two outs. Jackson Howard, Erick Orbeta, and Austin Thrasher each picked up hits with runners in scoring position in Hattiesburg.

NEED A SWEEP, HARD TO COME BY

South Alabama will need to sweep Arkansas State and get some help this week in order to make the conference tournament. The only problem, South Alabama has not swept Arkansas State since 2013.

WHAT HAS TO HAPPEN - ON THE OUTSIDE LOOKING IN

South Alanama finds itself on the outside looking in for the first time since 1985 of getting into the Sun Belt Conference with three conferences games remaining on the schedule. The Jags are three games back of Georgia State, Old Dominion and Georgia Southern (whom they lost the season series). South Alabama must sweep Arkansas State this weekend and have either ODU or Georgia State sweep the other as they play each other in Norfolk. A loss by the Jags in conference play against Arkansas State knocks the Jags out of the tournament.

LONGEST STREAK OF THE SEASON

South Alabnama is mired in its longest losing streak of the season at severn games after series sweeps at the hands of Southern Miss and Coastal Carolina in conference play, and Southeastern Louisiana in non-conference play on Tuesday.

EXTRA BASE HIT PRODUCTION

The Jaguars have recorded 141 extra-base hits (75 doubles, 13 triples, 53 home runs) in 51 games this season, which accounts for 30.0 percent of their hit total of 470. They have given up 140 (68 doubles, 11 triples, 61 home runs) as a pitching staff.

JAGUAR DEFENSE

South Alabama has committed at least one error in 35 of its 51 games this season, including a season-high five errors in a 15-3 loss to Nebraska at Stanky Field. The Jags turned in three consecutive games error-free against Coastal Carolina.

3 HOME RUNS IN INNING - FIRST TIME IN A DECADE IN REGULAR SEASON

South Alabama used three home runs in the third inning of the series finale aganst James Madison to open the game up after a scoreless tie, the first time since 2013 that the Jags had three in one inning with the last coming against Louisiana on May 12, 2013.

JAGS SET PROGRAM RECORD FOR WALKS

South Alabama drew 20 walks in Saturday's 26-6 win over Eastern Kentucky, which set a new program record. The previous record for walks in a game came on April 8, 1979, when the Jags drew 18 walks against Alabama.

GRAND SLAMS IN THE SAME GAME

Colson Lawrence and Will Turner hit grand slams in the same game over the weekend, hitting them late in a 19-3 victory in Friday night's game against James Madison.

TREY LEWIS NAMED SUN BELT PLAYER OF THE WEEK (vs. JMU)

Trey Lewis earned the first Sun Belt Conference weekly award after his performance over the last week in four games. Lewis erupted this week for the Jags leading them to a 3-1 week by hitting .667 and slugging 1.278 in four games. He also recorded an on-base percentage of .739 with five walks in 23 plate appearances. Lewis finished the week 12-for-18 with a 2.017 OPS, while collecting five extra base hits (two doubles and three home runs). All three home runs came in the three-game set against James Madison with one in each game. He also finished the week with 10 RBI and struck out just three times.

EXTRA INNINGS WIN

South Alabama has won a pair of games at Eddie Stanky Field in extra innings, and one on the

road against Nicholls this season. The latest was a 5-3 comeback in the ninth in a resumption of a suspended game against Alabama State. The Jags scored four runs in the 10th inning to pull away for a 9-7 victory.

SULLIVAN DRIVES IN EIGHT OF THE 13 RUNS SCORED AGAINST SOUTHERN

Joseph Sullivan had a career day against Southern on Tuesday, knocking in eight runs including the team's third grand slam in a week and the team's fourth of the season.

WALK-OFF FASHION TO WIN CONFERENCE SERIES

Erick Orbeta ended a 10-inning Sun Belt Conference contest against Texas State on Friday with a ball hit up the middle. The walk-off hit is the first in regular season conference play since April 16, 2017, when Dylan Hardy delivered against Coastal Carolina.

WILLINGHAM (RETURNS) AND PETRACCI MISS TIME DUE TO INJURY

Zach Willingham will miss time on the mound due to a scary incident on a ball hit up the middle against Georgia Southern on Sunday. The left handed pitcher was in the dugout for the game in Montgomery against Auburn. Robbie Petracci will miss time after being hit by a pitch against Louisiana this weekend. Willingham returned for the first time in a month when he took the mount against Alabama State on April 18, 2023 at Eddie Stanky Field - his first batter he faced, one pitch-one out.

HUGE WEEK FOR THE JAGS AT THE PLATE ON THE ROAD

South Alabama outscored James Madison and Nicholls combined, 57-41 in four games on the road this week. They finished the week hitting .368 as a team and slugging .658, led by Trey Lewis at .667. He was joined by a trio of guys over .400 for the week including Erick Orbeta (.474), JG Bell (.471), and Joseph Sullivan (.438). Three pitchers did not allow an earned run this week in Sam Knowlton, Eric Lin, and Zach Harlan.

BIG WEEK FOR EXTRA BASE HITS FOR THE JAGS (NICHOLLS / JMU)

The Jags finished the weekend with 18 total extra-base hits (seven doubles, two triples, nine home runs) and finished the four-game road trip with 22 extra-base hits.

JAGS PLATE 26 RUNS AGAINST EKU, MOST IN SIX SEASONS

South Alabama scored 26 runs in its win over Eastern Kentucky last Saturday at Stanky Field, which marked the most by a Jaguar team since Feb. 18, 2017, when the Jags plated 32 runs in a win over Eastern Illinois. MOORE INSERTED INTO ROTATION



<u>The Story</u>

Mark Calvi became the fifth head coach in South Alabama baseball history at the conclusion of the 2011 season after spending the year as associate head coach/head coach-in-waiting. Calvi has led the Jaguars to three Sun Belt Conference championships and one SBC Tournament title during his tenure at South Alabama.

In just his second season at the helm, Calvi led the Jags to their 14th SBC championship and 25th NCAA Regional appearance after recording the program's first 40-plus win season since 2003 and was named the 2013 Sun Belt Conference Coach of the Year and American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA)/Diamond South Central Region Coach of the Year.

Seven Jags earned all-conference honors in 2013, and Jordan Patterson was named the SBC Player of the Year becoming just the sixth Jaguar in the program's history to earn the honor. Patterson and Kyle Bartsch also earned ABCA South/Central all-region honors. Bartsch, Patterson, Nolan Earley and Dylan Stamey were selected in the 2013 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft. Patterson (4th round, 109th pick) became South Alabama's then-highest draftee since Adam Lind was taken by the Toronto Blue Jays in the third round of the 2004 MLB Draft.

Calvi led USA to its 15th Sun Belt crown in 2015 en route to his second SBC Ron Maestri Coach of the Year award. He was also named the Large College Division-Division I Coach of the Year by the Alabama Baseball Coaches Association.

Right-hander Kevin Hill was named the Sun Belt Conference Pitcher of the Year, and became the program's 27th All-American at the conclusion of the season. Center fielder Cole Billingsley was named first-team all-SBC, and received a 2015 American Baseball Coaches Association/ Rawlings Division I Gold Glove Award as one of three outfielders named to the team. Right-hander Ben Taylor also earned first-team all-SBC honors as a relief pitcher, and was selected in the seventh round of the 2015 MLB Draft by the Boston Red Sox.

The Jags led the SBC in batting average (.285), on-base percentage (.376) and sacrifice flies (28).

The South Alabama pitching staff led the conference in ERA (3.22), strikeouts (474), runs allowed (221), earned runs allowed (188) and home runs allowed (22). USA also led the Sun Belt with a .978 fielding percentage, which ranked tied for 10th nationally and broke the program's previous record of .972.

Calvi led the Jaguars to the program's 16th Sun Belt title and 26th NCAA Regional appearance in 2016, and closed the season ranked No. 26 in the final Collegiate Baseball poll. USA went 42-22 and advanced to the NCAA Tallahassee (Fla.) Regional final. The Jags also broke the school's single-season fielding percentage record for the second straight season with a league-leading mark of .979, which also ranked in the top 10 nationally. Calvi was named the 2016 Coach of the Year by the Alabama Baseball Coaches Association, the second time he has earned the honor at USA, following the season.

Hill was named the SBC Pitcher of the Year for the second consecutive season, and was also named the SBC Male Student-Athlete of the Year in addition to earning All-America honors from three different organizations as well as first-team all-region and first-team all-SBC accolades. Billingsley earned his second consecutive Rawlings Gold Glove Award in 2016, in addition to first-team all-SBC and second-team all-region honors after leading the league in stolen bases (31), which ranked 13th nationally, for the second straight year. Outfielder Travis Swaggerty was named a Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American by Collegiate Baseball, and Drew LaBounty earned first-team all-SBC honors at shortstop after leading the league and finishing sixth nationally in walks (59). Both Hill and Billingsley were selected in the 2016 MLB Draft.

In 2017, Calvi helped lead the Jaguars to the program's 12th Sun Belt Conference Tournament title and 27th NCAA Regional after finishing the season 40-21. USA went 22-8 in Sun Belt play before winning three straight games at the SBC Tournament in Statesboro, Ga. The Jags defeated host Georgia Southern in the championship game by rallying for three runs in the final two frames of the game, including an RBI walk-off single by Brendan Donovan in the bottom of the 10th inning, to clinch the championship.

South Alabama finished the season ranked 26th in the final Collegiate Baseball poll. It marked the second straight year the Jags have won 40 or more games, and the 21st time the program has won 40-plus contests. Calvi was named the Alabama Baseball Coaches Association Division I Coach of the Year in 2017, marking the third consecutive year he earned the honor.
