## LAST TIME OUT

### South Alabama 76, Alcorn 70: November 6, 2025

**MOBILE, Ala.** – South Alabama men's basketball used a late second-half rally to fend off Alcorn State 76-70 Monday night in the Jaguars' home opener. With the win, South Alabama improves to 2-0 on the season, while the Braves drop to 0-2.

#### Key Stats

- Senior forward Peyton Law commanded the Jaguars' offense all night, scoring 29 points on an incredible 13-of-15 shooting from the field while adding nine rebounds and two steals. Jayden Cooper was the only other Jaguar in double figures, finishing with a D1 career-high 22 points and a team-high three triples.

- Chaze Harris continued his strong start, tallying nine points and seven assists – his second consecutive game with seven dimes.

- Alcorn State had an impressive night from three-point range, knocking down 13 three-pointers, while South Alabama attempted just 12 the entire night. The Braves' bench provided a significant spark, outscoring the Jaguars 34-5.

- The Jags shot over 50 percent from the field for the second time this year, hitting 52.8 percent overall and outscoring the Braves 48-24 in the paint.

- After committing 13 first-half turnovers and falling behind by as many as 13 points (34-21), South Alabama responded by outscoring Alcorn State by 12 points in the second half, closing the game on a 7-0 run to seal the victory.

#### Key Moments

- Alcorn State controlled the tempo early, building a 34-21 lead while forcing 13 Jaguar turnovers.

- South Alabama closed the half with a 13-6 run to cut the deficit to 40-34 at intermission.

- The Jaguars trimmed the margin to two several times early in the second half but trailed by eight with under 12 minutes remaining.

- A pivotal 11-0 Jaguar run gave South Alabama its first lead of the half, 57-54, following a three-point play from Harris with 8:21 left.

- The Braves continued to connect from long range and led 66-63 with just over four minutes to play.

- Law took over down the stretch, scoring on back-to-back possessions before Alcorn regained a 70-69 lead with just over a minute left.

- On the ensuing possession, Law crashed the boards for an and-one putback to put the Jaguars ahead 72-70.

- South Alabama locked in defensively in the final minute, as Adam Olsen sank two sets of free throws and the Jags shut out Alcorn to secure the win.

## NOTES YOU NEED TO KNOW

### The Sheriff

- Peyton Law has been dominant through his first two outings this season, averaging 23.5 points, 7.5 rebounds, and 2.5 assists. He ranks 21st nationally in field goal percentage (88.0%) and is among the Top 50 in scoring. Law has been a force on the offensive glass, pulling down more offensive rebounds (4.0) than defensive boards (3.5). He also leads the country in total field goals made this season, connecting on 22-of-25 attempts.

### Owning the Paint

South Alabama has controlled the paint in all three contests this season (including the exhibition), outscoring opponents 186-90 inside. The Jaguars also outrebounded Toledo 36-26, establishing a strong interior presence early in the year.

### Red Hot Shooting

South Alabama leads the Sun Belt with a 54.1% field goal percentage so far this season. The Jags have done most of their damage inside, attempting just 31 three-pointers (11 made) through two games. Scoring has largely come from the starting five, as the Jaguar bench has contributed just 13 total points this year.

### Wheelin' & Dealin'

Chaze Harris has showcased his playmaking ability early on, dishing out seven assists in each of the last two games. He currently ranks third in the Sun Belt in assists per game.

### Dominant Debuts

- Three of South Alabama's six transfers made instant impacts in the season opener at Toledo. Adam Olsen led the Jags with 23 points and five three-pointers, while Peyton Law added 18 points, six rebounds, and three assists. Chaze Harris impressed as well, finishing with 10 points and seven assists in his first game with the program

## NOTES YOU NEED TO KNOW

### Banner Reveal Night

- South Alabama honored its 2024-25 regular-season championship Thursday night before the Alcorn State game by unveiling a brand-new Sun Belt Championship banner inside the Mitchell Center. Entering last season ranked No. 11 in the Sun Belt Preseason Coaches Poll, head coach Richie Riley guided the Jaguars to their first regular-season conference title in 17 years, earning Joe Gottfried Coach of the Year honors. The Jaguars' 21 regular-season victories marked the most in Riley's tenure and the program's highest total since 2008.

### Core Four

- South Alabama returns four players with experience from a year ago – John Broom, Jayden Cooper, Randy Brady, and JJ Wheat – along with Maxwell Land, who returns from injury. The Jaguars also welcome eight newcomers, highlighted by NAIA All-Americans Peyton Law and Chaze Harris, as well as Canadian sharpshooter Adam Olsen..

### Reloaded

- South Alabama enters the 2025-26 season having lost nearly 50 percent of its scoring from a year ago. The Jaguars have reloaded with eight newcomers, including six transfers and one freshman. Headlining the group are NAIA All-Americans Chaze Harris, a transfer from Life University, and Peyton Law, who comes over from Freed-Hardeman. The roster also features one standout international addition, Adam Olsen, a sharpshooter who played last season at the University of British Columbia, and junior college transfer Stephen Williams who played last season Coastal Alabama CC.

### History Against Spring Hill

- South Alabama leads the all-time series with a record of 24-3. They also hold a 20-game win streak over the Badgers. Last season, Eight of the nine Jaguar players logged points Monday night, with Dylan Fasoyiro leading the way with a season-high 19 points on 4-of-6 shooting from three-point range and four assists. John Broom nearly secured a double-double, finishing with a career-high 14 points and nine rebounds. The Jags set new season-highs in almost every statistical category, shooting 52 percent from the field with 13 three-pointers. They also were extremely efficient on the night, logging a phenomenal 23 assists while only giving up eight turnovers and forcing 23 Spring Hill turnovers.

### Preseason Polls

- Despite receiving a league-best four first-place votes, the Jaguars were projected to finish third behind co-regular season champions from a year ago – James Madison (175 points, one first-place vote) and Arkansas State (154 points, three first-place votes). Troy followed close behind South Alabama in fourth with 148 points, while Old Dominion rounded out the top five with 145 points.

### Underdogs

The Jags' roster is composed primarily of players from Division II programs, junior colleges, NAIA schools, and international backgrounds. Four players made their way to South Alabama through the NAIA ranks: Jayden Cooper (Faulkner), JJ Wheat (Freed-Hardeman), Chaze Harris (Life), and Peyton Law (Freed-Hardeman). Brian Hawthorne represents the team's lone Division II product, arriving from Rockhurst University, while Stephen Williams comes from Coastal Alabama Community College. Randy Brady and Hantz Louis-Jeune both bring prior Division I experience—Brady from Chattanooga and Louis-Jeune, a well-traveled veteran, from Florida A&M.

### Rooted through Defense

The Jaguars prided themselves on their defense last season, and Coach Riley looks to carry that same mentality into the 2025-26 campaign playing their patented zone defense. South Alabama ranked third in the Sun Belt and 51st nationally in field-goal percentage defense, holding opponents to just 39.7%. The Jags also limited their foes to 65.9 points per game – the second-lowest mark in the Sun Belt and 55th in the nation. Adding to their defensive résumé, they set a new program record with 299 steals in a single season.

## NOTES YOU NEED TO KNOW

### The Road Ahead

- South Alabama will travel to St.Petersburg, Fla. next week to participate in the inaugural Showdown in St. Pete. They will take on Central Michigan on Nov.13 at 10 a.m. and Coppin State on Nov.15 at 10 a.m. CT.

### Road Warriors

Tonight's matchup marks the final home game before more than a month on the road for South Alabama, as the Jaguars won't return to the Mitchell Center until Dec. 14 vs. North Texas. Following the Showdown in St. Pete, South Alabama will play a pair of in-state road games at Jacksonville State (Nov. 19) and UAB (Nov. 21) before heading west to Texas to take on UTSA (Nov. 30). The Jags will then fly to Johnson City, Tenn., to close out the road trip against East Tennessee State (Dec. 2).

In total, the Jaguars are set to travel an estimated 3,900 miles over the next month.

### Home Sweet Home

In eight seasons at the helm of the Jaguar program, Richie Riley has led his teams to a dominant 86-31 record at home inside the Mitchell Center. The Jags went 13-4 at home during the 2024-25 campaign.

### NAIA Dynamic Duo

Peyton Law and Chaze Harris join South Alabama after putting together two of the most impressive seasons in all of NAIA basketball last year.

Harris was named the Southern States Athletic Conference (SSAC) Men's Basketball Player of the Year, averaging 19.7 points, 6.9 assists, 6.6 rebounds, and 2.1 steals per game while shooting 59 percent from the field. Over his NAIA career, Harris totaled 1,490 points, 527 rebounds, 431 assists, and 157 steals.

Law earned First Team All-Mid-South Conference honors and was recognized as an NAIA First-Team All-American. A Top 25 finalist for the Bevo Francis Award, Law averaged 16.2 points, 6.7 rebounds, 1.7 assists, 1.7 steals, and 1.4 blocks per game, shooting 60.7 percent from the field and 39.4 percent from three-point range. Across his career, he started 90 games and compiled 1,172 points, 548 rebounds, 151 assists, 144 steals, and 104 blocks, shooting 55.7 percent overall and 34.6 percent from beyond the arc.

### 150 and counting...

At just 42 years old, Richie Riley is already among the top three coaches in South Alabama history. He is one of only three Jaguar head coaches to surpass 100 career wins while in Mobile. Riley currently owns a 131-94 record, trailing only Cliff Ellis (171) and Ronnie Arrow (211) on the program's all-time wins list.

### Roster Outlook

The 2025-26 South Alabama roster features a balanced mix of experience and youth, consisting of two freshmen, two sophomores, three juniors, five seniors, and one graduate student. The team represents eight different states, including four players from Alabama, two from Tennessee, two from Ohio, and one each from Florida, Kansas, Georgia, and Kentucky, along with one international player from Canada.

## Richie Riley

### Head Coach Eastern Kentucky, 2005 8th Season

Richie Riley became head coach of the South Alabama men's basketball program in 2018. In his seven seasons, he has led the Jaguars to seven straight non-losing seasons, the program's longest streak since 1983-89.

In 2024-25, Riley guided South Alabama to the Sun Belt Conference regular-season title, its first since 2008. Picked to finish 11th in the league's preseason coaches poll, Riley's squad defied expectations by posting a 21-11 overall record, the most wins in a season under his leadership and the most

regular-season victories by any Jaguar team since 2008. South Alabama also earned four wins over teams ranked in the top 150 of the NCAA NET rankings.

Riley's 2024-25 Jaguars were one of the most efficient and defensively sound teams in the nation, ranking sixth nationally in field-goal percentage defense (.384), 17th in scoring defense (64.3 points per game) and 15th in steals per game (9.3). The Jaguars also ranked in the top 10 nationally in several key categories: seventh in fouls per game (13.3), sixth in turnover margin (+4.9), seventh in turnovers per game (9.2) and 17th in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.59). South Alabama led the Sun Belt in each of those categories and won four league games by 25 points or more which the most in a single season since 1998-99.

In the 2023-24 season, Riley became just the third head coach in program history to reach 100 career wins at South Alabama. The Jaguars closed the regular season by winning six of their final eight games and secured the No. 8 seed in the Sun Belt Tournament for the second consecutive year. Following the 2023-24 season, two of Riley's players signed professional contracts. Forward Samuel Tabe, a Division II transfer from Seton Hill, signed with BC Psychiko of the Greek Elite League after earning Sun Belt Player of the Week honors on Feb. 26. Tabe capped his season with four straight 25-point games, including a conference-best 35-point performance against Arkansas State on Feb. 24. Veteran guard Tyrell Jones also went on to play professionally, signing with Enosis Neon Paralimni in the Cypriot Elite League. Jones, a three-year starter for the Jaguars, averaged 12.7 points, 3.8 rebounds and 2.1 assists per game in 2023-24.

In 2022-23, Riley led the Jaguars to a 19-16 record and a memorable late-season surge, winning 11 of their final 14 games en route to the program's first appearance in the Sun Belt Tournament championship game since 2009. Riley coached two all-conference selections: Isaiah Moore (first team) and Kevin Samuel (third team), with Samuel also earning Sun Belt Defensive Player of the Year honors after setting a single-season school record with 86 blocks.

The 2021-22 campaign saw Riley guide South Alabama to a 21-12 record – the program's highest win total since 2007-08 – and a run to the semifinals of The Basketball Classic. The Jaguars finished in the top three in the Sun Belt in both scoring offense and scoring defense, the only team to do so. Three players earned All-Sun Belt honors, and the team posted a 15-3 home record, the second-best in Mitchell Center history.

In 2020-21, Riley's Jaguars posted a 17-11 mark, including an eight-game Sun Belt winning streak. The season was highlighted by the performance of Michael Flowers, who led the league in scoring (21.0 ppg) and was named first-team All-Sun Belt and the conference's Newcomer of the Year.

Riley's second season, 2019-20, marked a breakthrough with a 20-11 record, the program's first 20-win season since 2008-09. The Jaguars were led by All-Sun Belt selections Josh Ajayi and Trahae Mitchell. Ajayi topped the league in field-goal percentage, while Mitchell ranked second in blocks per game.

Riley's debut campaign in 2018-19 saw South Alabama feature five double-figure scorers – a first for the program since 1996-97 – while improving offensive efficiency and establishing a fast-paced identity built around transfers and player development.

Before arriving in Mobile, Riley spent two seasons as head coach at Nicholls State, where he led the Colonels to a 21-11 record and a share of the 2018 Southland Conference regular-season title – their first in two decades. Nicholls ranked among the national leaders in steals, scoring and turnovers forced under Riley's leadership.

As an assistant, Riley held stints at Clemson, UAB, Eastern Kentucky and Coastal Carolina. At Clemson, he helped the Tigers win 10 ACC games in 2016-17 and recruited top-100 prospect Ty Hudson. At UAB, he helped sign a top-25 recruiting class and contributed to a victory over No. 16 North Carolina in 2013-14.

A native of Kentucky, Riley began his coaching career at Georgetown College and later coached at Hawaii Pacific and Pikeville. He earned his degree in special education and human behavior from Eastern Kentucky University in 2005.

Riley and his wife, Jess, have three sons: Reese, Rock and Rush.

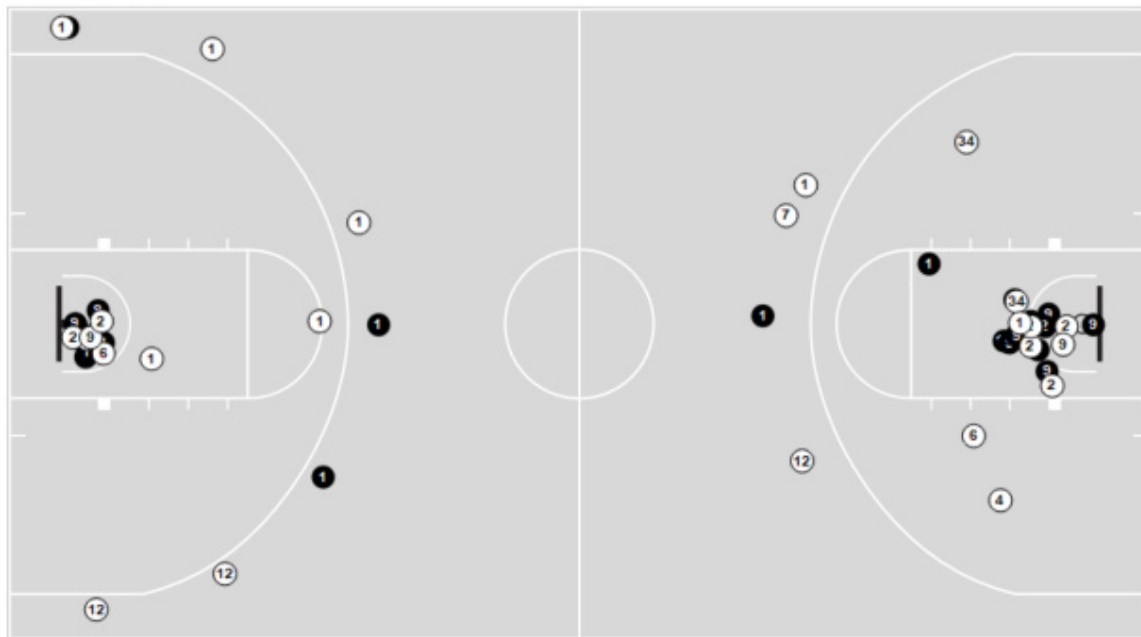

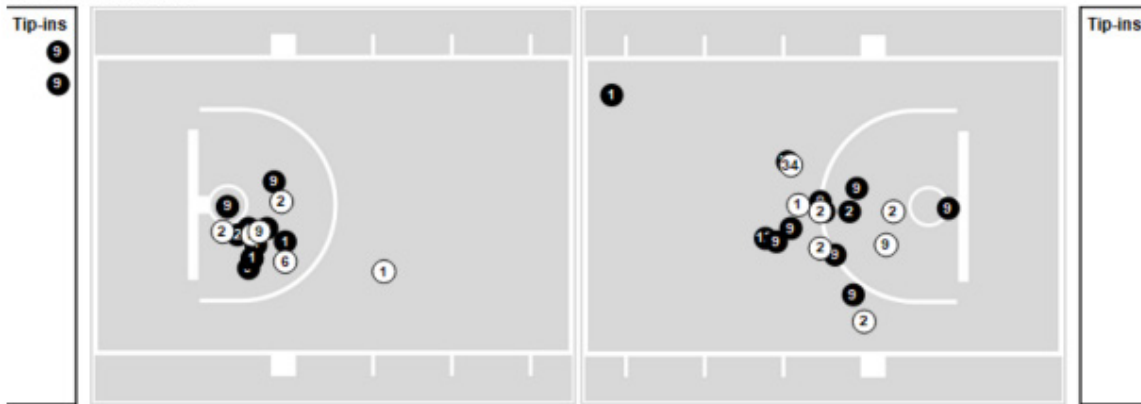
