Directions, parking, and facilities information:

Soccer: Games are played at Fin Land Field on the north end of the Bluffton Campus. Parking is available at the facility. Buses should unload players at the field entrance then park in the main parking area. Team Benches are on the opposite side of the field. Team locker rooms are at the Recreation Center on campus' south end and can be accessed through communication with USCB Coaches and/or USCB Athletic Administration. Modest restroom facilities are available at Fin Land field for players and spectators. Visitors wear dark uniforms unless otherwise agreed upon with USCB Coaches.

Directions

From I-95 Northbound

Take exit 8, take a right and go approximately 5 miles on Hwy 278E toward Hilton Head Island. Turn right at light onto University Parkway. Go approximately .5 miles, turn left on South Campus Drive at Palmetto Village guard gate. Fin Land Field parking is the first right.

From I-95 Southbound

Take exit 8, take a left and go approximately 5 miles on Hwy 278E toward Hilton Head Island. Turn right at light onto University Parkway. Go approximately .5 miles, turn left on South Campus Drive at Palmetto Village guard gate. Fin Land Field parking is the first right.

From East (Beaufort, Bluffton, Hilton Head)

Head west on US-278 W/William Hilton Pkwy toward I-95. Turn left at light onto University Parkway. Go approximately .5 miles, turn left on South Campus Drive at Palmetto Village guard gate. Fin Land Field parking is the first right.

From West (Hardeeville, I-95)

Head east on US-278 E toward Hilton Head Island. Turn right at light onto University Parkway. Go approximately .5 miles, turn left on South Campus Drive at Palmetto Village guard gate. Fin Land Field parking is the first right.

Basketball: Games are played at the USCB Recreation Center on the southeast section of the Bluffton of campus. Visiting team benches are in the northwest corner of the gym, visiting team locker rooms are accessed through the southwest doors of the gym. Team buses may drop athletes off at the Recreation Center then proceed to main parking for buses. Visiting teams wear dark uniforms unless otherwise agreed upon with USCB Coaches.

Spectators may enter the facility one hour prior to game time. Concessions are available through the final 15 minutes of the day's final game. Tickets and concessions operate on a cashless basis (credit cards and pre-purchase)

Directions:

From I-95 Northbound

Take exit 8, take a right and go approximately 5 miles on Hwy 278E toward Hilton Head Island. Go through the light at University Parkway and turn right at the *second* entrance to University Blvd (after passing the USCB sign in front of the pond). Follow University Blvd until taking a left on E Campus Drive. Continue down E Campus Drive until you reach the Recreation Center (next to lighted recreation field)

From I-95 Southbound

Take exit 8, take a left and go approximately 5 miles on Hwy 278E toward Hilton Head Island. From East (Beaufort, Bluffton, Hilton Head)

Head-west on US-278 W/William Hilton Pkwy toward I-95. Turn left at the first entrance to University Blvd. Follow University Blvd until taking a left on E Campus Drive. Continue down E Campus Drive until you reach the Recreation Center (next to lighted recreation field).

From West (Hardeeville, I-95)

Head east on US-278 E toward Hilton Head Island. Go through the light at University Parkway and turn right at the *second* entrance to University Blvd (after passing the USCB sign in front of the pond). Follow University Blvd until taking a left on E Campus Drive. Continue down E Campus Drive until you reach the Recreation Center (next to lighted recreation field).

Baseball and Softball: Baseball and Softball games are played at the Richard Gray Sports Complex located behind the Hardeeville Town Hall. The **GPS Address: 205 Main Street, Hardeeville, SC**

Baseball: Visitors use the first base dugout.

Softball: Visitors use the third base dugout.

We have renowned concessions which are available to spectators and teams alike. If you are interested in our concessionaire, Mr. Terry, putting together a team meal for you, he would be happy to do so with 24-hour notice. His fare ranges from typical ballpark food to grilled pork chops, sausage dogs, salads, chicken sandwiches and more. Please communicate with USCB Coaches or athletic administration if you wish to arrange for a team meal.

Directions

From I-95 Northbound

Take Exit 5, take a right and go approximately 2 miles to stoplight, take a right onto Hwy 46. Go 7/10 mile, turn left into the Hardeeville Town Hall. Richard Gray Sports Complex is located behind the Hardeeville Town Hall.

From I-95 Southbound

Take Exit 5, take a left and go approximately 2 miles to stop light, take a right onto Hwy 46.

Go 7/10 mile, turn left into the Hardeeville Town Hall.

From East (Bluffton Campus, Beaufort, Bluffton, Hilton Head)

Head west on US-278 W/William Hilton Pkwy toward I-95.

Go approximately 5 miles past Bluffton Campus to John Smith Road. Turn left onto John Smith Road.

Go 2.2 miles on John Smith Road. Turn left onto Hwy 17 at the end of John Smith Road.

Go approximately 1 mile to stoplight and turn left onto Hwy 46.

Go 7/10 mile, turn left into the Hardeeville Town Hall.

Richard Gray Sports Complex is located behind the Hardeeville Town Hall.

USCB Facilities Prohibited Items: The following items are prohibited at all USCB Athletic venues: tobacco (including smokeless tobacco), weapons of any kind, fireworks, air horns, laser pointers. Pets are prohibited at all indoor facilities (except for service animals). Pets are permitted at outdoor venues if they are leashed and under control.

Athletic Training

Athletic Training Facilities are in the USCB Recreation Center at the building's west end. A Certified Athletic will be present for all home basketball, soccer, baseball, and softball games. Visiting teams should notify USCB Sports Medicine staff if not traveling with an athletic trainer. If this is the case, please send a taping list with detailed instructions, with 24-hour notice, for athletes needing to be taped along with a fully stocked medical kit.

USCB will provide visiting teams with a cooler of ice water and cups and a cooler with injury ice. For Basketball and Soccer upon request, water and cups will be in the visitor locker room.

Emergency equipment (AED, splint bag) will be on-site during each competition should your team need any of those items.
