BARE E-SAND-SHELLS

- USC owns three beach volleyball national championships including the first-ever NCAA title in 2016 (AVCA, 2015).
- 8th-year head coach **Anna Collier** is **186-34 (.890)** and is the first and only collegiate head coach to reach 150 career victories.
- The Trojans are 16-1 all-time in the state of Arizona and won three duals in Tucson earlier this season. USC's only loss in Arizona was to UCLA in the semifinals of the 2017 Pac-12 Championship.
- AVCA All-Americans **Abril Bustamante** (Sr.) and **Tina Graudina** (So.) top the Trojans' lineup. The duo is 45-3 all-time together.
- Individually, Bustamante is **102-23** and Sr. Terese Cannon is **101-24** all-time.
- Bustamante and Graudina were named Pac-12 Pair of the Week (March 5). So. **Haley Hallgren** and Sr. **Alexandra Poletto** were chosen on March 12.
- Each of USC's top three pairs are made up of a senior and a sophomore. All three pairs have won at least 25 matches together and rank among the program's top 20 all-time pairs for total victories.



LOS ANGELES – No. 2-ranked USC (13-2) remains on the road this week and heads to the Copper State for the ASU Invitational in Tempe, Ariz. The Women of Troy take on host Arizona State (10-4) to open the tourney and then must face a pair of top-10 opponents in No. 5 Pepperdine (11-5) and No. 6 Hawai'i (10-4); each for the first time this season. The Trojans are on a three-match winning streak since suffering a 3-2 loss to No. 10 South Carolina on the East Coast.

USC HEAD COACH ANNA COLLIER



Anna Biller Collier, who coached women's beach volleyball teams in two Olympic games, is in her eighth season as USC's first-ever head coach of beach volleyball with a **186-34 (.890)** overall record.

Collier has led the Trojans to three national championships (AVCA 2015) including the first two NCAA titles in history. USC went **38-1** in 2017 and was **34-2** in 2016 when it finished on a 30-match winning streak. The Trojans are the first team ever to win back-to-back crowns and are also the first to win three in a row. Under her care, USC also won consecutive Pac-12 titles (2016-17). In 2015, USC was undefeated (**28-0**) and won the AVCA's national championship.

USC pairs have claimed four national titles under Collier. Sara Hughes and Kelly Claes won the 2015 AVCA and the 2017 USAV championships. Kirby Burnham and Hughes won the 2014 championship; and Burnham and Stevi Robinson won the 2013 crown.

In 2014, USC was **23-3** and Collier was named the **2014 AVCA National Coach of the Year**. The Trojans went **16-8** in 2013 and made their first-ever AVCA semifinals appearance as a team. Burnham and Robinson became USC's first-ever All-Americans in the sport. Collier took USC to a **7-4** record in 2012, the sport's inaugural season as an NCAA emerging sport, and sent two USC teams to the pairs championship of the first AVCA pairs tourney.

She has led two U.S. teams to fifth-place Olympic finishes: Holly McPeak and Nancy Reno (1996 Atlanta Games) and Annette Davis and Jenny Johnson (2000 Sydney Games). Collier has coached beach volleyball since 1990, and has worked with standouts Misty May-Treanor, Kerri Walsh, Nicole Branagh, Rachel Wacholder, and Angie Akers.

As head coach for the U.S. Senior A2 Beach National Team, she led teams to first and fifth place finishes at the 2012 World University Championships in Brazil. She coached U26 and U23 A2 U.S. squads at the 2010 Team FISU World University Championships in Turkey and coached the U26 U.S. squads at the 2011 championships in China. She served as coach of Team USA at the 2013 Summer World University Games in Russia. On top of her duties, she is a USAV High Performance coach and a founding member of the USAV Beach Coaching Accreditation Program Cadre.

Collier played professionally on the beach for seven seasons between 1978 and 1989; and posted 10 Top 10 finishes among her 20 tournament appearances. At USC (as Anna Biller) she was on the track and field, volleyball, and swimming teams and was a two-time All-American in track as a member of the 800-meter (1975) and 400-meter (1977) relay teams. Collier earned a degree in physical education from USC in 1977.

SCOUTING REPORT: Arizona State (10-4) is 8-1 in its last nine duals. Each of the Sun Devils' losses has come to teams ranked in the top 15 including No. 1 UCLA. At the top court, **Oluoma Okaro** and **Ashley Wenz** are 9-0 and were named the Pac-12 Pair of the Week. The Trojans are 10-0 all-time against ASU. No. 5 Pepperdine (11-5) had a five-match winning streak snapped by top-ranked UCLA and suffered only its second 5-0 sweep in program history (both to the Bruins this season). USC dropped four straight regular-season duals to the Waves in 2018 but knocked Pepperdine out of the NCAA championship with a 3-2 win. The Trojans trail, 12-11, in the all-time series. No. 6 Hawai'i (10-4) has won six in a row since going 2-2 at the East Meets West Invitational. Three of the Wahine's four losses have been 3-2 decisions. Four different pairs have occupied the top court for Hawai'i, but the Wahine are solid at the No. 2 (11-3) and No. 3 (13-1) positions. The Trojans are 12-3 all-time against Hawai'i, but had an eight-match winning streak snapped last season and suffered two losses on the islands.

LAST TIME OUT: The Women of Troy went 3-1 on the East Coast where they played for the first time in the Peach State. USC had a nine-match winning streak snapped in a 3-2 upset to No. 10 South Carolina, but bounced back to get 4-1 wins over No. 18 Georgia State, No. 16 Florida Atlantic, and No. 8 Florida International. Seniors **Abril Bustamante** and **Terese Cannon** each surpassed the 100-career victory mark individually while Bustamante and sophomore partner **Tina Gaudina** reached the 45-win plateau as a tandem to move into fifth all-time among USC pairs.

ALL ABOUT THE BENJAMINS: On Saturday, April 23, 2016, USC defeated Hawai'i, 3-0, to make head coach **Anna Collier** the first collegiate beach volleyball coach to reach the 100 career victories mark. She is now **186-34 (.890)** all-time. The next closest coach was Pepperdine's **Nina Matthies** who reached 100 in 2017 and retired from coaching following the 2018 season with 137 career victories. The next nearest active coach to Collier is UCLA's **Stein Metzger** who started the season at 110-38 and is now **125-38 (.767)**.

CENTURY CITY: Seniors **Abril Bustamante** and **Terese Cannon** joined USC's 100-career win club during a trip to the East Coast (March 12-15). They are the seventh and eighth players to reach that career plateau with the Trojans. Bustamante is **102-23** and Cannon is **101-24** all-time. The six Trojans ahead of them are school-record holder **Sara Hughes** (190); **Kelly Claes** (180), **Nicolette Martin** (141), **Allie Wheeler** (130), **Jenna Belton** (124), and **Jo Kremer** (103).

PAIR'S LAIR: USC's pair of **Abril Bustamante** and **Tina Gaudina** has won **45** matches (**45-3**) and are fifth all-time among Trojan pairs. They need five more victories to become just the fifth pair to win 50 matches in school history. At the top of that list is **Kelly Claes** and **Sara Hughes** who won 147 matches.

NATIONAL RECOGNITION: Trojan pairs have twice been chosen for the AVCA/CollegeBeachVB.com National Pair of the Week award. Both times, senior **Abril Bustamante** and sophomore **Tina Gaudina** were selected. Their first time was March 13, 2018; and more recently on March 12, 2019.

POW-WOW: USC pairs have won the Pac-12 Beach Volleyball Pair of the Week award **15 times** since its inception in 2016. **Abril Bustamante** and **Tina Gaudina** won the program's first award of 2019 (March 5) and were followed by first-time winners **Haley Hallgren** and **Alexandra Poletto** (March 12). In 2018, Bustamante paired with **Terese Cannon** for one of two USC awards. She also won with a then-freshman Gaudina. In 2017, USC pairs claimed five of the eight awards. All-Americans **Kelly Claes** and **Sara Hughes** are owners of a record five Pac-12 POW awards. **Jenna Belton** and **Jo Kremer** became the first-ever No. 5 pair to win the honor on March 21, 2017. USC's **Nicolette Martin** and **Allie Wheeler** have the great distinction of being the first-ever Pac-12 Pair of the Week honorees; chosen from the No. 3 position as juniors on March 8, 2016.

USC HOSTS 2019 PAC-12 CHAMPIONSHIP: The sand at Merle Norman Stadium will play host to the 2019 Pac-12 Championship from April 25-27. The Trojans also hosted the inaugural league tournament at the stadium in 2016 and won the first of its back-to-back conference crowns. Arizona hosted the 2017 tournament and Stanford played host to the tourney in 2018. For more information on the championship, please visit Pac-12.com/beach-volleyball.

SAND CASTLE: The Women of Troy are **47-8** at Merle Norman Stadium since it opened in 2013. The Trojans won **19 straight** home matches between 2014 and 2016; and went 10-0 in 2015 and 8-0 in 2014 on MNS sand. USC's later **16-match** winning streak was snapped on Feb. 28, 2018, when UCLA and Pepperdine claimed back-to-back 3-2 wins over the Trojans. Only four teams have ever come to Merle Norman Stadium and beaten the Women of Troy: Pepperdine (3), Florida State (2), UCLA (2), and Long Beach State (1).

POLL POSITION: USC opened the 2019 season ranked No. 2 in both the AVCA Coaches Top 20 and the *DiG Magazine* Top 20 media poll. The Trojans have been ranked in the AVCA's top 5 (and appeared in every poll) for **51 weeks**. The Women of Troy seized the top spot in both polls on March 23, 2015, following a victory over then No. 1-ranked Hawai'i on the road and held the ranking for the rest of 2015. USC has been ranked **No. 1 in 24** AVCA polls, the most all-time. The Trojans, the Waves, the Wahine, and UCLA are the only four teams ever to hold the top spot in the poll. USC is **96-7 all-time** when ranked No. 1. The Trojans received their first-ever No. 1 ranking in 2014 and maintained the position for much of the season, before they fell to eventual AVCA champion Pepperdine in the national semifinals. In 2013, USC started the season ranked third and finished in fourth.

LET'S GO STREAKING: USC set a new program record to close the 2016 season as winners of 30 consecutive dual matches. That streak carried into the 2017 campaign and reached **62** before a loss on April 28 in the 2017 Pac-12 Championship. The 62 victories rank sixth among longest streaks in the history of USC athletics. All-Americans **Kelly Claes** and **Sara Hughes** won 103 straight matches as a pair between April 2, 2015 and April 8, 2017. During that streak, the two Trojans lost just **seven sets** (only **one** in 2016 and **one** in 2017).

1-2 PUNCH: When No. 1 UCLA and No. 2 USC met at Merle Norman Stadium on Feb. 27, the Trojans played in their **12th** 1v2 matchup. The Trojans are **7-5 all-time** in No. 1 vs. No. 2 duals. They went 3-1 in 2016 but didn't play any such matches in 2015. In three 1-vs-2 duals in 2014, USC went 1-2. Overall, in these duals, USC is **5-3** when ranked No. 1 and **2-2** when ranked No. 2.

HIGH MARKS: Trojan All-Americans **Kelly Claes** and **Sara Hughes** are the winningest pair in program history. The duo won **147 matches (4 losses)** together over the course of a three-year relationship. **Nicolette Martin** and **Allie Wheeler** formed the second-most successful duo in school history from 2014-16 as they amassed **91 victories (91-14)** through the end of the 2016 NCAA championship run. Claes and Hughes own the USC single-season record for wins with a 48-0 mark achieved in 2016 and the record for longest winning streak with a 103-match run between April 2, 2015 and April 8, 2017.

FOUR SCORE: Trojans own four pairs' national titles. **Kirby Burnham** and **Stevi Robinson** won the 2013 AVCA championship. Burnham won again with **Sara Hughes** in 2014. Hughes later teamed with **Kelly Claes** to win in 2015. With the NCAA's sponsorship of beach volleyball as its 90th championship sport, it decided to hold a team championship and not a pairs' tournament. Claes and Hughes won a second national title as the USAV Pairs Champions in 2017.

TROJANS IN TV LAND: USC matches will be shown on Pac-12 Networks eight times this spring. The Trojans' home matches with LMU and UCLA on Feb. 27 were on the national network and the Pac-12 LA sub-network. USC's matches against Stanford, Arizona, and Oregon in the Pac-12 South Invitational (March 2-3) were also on Pac-12 Networks. When the Women of Troy and the Bruins clash in Westwood on April 3, the dual will be carried by Pac-12 Los Angeles. USC's home matches against Pepperdine and Long Beach State on April 11 will also be broadcast live. All matches in the 2019 Pac-12 championship will also be broadcast live from Merle Norman Stadium (April 25-27).

ALL-AMERICAN GIRLS: USC has celebrated **nine** AVCA All-Americans and **16** All-America certificates in six seasons. **Sara Hughes** became the first-ever four-time All-American in 2017. **Kelly Claes** is USC's second three-time All-American while **Kirby Burnham** and **Sophie Bukovec** are each two-time winners. **Abril Bustamante**, **Tina Gaudina**, **Stevi Robinson**, **Alexa Strange**, and **Allie Wheeler** each hold one-time All-America distinction on their resumes. Bustamante, Gaudina, Hughes, Claes, Bukovec, and Strange have also been chosen for *DiG Magazine* All-America honors.



DISTANCE RUNNING: Only one team can claim a winning record against the Women of Troy. Just seven teams have ever registered a win over USC and together are responsible for all **33** of USC's all-time losses. Pepperdine (12), UCLA (7), Long Beach State (5), Florida State (4), Hawai'i (3), California (1), and LSU (1) own those victories. Pepperdine is 12-11 all-time against the Trojans as the only opponent with a winning mark. The Trojans are undefeated against the other **32** of their all-time opponents.

INTERNATIONAL FLAVOR: Freshman **Tina Graudina** is the Trojan's first-ever player from Latvia, but she is the second to hail from Europe. **Natasa Siljkovic**, an indoor volleyball convert, played two seasons on the sand (2013-14), and is from Uzice, Serbia. They are two of just four international players to have held roster spots with the Trojans. **Alexandra Poletto** and **Sophie Bukovec** are each from Canada.

OH, CANADA: **Alexandra Poletto** is the Trojans' second Canadian player and hails from the same city as two-time All-American **Sophie Bukovec** (Toronto, Ontario). The tandem will pair this summer and train with the Canadian Beach Volleyball national team.

TEXAS THREE-STEP: The Trojans' roster features three players who hail from the Lone Star State. Sophomore **Maja Kaiser** is from Bulverde, a small town north of San Antonio. Fellow sophomore **Haley Hallgren** prepped at Carroll High School in Southlake, in the Dallas Metro area, but has deep roots in California, where her family previously lived. Sophomore transfer **Josannah Vazquez** is from Mansfield, a suburb to the southwest of Dallas. Vazquez is no stranger to California either after having spent one year at Long Beach City College.

OH, THE PLACES YOU'LL GO: The USC beach program is on the rise, and the nation knows. Since 2012, the Trojans have acquired student-athletes that have chosen to transfer in order to compete on one of the top teams in the country. Even USC's two oldest traditional football rivals have been represented on the Trojan roster. **Jo Kremer** played indoor volleyball at Notre Dame in the fall of 2014. 2016 graduate **Zoe Nightingale** and 2015 graduate **Meg Norton** were each previously members of UCLA's indoor volleyball team. 2016 grad **Alexa Strange** gave up the indoor game at Nebraska to join the Trojans and **Sophie Bukovec** did the same after a successful season at Long Beach State. In 2016, the Trojans got a transfer from Georgetown, a traditional basketball power, when **Terese Cannon** made the coastal change. **Alexandra Poletto** completed her indoor career at Colorado State in the fall of 2017 and joined the Women of Troy for the 2018 beach season.

STAFF INFECTION: Over the years, the Trojans' coaching staff has featured some of the game's biggest names. For four seasons (2015-18) Olympic gold-medal winner **Dain Blanton** served as the team's volunteer assistant coach. Blanton won beach volleyball gold in the 2000 Sydney Games with partner **Eric Fonoimoana**. Fonoimoana joined the staff as volunteer assistant in the fall of 2018 and will coach his first season in the spring of 2019. In 2015, Blanton replaced the Trojans' former assistant **Misty May-Treanor**, who was a three-time Olympic gold-medal winner on the sand herself. In 2017, **Gustavo Rocha** joined the staff following a stint at Pepperdine as the Waves' volunteer assistant coach. Rocha has also served as an assistant to Marcio Sicoli (now Pepperdine's head coach), who coached Olympic gold medalists May-Treanor and Kerri Walsh-Jennings.

USC ALUMS ON THE BEACH: USC women's volleyball players have shined on the pro beach world circuit, both internationally and domestically. Some top stars include Olympic medalists **April Ross** and **Jennifer Kessy**; **Tracy (Lindquist) Jones** (13-year pro); **Geena Urango**, **Jessica Gysin**, and **Keao Burdine** (young beach stars); **Bibiana Candelas** (indoor All-American who won the first-ever Collegiate Nationals Beach Championship in 2006); **Paula Weishoff** (an indoor Olympian and Volleyball Hall of Fame inductee); and **Miki McFadden** (indoor Olympian). More recently, **Sara Hughes**, **Kelly Claes**, **Nicolette Martin**, **Allie Wheeler**, and **Terese Cannon** have made inroads on the AVP (American Volleyball Professionals) tour.

MERLE NORMAN STADIUM

Merle Norman Stadium is the on-campus home to the USC women's beach volleyball program. Located on the east side of University Park Campus on Figueroa Street across from the Galen Center, it features three courts with sand from the U.S. Olympic Training Center. The palm tree-encircled stadium also has bleachers and a grass berm for spectator seating, a scoreboard and audio system, lighting, restrooms, showers, and multiple team storage areas.

Ground was broken to build the new venue in July of 2012 under the generous donations of Jack and Helen Nethercutt and John and Melinda Muller, and a large sum from an anonymous donor. The Mullers have a daughter (Erica) on the 2013 squad. A USC alumnus, Jack Nethercutt served as vice president of marketing and later President of Merle Norman Cosmetics in 1973. He left the company to pursue other ventures but returned to his presidency in March of 2002 and now serves as Chairman of the Board with his wife Helen as Vice Chairman.

The stadium is named for Nethercutt's great aunt and namesake of the cosmetics corporation, Merle Nethercutt Norman. Jack and Helen are active in Los Angeles non-profits and charities and are Galen Founders, Scholarship Club members, and Conquest supporters of the USC Trojan Marching Band.

On Thursday, March 7, 2013, USC officially opened and dedicated Merle Norman Stadium in conjunction with the beach volleyball program's alumni match. The Nethercutts were on hand to cut the ribbon with first Trojan head coach Anna Collier and athletic director Pat Haden. USC All-America alumnae and Olympic beach volleyball silver medalists Jennifer Kessy and April Ross christened the sand in their return to campus for the special match.

The Women of Troy played their first dual match in the stadium on Sunday, March 10, 2013, and earned a 4-1 victory over Loyola Marymount. The stadium hosted the inaugural Pac-12 Championship in 2016. USC produced a 7-3 mark in 2013 and was 8-0 in 2014 on its home sand at Merle Norman Stadium. USC also went undefeated in 2015 (10-0) and in 2017 (8-0). The Trojans are **47-8 (.855)** all-time at Merle Norman Stadium.
