CROSSEXAMINATION

- USC is ranked **No. 16** in the IWLCA coaches poll; the **48th** consecutive week that the Trojans are ranked in the poll.
- The Trojans' **seven-game** winning streak is a season long and the longest since a 12-game streak (March 26-May 14, 2017).
- The Women of Troy are amidst a **nine-day** stretch during which they will play four games; with the back two on the road.
- The Trojans are **8-3** all-time in the Bay Area. 3-0 at Cal; 2-0 at Saint Mary's College; 2-3 at Stanford; and 1-0 in neutral games (vs. Denver, 2016).
- USC has beaten Cal by double-digit margins in five of the last seven meetings.
- The Trojans and the Cardinal have had five one-goal final margins in 12 matchups including three times in the last four head-to-heads.
- USC has held each of its Pac-12 opponents under 10 goals (**5.80 gaa**).
- No. 20 Stanford is the fifth ranked opponent the Trojans face this season. USC owns **18 all-time wins** over ranked foes (18-27).
- Eight different Trojans have scored double-digit goals this season; nine players have scored five goals or more through 11 contests.
- Seventh-year head coach **Lindsey Munday** is 89-39 all-time.



LOS ANGELES – No. 16 USC lacrosse (10-1, 5-0 Pac-12) takes a season-long seven-game winning streak into the back half of the Pac-12 schedule and hits the road for match-ups at California (5-7, 2-3) on Friday (March 29) and at No. 20 Stanford (7-3, 3-2) on Sunday (March 31). This streak is the Trojans' longest since a 12-game streak took them into the 2017 NCAA quarterfinals (March 26-May 14).

The Trojans lead the Pac-12 and are 12th in the NCAA with a plus-5.70 margin of victory. USC also leads the conference in goals-against average (9.00 gaa), goals per game (14.70 gpg), and shot percentage (.434). Eight Women of Troy have scored double-digit goals through 11 games including sophomore team leader **Kelsey Huff** who has 27 points on 23 goals and four assists. Sophomore **Sophia Donovan** has 28 points (21g, 7a). Junior **Hope Anhut** also has 28 points as the team's top distributor with 10 assists (18 goals). Senior **Emily Concialdi** (18g, 7a) has 25 points. Huff also has 17 ground balls and 16 caused turnovers. Junior **Izzy McMahon** also has 25 points (18g, 7a).

Junior midfielder **Kerrigan Miller** does a little of everything. She has 14 goals, 29 draw controls, 30 ground balls, and a team-high 20 caused turnovers. She ranks third in the Pac-12 for ground balls (2.80 gbpg). In goal, sophomore **Riley Herford** leads the league with a 9.10 goals-against average and tops all players with 3.40 ground balls per game. In the center circle, senior **Jackie Gilbert** has 65 draw controls and leads the league at 6.10 per game. She also has 15 caused turnovers and 12 ground balls. Seventh-year head coach **Lindsey Munday** (89-39) leads an experienced and battle-tested squad into a quest for a fourth NCAA berth.

SONI MCALISTER FIELD

Soni McAlister Field is the home of USC women's soccer and women's lacrosse. Thanks to a generous \$150,000 donation from Hobart and Soni McAlister, a new field was built on the corner of 30th Street and Hoover Street in 1998. The field served as the home of USC soccer for 14 years before lacrosse was added as USC's 21st varsity sport in 2012. Trojan lacrosse played its first season in the spring of 2013, and hosted Massachusetts in their first game at the field on February 10.

In 2000, a permanent scoreboard was installed in the southwest corner of the field. In the summer of 2012, the field was moved eastward to accommodate the construction of a new fire station, which put the field's new entrance at 30th and University Avenue.

USC lacrosse is **40-10 (.800)** all-time at McAlister Field. The Trojans went undefeated there in 2015 (7-0), 2016 (9-0), and 2017 (7-0). USC has also hosted one home game at the LA Memorial Coliseum in each of the program's first five seasons and is **4-2** in the historic venue.



USC HEAD COACH LINDSEY MUNDAY



One of the most accomplished collegiate women's lacrosse players in the history of the sport, **Lindsey Munday** was handpicked to lead the first-ever USC women's lacrosse team in 2012.

Munday was named the MPSF Coach of the Year in 2015 and 2016; and was the IWLCA's West/Midwest Regional Coach of the Year. She was also chosen as the ILWomen National Coach of the Year in 2016. As a player, she won a pair of NCAA titles with Northwestern in 2005 and 2006. She then became an assistant at NU and helped the Wildcats to three titles from 2007-09.

Munday is a two-time world champion (2009 and '13) with the U.S. women's national team. In 2009, she earned All-World recognition with 17 goals and 20 assists (37 points) in seven games and later captained the 2013 squad to a record seventh FIL World Cup title.

Munday is **89-39 (.695)** overall at USC and guided the Trojans to three straight NCAA berths (2015-17), and back-to-back MPSF league titles (2016-17). In 2013, she led USC to a fourth-place MPSF finish with an appearance in the league tourney after the Trojans were picked to finish seventh.

As an assistant at Northwestern (2007-10) Munday was the recruiting coordinator and offensive coach. NU was 85-4 during her tenure and went 23-0 in 2009.

One of the greatest players in NU history, Munday was a Tewaaraton semifinalist in 2005 and 2006, and finished her career as the program's all-time leader in assists (128), third in points (268), and fifth in goals (140). She set single-season NU records for points (107) and assists (54) in 2005. The Wildcats were 64-12 and won the school's first-ever NCAA titles in the sport. She helped Northwestern become the first school outside the Eastern Time zone to win a national title and the first program to win consecutive NCAA championships.

Munday is a two-time first-team All-American (2005-06), All-Region, and All-American Lacrosse Conference selection. Munday received a bachelor's degree in communication from Northwestern in 2006.

SCOUTING REPORT



CALIFORNIA: The Golden Bears (5-7, 2-3 Pac-12) split games last week with their loss to the Trojans and a 12-11 overtime victory at Arizona State. The win over the Sun Devils snapped a three-game skid. Cal has five players in double-digit goals led by **Kirsten Swanson** and **Caroline Corzel** who have 25 and 23 goals respectively. **Eliza Christman** leads the team with 58 draw controls. Christman (21), **Susie Ropp** (18), and **Marisa Kuberra** (17) are the Bears' other three top scorers. In goal, **Jenny Wilkens** leads the team with 37 ground balls and has a .421 save percentage with a 12.75 goals-against average. The Trojans are 7-1 all-time against California and have won seven straight in the head-to-head series with five double-digit victories.



NO. 20 STANFORD: The Cardinal (7-3, 3-2 Pac-12) took down Arizona State but fell in a narrow 10-9 final to USC in its trip to the Southern Pac-12 teams. Two of Stanford's three losses are by a single goal and were suffered following last-second chances to tie. The Cardinal took a home loss to Colorado, 20-13, on March 8, but owns a big road win over No. 10 Stony Brook. **Ali Baiocco** leads Stanford in goals (28) and assists (14). **Daniella McMahon** (21, 9a) and **Katherine Gjertsen** (19g, 7a) are the Cardinal's other leading point scorers. In goal, **Trudie Graftan** has a 10.23 goals-against average and a .511 save percentage. USC is 6-6 in 12 all-time meetings with the Cardinal but 2-3 on the Farm. The Trojans and the Cardinal have had five one-goal decisions between them including three of the last four meetings.

TRACK THE TROJANS: For a behind-the-scenes look, fans of USC lacrosse can follow the Trojans on Twitter and Instagram at [@USCTrojansLax](#). USC will appear in four live Pac-12 Networks broadcasts this spring. Home games against Stanford (Mar. 25), Colorado (Apr. 5), and Oregon (Apr. 7); and a road game at Stanford (Mar. 31) will be shown on the Networks' national and regional channels. Pac-12 tournament games will also be carried on the network's channels. All non-broadcast league games will be shown on the Pac-12+ stream platform.

LAST TIME OUT: The Women of Troy extended to a season-long seven-game winning streak and completed the front half of the Pac-12 schedule undefeated (5-0) with a 19-7 win over California and a hard-fought 10-9 victory over No. 20 Stanford at McAlister Field. The two wins brought the program's all-time record at McAlister Field to 40-10. **Izzy McMahon** (4) and **Kaeli Huff** (3) had hat tricks against the Bears to mark the fifth time that two different Trojans had hat tricks in the same game this season. **Jackie Gilbert** matched her career high with 12 draw controls against Cal. **Riley Herford** posted a new career best and matched the second-highest total in school history with 17 saves in the one-goal win over the Cardinal. **Kelsey Huff** provided the firepower against Stanford and notched her 10th-career hat trick.

HOME, SWEET HOME: The Women of Troy are **44-12** all-time in home games and are **40-10** at McAlister Field. Between 2015 and 2018, the Trojans won 23 straight games on McAlister Field. Including two wins at the LA Memorial Coliseum, USC claimed 25 consecutive home victories during the impressive streak.

LET'S GET IT STARTED: USC improved to 4-3 all-time in season openers following its 15-10 win over Hofstra (Feb. 9). The Trojans started the year 3-0 before suffering a loss; the second-best start in school history. The program record for consecutive wins to open a season is 20 when USC blazed a trail into the 2016 NCAA quarterfinals with a 20-0 record. The Trojans are also 7-0 in all-time league openers (5-0 in the MPSF and 2-0 in the Pac-12).

FRESH RECORDS: In USC's game against Hofstra, freshman attacker **Katie Ramsay** became the first Trojan freshman to record a hat trick in her first collegiate game since 2013 (Maggie Mawhinney vs. Presbyterian; Feb. 13). She scored the first goal of the game, which marked only the third time that a freshman scored the Trojans' first goal of the season. Ramsay joined **Kelsey Huff** (2018 at Virginia Tech) and **Amanda Johansen** (2013 vs. Northwestern).

NET VALUE: Sophomore goalie **Riley Hertford's** win on Feb. 9 vs. Hofstra marked just the second time that a USC netminder has earned a victory in her first-career start. The other was **Cassandra Collins** (April 24, 2016) in her senior game start against UC Davis. Hertford's then-career high 11 saves against Jacksonville (Feb. 24) made her just the third USC goalie to collect double-digit saves in a game.

ALL-AMERICAN GIRLS: USC has celebrated **seven** IWLCA All-America selections through six years as a program. **Michaela Michael** was the first-ever All-American selection as a third-teamer in 2015. Michael and defender **Courtney Tarleton** were each named to the first team in 2016, with midfielder **Amanda Johansen** chosen to the third team. Michael repeated her first-team honors in 2017 and defender **Lydia Sutton** earned third-team honors. **Kerrigan Miller** joined the ranks as a third-team choice in 2018.

PAC IT UP: 2019 is the second season of Pac-12 lacrosse. In 2018, the Conference of Champions made lacrosse the 13th women's sport sponsored by the Pac-12. The addition of Arizona State brought the league to the minimum six teams to receive an automatic qualifier berth into the NCAA championship. The first-ever Pac-12 Lacrosse Championship was held at Prentup Field; hosted by Colorado. Stanford claimed the first Pac-12 title and will defend its crown at the 2019 championship in Eugene, Ore. (April 25-28). Previously a member of the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation, from the end of 2015 to the middle of the 2018 season, USC won a school-record 22 consecutive conference games. The Trojans were undefeated in the MPSF in 2016 (9-0) and 2017 (8-0). USC won the 2016 and 2017 MPSF championships. USC is 6-0 all-time in league openers and earned its first victory in a Pac-12 opener, 14-3, against Arizona State in 2018.

PAC-12 POW-WOW: Trojans own **eight** Pac-12 Player of the Week awards. Senior attacker **Emily Concialdi** nabbed her first-career Offensive Player of the Week honor on Feb. 25 following back-to-back hat trick performances against San Diego State and Jacksonville. Junior midfielder **Kerrigan Miller** was named Defensive Player of the Week on March 11 and became the first player in conference history to receive both the offensive and defensive awards in her career. Sophomores **Sophia Donovan** and **Riley Hertford** were named respectively for the offensive and defensive awards to make it a USC sweep on March 18. All-Pac-12 goalie **Gussie Johns** was named for the Defensive Player of the Week award twice in 2018. All-American defender **Lydia Sutton** was also Defensive Player of the Week once.

POLL POSITION: The Trojans opened 2019 ranked No. 21 in the IWLCA Coaches' preseason poll. USC has spent **48** consecutive weeks ranked in the IWLCA poll dating back to the 2016 preseason poll. USC spent a school-record **26 straight** weeks in the top 10 from March 21, 2016 through Feb. 19, 2018. The Trojans are **18-27** all-time against ranked opponents, which includes a **9-13** record against teams ranked in the top 10 and **2-10** against teams ranked among the top five.

EAST COAST BIAS: USC has played **26 games** on the East Coast (in the Eastern time zone) and holds a **13-13** overall record in those games. The Trojans own wins over Dartmouth (2), Notre Dame (2), LIU Brooklyn, Marist, Stetson, Florida, Virginia Tech, and Boston University in true road games. USC defeated James Madison at a neutral location in the 2015 NCAA first round in Durham, N.C.; beat Ohio State in a game played in New Jersey; and took down Jacksonville in Gainesville, Fla., in the first round of the 2017 NCAA tournament.

SISTER SITUATION: Four pairs of sisters have suited up for the Trojans. The first duo was fraternal twins **Glade** and **Shannon Nugent** (2014-16). The Nugent sisters played in a total of 10 games together in three seasons. All-American **Amanda Johansen** (2013-16) was on the Trojans' inaugural team and graduated before



younger sister **Kelly Johansen** joined the team for the 2017 season. The elder Johansen also served as one of Troy's assistant coaches in 2018. In the same year, midfielder **Kaeli Huff** was joined by sister **Kelsey Huff**. The Huffs comprise only the second sister pair to be on the same roster for the Trojans. All-MPSF attacker **Gabby McMahon** (2014-17) has departed but younger sister **Izzy McMahon** (Isabel) joined the Women of Troy in 2018 following her transfer from Army. The two McMahons are also the older sisters of Daniella McMahon, who is a junior at Pac-12 rival Stanford.

HAT TRICK MAGIC: Eight current Trojans are members of the program's hat-trick club. Junior midfielder **Kerrigan Miller** leads the group with **13**-career hat tricks, which ranks sixth among USC's career leaders. Sophomore midfielder **Kelsey Huff** has **10** hat tricks and ranks **eighth** all-time at Troy. Junior midfielder **Kaeli Huff** has **seven** and ranks **ninth** in a tie with junior attacker **Izzy McMahon** who has **seven** hat tricks at USC including one in her Trojan debut. McMahon had two four-goal games while at Army. Senior attacker **Emily Concialdi** and sophomore attacker **Sophia Donovan** each have **five**-career hat-trick games. Junior attacker **Hope Anhut** and freshman attacker **Katie Ramsay** each have **two**. USC's all-time leader is **Michaela Michael**, who finished her career (2014-17) with 41 games of three goals or more.

STATE YOUR CASE: USC's roster is made up of players from **11 different states**. In a bi-coastal battle, New York takes the edge with nine players from the Empire State on the 2019 Trojan squad. California is represented by seven Women of Troy. Four players hail from New Jersey, with two from Florida, Maryland, Oregon, and Pennsylvania. Connecticut, Georgia, Texas, and Virginia are each represented by one Trojan player.

POWER 100 PLAYERS: Freshman midfielders **Erin Bakes** and **Katie Ramsay** were each part of the ILWomen.com Power 100. Bakes was named the No. 2-ranked incoming freshman while Ramsay received the No. 47 rating. Frosh midfielder **Nicole Macolino** rounded out a trio of Trojans with her selection as one of 50 freshmen "On the Rise." Last year, **Riley Herford** (No. 12) and **Kelsey Huff** (No. 13) were ranked among the nation's top 15. In 2016, the Women of Troy landed the country's No. 1-rated recruit in **Kerrigan Miller**. In 2015, **Jackie Gilbert** was rated the No. 17 incoming recruit by the publication.

RED, WHITE, AND BLUE FOR TWO: All-American midfielder **Kerrigan Miller** was chosen as a member of the 2019 U.S. Lacrosse Women's Senior National Training Team along with former all-league goalie **Gussie Johns**. Miller has experience with the U19 team and helped Team USA take silver at the 2015 FIL Women's World Cup in Edinburgh, Scotland. Senior defender **Jackie Gilbert** was also a member of the 2015 U.S. U19 roster and has the distinction of being the first California native to be selected to a U.S. lacrosse national team.
