POSTGAME NOTES

No. 15 USC vs. Stanford Galen Center • Los Angeles, Calif. Thursday, January 27, 2022

Final: USC 61, Stanford 64

- With the 64-61 loss tonight, USC fell to 17-3 (7-3) and Stanford improved to 12-6 (5-3).
- USC falls to 8-2 at the Galen Center this season.
- Stanford jumped out to a 14-5 lead by making 5 of its first 7 shots, including 4-for-4 from 3-point range five minutes into the game. Stanford made its first five 3-point shots in the half. USC finished the first half on a 15-2 run to take a 34-28 lead into the break. Stanford outscored USC 36-27 in the second half to earn the victory.
- Freshman guard Kobe Johnson had a career-best 6 points and a career-high 4 rebounds.
- Isaiah Mobley had a career-best 9 assists tonight. In the last seven games he has registered 32 assists (4.6 per game).
- USC made 9 of 21 three-pointers tonight (42.9 percent) and has made 28 of 63 shots from beyond the arch the last three games (44.4 percent).
- Stanford made 42.6 percent of its shots tonight, just the fifth time this season a USC opponent has made more than 40 percent (twice by Stanford). In the two games against USC, Stanford has made 42.3 percent of its shots (48-for-111).
- Stanford had been 0-12 against Top 25 opponents on the road under coach Jerod Haase.
- USC had 17 assists tonight and 52 total in the last three games (17.3 per game).
- Forward Joshua Morgan missed his second consecutive game with right knee tendinitis. He is listed
 as day-to-day.
- USC's next game will be Saturday, Jan. 29 vs. California. The game is at 4:00 p.m. and will air on the Pac-12 Network.

"It was not the result we wanted. It came down to the last possession. Stanford played well. We had our chances, but couldn't get it to go down."

"The last play was not executed how we wanted. But we still had a chance."

"We have to do a better job of withstanding what the opposing players do well."

"We missed 4 layups at the start, so it was hard to get off to a good start when you do that. All those misses hurt and add up."

"I'm disappointed with our upperclassmen. We made errant passes, that was frustrating. Fourteen turnovers is too many, that's on us."
