POSTGAME NOTES

No. 15 USC vs. California Galen Center • Los Angeles, Calif. Saturday, January 29, 2022

Final: USC 79, California 72

- With the 79-72 win today, USC improved to 18-3 (8-3) and California fell to 9-12 (2-8).
- USC improved to 9-2 at the Galen Center this season.
- California jumped out to a 20-9 lead 8 minutes into the game. Cal made 8 of its first 10 shots (2-for-2 on 3-pointers), while USC started out 4-for-12 (1-for-5 on 3-pointers). USC outscored the Golden Bears 32-15 the rest of the half to lead 41-35 at the break.
- Boogie Ellis made 8 of 10 shots and finished with a season-best 21 points.
- Isaiah Mobley scored a career-best 24 points tonight. His previous best was 23 points on Dec. 7 vs. Eastern Kentucky earlier this season.
- USC had a season-low four turnovers today. It ended a 7-game streak of committing at least 10 turnovers in a game. It was the fewest in a game by the Trojans since committing three turnovers at UCLA on Feb. 28, 2019.
- USC had 11 assists tonight and has had 63 assists in the last four games (15.8 per game in that stretch).
- Ethan Anderson had a season-best 5 assists tonight.
- USC outscored California 16-2 on fast break points and 34-6 combined the last two games.
- Forward Joshua Morgan missed his third consecutive game with right knee tendinitis. He is listed as day-to-day.
- USC's next game will be Thursday, Feb. 3 at Arizona State. The game is at 8:00 p.m. (PT) and will air
 on the Pac-12 Network.

ANDY ENFIELD QUOTES:

"That was our fifth game in 10 days, we're very tired. Credit to our players, we've gone 4-1 in that stretch and we were 20 seconds away from being 5-0."

"Cal played outstanding offensive basketball. They made shot after shot and competed at a high level. They played well. It took everything we had."

"Isaiah Mobley is a tremendous player. You saw tonight what kind of player he is. He was aggressive on both sides of the court. He played a tremendous game. I'm proud of him."

"Ethan controlled the game with his toughness and ball handling. He played great. This is what we need him to do. If he plays like that, it's tough to take him off the court. "

"Isaiah White was the key to the game in the first half. He came with so much energy. He and Ethan turned the game around when we were down."
