WEEKLY TRACK AND FIELD RELEASE - June 5, 2024

THIS WEEK - The USC track and field team will be competing at the 2024 NCAA Outdoor Track & Field Championships hosted by Oregon at Hayward Field in Eugene, Ore. from June 5-8. The top 24 athletes in the country, 12 in each event from both the East & West Preliminary Rounds, have advanced to the championships. USC has 10 women who have qualified in individual events, plus the 4x400m relay for a total of 11 opportunities to score, tied for ninth-most by a school. The men's team has 11 athletes qualified in individual events, plus the two relays for a total of 13 opportunities to score at the Championships, tied for third-best among the teams competing.

USC AT THE NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS -- The USC men's track and field team has won 26 NCAA outdoor titles, more than double the next-best program Arkansas, which has won 12. USC won a record 9-straight titles from 1935-43. The USC women's team won the 2021 team title and has won it three times overall (also 2018 & 2001). USC's men have placed in the top 10 in 18 of the last 28 seasons. USC's women have finished in the top 10 in 17 of the last 28 seasons. USC's women have finished in the top three in four of the last six NCAA Outdoor Championships. At least one Trojan man or woman has won an individual NCAA outdoor title in 23 of the last 31 championships.

WHERE TO WATCH THE MEET - The 2024 NCAA Track & Field Championships will be televised on ESPN, ESPN2 and streamed on ESPN+. On June 5, the first day of the men's championship, ESPN2 will begin coverage at 4:30 p.m. On June 6, the first day of the women's competition, ESPN2 will begin coverage at 5:30 p.m. On June 7, the men's finals, coverage on ESPN2 will begin at 6 p.m. PT. On June 8, the women's finals, coverage on ESPN begins at 2:30 p.m. All times are Pacific.

THE GREEK HAMMER - Junior hammer thrower Nikolaos Polychroniou from Athens, Greece, had a PR of 246-10 (75.24m) to win the USC-UCLA Dual Meet hammer throw competition on April 27. His throw moved him from sixth to third on USC's all-time list and he ended the regular season ranked fourth in the country. Polychroniou placed second in the hammer throw at the 2024 Pac-12 Championships, his second consecutive runner-up finish. He went on to place second at the West Preliminary Rounds. Last year he finished fifth at the NCAA Championships to earn All-America honors.

JONES CLEARING ALL HURDLES - 2022 Pac-12 100m hurdles champion and 2022 NCAA 100m hurdles runner-up Jasmine Jones is back in action after battling injuries since then. First she won the 2024 NCAA indoor 60m hurdles title with a school-record time of 7.77. Then, she won the Pac-12 100m and 400m hurdles titles, the latter with a meet-record time of 53.87. Jones had the top NCAA 400m hurdles time and the 10th-fastest 100m hurdles time before the NCAA Preliminary Rounds, the only NCAA woman to rank in the top 10 in both events this season.

OJORA SOARING TO NEW HEIGHTS - USC senior jumper Temi Ojora placed second at the NCAA West Prelims with a school record jump of 45-7.25/13.90 (+2.0), breaking Wendy Browns mark which had stood since 1988. She entered the meet ranked third in the country. She won all five of her triple jump competitions this season before the West Prelims, including winning the Pac-12 title with a jump of 44-5.25/13.54m (-1.2) on May 12. Ojora also has cleared a career-best 5-10.75 (1.80m) in the high jump and has a long jump best this season of 20-7.75/6.29m (+1.4). She won all three events at the annual USC-UCLA Dual Meet on April 28 to lead USC to victory, its 10th consecutive over the Bruins.

WILLIAMS AND KISS GET CALL FROM THE HALL -- Angela Williams, the only 4-time NCAA 100m champion, and Balazs Kiss, 4-time NCAA hammer throw champion and NCAA record-holder in the event were inducted into the T&F Hall of Fame on Sunday, June 2. The induction ceremony, produced by the USTFCCA and hosted by former ESPN personality Neil Everett, was held at the Hull Center for Performing Arts in Eugene, Ore.

USC TRACK AND FIELD HISTORY - USC track and field is well known as one of the most successful athletic programs in the history of the NCAA, with 31 men's and women's national team titles. The Trojans have won far more NCAA team and individual titles combined than any other university. However, the most dominant force in USC's slate of athletic programs is not the baseball team (12 College World Series titles) or the football squad (nine national championships) but the men's track and field program, with an unprecedented 28 NCAA titles (including nine straight, 1935-43). In fact, in the history of the NCAA, only the Oklahoma State wrestling program (34) has more national titles than USC men's outdoor track and field. Trojan athletes have dominated the track and field scene for decades. From the exploits of sprinter Charlie Paddock and thrower Clarence "Bud" Houser in the 1920s and 1930s, sprinter Mel Patton in the 1940s, thrower Parry O'Brien in the 1950s, sprinter Lennox Miller and pole vaulter Bob Seagren in the 1960s, sprinter Quincy Watts in the 1980s, to four-time NCAA hammer champion Balazs Kiss (only the fifth collegian to win four in a row) in the 1990s, World Champion hurdler Felix Sanchez early in the 2000s, and NCAA champion and Olympic medalist Andre DeGrasse, and NCAA champions and collegiate record-holders Rai Benjamin and Michael Norman, USC is synonymous with track and field excellence.

TROJAN PROGRAM REMAINS IN GOOD HANDS WITH QUINCY WATTS - Former Trojan Olympic great Quincy Watts was promoted to USC Director of Track and Field and Cross Country on June 17, 2021 after eight seasons on Caryl Smith Gilbert's staff as an assistant in charge of sprints, long hurdles and relays. In his 10 seasons working with USC athletes, he has guided Trojans to 104 indoor and outdoor All-America honors in the 400 meters, 400-meter hurdles and 4x400-meter relay. His Trojan athletes also claimed 20 NCAA titles and 33 Pac-12 crowns, and they set three collegiate records and 28 school records plus all four USC freshman 400-meter records and the women's 400-meter hurdles freshman record. During the 2023 season at the helm of the Trojan program, Watts led the men's and women's team to second-place finishes at the Pac-12 Championships, with the Trojans winning nine event titles. His 400m crew was especially dominant with freshman William Jones edging teammate and two-time defending champion Johnnie Blockburger in the final with a time of 44.65, just 0.05 off the school freshman record. On the women's side, Jan'Taijah Jones won the title with the second-fastest 400m time by a USC woman of 50.44, to lead a 1-2-3-5 finish for the Trojans in the event. The women's 4x400m relay earned outdoor All-America honors and the women's and men's 4x400m relays earned indoor All-America honors. Jan'Taijah Jones also placed fifth in the 400m at the NCAA Indoor Championships. USC athletes combined to post 60 indoor and outdoor Trojan all-time top 10 results during the season. During the season Allie Jones set the USC heptathlon record, Tade Ojora the men's 60m hurdles record, Samirah Moody the women's 60m record and Summer Mosley the women's weight throw record. Watts also continues coaching USA Olympic medalists Michael Norman, Rai Benjamin and Kendall Ellis. Norman won gold medals in the 400m and with the USA 4x400m relay team and Benjamin a silver medal in the 400m hurdles at the 2022 World Athletics Championships.

TROJANS' OLYMPIC GLORY - USC athletes of the present and past won 21 medals at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics, 11 golds, 5 silvers and 5 bronze, and have won over 20 medals at three consecutive Olympics. The success in Tokyo kept USC as the leader among U.S. universities for most all-time medals and gold medals. USC has had 510 Olympians who have earned 326 medals, 153 gold, 96 silver and 77 bronze. Forefront in the USC success is the 151 track and field athletes who have earned 49 gold medals. Former Trojan students won a record 13 medals at the 2020 Olympics, six gold, two silver and five bronze. USC's previous record for most track and field medals won in a single Olympics was nine at the 2016 Rio Games. This was the fifth consecutive Summer Olympics in which a USC track and field athlete earned at least one gold medal and a Trojan track and field athlete has won at least one medal in every Olympics since 1912.

ALL-STAR COACHING STAFF - Olympic gold medalist Quincy Watts has put together an impressive coaching staff that looks like an all-star roster. Jebreh Harris (distances and cross country), Olympic gold medalist Joanna Hayes (hurdles), two-time Olympian Martin Maric (throws) and newcomers added this season John Bolton (sprints), Karl Goodman (sprints) and Jeff Petersmeyer (jumps).

2024 INDOOR SEASON RECAP -- The USC men tied for seventh and the Trojan women tied for eighth at the 2024 NCAA Indoor Track & Field Championships held in Boston, Mass. Jasmine Jones won the women's 60m hurdles title, Johnny Brackins Jr. placed second in the men's 60m hurdles and the women's 4x400m relay took second at the 2024 NCAA Indoor Track & Field Championships being held at the TRACK at new balance in Boston, Mass. The USC women's team scored 27 points to tie for eighth and the men's team scored 23 points to tie for seventh. Twelve different Trojans earned first-Team All-America honors.

During the 2024 indoor season, USC's men posted 17 all-time Trojan top 10 performances, including Johnny Brackins Jr. setting the USC indoor long jump record of 27-0 (8.23m), a record which had stood for 34 years. USC men athletes also posted six other times for marks which rank second on USC's all-time indoor lists. The Trojan women posted 15 all-time top 10 indoor times or marks, led by school records set by Marne Sullivan in the 800m (2:04.17), Jasmine Jones in the 60m hurdles (7.77) and Allie Jones in the pentathlon (4,528). Also, Temi Ojora posted the second-farthest indoor triple jump in school history of 45-2.25 (13.77m).

TROJANS LEAVING THEIR MARKS - The Trojans have 30 athletes on the current team that have posted 69 outdoor top 10 marks all-time by a Trojan, including 23 marks that rank in USC's all-time top 5. The following is a list of those athletes and their ranking at USC:

RETURNING ALL-AMERICANS -- USC has four current athletes which were 2023 T&F All-American: Yemi John (4th - 4x400m), Christine M. Mallard (4th - 4x400m), Temi Ojora (6th - TJ) and Nikolaos Polychroniou (5th - HT).

FOUR TROJANS EARN PAC-12 YEARLY HONORS -- USC's Johnnie Blockburger and Jasmine Jones were named 2024 Pac-12 Track Athletes of the Year and Racquil Broderick and Madison Whyte were named 2024 Pac-12 Track and Field Freshmen of the Year it was announced by the Conference on May 17.

SULLIVAN IS BEING HEARD -- Graduate transfer Marne Sullivan has had an impressive first season at USC. She set the USC indoor 800m record with a time of 2:04.19 and has run the eighth-fastest USC women's outdoor 800m race of 2:04.59. She was born deaf and received a cochlear implant at the age of 3 and 1/2. She has said she always felt to be a step behind her peer due to the time she had to spend in speech therapy, attending multiple audiologist appointments and working with learning specialists. She learned to cope and fit in well with her familiar environment, but really felt out of place when she went off to Boston College and had to interact with new people and an unfamiliar environment. She realized there was a lack of understanding and decided to use her situation to be a leader for deaf awareness and began using her platform as an athlete to share her story and educate others. Through social media she has helped become an inspiration to others with hearing and other disabilities. She founded and was the head of the non-visible/visible disability sub-committee through Eagles for Equality, a DEI student-athlete organization on the BC campus. She has continued her efforts at USC by partnering with brands for Deaf Awareness month and more. In March, Sullivan was named the CalHope Courage Award winner which recognizes two student-athletes at California colleges and universities monthly for overcoming the stress, anxiety, and mental trauma associated with personal hardships and adversity.

BRODERICK MAKING AN IMMEDIATE IMPACT -- Freshman Racquil Broderick set the USC freshman discus throw record in his very first meet with a throw of 204-6 (62.34m) to win the Beach Opener on March 2. His throw also moved him to second on USC's all-time list, a foot and a half behind the school record of 206-0 (62.78m) set by Gary Carlsen in 1967. Broderick has won five of the six discus throw competitions he entered this season, before placing fourth at the NCAA West Preliminary Rounds with a mark of 197-0 (60.05m).

STEVENSON POSTS USC TOP 6 INDOOR AND OUTDOOR LONG JUMP MARKS -- Sophomore JC Stevenson has posted the fifth-farthest long jump ever indoors and outdoors by a Trojan this season. His outdoor jump was later bumped to sixth on the USC all-time list by teammate Johnny Brackins Jr. His indoor jump was 26-1.00 (7.95m) to win at the Spokane Sports Showcase on Jan. 12 and his best outdoor jump went for 26-5.00 (8.05m) to win at the Mt. SAC Relays on April 20. He placed second in the long jump at the 2024 Pac-12 Championships with a jump of 25-1.75/7.66m (+0.1).

BRACKINS JR IS A TRIPLE THREAT -- Junior Johnny Brackins Jr. has been making a name for himself this season as a jumper, hurdler and sprinter. During the indoor season, Brackins Jr. set the USC indoor record in the long jump with a leap of 27-0.00 (8.23m), breaking Detmer Haaf's school record of 26-11.25 (8.21m) which had stood since 1990. Brackins Jr. also had a time of 7.55 in the 60m hurdles to move into second on USC's all-time list and placed second in the event at the NCAA Indoor Championships with a time of 7.57. During the outdoor season he has run 13.44 in the 110m hurdles which is tied for eighth on USC's all-time list. He also ran the 400m hurdles for the first time at the USC-UCLA Dual Meet on April 28 and in his second race ran 50.84 at the Oxy Invitational on May 4, which ranked 47th nationally. Brackins Jr. set his outdoor long jump PR of 26-9.00/8.15 (+0.5) at the West Prelims, the top mark there and fourth on USC's all-time list.

USC MEN & WOMEN PLACE 2ND AT THE PAC-12 CHAMPIONSHIPS -- The USC men's and women's teams both placed second at the 2024 Pac-12 Track & Field Championships hosted by Colorado on May 10-12. Jasmine Jones won the 100m and 400m hurdles titles, including setting the meet record in the 400m hurdles. Johnnie Blockburger won the men's 200m and 400m and ran on the winning USC 4x100m relay, making it 9 career Pac-12 titles for Blockburger. Blockburger was named the 2024 Pac-12 Men's Athlete of the Meet. The USC men's team (141 points) and women's team (136 points) combined for 277 points, 44 points more than the next closest program (Oregon).

400 METERS TO PAC-12 GLORY -- USC's Johnnie Blockburger won the 2024 Pac-12 men's 400m title and Jan'Taijah Jones won the 2024 Pac-12 women's 400m title. Blockburger won the title for the third time in four seasons, only placing second to teammate William Jones last season. Jones is the third conference woman to win three consecutive Pac-12 400m titles (Keshia Baker and Phyllis Francis).

YOU MIGHT NEED A PROGRAM -- USC added 30 new athletes to its track and field program since the end of the 2023 season. In fact, 39.0 percent of the roster is new from last season with 19 of the 43 women and 11 of the 34 men on the rosters competing in their first seasons as a Trojan.

FRESHMEN MAKING THEIR MARKS -- USC freshmen athletes have set five school freshmen records this year. **Racquil Broderick** (Discus Throw - 204-6), **Nathan Cumberbatch** (Indoor 800m - 1:47.78), **Marjourie Lopez** (10000 - 36:32.25, Indoor 3000m - 10:11.90), **Madison Whyte** (Indoor 200m - 22.90).
