SCOUTING THE BADGERS

- No. 24 Wisconsin is 14-3 overall and 4-2 in Big Ten conference play this season. However, Wisconsin is 1-2 when playing away from home in 2024-25. The Badgers are on a six-game winning streak as they most recently took down Rutgers, Minnesota and Ohio State.
- Wisconsin leads the entire nation from the free throw line as the team is shooting at 85.4 percent. The Badgers have made 316 of their 370 free throw attempts. Wisconsin ranks 14th in the country for free throws made per game (18.6).
- Wisconsin's starting lineup is the best in the Big Ten. According to EvanMiya.com, the starting have an offensive efficiency of 156.4 (when looking at a minimum of 25 possessions).
- Graduate guard John Tonje has proven to be a solid scorer for the Badgers. The Nebraska native is leading Wisconsin in points per game with 18.2 per game, which ranks sixth among all Big Ten players. Tonje has also been a threat at drawing fouls. He ranks 15th in the nation in free throws attempted (125), fourth in free throws made (117), and eighth in free throw percentage (93.6 percent).
- Sophomore guard John Blackwell is second behind Tonje in points as he is averaging 15.4 per game. Blackwell leads the Badgers in minutes as he contributes an average of 30.4 per game.
- Wisconsin has some of the best shooters in the Big Ten. Senior guard Kamari McGee is one of the best three-point shooters in the Big Ten as he is shooting at a 55.6 percent clip from beyond the arc, which is the top number in the conference according to KenPom. Sophomore forward Nolan Winter steps up for the Badgers with two-pointers as he leads the Big Ten in two-point field goal percentage as he shoots at a 73.6 percent clip from close range.

TROJANS IN THE RANKINGS

Chibuzo Agbo is a threat from beyond the arc. He is fourth in the Big Ten Conference when it comes to total made three-pointers as he has accumulated 40 so far this season.

Desmond Claude knows how to get to the charity stripe. He is third in the Big Ten when it comes to free throw rate (64.4), which calculates his ability to make it to the free throw line.

When it comes to free throws, Josh
Cohen is one of the top players in the
country. He is currently ninth of active
Division I NCAA players for made free
throws, securing 449 in his career.

Desmond Claude has been instrumental to the Trojans' offense. He is 12th in the Big Ten when it comes to assist rate. He is assisting on 25.1 percent of the shots his team makes.

Saint Thomas is one of two players to start every game for USC and has been an impact player. He currently plays in 82.3 percent of minutes according to KenPom, the fifth-most in the Big Ten.

THE LAST FIVE GAMES

Desmond Claude, Chibuzo Agbo, Wesley Yates III and Saint Thomas have had tremendous performances for the Trojans over the last five games. Claude has been leading the way with 20.6 points and 5 assists per game to go along with a 48.6 field goal percentage. He has also been crucial in other areas as he boasts a 58.5 true shooting percentage and a 25.6 assist percentage. For Agbo, he is averaging 13.0 points and 5.2 rebounds. Yates III has also been excelling as he averages 16.8 points and 3.0 rebounds per game. Rounding out the list is Thomas, who is leading the team in rebounds with 7.2 per game while averaging 12.2 points per game. His field goal percentage is also up eight percent over the last five games as he is shooting at a 53.3 percent clip.

As a team, the Trojans have maintained an effective field goal percentage of 55.4 percent, a field goal percentage of 49.8 percent, and a three-point field goal percentage of 36.7 percent. Along with that, the Trojans have an assist percentage of 60.5 percent, which is in the 92nd percentile according to CBB Analytics.

TOPPING THE BIG TEN

When it comes to Big Ten Conference play, one player has been making his mark, and that is Desmond Claude. He currently leads all players in the conference in points as he is averaging 22.0 per game through six conference games.

SHARING IS CARING

When it comes to distributing the ball, the Trojans dish out assists. Of the shots the Trojans make, 59.7 percent of those shots are assisted.

Individually, Saint Thomas and Desmond Claude have been a big part of the equation. Both Claude and Thomas rank in the Top 10 in the Big Ten in assists, notching 71 and 70, respectively. Claude is also 12th in the Big Ten when it comes to assist rate, which is calculated by the number of assists a player has divided by the team's made field goals. Claude currently boasts a 25.1 assist rate. Thomas comes up close behind him with a 22.4 assist rate, the 18th-best in the Big Ten.

THE BEST OF BUZO

Chibuzo Agbo is second on the team in points as he currently has 217 this season. Agbo is also crucial to the team from beyond the arc. When he makes at least one three-pointer in a game, the team has an 11-4 record. When Agbo doesn't make a three, the team is 0-2. The Trojans are also 8-2 when Agbo scores more than 10 points. As if this wasn't enough, Agbo is also an asset from the charity stripe. He is currently 10th in the Big Ten for his free throw percentage this season, which sits at 86 percent.

Agbo also knows how to take care of the ball. Of all his possessions, he only turns over the ball 8.4 percent of the time. This ranks in the 90th percentile out of all Division I men's basketball players.

DES DOMINATES

Desmond Claude has been instrumental for the Trojans over the last five games, as shown above. His 20.6 points per game average is in the 99th percentile in the NCAA according to CBB Analytics. He had back-to-back games with 25 or more points as he secured 25 against lowa and 31 against No. 13 Illinois. With his assists added in, Claude contributed to 39 of the team's 82 points against the Illini and 48 of the team's 99 against the Hawkeyes.

When it comes to making it to the free throw line, Desmond Claude has made it to the line the most on USC's team. He draws an average of 6.3 fouls per game, the fifth-most in the Big Ten. He had his best game for free throws against No. 13 Illinois as he went seven-for-seven from the charity stripe. He followed that up by making 10 of his 12 attempts against lowa. He also has more than double the number of free throws as the next Trojan as he sits at 115 attempts this year. These numbers also show how efficient he is when it makes it to the free throw line. His free throw rate sits at 64.4, which is the third-best in the Big Ten according to KenPom.

YATES THE GREAT

Since Wesley Yates III has stepped into a starting role, he has stepped up big for the Trojans which has landed him Big Ten Conference Freshman of the Week honors. Since becoming a starter, Yates has averaged 14.6 points, 3.4 rebounds and 1.9 assists per game. Along with that, he is shooting at a 52.4 percent clip from the field.

THE REAL AGEE

Rashaun Agee has come into his own in these last two games. During both of these games, he led the Trojans in rebounding as he grabbed eight boards against the No. 1 rebounding team in the country in Illinois. He was also the first Trojan to grab double-digit rebounds in a game this season as he snagged 10 against lowa. He has also got the job done on offense these last two games as he shot at 52.9 percent from the field while averaging 11 points a game.

BIG TEN CAREER RANKINGS

In just the first season in the Big Ten for USC, two players rank in the Top Five in active career points, and they are Josh Cohen and Bryce Pope. Cohen leads all players in the Big Ten in career points with 1,767 while Pope ranks fifth in the conference in this stat category with 1,637. Cohen is also second in the conference in career field goals made (653) and sixth in career rebounds (789).

BIG TEN IN THE TOP 25 POLL

The Big Ten is one of the most represented conferences in the AP Top 25 College Basketball poll. At the start of this week, there are six Big Ten teams in the Top 25 and one team who is receiving votes. The top-ranked team is Michigan State, coming in at No. 12. The five other teams in the Top 25 are Oregon (13th), Purdue (17th), Illinois (19th), Michigan (20th) and Wisconsin (24th), who the Trojans will play tonight. The one team that is receiving votes is Maryland.

FAMILY TIES

The Trojan family is more than a figure of speech on the USC men's basketball squad as head coach Eric Musselman is the father of USC assistant coach Michael Musselman and graduate assistant Matthew Musselman. USC assistant coach Quincy Pondexter and Trojan Wesley Yates III are cousins and joined USC after time spent at Washington.

BROTHERLY LOVE

USC is home to Trojans Kevin Patton Jr. and Kallai Patton, brothers from Murrieta, California. Both attended Rancho Christian High School. Kevin graduated in 2023, while Kallai was a 2024 graduate. In 2023, the two teamed up to capture the DII CIF Southern Section title for Rancho Christian.

OUT IN THE COMMUNITY

The USC Men's Basketball tries to be a conscientious member of the community and has routinely had youth groups or schools visit practice or venture out into the community for an event over the last several years. The Trojans recently handed out backpacks in partnership with World Vision at the Barack Obama Charter School to kick off the new year back in August.

Not only that, but the team has done what they can to give back to the Los Angeles community following the Palisades and Eaton Fires. On Thursday and Friday of this week, members of the team and coaching staff volunteered in Pasadena and at the BMO Stadium to pass out supplies to those impacted by these fires.

IN THE NBA

USC had 11 former players who began the 2024-25 season on NBA rosters, which ranked in the top 5 among all schools. Opening night of the 2024-25 season saw Trojan Drew Peterson receive his 2024 NBA Championship ring with the Boston Celtics and Onyeka Okongwu recorded a career-high 28 points. Recent Trojan Bronny James also made history with his father and 22-year NBA veteran Lebron James on opening night, as the pair became the first father-son duo to play together in an NBA game.

1.000-POINT CLUB

When it comes to scoring, the Trojans have five players who already have 1,000 career points and two others who are within 100 of hitting that career marker. Currently, Josh Cohen has the most career points on the team with 1,765 while Bryce Pope is close behind with 1,637. Clark Slajchert also has 1,000 career points, sitting at 1,042. Chibuzo Agbo also hit this milestone earlier this season on his birthday against Saint Mary's as he now has 1,140 points on the season. Desmond Claude is the most recent Trojan to hit this milestone as he grabbed his 1,000th point against lowa. There are two Trojans who are closing in on this milestone, and they are Matt Knowling and Saint Thomas. Both are within 100 points of this achievement.

STARTING FIVE

Head Coach Eric Musselman is starting to keep a consistent starting lineup, sticking with Saint Thomas, Desmond Claude, Wesley Yates III, Chibuzo Agbo and Josh Cohen. Saint Thomas and Josh Cohen are the only two Trojans to start in every game for USC. With this starting lineup, the Trojans are 7-2 which includes a Quad 1 win over No. 13 Illinois. They also have an offensive rating of 131.3, which is the number of points the Trojans score on 100 possessions.

RACKING UP THE POINTS

Since the 2019 season, USC owns a 92-20 record when it scores 70 or more points.

IN THE PAINT

The Trojans shot 51.4 percent of their shots from the paint. Of those shots, they find the most success within 4.5 feet of the rim as they make 67.5 percent of the shots they put up in that range. Overall, the Trojans are shooting at 58.4 percent from the paint.

NEW HEIGHTS

USC has eight players listed on the roster who are 6-7 or taller. When looking at KenPom, the Trojans' average height based on the height of every player on the roster and the minutes they are playing is 78.6 inches, the 23rd tallest average in the country.

BOARDS GALORE

One name continues to show up consistently as the leading rebounder for the Trojans, and that name is Saint Thomas. He has now had the most rebounds or was tied for the most rebounds on the team in 10 of the team's 17 games. He leads the team in this stat category with 105. Following the team's game against lowa, Thomas got himself to 489 career rebounds, which is just 11 boards away from hitting the 500-rebound club.

Along with that, Josh Cohen has been a great rebounder throughout his career. He secured his 500th-career defensive rebound against Michigan. With those rebounds, he now sits at 789 career rebounds. His total career points and rebounds together puts him in the 1,500-point and 600-rebound club. There are just 31 active Division I players who have hit both of these markers.

TRANSFER TROJANS

The Trojans are the most experienced Power 5 team in college basketball based on minutes played per game last season (327.6). The Trojan transfer class combined to average almost 150 points per game last season - the most incoming points of any transfer class in the nation. These transfers came from Michigan, Xavier, Yale, Northern Colorado, UC San Diego, Texas Tech, Washington, Bowling Green and Penn.

WORKING ON AND OFF THE COURT

During this fall semester, the Trojans put in work in the classroom. The team finished with a 3.129 GPA, the third-highest cumulative GPA in program history.

Along with the work the team is doing in the classroom, the Trojans have seven of their players working towards postgraduate degrees. Chibuzo Agbo and Rashaun Agee are working towards degrees in Digital Media Management, Matt Knowling and Terrance Williams II are working towards degrees in Public Relations Innovation, Strategy and Management, Bryce Pope is working towards a degree in Entrepreneurship and Innovation, Clark Slajchert is working towards a degree in Social Entrepreneurship, and Josh Cohen is working towards a graduate certificate in Gerontology.

CONTROLLING THE BALL

One Trojan ranks 11th in the Big Ten when it comes to turnover percentage, and that is Chibuzo Agbo. His turnover percentage sits at 9.9 percent, which means he only turns the ball over 9.9 percent of the time.

EXPERIENCE IS KEY

When looking at the years of the members of the team along with their production when they are on the court, KenPom calculates that the average experience of USC's team is at 2.63, which ranks in the Top 40 in the NCAA.

THE GALEN ADVANTAGE

USC is 220-87 at the Galen Center since it opened on Nov. 16, 2006. USC is also 111-26 in non-conference games at the Galen Center.

AN ELITE THREE

The trio of Chibuzo Agbo, Desmond Claude and Wesley Yates III has been great for the Trojans. They maintain an offensive rating of 124.4 and a field goal percentage of 50.9 percent, which is 92nd percentile compared to other trios in the NCAA. These three are also good at dishing out the ball as they have a combined assist percentage of 59.7 percent.
