BARE E-SAND-SHELLS • TL;DR

- USC has won the last **four** NCAA championships and owns **seven** national titles including the first NCAA crown awarded in 2016 (AVCA '15, NCAA '16, '17, '21, '22, '23, '24).
- The Trojans own **five** Pac-12 titles (2016, '17, '19, '22, '24).
- USC is **146-22** (.869) under sixth-year head coach **Dain Blanton**.
- The Women of Troy are ranked **No. 3** in the AVCA poll. It is the 114th time (of 114) USC is ranked; its **113th** time among the top 5. The Trojans have also held the No. 1 spot a record **50** times and are 159-20 in duals when they are the top-ranked team.
- USC holds a **91-11** record at Merle Norman Stadium and has won its last 26 duals on home sand. The Trojans' last home loss was to LSU on April 4, 2021.
- The Trojans are 12-1 in home openers with the only loss to UCLA on Feb. 28, 2018.
- USC has celebrated 15 AVCA All-Americans and 32 individual certificates.



LOS ANGELES – No. 3-ranked USC (4-2) co-hosts the Battle for Los Angeles this week and will play its only two days on home sand when Concordia (3-1), Pepperdine (1-3), No. 16 Washington (2-2), and No. 8 Long Beach State (2-0) visit Merle Norman Stadium. The Women of Troy are 91-11 all-time on home sand and have won 26 consecutive duals dating back to the 2021 season. The three-site tournament is also joint-hosted by UCLA and Loyola Marymount.

The Trojans take on the Golden Eagles (10 a.m. PT) and longtime archrival Waves (12 p.m.) on Friday (Feb. 28). Prior to the start of the first match, USC will unveil its 2024 NCAA championship banner. CUI and Pepperdine will also meet in a neutral dual at 2 p.m. On Saturday, March 1, the Trojans take on the Huskies (10 a.m.) and the Beach (12 p.m.) on Senior Day. Washington and LBSU will meet in a neutral-site dual at 2 p.m. USC will honor graduates **Maya Gessner** and **Ella Larkin** and graduating juniors **Bailey Showalter** and **Gabby Walker** in pre-match ceremonies.

USC HEAD COACH DAIN BLANTON



DAIN BLANTON—an Olympic gold-medalist and the 2024 AVCA National Coach of the Year—is in his sixth season as USC’s head coach (2025) with a **146-22 (.869)** career record. Under Blanton, the Trojans have won four consecutive NCAA championships in 2021, '22, '23, and '24 and raised the program’s total to seven national titles. USC has also won two Pac-12 championships under his guidance (2022, '24) and were runners-up for the 2021 crown.

Previously, he was the volunteer assistant coach at USC (2015-18) when the Trojans won the 2015 AVCA championship and NCAA championships in 2016 and 2017. USC also won back-to-back (2016-17) Pac-12 titles with Blanton on staff. He has coached **13** AVCA All-Americans including **Kelly Claes** and **Sara Hughes** to the 2015 AVCA Pairs Championship and the 2017 USAV Collegiate Pairs crown. The duo also won back-to-back Pac-12 titles in 2016 and 2017.

In 2019, Blanton was a color analyst and sideline reporter for ESPN and the Olympic Channel. He has had a distinguished career as a sports broadcaster, covering NBA basketball, Major League Baseball, college basketball, football, and beach volleyball for networks including ESPN, NBC, ABC, FOX Sports Net, Universal Sports Network, Pac-12 Networks, Olympic Channel, and Amazon Prime. He covered beach volleyball for NBC at the 2016 Olympics.

Blanton was the first two-time U.S. male beach volleyball Olympian. He and **Eric Fonoimoana** won gold at the 2000 Sydney Games as the ninth seed. He then partnered with **Jeff Nygaard** at the 2004 Olympic Games in Athens.

Blanton has won an NCAA title, Olympic gold, and multiple pro crowns. At Pepperdine (1991-94), he won the 1992 NCAA title as a sophomore and received All-America honorable mention in 1994. Blanton won 11 beach tournaments, including nine AVP championships and two FIVB titles. In 2003, he and Nygaard were the AVP Team of the Year and Blanton was the AVP’s Best Offensive Player. He was the first male African American to win a major beach volleyball event when he won the 1997 AVP Hermosa Grand Slam. He and **Kent Steffes** won bronze medals at the 1997 Beach Volleyball World Championships.

Blanton was the 1990 Orange County Boys’ Volleyball Player of the Year at Laguna Beach (Calif.) High, where he was also an All-State basketball player. In 1997, Blanton started a charity called Dain’s Day at the Beach; and he has spent time mentoring students as a motivational speaker through his non-profit organization Getting to Gold. Blanton graduated with a bachelor’s degree in public relations from Pepperdine in 1994 and holds a teaching credential in physical education.

Blanton was inducted into the USA Volleyball Hall of Fame as an All-Time Great Beach Athlete in 2024 and is also a member of the CBVA Hall of Fame as a part of the Class of 2016 and was inducted into the Southern California Indoor Volleyball Hall of Fame in 2020. Blanton is also a member of the Pepperdine Athletics Hall of Fame’s class of 2008.

LAST TIME OUT: In Honolulu for the Outrigger Duke Kahanamoku Beach Classic, USC opened the season with a 3-2 win over 12th-ranked Hawai'i to improve to 14-0 all-time in season openers. As the top-ranked team in the tournament, the Trojans were upset by seventh-ranked Loyola Marymount—the Lions' first-ever win over USC—and then fell to fifth-ranked Stanford by a 3-2 count. USC turned its fortunes around when it picked up a 5-0 sweep of No. 11 Arizona State and then closed out the weekend with a pair of 3-2 wins over No. 3 UCLA and No. 2 TCU. **Madison White** was chosen for the tournament's Best Blocker award. The Trojans emerged from the islands with a 4-2 mark to open the year and moved to 31-6 all-time in the state of Hawai'i and settled at 159-20 when ranked No. 1 in the AVCA poll.

OPENING UP: USC improved to **14-0** in season openers with a win over No. 12 Hawai'i at Queen's Beach in the Outrigger Duke Kahanamoku Beach Classic.

NEW DIGGS: USC will play its first season as a member of the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation in 2025. The Trojans were members of the Pac-12 from 2016 through 2024 and won five conference titles (2016-17, '19, '22, 24) including the final crown awarded in 2024. With the dissolution of the league, USC moved to the MPSF and is joined by UCLA, California, Stanford, Oregon, Washington, and Grand Canyon. The first MPSF beach volleyball tournament will be played April 23-25 on Spiker Beach in Huntington Beach, Calif. The champion of the seven-team league will receive the conference's automatic berth into the NCAA championship.

OLD DAWG: When the Trojans host 16th-ranked Washington on March 1, sophomore **Zoey Henson** will face her former team. The Southern California native (Cypress) transferred to USC following a freshman campaign with the Huskies in which she produced a 26-9 record and was chosen for Pac-12 All-Conference second-team laurels. She was also a member of the Pac-12 All-Freshman Team after she went 4-1 at the top court and was 22-8 in the No. 2 position with partners Lauren Wilcock and Magdalena Rabitsch.

A BIG DEAL: USC's home duals will be shown live on Big Ten Plus streams this spring. As part of a new agreement between the MPSF and the Big Ten Network, beach volleyball and men's volleyball contests at member schools will be carried on Big Ten Plus and are available inventory for BTN linear broadcasts. Check USC Trojans.com for links to live streams and broadcast information.

TOP CLASS: USC bid farewell to four pillars of the team's success through its four-peat NCAA run. All-Americans **Delaynie Maple** (128 career wins) and **Megan Kraft** (125) depart as the program's fifth and seventh all-time leaders in victories. All-Pac-12 twins **Nicole Nourse** (127) and **Audrey Nourse** (124) concluded their illustrious careers as the sixth and eighth winningest Women of Troy in school history. The foursome won four NCAA titles, two Pac-12 crowns, and were part of the most successful run the team has had. Kraft finished as a four-time All-American and was the first-ever AVCA National Player of the Year in 2024. Maple was a two-time All-American and was a two-time co-captain with Nicole. Audrey and Nicole were each two-time CSC Academic All-Americans. From 2024 alone, the Trojans also graduated **Olivia Bakos**, **Emily Fitzner**, **Maddi Kriz**, **Molly Phillips**, **Ainsley Radell**, and **Grace Seits**, who combine for a total 328 career victories.

ROAD WARRIORS: The Trojans will play 28 of their 32 regular-season duals on the road this season. USC will take a total of six trips (one to Laguna Beach) in the regular season. Last year, including trips to play in the Pac-12 and NCAA tournaments, the Women of Troy took eight trips in total.



POLL POSITION: USC opened the 2025 season ranked **No. 1** in the AVCA Collegiate Beach preseason poll. The Women of Troy have been ranked in **every AVCA poll** for a total of **114 weeks**. USC has also been ranked in the top five of the poll **113** times. The Trojans held that top-five distinction for 63 consecutive weeks from its inception until March 2, 2020. USC first seized the No. 1 ranking in both the AVCA and Volleyball Magazine polls on March 23, 2015, following a victory over then No. 1-ranked Hawai'i on the road and held the ranking for the rest of 2015. USC has been ranked **No. 1 in 50** AVCA polls, the most all-time. The Trojans, Pepperdine, Hawai'i, UCLA, LSU, Florida State, and TCU are the **only seven teams** ever to hold the top spot in the poll. USC is **159-20 all-time** when ranked No. 1.

SANDCASTLE: The Trojans are **91-11 (.892)** at Merle Norman Stadium since it opened in 2013. The Trojans won 19 straight home matches between 2014 and 2016; and went 10-0 in 2015 and 8-0 in 2014 on MNS sand. Only five teams have ever come to Merle Norman Stadium and beaten the Women of Troy: Pepperdine (3), UCLA (3), Florida State (3), Long Beach State (1) and LSU (1). USC set a new school record for consecutive home wins on March 1 and is currently on an active **26-dual** home win streak.

1-2 PUNCH: The Trojans have played in **35** 1v2 matchups and are **20-15 all-time** in such duals. USC caught a 1-2 match on the first weekend of 2025 and claimed a 3-2 win over No. 2-ranked TCU. In 2024, USC was **4-3** in 1v2 matches and was **0-1** in 2023; **1-1** in 2022; and **4-3** in 2021. In 2019, USC was part of 1v2 matches six times and went **3-3**. USC was **2-1** in 2017 and went **4-1** in 2016 but didn't play any such matches in 2015. In three 1-vs-2 duals in 2014, USC went **1-2**. Overall, USC is **12-10** when ranked No. 1 and **8-5** when ranked No. 2.

POW-WOW: USC pairs won the Pac-12 Beach Volleyball Pair of the Week award a league-best **29 times** from 2016-24. **Megan Kraft** and **Delaynie Maple** were the only pair to win the award in 2024 and did so on the final week of the regular season (April 23). They also won the award in 2023 along with **Audrey Nourse** and **Nicole Nourse** who were also chosen once. All-American **Tina Gaudina** owns a record eight weekly awards having won with **Abril Bustamante** three times (2018-19), twice with **Sammy Slater** (2021), and once with Kraft (2021). As pairs go, All-Americans **Kelly Claes** and **Sara Hughes** are owners of a school-record five Pac-12 POW awards. **Jenna Belton** and **Jo Kremer** were the first-ever No. 5 pair to win the honor on March 21, 2017. USC's **Nicolette Martin** and **Allie Wheeler** have the great distinction of being the first-ever Pac-12 Pair of the Week honorees; chosen from the No. 3 position as juniors on March 8, 2016.

LET'S GO STREAKING: In 2016, USC closed the season as winners of 30 consecutive duals and carried won 32 to begin the 2017 campaign to reach **62 wins** before a loss on April 28 at the 2017 Pac-12 Championship. The 62 wins rank **sixth** among longest streaks in the history of USC athletics. All-Americans **Kelly Claes** and **Sara Hughes** won **103** straight matches as a pair between April 2, 2015, and April 8, 2017. During that streak, they lost just seven sets (only one in 2016 and one in 2017). **Tina Gaudina** and **Hailey Harward**'s 29-match win streak is the second longest in program history behind Claes-Hughes' effort. **Delaynie Maple** and **Julia Scoles** won 28 straight matches to start the 2022 season, which ties for the third-longest streak in school history.

GOT FIVE ON IT: The Trojans have defeated opponents by a 5-0 count **155** times. USC is **155-2** all-time in 5-0 results (**47-0** at home; **21-2** on the road; **87-0** at neutral locations). In 2016, the Women of Troy posted 17 clean 5-0 wins and had 22 sweep victories including 3-0 wins. The Trojans did it again in 2022 with another 17 clean sweep 5-0 victories to go with seven 3-0 wins for a total of 24 sweeps. In 2024, the Trojans collected 16 5-0 victories and had six more 3-0 wins.

HIGH STANDARD: No team can claim a winning record against the Women of Troy. Only **13** teams have ever even registered a win over USC and together are responsible for all **60** of USC's all-time losses. UCLA (20) and Pepperdine (13) are the only two teams to have ever beaten the Trojans more than five times. After the Bruins and the Waves, Long Beach State (5), Florida State (5), Hawai'i (3), California (3), LSU (3), South Carolina (2), Stanford (2), Stetson (1), Grand Canyon (1), TCU (1) and Loyola Marymount (1) own the other victories. USC is otherwise undefeated against the other **35** of its all-time opponents.

MERLE NORMAN STADIUM

Merle Norman Stadium is the on-campus home to the USC women's beach volleyball program. Located on the east side of University Park Campus on Figueroa Street across from the Galen Center, it features three courts with sand from the U.S. Olympic Training Center. The palm tree-encircled stadium also has bleachers and a grass berm for spectator seating, a scoreboard and audio system, lighting, restrooms, showers, and multiple team storage areas.

Ground was broken to build the new venue in July of 2012 under the generous donations of Jack and Helen Nethercutt and John and Melinda Muller, and a large sum from an anonymous donor. The Mullers have a daughter (Erica) on the 2013 squad. A USC alumnus, Jack Nethercutt served as vice president of marketing and later President of Merle Norman Cosmetics in 1973. He left the company to pursue other ventures but returned to his presidency in March of 2002 and now serves as Chairman of the Board with his wife Helen as Vice Chairman.

The stadium is named for Nethercutt's great aunt and namesake of the cosmetics corporation, Merle Nethercutt Norman. Jack and Helen are active in Los Angeles non-profits and charities and are Galen Founders, Scholarship Club members, and Conquest supporters of the USC Trojan Marching Band.

On Thursday, March 7, 2013, USC officially opened and dedicated Merle Norman Stadium in conjunction with the beach volleyball program's alumni match. The Nethercutts were on hand to cut the ribbon with first Trojan head coach Anna Collier and athletic director Pat Haden. USC All-America alumnae and Olympic beach volleyball silver medalists Jennifer Kessy and April Ross christened the sand in their return to campus for the special match.

The Women of Troy played their first dual match in the stadium on Sunday, March 10, 2013, and earned a 4-1 victory over Loyola Marymount. The stadium hosted the inaugural Pac-12 Championship in 2016 and hosted the tournament again in 2019. The Trojans won the league crown in both years. USC produced a 7-3 mark in 2013 and was 8-0 in 2014 on its home sand at Merle Norman Stadium. USC also went undefeated at home in 2015 (10-0), 2017 (8-0), 2022 (6-0), 2023 (11-0), and 2024 (8-0). The Trojans are **91-11 (.892)** all-time at Merle Norman Stadium.



DEEP IN THE HEART OF TEXAS: Seven current Trojans hail from the Lone Star State. Juniors **Mabyn Thomas** (Southlake/Carroll HS) and **Gabby Walker** (Flower Mound/Flower Mound HS) enter their third year with the Women of Troy. Florida State transfer **Kaileigh Truslow** (Liberty Hill/Liberty Hill HS) joins two Lone Star State sophomores **Madison Goellner** (Rockwall/Rockwall HS) and **Kaylee Young** (Southlake/Carroll HS). And a pair of freshmen arrive this year from Texas towns. **Mackenzie Miller** is from Leander (Leander HS) and **Calla Tufto** hails from Austin (St. Michael's Catholic Academy). All-time, 17 Women of Troy have come from hometowns in Texas.

TWO RAYS OF SUNSHINE: Hailing from Bradenton, Florida, **Ashley Pater** (Lakewood Ranch HS) was only the second recruit to join the Trojans from the Sunshine State. This year, she is joined by freshman **Kennedy Coakley** from Lutz (Steinbrenner HS) to make it three years in a row with two Floridians on the USC roster. This year, USC adds a Florida State transfer—**Kaileigh Truslow**—who is the second Seminole transfer the Women of Troy have taken. In 2023, USC had graduate transfer **Jenna Johnson** (Stuart, Fla./Jensen Beach HS) who previously played at Florida State. The Trojans' strength and conditioning coach **Madison Peele** was previously an intern and graduate assistant at Florida State where she earned a master's degree in sport science.

CACTUS LEAGUE: Only two native Arizonans have played for the Women of Troy. All-American **Hailey Harward** (Phoenix, Ariz.) played three seasons in the Cardinal & Gold (2020-22) and pushed her career win total over 100 with the Trojans. **Madison White** (Scottsdale, Ariz.) became just the second player from Arizona to don the colors and represents the first high school athlete to sign with the Women of Troy from the Grand Canyon State.

SENIOR DISCOUNT: The Trojans have no seniors on the roster this spring. In fact, USC's two eldest players are graduate transfers **Maya Gessner** (La Jolla, Calif./La Jolla HS) from California and **Ella Larkin** (Maize, Kan./Bishop Carroll Catholic HS) from Kansas State. Gessner played three seasons for the Golden Bears (2021-23) before making her way to Southern California. Larkin played three seasons on the sand at LSU (2022-24) and then spent the fall of 2024 as a libero with Kansas State's indoor volleyball team.

FROSH B'GOSH: The Trojans add five talented freshmen to the squad this spring: **Macy Bolyard** (Summerfield, N.C./Northern Guilford HS), **Kennedy Coakley** (Lutz, Fla./Steinbrenner HS), **Calinda Kok** (Kitchener, Ontario, Canada)/Kitchener Vocational School), **Mackenzie Miller** (Leander, Texas/Leander HS), and **Calla Tufto** (Austin, Texas/St. Michael's Catholic Academy).

DAIN 'SPLAINING: With a **146-22** coaching record, sixth-year head coach **Dain Blanton** is one of the winningest coaches in the collegiate game. He was the 2024 AVCA National Coach of the Year and the 2022 Pac-12 Coach of the Year. He has had a part in all seven of USC's national titles and is a member of four halls of fame including an induction into the USA Volleyball Hall of Fame in 2024.

OLYMPIC RINGS: Four USC beach volleyball alumnae have made Olympic teams for their respective countries. Four-time All-American **Tina Graudina** became the first NCAA collegiate beach volleyball player ever to qualify for the Olympics when she and partner **Anastasija Kravcenoka** (Samoilova by marriage) won the European Championship in the summer of 2019. While the 2020 games were postponed, Graudina-Samoilova represented Latvia and competed in the summer of 2021 in Tokyo coached by USC associate head coach **Gustavo Rocha**. The Latvian duo finished fourth in the final standings and made a second appearance in the 2024 Paris Games. Three-time All-American **Kelly Claes** (Cheng) also qualified for the 2020 Games with partner Sarah Sponcil and advanced to the round of 16 in Tokyo. Cheng and four-time USC All-American **Sara Hughes**—partners while in school—qualified as a pair to represent the United States in Paris and finished in the quarterfinals. Two-time USC All-American **Sophie Bukovec** partnered with Heather Bansley to earn a qualifying bid to the 2024 Games and represented Canada. From the USC indoor program, three-time USC All-American **April Ross** played in her third Olympic Games in 2021 and claimed gold for Team USA with partner **Alix Klineman** to complete her trifecta of Olympic medals.

ALL-AMERICAN GIRLS: USC has celebrated **15** AVCA All-Americans and **32** All-America certificates. **Sara Hughes** became the first-ever four-time All-American in 2017. **Tina Graudina** joined her as only the fourth collegian ever to receive first-team All-America honors four times in her career. **Megan Kraff** earned her fourth All-America nod in 2024; her third first-team award. **Kelly Claes** was USC's second three-time All-American and was joined by **Sammy Slater** in 2022. **Kirby Burnham**, **Sophie Bukovec**, **Abril Bustamante** and **Delaynie Maple** are each two-time selections; and **Stevi Robinson**, **Alexa Strange**, **Allie Wheeler**, **Terese Cannon**, **Julia Scoles**, and **Hailey Harward** each hold one All-America award on their resumes. Several Trojans have also been chosen for DiG Magazine All-America honors in their careers.

TRIFECTA: The Trojans own the last four NCAA championships, but 2023-24 was a special year as Trojans also won three of the most important titles in beach volleyball. Three-time Olympic medalist and three-time USC All-American **April Ross** and partner **Alix Klineman** were the defending Olympic gold-medal winners. All-Americans **Kelly Claes** (Cheng) and **Sara Hughes** won the Beach Volleyball World Championship after claiming that title in Tlaxcala, Mexico, in October 2023. Domestically, All-American **Julia Scoles** won the AVP Manhattan Beach Open with partner **Betsi Flint**.

USC'S NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP HISTORY: USC has played in the national collegiate tournament all but once since the program began in 2012. It made appearances in the AVCA championship in 2013 and 2014 but went 2-2 each year as Pepperdine and Long Beach State claimed national titles. Under head coach **Anna Collier**, the Trojans broke through to win their first national crown in 2015; a title accompanied by an unblemished 28-0 record. In 2016, the NCAA sponsored its first beach volleyball championship as USC went 3-2 to capture the first-ever NCAA title with back-to-back wins over top-seeded Florida State. The Trojans won 32 in a row to open 2017 and finished the year with their second consecutive NCAA title; and third straight national championship. USC was 2-2 in 2018 and finished as the runner-up to UCLA in the 2019 NCAA championship. While there was no 2020 championship due to the COVID-19 world pandemic, the Women of Troy returned to form in 2021 and went 30-4 overall under head coach **Dain Blanton** to secure the program's fourth national crown. In 2022, the Trojans were 37-1 and won 36 in a row to lock up back-to-back national championships. USC entered the 2023 championship as the third seed and shocked the field with wins over No. 2 TCU and No. 1 UCLA in the semifinal and championship duals, respectively, to win an unprecedented third straight NCAA title. In 2024, USC did the unthinkable and won a fourth straight NCAA title to lay claim to seven of the nine available NCAA crowns.

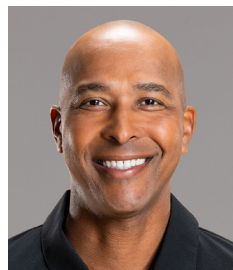
