THE TEAM

» Out-rebounding opponents by 7.1 boards per game (52nd-best in the nation), the Bulls have found success early this season on the glass. USF is 6-1 this season when out-rebounding its opponent, the lone loss coming against St. John's.

» USF is off to a great start early in the RPI department, ranked 36th nationally after ten games, with the 27th-best strength of schedule. The Bulls' losses have come to RPI No. 3 Kentucky (by 4 points), RPI No. 30 St. John's (by 3 points), and RPI No. 42 Maryland. Maryland's RPI will jump substantially come conference season.

» Only eight teams of the 38 receiving votes in the AP Poll have a better strength of schedule ranking than USF. Seven are ranked.

» Scoring 15 points against St. John's, Courtney Williams became the 21st Bull in school history to eclipse 1,000 points, and 10th to do it prior to her senior season. Williams is currently 20th on the list of all-time scorers, on pace to be one of USF's top 10 scorers in history by the end of the season.

» Scoring a career-best 16 points and grabbing a career-high seven rebounds in USF's lone game against College of Charleston last week, Laura Ferreira was named the conference Freshman of the Week Monday. It was her second consecutive mention in the weekly honors, earning an honor roll mention last week.

» USF received its first-ever first-place vote in the conference preseason coaches poll, and were picked to finish second in The American this season, behind National Champion UConn

» Williams was one of just two players to be unanimously selected to the preseason all-conference first team, joining fellow All-American Breanna Stewart.

» USF's first three games, all on the road, were against RPI Top-50 teams from 2013-14's final ranking, and eight of its first nine opponents played in either the NCAA Tournament or WNIT. It was the 11th-toughest first nine games in the nation, according to RealTimeRPI.com

» Already making history with the first WBCA Top 25 ranking in school history this year, the Bulls have received votes in both the AP Poll and the WBCA poll in every week this season until this one. USF's only game last week was a 20-point win over College of Charleston. The Bulls have never been ranked in the AP Poll.

» Of all returning guards among NCAA Division I teams, Courtney Williams ranks third with 10 double-doubles in 2013-14. Only five returning guards in the nation recorded more than six double-doubles all season last year. Williams was named to the Wooden preseason Top 30 Watch List, for the most prestigious individual award in women's college basketball.

» Alisia Jenkins was named to the American's preseason all-conference second team. Jenkins posted 14 double-doubles as a forward last season, and nearly averaged a double-double throughout the season. She has six already this season, tied for the 6th-most in the NCAA.

» The Bulls went 16-0 in 2013-14 when scoring more than 70 points, and went 2-9 when scoring 59 points or less.

THE COACH

» USF's Jose Fernandez is 241-211 in his 15th season with the Bulls, and has led USF to the postseason 10 times in the last 11 years.

» DO YOU RECOGNIZE THIS MAN?

You should, along with the program he's created. USF Head Coach Jose Fernandez, the only hispanic male head coach in Div. I women's basketball, has taken the Bulls to 10 of the last 11 postseasons, won a WNIT Championship, placed USF in the Coaches' Poll Top 25, and came one overtime period away from guiding USF into the NCAA Sweet 16 with a clear path to the 2012-13 Final Four.



ESPN writer Graham Hayes called UConn the only "nationally relevant program" in The American in a season preview, but what he might have meant to say is the Huskies are the only "nationally recognized program" in The American, at least among the media. Ask Division I coaches and others immersed in the women's basketball game however, and not only is Fernandez recognized and relevant, but so are his Bulls.

» MOST IMPROVED

Tamara Taylor was a highly-touted junior college transfer who got adjusted during the 2013-14 season. As a senior in 2014-15, Taylor is back, in shape and better than ever looking very much like the player Fernandez and co. thought she could be. Expect the senior to see more minutes in 2014-15.

» THE OTHER COURTNEY WILLIAMS

Texas A&M junior guard/forward Courtney Williams is grabbing preseason attention as a potential SEC Player of the Year candidate, and is highly touted as one of the most electric players in the game today. Don't forget about the "other" Courtney Williams at USF, flying under the radar at 5-8, with a 52-inch box-jump and explosive first step. The USF Courtney Williams outscored A&M's 586-485, and out-rebounded (269-194), out-blocked (19-11), out-assisted (88-72), out-stole (36-20), out-FG percentaged (.438-.412) and out-double-doubled (10-2) the 6-foot, 1-inch Williams last season.

USF's Courtney Williams posted more double-doubles (10) than any other returning guard in The American, Big Ten, ACC, SEC, Big 12, Pac 12 and BIG EAST, and is in the top five in several other categories, putting her on the short list for All-American Candidates in 2014-15.

An All-America Honorable Mention award winner, she returns for her junior season with the Bulls, fresh off a season where she set a sophomore scoring record within the program, and became just the third person in USF history to surpass 550 points in a season. Williams became the 21st player in school history to eclipse 1,000 points earlier this season, against St. John's on Dec. 7, 2014.

» RIP TO LOW RPI

On the wrong side of the bubble following the NCAA Tournament Selection Show last year, the Bulls had nothing to keep them out but one thing - no wins against RPI Top 50 opponents. Playing just four ranked teams all season (Final Four team Maryland, National Champion UConn, RPI-Top 5 Louisville, Sweet 16 team Oklahoma State), USF had few opportunities to prove its worth. That won't be the case in 2014-15. The Bulls square off with seven different teams in the top 50 of last season's final poll this year, including three in their first three games of the year. One of the toughest non-conference schedules in the nation, USF's wins in 2014-15 will carry plenty of weight when selection time rolls around.

» PLAYING THE "NAME GAME": WHICH TEAMS SHOULD BE RANKED AS A TOP 25 TEAM?

The WBCA Coaches' Poll briefly gave the Bulls recognition as a Top 25 team after USF ended Chattanooga's 40-game home winning streak in November. But receiving votes in the AP Poll without a big-time name beside you seems like a herculean task. Below is a side-by-side comparison of stats, without names attached... Can you pick out the three teams in the AP Top 25? More importantly, can you pick the only team of the six which didn't receive a single vote?
