ITEMS OF NOTE

• The Bulls have met the Green Wave 31 times in program history, their first meeting in 1992. While the Green Wave have a 19-12 series edge, the Bulls are 7-2 in the Fernandez era.

• Freshman **Kitija Laksa** turned in an accomplished week and was honored by the US Basketball Writers Association (WSBWA) as the National Freshman of the Week. Laksa was also named the American Athletic Conference as the Player of the Week. Laksa shocked the league in three outings and totaled 76 points in an efficient manner, shooting 52 percent from the floor, including a 63 percent three-point shooting effort. For the week, Laksa averaged 25.3 points per game, shooting 52 percent from the floor. She enters the week third on the Bulls roster, averaging 12.1 points per game.

• **Courtney Williams** scored 26 points against No. 1 UConn Sunday, and moved to third on the all-time scoring list. The senior is shooting for 2,000 career points, and needs 157 points to reach the milestone, but only needs 99 points to become the second highest point scorer in USF history. Only one other player in program history has surpassed 2,000 career points.

UNCASVILLE, CONN., MARCH 8, 2015 – A record-setting performance from Alisia Jenkins and late-game heroics out of Courtney Williams propelled USF past Tulane Sunday night, and into the American Athletic Conference Championship game Monday.

Jenkins set a new USF single-season rebounding record, pulling down fifteen as the Bulls (26-6 overall) used four double-digit efforts to push past Tulane 78-69 Saturday advancing to a conference championship for the first time in school history.

Seven consecutive points from Courtney Williams nullified a late-game run by the Green Wave (22-10), as USF's junior scorer turned a 61-61 tie into a 68-63 lead in a matter of two minutes late in the game. The Bulls extended the lead further on a big three-point play from Jenkins, and iced the game at the free throw line.

Jenkins started out of the gate hot for the second consecutive day, putting 10 quick points on the board. Tulane tried slowing the Bulls' offense down with a zone, but USF's bench came on strong early, scoring 11 points with the help of three-pointers from Tamara Taylor and Shalethia Stringfield to open up the lane.

Williams scored an efficient eight points in the first half, including a scoop-and-score at the end of the period to send USF into the locker room with a 34-29 lead.

The Bulls extended that lead to as much as 11 early in the half, getting good offensive output from Jenkins, whose 22 points led the way for a second consecutive night, and Williams, who recorded her 19th 20-point game of the season.

Stringfield and Taylor both played well down the stretch, Stringfield finishing the day with 11 points and six assists, while Taylor dropped 10.

Tulane rallied back from an 11-point deficit to tie the game with five minutes to go on the back of Danielle Blagg's hot hand, but Williams' shot-clock beating three with four minutes remaining pushed momentum back in USF's favor for the final time. As of today, Tulane was listed on the right side of Charlie Creme's ESPN Bracketology bubble, and will have a good chance to be The American's third representative in the NCAA tournament.

The Bulls face No. 1 UConn Monday at 7 p.m. on ESPN for the title, matching up with the Huskies for the second time in eight days.

LAST TIME OUT

BULLS MAKE STRIDES AGAINST NO. 1 UCONN IN LOSS

TAMPA, JAN. 10, 2016 – Short-handed USF embraced the moment and continued to make strides against the top team in the nation before a record crowd of 6,634 at the Sun Dome on Sunday afternoon.

No. 22/18 USF jumped out to a 14-6 lead, trailed by just five at the half and sank 12 3-pointers in a 75-59 loss to No. 1 UConn. The Bulls nearly took the lead back in the third quarter and played efficiently with just eight turnovers despite being without all-conference forward Alisia Jenkins, who missed her second straight game with an injury.

USF (10-4, 3-1) lost for the first time in 10 games at the Sun Dome this season and got standout performances from key players.

Courtney Williams made a big push for All-America status with a game-high 26 points and 13 rebounds. The Naismith Trophy candidate tied her career high with four 3-pointers and added two assists and two steals.

Freshman Kitija Laksa scored in double figures for the third straight game and capped off her stellar week with 17 points after knocking down five of seven attempts from long range. Laura Ferreira and Shalethia Stringfield finished with seven points apiece.

The first-ever regular season battle between two ranked teams at the Sun Dome was packed with exciting moments from the beginning of the nationally televised ESPN game. Fans of the Green and Gold rocked the venue from opening tip as USF opened with the hotter hand and a sizeable lead thanks to starting 4-for-5 from beyond the arc.

Laksa drained back-to-back 3-pointers before Williams and Ferreira connected from long range to help the Bulls jump out to a 14-6 advantage just over six minutes into the action.

Despite USF's fast start, UConn ended the first quarter with a 17-15 lead with Breanna Stewart and Morgan Tuck up to six points apiece. The Huskies led by as many as 10 in the second quarter, but USF finished the half on a 5-0 run and trailed, 33-28, at the break.

Williams powered the Bulls' late run and led all scorers with 16 points at the half after starting 6-for-12 from the field with two 3-pointers.

Solid defense also helped keep USF within striking distance as UConn started 37.8 percent from the field (14-for-37) with five turnovers. USF joined No. 23 DePaul and No. 3 Notre Dame as the only three teams that have stayed within five points of UConn at the half.

Fresh off a 38-point performance, Laksa stayed in her groove with consecutive 3-pointers that cut USF's deficit down to 35-34 early in the third quarter. USF's go-ahead basket rimmed out and UConn took back the momentum with a 12-2 run.

USF worked its deficit down to 53-44 by the end of the third quarter thanks to 3-pointers by Ferreira and Laksa, who made 17 in three games this week.

UConn seized control of the game by opening the fourth quarter on a 9-0 run and Katie Lou Samuelson's 3-pointer extended the advantage to 62-44 with just over eight minutes to play.

Two 3-pointers by Williams and another from Shalethia Stringfield got USF within 12 with less than four minutes to go, but UConn halted the Bulls' rally with a pair of 3-pointers from Kia Nurse.

Nurse made four of UConn's 13 3-pointers and finished with 16 points. Tuck had a team-high 22 points and 12 rebounds, while Stewart added 12 points and 11 rebounds in a game the Huskies were highly motivated for going in.

USF looks forward to seeing UConn again at least one more time before the NCAA tournament.

AMERICAN HONORS

Freshman Kitija Laksa turned in an accomplished week and was honored by the US Basketball Writers Association (WSBWA) as the National Freshman of the Week. Laksa was also named the American Athletic Conference as the Player of the Week. Laksa is the first freshman in the league this season to receive the honor in the 2015-16 season. The Latvian native is the third Bull this year to be named Player of the Week. Courtney Williams earned POW Nov. 19 and Alisia Jenkins on Dec. 7.

TOP-25 IN THE DOME

On Jan. 10 No. 22/18 USF hosted No. 1 UConn and the Top-25 match-up marked the second time in school history two ranked opponents played in the Sun Dome (men or women). The first ranked showdown came last season during the NCAA Tournament, No. 25 USF hosted No. 8 Louisville (3/23/15) in the second round. The showdown was the first Top-25 in the regular season.

NEW KIT ON THE BLOCK

Laksa's 38 points vs. SMU (1/7/16) are the second-most single game points in league history behind only UCF's Zykira Lewis, who registered 41 in a game last season. Laksa now ranks fourth in USF's single-game scoring records and her eight 3-pointers are good for second-best in school history.

Laksa also tied The American's top single-game field goal percentage mark by going 15-for-24 from the field in USF's third straight win to open conference play.

Before her career night as a Bull, Laksa led the team with 21 points in a 108-63 rout of rival UCF on Tuesday night. During the superb two-game stretch, Laksa shot nearly 56 percent from the field (20-for-36), 60 percent from long range (12-for-20) and made all seven of her free throw attempts.

HOT HAND

Laura Ferreira turned in a strong performance against UCF, and continued her streak of scoring at least one three-pointer in a game. The sophomore went 14-straight games with at least one three-pointer, a streak that dates back to March 23, 2015 and ended Jan. 7 vs. SMU.

CHARITY STRIPE

The Bulls set a new program record, collecting 36 free throws on 43 attempts. USF ranks second in the country thanks to a season average of 78.3 percent. USF has shot more free throws than its opponents in all but four games this season. Alisia Jenkins leads the Bulls with an 87.9 free throw percentage.

THE OPTOMETRIST

Prior to last season, the last time one player scored 20 points and grabbed 20 rebounds was Feb. 13, 1990. **Alisia Jenkins** has now done it twice, in two seasons. The senior grabbed her first 20/20 performance last season at Penn State when she grabbed a career high 21 rebounds and scored her then career high 23 points. This season, the senior reached the feat against Harvard and set a new career high, 27 points, and pulled in 20 rebounds.

AT THE BREAK

The Bulls are 7-0 when leading at the half. In one of USF's win when trailing, the Bulls were down two points to Butler and exploded in the second half for an 87-77 victory in the Sun Dome. The Bulls have never trailed by more than 12 points at halftime.

MAGIC NUMBER 3

The Bulls have delivered a balanced offense throughout the season, but the magic number of scorers in double-digits is three. When USF has at least three scorers in double figures, the Bulls are 6-2.

HIT THE BOARDS

USF has a rebounding margin of +10.5 through 12 games, only trailing in rebounds twice this season. The Bulls average 44.7 rebounds per game, and top The American with 30.0 defensive rebounds per game. **Alisia Jenkins** leads USF with 13.3 rpg, while **Courtney Williams** follows with 8.6 rpg.

TWENTY SOMETHING

Courtney Williams has collected 20+ point performances in seven games this season. She collected six consecutive 20+ point performances, dating back to last season prior to the Harvard game. The senior has turned in 20+ points 35 times in her career.

WELCOME TO THE CLUB

Alisia Jenkins scored eight points against Jacksonville (11/13/15) but it was all the senior needed to join the 1,000-point club. Jenkins grabbed 14 rebounds at Baylor to surpass the 1,000-rebound mark. Jenkins is just the second Bull in program history to eclipse the 1,000-point and 1,000-rebound career mark.

- Opened in December 1980, the 30-year old Sun Dome Arena has served as the home venue and facility for the USF men's and women's basketball teams.

The multi-purpose venue also has hosted an abundance and variety of other events both internal and external to USF including, but not limited to, commencements, concerts, sports and entertainment events, consumer shows, religious services, conventions, ethnic festivals, rodeos, wrestling, youth sports camps, gymnastics and cheerleading competitions, lectures, and political rallies among other corporate, community and USF events.

- In June 2011, the USF Board of Trustees approved a \$35.6 million major renovation to the 250,000-square-foot Arena including, but not limited to, the complete reconfiguration of the approximately 10,000 seat bowl (to oval bowl seating setting), adding a state-of-the art center hung LED scoreboard, additional concessions and restrooms at the concourse level (by adding a concourse under and throughout the permanent second level seating), modifying and enhancing the southeast and southwest entries, and the restoration of existing exterior concrete amongst other cosmetic improvements.

- Additionally, the project provided for 10 loge boxes with a total capacity of ~60 seats to be sold by the USF Athletics Department. Basketball loge box holders have the first right of refusal to purchase tickets to other external events (e.g. concerts). The project, which was completed in May 2012, is anticipated to extend the useful life of the Arena for a 30-year time period.

THE AMERICAN OPENER

The Bulls are 2-1 in The American Conference openers.

During the Fernandez era, the Bulls are 6-10 in conference openers. In the past 16 seasons, the Bulls have played in the Conference USA (2000-2005), the Big East (2005-2013) and the American Athletic (2013-present).

TOP-10 BATTLES

USF has faced Top-10 teams 42 times since 1994, and has yet to defeat a team ranked higher than 11th. The Bulls defeated No. 11 DePaul 70-77 (OT) Dec. 7, 2005.

VS. THE BIG 10

USF is 7-19 all-time against the current Big 10. The Bulls have played Rutgers 12 times, when the pair were in the Big East. Four of USF's Big 10 wins came against the Scarlet Knights, the others against Iowa, Illinois and Penn State.

VS. THE SEC

USF has battled the Southeastern Conference 57 times (9-48) since the start of the program, including 41 meetings against the University of Florida. The Bulls are looking for their 10th win in program history versus the SEC. USF is 3-3 since the 2010-11 season, which includes the Bulls 73-64 win over LSU in the first round of the NCAA Tournament last season.

2-0

After the success of the 2014-15 season, head coach **Jose Fernandez** and the Bulls opened the season 2-0 for the sixth time in the Fernandez era. The Bulls were hot off a 22-point win in their season opener and preseason All-American Honorable Mention Courtney Williams picked up right where she ended last season. The senior notched her first double-double performance of the year with 34 points, one point shy of her career high, and a career high 18 rebounds.

EARLY SIGNEES

Head coach Jose Fernandez and the USF women's basketball staff announced the signing of four student-athletes during the early signing period, welcoming in top recruits from around the world to Tampa. Jazzmaine Bond, Tamara Henshaw, Shae Leverett and Enna Pehadzic were ranked among the best talent in the 2016 recruiting class.

Bond, a 6-3 forward from Murfreesboro, Tenn., is no stranger to success. In her junior season, Bond helped lead Blackman High School to the Tennessee AAA State Championship.

Henshaw, a 6-1 forward from Palm Coast, Fla.,

led Flagler Palm Coast (FPC) to the Florida State Class 8A Final Four in 2015, the first Final Four appearance in program history.

Leverett, a 6-2 forward from Rincon, Ga. is a 1,000-point scorer from South Effingham High School. Leverett reached the career mark as a junior and was the Georgia Region 3 5A Offensive Player of the Year. Adding to the Bulls international flavor is a 5-9 guard **Pehadzic** from Denmark. Pehadzic played for the Denmark U18 National Team this past summer in the European Championship, led the squad with 17.6 points to go along with 5 rebounds and 3 assists per game.

FIRST-EVER PRESEASON RANKING

Entering its 16th season under Head Coach **Jose Fernandez**, USF was ranked as high as No. 15 in the Preseason Top 20 women's basketball ranking published in the Sporting News 2015-16 Basketball preview Magazine. The top 20 ranking was the highest for the Bulls' program, which also appeared in the preseason top 25 polls by Lindy's Sports (No. 22), ESPN (No. 21), and Athlon (No. 23). The Bulls were one of two American Athletic Conference teams ranked in the Sporting News poll, joining No. 2 UConn.

POST SEASON SEASONED

USF has reached the post season in 11 of the last 12 seasons, including making the programs third NCAA Tournament appearance and second in three seasons last year. During that span, the Bulls have also won a WNIT title (2009) and reached the WNIT final four (2014). The Bulls have played in 25 post season NCAA or WNIT tournament games during that span. Seniors on the 2015-16 team have been involved in nine NCAA or WNIT games, winning six.

TWO FOR THE SHOW

USF was among five schools nationally to have two players named to the preseason first and second-team All-America lists by Sporting News joining preseason No. 1 South Carolina, No. 2 UConn, No. 4 Baylor and No. 5 Ohio State. The Sporting News named two-time American Conference first-team guard **Courtney Williams** to its first-team preseason All-America list and 2015 second-team all-conference forward Alisia Jenkins to its second-team preseason All-America list.

WILLIAMS ON RECORD PACE

Senior Guard **Courtney Williams** was named a preseason first-team All-American by the Sporting News and was named an AP preseason All-American, Honorable Mention. Williams returns after a stellar junior season that saw her lead The American in scoring (20.3 ppg) and finish among the top 11 conference leaders in 10 categories, including assists, (7th, 3.3 apg), rebounds (8th, 7.5 rpg) and blocked shots (10th, 0.9 bpg). Williams



broke Jessica Dickson's (2005-06) USF single season scoring record, posting 710 points for the ninth best total in the nation. Williams recorded 20, 20-point games and broke 30 points twice as she secured a spot among 12 finalists for The Wade Trophy - women's basketball's version of the Heisman.

She enters her senior campaign fifth all-time on the USF career scoring chart with 1,541 points, 10th on the career rebounding chart (645), and 14th on the career assists chart (231). She is on pace to join Dickinson as the Bull's second 2,000-point scorer in program history and become the first USF player to every post 2,000 points, 800 rebounds and 300 assists.

SPANISH FLAVOR

USF's foreign summer tour marked the first trip out of the country for many Bulls, but for three players it's plane ride to home, sweet home.

Sophomore guard Laia Flores, junior guard Laura Marcos Canedo and junior guard/forward Ariadna Pujol all hail from Spain. Flores and Pujol each come from Mataro, a city located 19 miles northeast of Barcelona. Canedo is from Salamanca, a city in northwestern Spain that's 120 miles west of the Spanish capital of Madrid.

USF traveled to Torrejon, a city close to Madrid, to face CREF and Club Baloncesto Estudiantes. USF played two more games in Barcelona against Girona and Saint Adria.
