ITEMS OF NOTE

• It's been 36 years since the Bulls lost to UCF and No. 15 USF is looking to stretch its longest series win streak to 19. In their last meeting, the Bulls passed the century mark, scoring 108 points, the second time they scored 100-plus points on the Knights in the series. The first came in a 110-55 victory in Tampa on Dec. 1st, 1992.

• Senior Shaletia Stringfield (Jacksonville, Fla.) dropped a game high 22 points in the Bulls 75-54 action packed American Athletic Conference match-up last Sunday. The fourth quarter belonged to Stringfield, who just four days earlier lifted the Bulls (12-4, 5-1 AAC) past Tulane with the game winning shot. The 5-6 guard scored 14 of her 22 in the final ten minutes, which also accounted for 14 of the Bulls 22 points in the fourth quarter. Stringfield played 32 minutes, shooting 66 percent (6-for-9) from the floor and collected nine points on 11 trips to the free throw line.

• **Courtney Williams** scored 31 points at Tulane last Wednesday and 21 points against East Carolina Sunday and now ranks third on the all-time scoring list. The senior is shooting for 2,000 career points, and needs 83 points to reach the milestone, but only needs 25 points to become the second highest point scorer in USF history. Only one other player in program history has surpassed 2,000 career points.

USF 108, MEMPHIS 63

Jan. 5, 2016 in Tampa, Fla.

TAMPA, JAN. 5, 2016 – It was a record night for No. 22/18 USF Tuesday as the Bulls stormed to a 108-63 victory over visiting UCF. Five different players scored in double-digits, led by freshman Kitija Laksa with a career high 21 points.

The Bulls turned in the sixth-highest point total in program history, shooting 45 percent for the first time since Dec. 20. Laksa led the Bulls with four three-point shots and a 50% three-point field goal percentage (4-for-8). Senior Courtney Williams' stat line proved why she's listed on many Player of the Year watch lists with 18 points, eight rebounds, five assists, four blocks and one steal, in just 26 minutes of action.

Sophomore Laura Ferreira added 18 points, six rebounds, and two steals while Maria Jespersen collected 15 points, seven rebounds. Katelyn Weber finished the final two quarters strong, scoring 12 of her career high 13 points in the final two quarters.

UCF pushed to keep up with the Bulls in the first quarter and ended the first frame down 21-11 after the first 10 minutes. The Bulls stretched its lead to 47-23 at the break, their largest halftime margin of the season. The first two quarters mirrored the Bulls play all season, Williams the leading scorer, Jenkins the leading rebounder, but the 1,856 fans in attendance caught a glimpse of the future in the second half.

Five of the Bulls seven international players doubled and tripled their minutes played this season and chipped in to the 50 points that came from USF's bench. Laksa scored 16 of her 21 points in the second half, and went 3-for-3 from behind the arc. Jespersen scored 12 points, but Ariadna Pujol and Laia Flores scored all their points in the second and aided USF's highest scoring third quarter this season.

USF went 36-for-43 from the charity stripe thanks to 26 Knights fouls. The Bulls' 36 made free throws is a program record.

UCF entered the contest leading the American Athletic Conference, surpassing USF for the first time this season with 44.7 rebounds per game. The Bulls won the battle for the boards and grabbed 53 rebounds, surpassing the 50-rebound mark for the fourth time this season.

The Knights were led by Zykira Lewis with 30 points, with Aliyah Gregory adding 16. Lewis' 30 marked the first time since Jan. 2015 an opponent scored 30 points against the Bulls.

LAST TIME OUT

NO. 15 BULLS UPSET AT MEMPHIS, 88-87

MEMPHIS, Tenn., JAN. 20, 2016 – Courtney Williams led four Bulls in double figures with 22 points, but shorthanded USF fell in its first overtime game of the season, 88-87, at Memphis on Wednesday night.

Freshman Kitija Laksa scored 15 of her 20 points in the third quarter and made five of the Bulls' 13 3-pointers. Senior Shalethia Stringfield continued her hot stretch with 19 points and knocked down a go-ahead 3-pointer with 59 seconds left in regulation.

USF (12-5, 5-2) also got a 17-point performance from Laura Ferreira in its first game since being ranked No. 15 in both major polls. The Bulls were missing one of their biggest stars for much of the game with senior Alisia Jenkins playing only two minutes because of an injury.

Memphis (10-9, 4-4) forced overtime with Brianna Wright's layup with three seconds left and made 11 free throws in overtime. Ariel Hearn scored a game-high 33 points and Asianna Fuqua-Bey added 16 points and 11 rebounds. Memphis scored 36 points in the paint and outrebounded USF, 43-30.

"We're going to get everybody's best game and today it's disappointing to give up 88 points. It started on the defensive end," head coach Jose Fernandez said.

Wednesday's back-and-forth first half featured 10 lead changes on the way to a 38-38 tie by the break. Each team went 14-for-28 from the floor and the Bulls did most of their damage with five 3-pointers.

Williams went 2-for-3 from long range and led USF with 12 points in the half. Ferreira also boosted the Bulls with a pair of 3-pointers and had 10 points in the first 20 minutes.

Laksa took over with 15 points in the third quarter and the scoring surge happened in explosive fashion. The forward from Latvia caught fire with four straight 3-pointers in a two-minute span and her fifth of the game gave USF a 50-45 lead.

USF sank five 3-pointers in the third quarter and Ferreira's third of the game extended the advantage to 58-48 with 4:21 remaining. The Bulls were held scoreless the rest of the way while Memphis finished the quarter on an 8-0 run.

USF had a 67-61 lead with 5:43 left in regulation but was hampered by a scoring drought that lasted nearly three minutes.

"We just have to regroup and get back to work," Fernandez said.

The Bulls look to bounce back against rival UCF 2 p.m. Sunday in Orlando (TV: ESPNU). USF is seeking its second series sweep of the season after defeating the Knights, 108-63, at the Sun Dome on Jan. 5.

WOODEN AWARD MIDSEASON TOP 20

At the halfway point of the season, senior Courtney Williams (Folkston, Ga.) has led the Bulls to an 11-4 record (4-1 in The American) and ranks 10th in the country in points per game. The senior's efforts haven't gone unnoticed as Williams was named to the Wooden Award Midseason Top-20 list, announced Friday.

The senior has collected three 30-plus point performances this season and has scored 15-plus points in all but two games in her senior year. Williams is 127 points away from scoring her 2,000th career point and needs just 68 points to move to second in USF's career points record books.

USBWA NATIONAL FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Freshman **Kitija Laksa** turned in an accomplished week and was honored by the US Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) as the National Freshman of the Week. Laksa was also named the American Athletic Conference Player of the Week. Laksa shocked the league in three outings and totaled 76 points in an efficient manner, shooting 52 percent from the floor, including a 63 percent three-point shooting effort. For the week, Laksa averaged 25.3 points per game, shooting 52 percent from the floor. She enters the week third on the Bulls roster, averaging 12.1 points per game.

CREAM OF THE CROP

Courtney Williams joins fellow Wooden Award midseason watch list member Brittany Martin (Oklahoma State) as just one of two players in the country averaging over 20 points, eight rebounds and two assists per game. Williams ranks 10th in Division I with 22.2 points per game and has six double-doubles this season.

AMERICAN HONORS

Freshman Kitija Laksa turned in an accomplished week and was honored by the US Basketball Writers Association (WSBWA) as the National Freshman of the Week. Laksa was also named the American Athletic Conference as the Player of the Week. Laksa is the first freshman in the league this season to receive the honor in the 2015-16 season. The Latvian native is the third Bull this year to be named Player of the Week. Courtney Williams earned POW Nov. 19 and Alisia Jenkins on Dec. 7.

THE NEXT LEVEL

The Bulls have broken the Top-25 barrier with some of the best play in program history. Three Bulls average points in the double-digits, and have won eight games by 20+ points this season. USF has surpassed the century mark twice this season, and two Bulls have turned in 30-plus point performances on four different occasions this season.



TOP-25 IN THE DOME

On Jan. 10 No. 22/18 USF hosted No. 1 UConn and the Top-25 match-up marked the second time in school history two ranked opponents played in the Sun Dome (men or women). The first ranked showdown came last season during the NCAA Tournament, No. 25 USF hosted No. 8 Louisville (3/23/15) in the second round. The showdown was the first Top-25 in the regular season.

NEW KIT ON THE BLOCK

Laksa's 38 points vs. SMU (1/7/16) are the second-most single game points in league history behind only UCF's Zykira Lewis, who registered 41 in a game last season. Laksa now ranks fourth in USF's single-game scoring records and her eight 3-pointers are good for second-best in school history.

Laksa also tied The American's top single-game field goal percentage mark by going 15-for-24 from the field in USF's third straight win to open conference play.

Before her career night as a Bull, Laksa led the team with 21 points in a 108-63 rout of rival UCF on Tuesday night. During the superb two-game stretch, Laksa shot nearly 56 percent from the field (20-for-36), 60 percent from long range (12-for-20) and made all seven of her free throw attempts.

HOT HAND

Laura Ferreira turned in a strong performance against UCF, and continued her streak of scoring at least one three-pointer in a game. The sophomore went 14-straight games with at least one three-pointer, a streak that dates back to March 23, 2015 and ended Jan. 7 vs. SMU.

CHARITY STRIPE

The Bulls set a new program record, collecting 36 free throws on 43 attempts. USF ranks second in the country thanks to a season average of 78.3 percent. USF has shot more free throws than its opponents in all but four games this season. Alisia Jenkins leads the Bulls with an 87.9 free throw percentage.

THE OPTOMETRIST

Prior to last season, the last time one player scored 20 points and grabbed 20 rebounds was Feb. 13, 1990. **Alisia Jenkins** has now done it twice, in two seasons. The senior grabbed her first 20/20 performance last season at Penn State when she grabbed a career high 21 rebounds and scored her then career high 23 points. This season, the senior reached the feat against Harvard and set a new career high, 27 points, and pulled in 20 rebounds.

AT THE BREAK

The Bulls are 7-0 when leading at the half. In

- Opened in December 1980, the 30-year old Sun Dome Arena has served as the home venue and facility for the USF men's and women's basketball teams.

The multi-purpose venue also has hosted an abundance and variety of other events both internal and external to USF including, but not limited to, commencements, concerts, sports and entertainment events, consumer shows, religious services, conventions, ethnic festivals, rodeos, wrestling, youth sports camps, gymnastics and cheerleading competitions, lectures, and political rallies among other corporate, community and USF events.

- In June 2011, the USF Board of Trustees approved a \$35.6 million major renovation to the 250,000-square-foot Arena including, but not limited to, the complete reconfiguration of the approximately 10,000 seat bowl (to oval bowl seating setting), adding a state-of-the art center hung LED scoreboard, additional concessions and restrooms at the concourse level (by adding a concourse under and throughout the permanent second level seating), modifying and enhancing the southeast and southwest entries, and the restoration of existing exterior concrete amongst other cosmetic improvements.

- Additionally, the project provided for 10 loge boxes with a total capacity of ~60 seats to be sold by the USF Athletics Department. Basketball loge box holders have the first right of refusal to purchase tickets to other external events (e.g. concerts). The project, which was completed in May 2012, is anticipated to extend the useful life of the Arena for a 30-year time period.

one of USF's win when trailing, the Bulls were down two points to Butler and exploded in the second half for an 87-77 victory in the Sun Dome. The Bulls have never trailed by more than 12 points at halftime.

MAGIC NUMBER 3

The Bulls have delivered a balanced offense throughout the season, but the magic number of scorers in double-digits is three. When USF has at least three scorers in double figures, the Bulls are 6-2.

HIT THE BOARDS

USF has a rebounding margin of +10.5 through 12 games, only trailing in rebounds twice this season. The Bulls average 44.7 rebounds per game, and top The American with 30.0 defensive rebounds per game. **Alisia Jenkins** leads USF with 13.3 rpg, while **Courtney Williams** follows with 8.6 rpg.

TWENTY SOMETHING

Courtney Williams has collected 20+ point performances in seven games this season. She collected six consecutive 20+ point performances, dating back to last season prior to the Harvard game. The senior has turned in 20+ points 35 times in her career.

WELCOME TO THE CLUB

Alisia Jenkins scored eight points against Jacksonville (11/13/15) but it was all the senior needed to join the 1,000-point club. Jenkins grabbed 14 rebounds at Baylor to surpass the 1,000-rebound mark. Jenkins is just the second Bull in program history to eclipse the 1,000-point and 1,000-rebound career mark.

THE DOME

During the Fernandez era, the Bulls are 6-10 in conference openers. In the past 16 seasons, the Bulls have played in the Conference USA (2000-2005), the Big East (2005-2013) and the American Athletic (2013-present).

TOP-10 BATTLES

USF has faced Top-10 teams 42 times since 1994, and has yet to defeat a team ranked higher than 11th. The Bulls defeated No. 11 DePaul 70-77 (OT) Dec. 7, 2005.

VS. THE BIG 10

USF is 7-19 all-time against the current Big 10. The Bulls have played Rutgers 12 times, when the pair were in the Big East. Four of USF's Big 10 wins came against the Scarlet Knights, the others against Iowa, Illinois and Penn State.

VS. THE SEC

USF has battled the Southeastern Conference 57 times (9-48) since the start of the program, including 41 meetings against the University of Florida. The Bulls are looking for their 10th win in program history versus the SEC. USF is 3-3 since the 2010-11 season, which includes the Bulls 73-64 win over LSU in the first round of the NCAA Tournament last season.

2-0

After the success of the 2014-15 season, head coach **Jose Fernandez** and the Bulls opened the season 2-0 for the sixth time in the Fernandez era. The Bulls were hot off a 22-point win in their season opener and preseason All-American Honorable Mention Courtney Williams picked up right where she ended last season. The senior notched her first double-double performance of the year with 34 points, one point shy of her career high, and a career high 18 rebounds.

EARLY SIGNEES

Head coach Jose Fernandez and the USF women's basketball staff announced the signing of four student-athletes during the early signing period, welcoming in top recruits from around the world to Tampa. Jazzmaine Bond, Tamara Henshaw, Shae Leverett and Enna Pehadzie were ranked among the best talent in the 2016 recruiting class.

Bond, a 6-3 forward from Murfreesboro, Tenn., is no stranger to success. In her junior season, Bond helped lead Blackman High School to the Tennessee AAA State Championship.

Henshaw, a 6-1 forward from Palm Coast, Fla., led Flagler Palm Coast (FPC) to the Florida State Class 8A Final Four in 2015, the first Final Four appearance in program history.

Leverett, a 6-2 forward from Rincon, Ga. is a 1,000-point scorer from South Effingham High School. Leverett reached the career mark as a junior and was the Georgia Region 3 5A Offensive Player of the Year.

Adding to the Bulls international flavor is a 5-9 guard **Pehadzie** from Denmark. Pehadzie played for the Denmark U18 National Team this past summer in the European Championship, led the squad with 17.6 points to go along with 5 rebounds and 3 assists per game.

FIRST-EVER PRESEASON RANKING

Entering its 16th season under Head Coach **Jose Fernandez**, USF was ranked as high as No. 15 in the Preseason Top 20 women's basketball ranking published in the Sporting News 2015-16 Basketball preview Magazine.



The top 20 ranking was the highest for the Bulls' program, which also appeared in the preseason top 25 polls by Lindy's Sports (No. 22), ESPN (No. 21), and Athlon (No. 23). The Bulls were one of two American Athletic Conference teams ranked in the Sporting News poll, joining No. 2 UConn.

POST SEASON SEASONED

USF has reached the post season in 11 of the last 12 seasons, including making the programs third NCAA Tournament appearance and second in three seasons last year. During that span, the Bulls have also won a WNIT title (2009) and reached the WNIT final four (2014). The Bulls have played in 25 post season NCAA or WNIT tournament games during that span. Seniors on the 2015-16 team have been involved in nine NCAA or WNIT games, winning six.

TWO FOR THE SHOW

USF was among five schools nationally to have two players named to the preseason first and second-team All-America lists by Sporting News joining preseason No. 1 South Carolina, No. 2 UConn, No. 4 Baylor and No. 5 Ohio State. The Sporting News named two-time American Conference first-team guard **Courtney Williams** to its first-team preseason All-America list and 2015 second-team all-conference forward Alisia Jenkins to its second-team preseason All-America list.

WILLIAMS ON RECORD PACE

Senior Guard **Courtney Williams** was named a preseason first-team All-American by the Sporting News and was named an AP preseason All-American, Honorable Mention. Williams returns after a stellar junior season that saw her lead The American in scoring (20.3 ppg) and finish among the top 11 conference leaders in 10 categories, including assists, (7th, 3.3 apg), rebounds (8th, 7.5 rpg) and blocked shots (10th, 0.9 bpg). Williams broke Jessica Dickson's (2005-06) USF single season scoring record, posting 710 points for the ninth best total in the nation. Williams recorded 20, 20-point games and broke 30 points twice as she secured a spot among 12 finalists for The Wade Trophy - women's basketball's version of the Heisman.

She enters her senior campaign fifth all-time on the USF career scoring chart with 1,541 points, 10th on the career rebounding chart (645), and 14th on the career assists chart (231). She is on pace to join Dickinson as the Bull's second 2,000-point scorer in program history and become the first USF player to every post 2,000 points, 800 rebounds and 300 assists.

SPANISH FLAVOR

USF's foreign summer tour marked the first trip out of the country for many Bulls, but for three players it's plane ride to home, sweet home.



Sophomore guard Laia Flores, junior guard Laura Marcos Canedo and junior guard/forward Ariadna Pujol all hail from Spain. Flores and Pujol each come from Mataro, a city located 19 miles northeast of Barcelona. Canedo is from Salamanca, a city in northwestern Spain that's 120 miles west of the Spanish capital of Madrid.

USF traveled to Torreon, a city close to Madrid, to face CREF and Club Baloncesto Estudiantes. USF played two more games in Barcelona against Girona and Saint Adria.
