Matilda Mossman

Western Kentucky, 1979

Head Coach

10th Season

Matilda Mossman is in her 10th season at The University of Tulsa after being appointed as the head women's basketball coach on March 22, 2011. Mossman took over a five-win team and in just her second year won a conference championship and advanced to the NCAA Tournament.

The 17-year collegiate head coaching veteran has transitioned the program from Conference USA to the American Athletic Conference.

In her first season at the helm of the program (2011-12), the Golden Hurricane posted 13 wins, and finished league play with an 8-8 record and a sixth-place finish. However, a year later, the program took another big step forward as the Hurricane captured the 2013 Conference USA tournament title, advanced to the NCAA Tournament and posted the first non-losing record (17-17) since 2006.

Mossman led Tulsa to an 18-14 mark in 2014-15, the school's first winning season since 2006. Tulsa advanced to the WNIT Second Round during that season.

During her tenure, Mossman has coached two-time all-Conference USA performer Taleya Mayberry, and helped Kelsee Grovey earn C-USA All-Freshman team accolades, as well as Mayberry, Grovey and Tiffani Cousinard receive C-USA All-Tournament team recognition in 2013. She also coached Ashley Clark to all-C-USA second team accolades as a sophomore, second team all-conference accolades and Sixth Man of the Year recognition as a junior in the American Athletic Conference, and third-team all-conference accolades as a senior; and Crystal Polk to third-team all-American Athletic Conference accolades in 2018-19.

In 18 years as a collegiate head coach, Mossman has registered an overall 262-257 record. She had a 67-27 mark at Arkansas (1981-84), an 80-66 mark at Kansas State (1984-89), and a 115-164 record in 10 seasons at Tulsa. She also coached on the high school level for nine seasons. In 27 years as a head coach, Mossman has compiled a 453-310 record for a .594 winning percentage.

She has two sons, Scott and Matt.

Facing USF

- This is the eighth time that Tulsa and USF will meet on the women's basketball court
- The Bulls have won all seven previous meetings, including a 68-52 win last season in Tulsa
- The Bulls have a 5-1 mark this season, including a 2-0 mark in The American
- Sydni Harvey and Elena Tsineke both average double-digit points for USF with 11.8 and 10.0 points per game, respectively
- Bethy Mununga has a team-best 11.3 rebounds, Beatriz Jordao has nine blocks and Harvey has eight steals

In the Last Game

- Desiree Lewis tallied a team-best 16 points, while Maya Mayberry added 15 and Rebecca Lescay had 10
- Although Tulsa played 12 players, only five points came from the bench
- The Hurricane shot a dismal 29-percent from the field, just 30-percent from three-point range and 50-percent from the free throw line.

Wyvette Mayberry Named The American Freshman of the Week

- Wyvette Mayberry was named the American Athletic Conference Freshman of the Week on December 14.
- Mayberry made her collegiate debut a memorable one. She tallied a team-leading 16 points in just 11:25 off the clock against Oklahoma State.
- This was TU's first and only other Freshman of the Week honor since the 2016-17 season when Kendrian Elliott, Alexis Gauden and Shug Dickson each earned the honor twice.

- TU returns nine letterwinners from last season, as well as junior-transfer Madi Washington who had to sit out last year due to NCAA transfer rules. Tulsa added five newcomers to the roster, including two junior-transfers and three true freshmen.
- TU has two seniors (Morgan Brady and Rebecca Lescay), eight juniors, two sophomores and three freshmen on the roster

Maddie Bittle

- According to a recent NCAA Division I women's basketball survey, Maddie Bittle is just one of 18 Native Americans playing collegiate basketball at the D1 level.

An Accurate Shot

- Destiny Johnson ranks second (.400 = 4-10) in program history for three-point field goal percentage.
- Maddie Bittle ranks ninth (.822 = 37-45) in program history for free throw percentage

A College Graduate

- Tulsa senior Rebecca Lescay earned her bachelor's degree in marketing in 2020 and is now working towards her master's degree in business analytics

A Returning Leader

- Rebecca Lescay is TU's returning leader in scoring (7.7 ppg), assists (70) and steals (53) from a year ago

The Family Connection

- Assistant Coach Taleya Mayberry played at Tulsa from 2009-13, and returned to her alma mater and joined the coaching ranks prior to the 2018-19 campaign
- This season, she is coaching two of her younger sisters, Maya, who is a junior-transfer from crosstown rival Oral Roberts, and Wyvette, who is a freshman this season

Destiny Johnson Hit her Stride in February Last Season

- Destiny Johnson hit her stride in the last two months of the 2019-20
- She averaged 2.1 points per game leading up to the Memphis game (2-1-20), and then averaged 10.3 ppg in February and March
- Johnson tallied eight points against both Memphis and Cincinnati, 10 points against both Wichita State and Tulane, 15 points against UCF, 16 points against SMU, and 23 points against Houston.
- Johnson also had one steal in the first three months of the season, and had 12 in the final nine games; and similarly had 12 of her 13 assists in the final nine games of the year.

Back-to-Back-to-Back

- Desiree Lewis had back-to-back-to-back double-doubles during the 2018-19 season, making her the fifth player in school history to reach this milestone
- Lewis is just the third to accomplish this as a freshman
- Lewis hit back-to-back-to-back double-doubles against Wichita State (12p, 10r), Memphis (10p, 12r) and ECU (16p, 13r)
- This feat has been accomplished just 16 times in school history, including Kendrian Elliott who reached this milestone during the 2019-20 campaign

Mossman Has 262 Career Wins

- Matilda Mossman has collected 262 career victories
- She had 67 wins at Arkansas and 80 wins at Kansas State, and currently has 115 wins at TU
- Mossman has the most wins by a TU women's basketball coach

Tulsa Picked 11th in The American Preseason Coaches' Poll

- In the American Athletic Conference coaches' poll, Tulsa was picked to finish 11th by the league's coaches
- The 2020-21 predicted order of finish is USF, UCF, Tulane, Cincinnati, Temple, Wichita State, Houston, Memphis, ECU, SMU and Tulsa

Tulsa in The American Championship

- Tulsa has a 4-6 mark in The American Championship
- TU earned wins in the first round in 2016, 2017, 2018 and 2019
- The Golden Hurricane lost matches in the quarterfinals in 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018 and 2019, and lost in the first round in 2020

Tulsa in Postseason

- Tulsa has made five postseason appearances
- TU earned WNIT bids in 2004, 2005 and 2015
- The Hurricane played in the NCAA Tournament in 2006 and 2013
- Tulsa lost in the first round in 2004 (Memphis), 2005 (Texas A&M) and 2013 (Stanford), but went 1-1 (W, North Carolina State; L, DePaul) in 2006 and 2015 (W, Missouri State; L, Eastern Michigan)
- The Hurricane has a 2-5 overall mark in postseason play

A Hurricane in Tulsa?

The Origination of The University of Tulsa nickname - Golden Hurricane - was created in 1922. A new football coach, Howard Archer came to town and inherited a slew of nicknames dating back to 1895. In the past, Tulsa had been named "Kendallites," "Presbyterians," "Tigers," "Orange and Black," "Tulsans," and of course, "Yellow Jackets." The team started working out in the fall with a new nickname "Yellow Jackets" which was apparently due to the fact that the team was wearing new black and yellow uniforms. The team opened the season and it was apparent that Tulsa was going to have a great year, and trying to seize some publicity for his team, Archer wanted to find a new nickname quickly. After a remark was made in practice one day about "roaring through opponents," and because of their new jersey colors, he thought of "Golden Tornadoes." But a check showed that Georgia Tech already had chosen that tag in 1917. From the tornado, he evolved meteorologically to the hurricane. A few days before the team left for a game against Texas A&M, Archer asked the squad to vote on the name, and thus "Golden Hurricane" was born.
