STARTING FIVE

1. Freshman JerKaila Jordan has made a splash early in her collegiate career. She has been honored by the AAC seven times. Back on Dec. 14 she was named Conference Player of the Week. Jordan has picked up five Freshman of the Week awards this season. She has led the Green Wave in scoring in 11 of the team's 20 games this season.
2. Jordan currently ranks in the top 10 in the American Athletic Conference in scoring (15.5), field goal percentage (.477), free throw percentage (.704) and steals (2.1).
3. Jordan is eighth in the nation among all freshmen in field goal percentage and 11th in points per game. She leads all freshman in The American in both categories.
4. Senior Krystal Freeman leads the Green Wave and ranks fourth in the AAC with 7.6 rebounds per game. She is second on the team and ninth in the conference with 12.7 points a game.
5. Senior Arsula Clark earned Preseason Second Team All-AAC honors. She currently ranks third on the team and 13th in the conference in scoring with a 11.9 points per game average.

SERIES HISTORY – SOUTH FLORIDA

- The Green Wave and the Bulls have met 44 times in program history with South Florida holding a 25-19 edge.
- South Florida has taken 16 straight games over the Green Wave dating back to the 2014-15 season.
- The Bulls took the meeting between the two teams earlier this season, 72-53. Elisa Pinzan led the Bulls with 22 points and seven assists. Senior Arsula Clark was the top scorer for the Green Wave with 20 points.
- USF hit 10 threes and scored 30 points in the paint earlier this season in New Orleans.
- Tulane head coach Lisa Stockton holds a 15-22 all-time record against South Florida in her career at Tulane.
- Tulane has a 7-9 record under Stockton when playing USF in Tampa.

SCOUTING THE BULLS

- South Florida enters its matchup at Tulane ranked No. 12/15 nationally and carrying a 12-1 overall record and a 9-0 conference mark. The Bulls are riding an 11-game winning streak, including a win over then-No. 6/7 Mississippi State in overtime.
- USF will return to the hardwood after defeating Cincinnati, 69-65, in overtime on Feb. 17. After playing Tulane earlier this season the Bulls went on a three-week COVID pause.
- The Bulls lead the AAC in scoring offense (71.1), scoring margin (+17.7), 3-point field goal percentage defense (.201), rebounds (45.7), rebound margin (+10.5), blocks (4.2), assists (17.4), assist/turnover ratio (1.3), offensive rebounds (16.2), defensive rebounds (29.5) and 3-point field goals made (8.1).
- South Florida leads the nation in 3-point field goal percentage defense. The Bulls are also sixth in the NCAA in rebounds per game, ninth in field goal percentage defense, 11th in rebound margin and assist/turnover ratio and 15th in assists per game.
- The Bulls share the ball well as they have five players in the top 30 in scoring in the AAC.
- Sophomore guard Elena Tsineke leads the way with 12.0 points per game to rank 12th in the conference, junior point guard Sydney Harvey is second on the team and 15th in the conference at 11.7 per game and senior forward Bethy Mununga ranks third on the team and 16th in the AAC at 11.5.
- Junior Elisa Pinzan (9.9) and sophomore Maria Alvarez (9.5) and round out the group ranked 24th and 26th in the conference, respectively.

- Mununga leads the conference and ranks ninth nationally in rebounds per game at 12.0. She had a career day against ECU with 23 points and 21 rebounds on Jan. 2.
- Mununga has logged double-digit rebounds in 11 of the Bulls' 13 games this season.
- Pinzan is tops in the conference and ranks second in the country with 7.3 assists per game. She also third nationally in assist/turnover ratio at 4.13.
- South Florida head coach Jose Fernandez is in his 21st season on the bench for the Bulls and has posted a 385-273 mark since arriving in Tampa.

CARDIAC WAVE

- The Olive and Blue have had 33 of their last 49 games decided by 10 points or less dating back to last season. The Green Wave are 15-18 in those games.
- Within those 32 games, 23 were decided by five points or less. Tulane is 14-9 in games decided by five points or less dating back to last season, including going 2-1 in games that finished with the exact final score of 64-62.
- Although the Wave have played many close games in the last two seasons, Tulane has only played two overtime games in that time. The Olive and Blue beat Tulsa Jan. 8 and fell to Houston Feb. 1 in overtime last season.
- The Green Wave also had a knack for mounting double-digit comebacks last season. Tulane started the trend in the second game of the season as it overcame an 18-point deficit at Washington to take a 64-62 win over the Huskies.
- The Green Wave mounted 17-point comebacks at both Southern Miss and SMU as well.

QUEST FOR 600

- Tulane women's basketball coach Lisa Stockton has compiled 599 wins in her career. With one more win, she will become just the 77th NCAA women's basketball coach to achieve the feat of winning 600 games in a career. Stockton will be the 19th active Division I head coach with 600 wins.

AMONG THE LEAGUE LEADERS

- Tulane ranks among the league's top five in 15 different statistical categories.
- The Green Wave lead the conference in field goal percentage at .430. They rank second the conference in scoring (68.6), scoring margin (+8.9), assists (14.7) and assist/turnover ratio (1.0).

JORDAN SETS RECORDS

- Freshman Jerkaila Jordan has won five American Athletic Conference Freshman of the Week awards this season.
- Jordan is now tied with Cincinnati's Ilmar'I Thomas (2017-18), Rutgers' Tyler Scaife (2013-14) and Temple's Feyonda Fitzgerald (2013-14) for the all-time conference record for freshman of the week awards by a single player.

FRESHMAN LEADS THE WAY

- Freshman Jerkaila Jordan currently leads the Green Wave with 15.5 points, 58 assists, 24 made threes and 41 steals.
- She is second on the team with 13 blocked shots.
- Jordan has scored in double figures in 17 of the Green Wave's 20 games.
- The New Orleans native is seventh all-time in total points among freshmen in program history. She currently has 309 points on the year. Her 15.5 points per game are second all-time among freshmen, only behind Barbara Farris' 15.6.
- The freshman guard had a career day against UCF on Feb. 17. She scored a season-high 28 points on 9-17 from the field and 4-9 from three. This is the most points a Tulane freshman has scored since stats were readily available.

TULANE VS. RANKED TEAMS

- The Tulane University women's basketball program has an all-time record of 13-83 record against ranked teams.
- The Green Wave last beat a ranked team when they defeated No. 20 LSU, 65-62, in overtime on Nov. 19, 2011 at Fogelman in Devlin.
- The Green Wave have lost 22 consecutive games at the hands of ranked opponents. Tulane have an 0-6 record when facing a ranked USF team.
- The Olive and Blue hold a 0-1 against teams ranked No. 12.

FREEMAN IS BACK

- Senior Krystal Freeman returns for her senior season after leading the Green Wave in points and rebounds in the past two seasons.
- Freeman opened the season with the 18th double-double of her career as she scored 23 points and grabbed 10 rebounds against Nicholls.
- She continued to be one of the top players for the Green Wave, as she logged 25 points, 17 rebounds and two blocks at East Carolina for her 19th career double-double.
- She currently leads the Green Wave with 7.7 rebounds per game. Freeman is second on the team averaging 13.1 points per game.
- Freeman narrowly missed the 20th double-double of her career when she posted 10 points and nine rebounds against Tulsa on Feb. 10.

HOMETOWN CONNECTION

- The 2020-21 Tulane roster boasts three graduates of John Curtis Christian. Junior Dynah Jones, sophomore Salma Bates and freshman Jerkaila Jordan all played at John Curtis under Tulane alum Barbara Farris, who now serves as an assistant coach at Stetson University.
- During their time at John Curtis, Jones won two Louisiana State Championships, Bates captured three state titles and Jordan took home four. Jordan was named MVP of all four title games.
- They all join former Tulane great Kolby Morgan (2015-18) as graduates of John Curtis to play at Tulane.

RETURNING THE OFFENSE

- Tulane brings back 89.3 percent of its scoring and 95.2 percent of its rebounding from the 2019-20 season. This is the second-highest percentage of any team in the American behind SMU.
- The four seniors (Krystal Freeman, Arsula Clark, Sierra Cheatham and Kaila Anderson) on the roster for the Olive Blue are tied for second with Memphis and Temple for the most in the American Athletic Conference. ECU boasts six for the highest number in the league.
- The Green Wave graduated two seniors last season, Kayla Manuirirangi and Maddison Wells.
- Tulane opened the season with an 88-point outburst. This was the most points the Green Wave have scored since they beat FAU, 88-45, on Nov. 28, 2018.
- The Olive and Blue have topped the 80-point mark four times this season.
- The 80 points against Memphis and Temple were the most the Green Wave had scored against an American Athletic Conference team in regulation since beating Houston, 82-56, on Jan. 14, 2017.
- Both games against Memphis and Temple ended with the exact score of 80-44.
- The 36-point margins of victory were the largest against a conference opponent since the Olive and Blue topped Tulsa by 37 points, 78-41, on Jan. 24, 2009.
- With the two wins of 30+ points, Tulane has beaten two conference opponents by 30+ points in the same season five times since Lisa Stockton arrived Uptown.

BATES COMES UP BIG

- Sophomore Salma Bates has made a habit of coming up big for the Green Wave recently. She scored the last five points to solidify the Green Wave's 61-59 win over Cincinnati.
- She followed that up by having a career day against Tulsa. Bates posted the first double-double of her career with and led Tulane with career highs of 15 points, 10 rebounds and six assists. The New Orleans native shot 7-9 from the field against the Golden Hurricane.
- Bates finished off the week with 15 points, three rebounds and three assists against Wichita State. The Kenner, La., native was placed on the AAC Weekly Honor Roll for her efforts.

CLARK STEPS UP

- The Miami native was named Preseason All-AAC Second team.
- Clark narrowly missed recording the first triple-double in program history when she logged 18 points, nine rebounds and eight assists in the win over Cincinnati on Jan. 18, 2020.
- She opened her 2020-21 season right where she left off posting 17 points, five rebounds, two assists and two steals at South Alabama.
- Clark poured in a season-high 28 points on 9-of-15 shooting at ECU back on Dec. 22. She also went 10-of-13 at the free throw line to complement seven rebounds and six steals.
- She led the Green Wave with 20 points and five rebounds against South Florida. Clark was named to the AAC's Weekly Honor Roll after her performance.

FREEMAN JOINS THE 1,000-POINT CLUB

- Senior Krystal Freeman scored the 1,000th point of her career as she connected on a jumper from the wing against UCF in the third quarter of the Green Wave's league opener on the road.
- Freeman became the 29th player in program history to surpass 1,000 points. She currently ranks 16th in scoring in program history with 1,190 points.

• Jordan was named the Gatorade Player of the Year and Miss Basketball in the state of Louisiana in 2020. She was also the No. 45 recruit in the nation coming out of high school.

• She opened her collegiate career with 17 points, nine rebounds, four assists and two steals against Nicholls. Jordan earned AAC Freshman of the Week honors for her efforts.

• She followed that performance up with 20 points, five rebounds, three assists and two steals at South Alabama. The freshman guard shot 2-3 from behind the arc and 4-4 from the charity stripe in Mobile, Ala.

• Jordan was named player of the week from the AAC on Dec. 14.

• The standout freshman earned her third AAC Freshman of the Week Award on Jan. 4, after logging 15 points, three rebounds and three steals in the win over Memphis.

• The New Orleans native earned her fourth Freshman of the Week Honor after tying her career-high with 22 points in the win at Tulsa. She had a career day shooting going 8-9 from the field and 4-4 from three against the Golden Hurricane.

LISA STOCKTON

HEAD COACH • 27th SEASON

Wake Forest, 1986 • Greensboro, N.C. • Career Record: 599-324

Head Coach Lisa Stockton will embark upon her 27th season at the helm of the Tulane women's basketball program for the 2020-21 campaign and 30th overall as a head coach.

Stockton's career record of 599-324 as a collegiate head coach is good for a .649 winning percentage and she is 536-297 (.643) during her time at Tulane, including a 246-174 (.586) mark in conference play. In 2018, Stockton won her 500th game as the head coach of the Green Wave when Tulane defeated Nicholls 71-46 on December 4.

She is among the top 50 winningest college women's basketball coaches of all time and 19th among active coaches heading into the 2019-20 season.

Stockton has led the Green Wave to the postseason 18 times (11 NAAs, 7 WNITs) and claimed conference Coach of the Year honors three times (Metro in 1995, C-USA in 2007 and 2010). In addition, Tulane has won four C-USA regular-season championships (1996-97, 1998-99, 2006-07, 2009-10) and the C-USA tournament title on five occasions (1997, 1999, 2000, 2001, 2010).

Stockton is one of three active coaches to take a Top 50 academic institution as listed in U.S. and World Report to at least 11 NCAA Tournaments, joining Tara Vanderveer of Stanford and Muffet McGraw of Notre Dame. North Carolina's Sylvia Hatchell was part of the group prior to her retirement. In addition, 20 of her players have become members of Tulane's 1,000-Point Club.

Taking the reins of a program that had never been to the NCAA Tournament and whose only postseason appearance came via the WNIT the year prior to her arrival, Stockton made her presence at Tulane felt right away. Her 1994-95 club went 19-10 overall and 9-3 in the now-defunct Metro Conference. The Green Wave's league record was good for second-place in the final Metro standings – a high-water mark for the program – and Stockton's team earned an at-large bid to the NAAs.

Tulane's trip to "The Big Dance" was the first of nine consecutive NCAA bids for Stockton-coached teams and the first of nine straight winning seasons. A year later, a 21-10 record in 1995-96 was the first of what has now become 15 straight 20-plus win seasons with the Green Wave including a school-record 27 wins in 1996-97 and again in 1999-2000.

While the postseason streak was snapped in 2004, Stockton reloaded her team for success with the addition of four freshmen to an already young-but-talented squad that did not feature a senior on the active roster for the 2005-06 season. As the Tulane student-body began the move-in process for the school year, however, the Tulane community, the New Orleans area and the Gulf Coast region was rocked to its core as Hurricane Katrina made landfall on Aug. 29, 2005, and the subsequent floodwaters consumed the area.

Relocated to Lubbock, Texas, and the campus of Texas Tech University for the semester, Stockton's Green Wave finished what has become known as the "Katrina Season" 15-12 and sparked a run of 12 straight winning seasons that remained alive until 2017-18.

The following year, Stockton's troops went 26-7, won the C-USA regular-season title with a 13-3 league mark and returned to the postseason for the first time since 2003 as Tulane advanced to the second round of the 2007 WNIT. Three years later, the Green Wave won another C-USA regular-season crown with a 12-4 conference record, finished the year 26-7 overall and returned to the NCAA Tournament. In each of the next two seasons, Stockton guided the Green Wave to 23-11 overall record, advanced to the C-USA Championship games and a trip to the second round of the 2011 and 2012 WNIT. In 2013, the Green Wave finished 24-9 and accomplished a program first when they advanced to the round of 16 in the WNIT.

The Green Wave closed out their tenure with C-USA in 2014, as Coach Stockton recorded a final tally of 397 total victories while in the league, which stood as a C-USA best.

The 2014-15 season issued in a new era for Stockton and the Green Wave, competing in the American Athletic Conference for the first time. Tulane responded with a 22-11 overall record, a run to the semifinals in the conference tournament, and ended the program's five-year NCAA Tournament drought, traveling to Durham for a first round match-up vs. Mississippi State, marking the program's 11th NCAA Tournament appearance. The 2014-15 season also witnessed Coach Stockton capture her 500th career victory, as she became the 32nd active Division-I women's basketball coach to reach the prestigious 500-win club.

In 2015-16, the Wave's 23-12 record resulted in a WNIT berth which led to a run to the third round, they made their second straight American Conference Tournament semifinal, handed No. 1 UConn its largest deficit of the season, went 3-0 against SEC competition and tied the program record for most wins at home with 14.

In 2016-17 the Green Wave took a strength of schedule ranked 35th in the country and went 18-15 overall, achieving their 12th straight winning season and eighth consecutive trip to the postseason. In addition, Stockton's Green Wave once again tied its longest run in the WNIT by reaching the third round, produced their ninth straight year with 10 or more wins at home (12-5) and most notably took a 100-game win streak team in No. 1 UConn to its limit with a 63-60 loss - marking the second closest any team had gotten to the upset and closest any American squad had gotten, besting USF's 16-point loss in January of 2016.

Tulane's eight-year postseason streak came to an end in 2017-18, but the campaign was highlighted by the individual excellence of guard Kolby Morgan. Finishing out her career, Morgan eclipsed 2,000 points and scored 600 points for the third straight year, becoming the first Green Wave player to ever do that. Morgan ended her career ranking second in points in team history and first in games started, field goals made and field goals attempted. She was named LSWA First Team All-State for the second straight year and Second Team All-AAC for the third straight year.

The Green Wave got better in 2018-19 but just missed out on a postseason berth in Stockton's 25th year as head coach. Still, progress was evident as sophomore Krystal Freeman went from little-used freshman to the American Athletic Conference's Most Improved Player after racking up 14.4 points and 7.5 rebounds per game. She was also named Second Team All-Conference, and Dynah Jones was on the All-Freshman Team and Sierra Cheatham won the program's first Ambassador Award. Stockton won her 500th career game at Tulane in December when the Green Wave defeated Nicholls.

Tulane posted the best conference start in program-history winning the first six games in American Athletic Conference play in the 2019-20 season. Freeman's performance continued to improve as she led the team with 15.0 points and 7.7 rebounds. She was named Second Team All-Conference, while Jones collected Sixth Player of the Year honors. Cheatham became the first player in conference history to win the Ambassador Award twice.

While team success has been the ultimate goal for Stockton and the Green Wave since the 1994-95 season, individual recognition has been a mainstay at Tulane during that time as well. In 25 years under its current head coach, Tulane has seen 25 different student-athletes earn all-conference honors 41 times (nine first-team, 18 second-team and 14 third-team) and 12 receive All-Freshman recognition.

In addition, Stockton's players have earned conference Defensive Player of the Year (Janell Burse/C-USA/1999,2000,2001), Sixth Player of the Year (Burse/C-USA/1999, Grace Daley/C-USA/1997, Teana McKiver/C-USA/2001) and Freshman of the Year (Barbara Farris/Metro/1995, Daley/C-USA/1997, Danielle Blagg/C-USA/2012) on three occasions each, as well as Player of the Year (Burses/C-USA/2000), Newcomer of the Year (Indira Kaljo/C-USA/2009), Most Improved Player (Krystal Freeman/AAC/2019) once apiece. At the 10th anniversary of Conference USA in 2005, Burse and Daley were named to C-USA Team of the Decade, making Tulane one of two schools to have multiple players on the prestigious list.



Tulane student-athletes have also garnered national honors under Stockton's watch as well as Farris (1987), Daley (1998-2000), Burse (2000-01), McKiver (2002-03) and Jamie Kaplan (2013-14) all earned All-America recognition. Ashley Langford was a Freshman All-American in 2006 and Chassity Brown was named to the WBCA All-Region IV Team in 2010. In addition, seven of Stockton's former student-athletes – Burse, Daley, Farris, McKiver, Montagnino, Langford and Slaughter – have been elected into the Tulane Athletics Hall of Fame.

For some of Stockton's prized pupils, success on the court did not end once their collegiate eligibility expired. Five former Green Wave standouts have gone on to play in the WNBA – including Farris and Burse who won WNBA Championships with the Detroit Shock in 2003 and Seattle Storm in 2004, respectively – and many more have enjoyed pro playing careers overseas.

But what Stockton may be most proud of is her student-athletes' collective accomplishments in the classroom as every four-year player has completed their degrees under her watch.

Forty-three women's basketball players earned C-USA Commissioner's Honor Roll recognition 93 times for holding GPAs of 3.2 or higher since the 1995-96 season. Six student-athletes – Brooke Blankenship ('10-'11, '11-'12, '13-'14), Kiki Cizmar ('96-'97), Jamie Kaplan ('12-'13, '13-'14), Courtnee Latham ('13-'14), Gwen Slaughter ('02-'03), Britt Thomann ('99-'00, '00-'01, '01-'02, '02-'03), Christy Thomaskutty ('95-'96) and Leslie Vorpahl ('13-'14) – claimed C-USA Commissioner's Academic Medal honors for maintaining at least a 3.75 GPA. Ashley Langford ('08-'09) and Jami Montagnino ('06-'07) were named C-USA Scholar Athletes, and Thomann earned a C-USA Postgraduate Scholarship in 2003.

Furthermore, after joining The American, Stockton's point guards have shone the brightest after collecting the American Scholar-Athlete Award twice in the past five years, courtesy of Leslie Vorpahl (2017) and Jamie Kaplan (2015). Kaplan was also named a Senior CLASS First Team All-American for her body of work both on and off the court. In 2019, Sierra Cheatham earned the league's Ambassador Award for tremendous contributions to the community.

Stockton's impact has not been limited to her players, however, as four former assistant coaches at Tulane went on to become collegiate head coaches: Katie Meier (Charlotte and Miami [Fla.]), Kellie Kennedy (Loyola-New Orleans), Michele Savage (Davidson) and Jenny Yopp (Portland State and Illinois State).

While Stockton's teams and student-athletes have achieved success both on the court and in the classroom, these accomplishments are nothing that the head coach herself did not earn while she was a collegiate player.

Following a standout prep career at Western Guilford High School, Stockton packed her bags for Wake Forest University. During her four-year career with the Demon Deacons from 1983-86, she set the school's career records in scoring (1,347), scoring average (12.1 ppg), field goals made (592), field goals attempted (1,262), field goal percentage (.462), assists (330), steals (206) and minutes played (3,385).

Stockton still holds the Wake Forest record for consecutive games started with 97 and still ranks in the top 10 for points, made field goals, assists and steals. As a senior during the 1985-86 season, Stockton was named honorable-mention Fast Break All-American after scoring 473 points and hitting 204-of-415 shots (.491), pulling down 94 rebounds, dishing out 97 assists and tallying 58 steals.

She was named ACC Player of the Week and claimed MVP honors of the Dartmouth Tournament as a junior and was named MVP of the James Madison Invitational and of the Demon Deacon team as a senior.

Stockton earned a spot on the ACC Academic Honor Roll following each of her final two seasons at Wake Forest and graduated cum laude with a bachelor's degree in health and sports science in 1986.

She was drafted by the National Women's Basketball Association following her senior season but chose instead to begin her coaching career as a volunteer assistant at the University of North Carolina for the 1986-87 season where she helped the Tar Heels go 19-10 overall, finish third in the ACC with a 9-5 league record and advance to the second-round of the NCAA Tournament. Stockton also enveloped herself in post-graduate studies and completed her master's degree in 1987.

From there, Stockton accepted her first collegiate head coaching position at Division III Greensboro College. In three seasons there, she helped guide the Pride to a combined 63-27 record. Along the way, six players earned all-conference honors, including first-team selections Lorraine Orr and Susan Gasperson in 1987-88, Gasperson in 1988-89, and Tara Thompson in 1989-90.

She returned to the Division I level the following year when she accepted the top assistant position at Georgia Tech where she was responsible for coordinating recruiting efforts, monitoring academic progress, supervise scheduling and coaching the offense. In four years with Stockton on the staff in Atlanta, the Ramblin' Wreck combined to go 63-52, including a 20-13 mark in 1991-92 when North Carolina won the WNIT. The following season, Georgia Tech went 16-11, finished tied for fourth in the ACC with an 8-8 league record and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in school history.

Along with her Coach of the Year accolades, Stockton was named one of CitiBusiness' Women of the Year in 2007. She is a member of the NCAA Women's Basketball Issues Committee and also serves on the Academic Subcommittee for the issues committee. Stockton has also served two terms on the Kodak All-American Committee, twice chaired the C-USA Women's Basketball Coaches and served four terms as the WBCA Conference Captain.

In her 25 seasons, Stockton has built Tulane into a winning program with victories over ranked programs, tournament championships and a succession of All-Americans and future professional players piling wins on top of wins.
