NOTABLE RETURNERS

OFFENSE:

■ Sophomore quarterback **Byrum Brown** set numerous USF season passing records in 2023, including yards (3,292), touchdowns (26) and completion percentage (64.6%). He also ran for a team-best 809 yards and 11 touchdowns, joining Heisman winner Jayden Daniels as the only FBS players to pass for 3,000 and run for 800 yards.

■ Wide receiver **Sean Atkins** (2nd TM All-AAC) had a monster 2023, setting USF records with 92 receptions for 1,054 yards and seven touchdowns. He made six or more catches in each of the last eight games and had 90+ yards in five games.

■ Senior running back **Nay'Quan Wright** ran for a career-best 797 yards, eight touchdowns and three 100-yard games. Senior **Kelley Joiner Jr.** has three 100-yard games on his career while running for 1,412 yards on his career. Senior **K'Wan Powell** ran for 215 yards and a touchdown last year.

■ Offensive line stalwarts **Mike Lofton** (C, 16 career starts), **Derek Bowman** (RT, 12 starts), **Zane Herring** (HM All-AAC, RG, 12 starts), **Andrew Kilfoyl** (LG, 7 starts), **R.J. Perry** (T, 5 starts) and **Cole Skinner** (LG, 4 starts) all return with considerable experience from last season - with Skinner, Lofton, Herring and Bowman all starting the last four games.

DEFENSE:

■ Linebacker **Jhalyn Shuler** (HM All-AAC, 13 starts, 97 tck, 8.5 TFL) was the Bulls' leading tackler in 2023 in his first season of extensive action, while **Mac Harris** (33 tck, 4.5 TFL) and **DJ Gordon** (58 tck, 9 TFL, 3.5 sacks) saw extensive action and starts.

■ Cornerbacks **Aamaris Brown-Bunkley** (HM All-AAC, 40 tck, 2 INT) is the Bulls most experienced returner with 23 career starts. Sophomore corner **Tavin Ward** (38 tck, 2 INT) showed well in five starts in his first season of action.

■ Safeties **Logan Berryhill** (11 starts, 56 tck, 3 INT) and **Jaelen Stokes** (11 starts, 61 tck, 2 INT) were reliable and often dynamic in their first seasons as starters in 2023.

■ Outside linebackers/edge rushers **Tramel Logan** (10 starts, 33 tck, 8 TFL) and **D.J. Harris** (7 starts, 35 tck, 3 TFL) are coming off career-best years, Logan tied a USF record with three touchdown returns for touchdowns (2 fumbles and an INT). USF also welcomes the return of **Jason Vaughn** (2022: 7 starts, 35 tck, 8.5 TFL, 5 sacks) from a season-ending injury early in the 2023 season.

■ Senior defensive tackle **Rashad Cheney** (HM All-AAC, 12 starts, 42 tck, 8.5 TFL) has become a stalwart up the middle and a defensive leader with 18 starts in the last two seasons. He was joined by **Doug Blue-Eli** (19 tck, 3 TFL), who started 12 games at nose in 2023.

SPECIAL TEAMS:

■ Senior punter **Andrew Stokes** had a career-best year in 2023, averaging 41.3 ypp on 56 attempts and has punted in three seasons for the Bulls. Kicker **John Cannon** went 11-16 on field goal attempts, with a 45-yard long, and 52-52 on extra points.

SIGNIFICANT LOSSES

OFFENSE:

■ Left tackle **Donovan Jennings** started 45 career games and played in a USF record 55 while providing leadership.

■ Wide receiver **Khafre Brown** had 27 catches for 435 yards and five touchdowns in 2023, to rank fourth on the team.

■ Running back **Michel Dukes** had 63 carries for 350 yards and two touchdowns to rank third on the team.

DEFENSE:

■ Safety **Daquan Evans** (25 career starts) was a dynamic playmaker at nickel, leading the team with 14 TFL and four sacks and ranking second with 63 tackles and adding an INT.

■ Defensive lineman **Jonathan Ross** (3 starts) excelled down the stretch in 2023 and finished with 47 tackles, 6.5 TFL and two sacks.

QB • #17 BYRUM BROWN • 6-3 • 221 • JR. - 8TH IN NCAA/2ND AAC IN TOTAL OFFENSE (315.5)

★ 7TH IN QB RUSHING IN NCAA; 8TH NCAA/1ST AAC IN POINTS RESPONSIBLE FOR (17.4)

'23 Season Stats: PASSING: 3,292 yards, 26 TD, 11 INT, 64.6% ; **RUSHING:** 809 yards, 11 TD, 4.0 ypc

- Joined Heisman Trophy winner Jayden Daniels as the only players to pass for 3,000 and run for 800 yards in 2023.
- His 4,101 total yards and 37 total touchdowns accounted for in 2023 both rank second all-time at USF.
- Set USF season records for passing yards, touchdowns and completion percentage.
- Tied a USF record (Quinton Flowers) with four 300+ passing games in the 2023 season, and set a USF record passing for 435 yards (22-of-29) and two TD vs. Rice (9.23)
- His 517 total yards at Rice rank as the second-most in USF history, joining Quinton Flowers (rec: 605 at UCF in 2017) as the only players in USF history to achieve the mark.
- Went 31 of 39 (79%) for 357 yards (2nd most in career) with five passing TD at Memphis (11.2), which tied the 21-year-old program record for passing TD in a game held by Marquel Blackwell. Also ran for 100 yards to give him 457 total yards in the game.
- Led USF with 809 rushing yards in 2023. Has four career 100-yard rushing games - three coming in the 2023 season, including 160 yards at Western Kentucky (9.2), 136 at UAB (10.7) and 100 at Memphis (11.4). Had a 60-yard rushing TD at UAB, the fifth-longest rushing TD by a USF QB.
- Trailing 21-10 in the 4th qtr at UConn (10.21), Brown drove the Bulls 75 yards for a score, going four-for-four (54 yards) in the air and rushing for 12 yards and a score on the ground. On the next offensive drive, Brown drove USF 90 yards to score and take the lead, with four completions on six attempts for 42 yards.
- Led USF to its first road win in four years, passing for 338 yards, 3 TD, 76% completion percentage at Navy (9.30) while leading five TD drives of 67+ yards after trailing 14-0.
- Honored by the AAC SIX times on the year - twice earning Player of the Week and four times being named to the Weekly Honor Roll.

RB • #5 NAY'QUAN WRIGHT • 5-9 • 206 • GR. - 7TH AAC IN RUSH YARDS (797)

- Bulls second-leading rusher in 2023 with a career-best 797 yards and 4.4 ypc. Owns three career 100-yard rushing games.
- Posted 26 carries for a career-high 186 yards (team high on season) and a career-high two rushing D at UConn (10.21).
- Ran 15 carries for 106 yards vs. FAU (10.14) and 111 yards on 17 carries (6.5 ypc) in the USF season-opener at WKU (9.2).
- Transferred from Florida to USF in Spring of 2023 after earning his bachelor's degree at UF in the Fall of 2022.
- Played in four seasons and 33 games at Florida: 189 carries for 753 yards and 5 TD rushing, 35 receptions for 415 yards.

- Set USF season records for receptions and yards, becoming the program's first 1,000-yard receiver.
- Former walk-on, he was a Burtsworth Trophy semifinalist in 2023 and entered the 2023 season with 29 career catches in four seasons.
- Posted two 100-yard receiving games and six games with 89+ yards in 2023 season.
- Had 4+ catches in every game, 6+ in each of his last eight and totaled eight games with 7+ receptions.
- Hauled in seven catches for 61 yards vs. Charlotte (11.25) and threw his first career TD on hook-and-ladder that went for 62 yards to RB Kelley Joiner Jr..
- Career-best 169 yards on 9 catches vs. Temple (11.11); 9 receptions for 89 yards and a TD at Memphis (11.3); at UTSA (11.17) had career-best 10 catches for 92 yards.
- Recorded 116 yards and two TD on four catches at Navy (9.30), including an 88-yard TD from QB Byrum Brown.
- A former quarterback, wide receiver and safety in high school, Atkins is 4-for-4 in his career passing for 149 yards with one TD (62 yards vs. Charlotte in 2023) and has a pass efficiency rating of 568.4. In 2023 he had completions of 62 (TD), 39, 27 and 21 yards and also has two career two-point conversion completions.

'23 Season Stats: 39 catches, 637 yards, 5 TD, 16.3 ypc, 49.0 ypg - Ranked 12th in the AAC in receiving yards, 2nd on team receiving yards and receptions in 2023.

- Set the all-time USF single game receiving yard record with eight catches for 272 yards and one TD vs. Rice (9.23), the second most receiving yards in AAC history and the most ever by a state of Florida FBS college player, breaking a mark set in 1968.
- An all-NEC transfer from FCS Wagner University, made 72 receptions for 1,067 yards and seven TD in two seasons.
- Led Wagner with 50 catches for 796 yards (72.36 ypg) and six TD in 2022. • Has never eaten red meat (beef or pork) in his entire life.

OFFENSIVE PRODUCTION RETURNS

Led by the return of 3,000-yard passer Byrum Brown and 1,000-yard receiver Sean Atkins, the Bulls return the bulk of their offensive production from 2023:

- Return 100% of passing yards (3,494), 85% of rushing yards (2,023), 84% of receiving yards (2,947) from the 2023 season.
- Return top passer, top rusher and seven of the top eight, top receiver and eight of the top nine, four offensive line starters and six players that started at least four games in 2023 on the line.

In its first season in Alex's Goleth's uptempo offense and with a first year starting quarterback in Byrum Brown, USF still led the nation running 82.1 plays per game - the only team in the nation to run more than 80 a game - and set 12 team and 16 individual USF records

- The next closest programs in plays run were North Texas (79.3), Clemson (78.2) and Jacksonville State (78.0).
- USF set a program record for total plays (1,028) on the season and ran 80+ plays in six games, including a season-high 95 at Western Kentucky.
- Among the offensive team records set were most pass yards (3,494), most touchdown passes (27), best completion percentage (64.1%) and most completions (287).
- Among 16 individual records and another 11 notable marks that registered in the top three all-time, included season records for passing yards (3,292), touchdown passes (26) and season completion percentage (64.6%) from redshirt freshman quarterback Byrum Brown and season receptions (92) and receiving yards (1,054) marks from wide receiver Sean Atkins.
- USF's 5,871 offensive yards rank as the third-best total in program history, while its 415 points in 2023 stand fifth.

ARCHIE ON THE MOUND

Quarterback Bryce Archie, a standout pitcher in high school who had multiple DI offers to pitch and played for the Georgia Jackets Club Team, became a dual-sport athlete at USF this spring when he joined the baseball team. Touching 94-96 mph with his fastball, Archie struck out the first batter he faced in a contest vs. Marist on Feb. 25 on three pitches, including a curveball for the strikeout, and retired three batters in the inning. Through March 9, he had pitched 3.1 innings in relief and recorded three strikeouts as USF won three of his four appearances.

OFFENSIVE LINE STARTS RETURN

- USF returns 66 of a possible 78 starts (84%) from 2023 across the offensive line and tight end positions, losing one significant starter in left tackle Donovan Jennings (10 starts in 2023/ 45 career).
- The Bulls return five primary starters at five of the six positions, including LG Andrew Kilfoyn (7), C Mike Lofton (13), RG Zane Herring (12), RT Derek Bowman (12) and TE Weston Wolff (10).
- They add to that T/G RJ Perry (5), LG Cole Skinner (4) and TE Gunnar Greenwald (1) who all saw starts in 2023.
- Five of the six starters from the Boca Raton Bowl return.

NOTABLE ADDITIONS

• Abdur-Rahmaan Yaseen, WR, 6-2, 200, Gr.

- A former four-star recruit, Yaseen transferred to USF after four seasons at Purdue that saw injuries slow his career. Appeared in 18 games for the Boilermakers, making 34 catches for 456 yards, including a 10 catch, 114-yard outing vs. Syracuse in 2023.

• Jonathan Echols, TE, 6-6, 225, Fr.

- Rated a four-star recruit by 247Sports and Rivals. As a senior in 2023 at IMG Academy, hauled in 14 receptions for 232 yards and four touchdowns and made a name posting a laser-timed 4.8 in the 40-yard dash.

• Junior Uzebu, OL, 6-6, 330, Gr.

-Comes to USF having seen action in three seasons at Vanderbilt, including five starts in 2022, and five seasons of collegiate experience at West Virginia and Vanderbilt.

DEFENSIVE PRODUCTION RETURNS

USF returns nine primary starters from the 2023 season on defense, including 10 that started the Boca Raton Bowl, and 12 players that started a game in 2023

- The Bulls return 74% of their tackles (659/888), 70% of tackles for loss (68.5/98), 72% of sacks (16.5/23), 86% of interceptions (12/14), 90% of fumble recoveries (9/10) and 86% of forced fumbles (6/7) from the 2023 season.

ATTACK MODE

An aggressive defense under first-year defensive coordinator Todd Orlando in 2023 saw USF's tackle for loss total jump to 98 from 63 (+36) and sack total to 23 from 14 (+9) over the Bulls 2022 totals. USF ranked 7th in FBS and 2nd in the AAC in tackles for loss, posting 7.5 tpg.

- Six Bulls posted 6.5 TFL or more on the year led by S Daquan Evans' 14. Four of the Bulls top six leaders in TFL in 2023 return, led by LB DJ Gordon (9), LB Jhalyn Shuler (8.5), DT Rashad Cheney (8.5) and OLB Tramel Logan (8).
- The Bulls return 70% (68.5) of their TFL from last season.

LOGAN IN THE ENDZONE

Outside linebacker Tramel Logan tied for the national lead in defensive touchdowns scored in 2023 with three, tying a USF program record set in 2007.

- Logan scored on a 61-yard fumble return in the Boca Raton Bowl vs. Syracuse, a 70-yard fumble return at Navy and a 22-yard interception return vs. Temple.
- His 131 fumble return yards in 2023 set a new program record.
- Only 14 teams had more defensive TD in 2023 than Logan and he had more than 105 of 133 FBS teams in 2023
- Oklahoma's Billy Bowman (3 INT TD) and Washington State's Jackson Brennan (3 Fumble return TD) equaled Logan's total in 2023.

DEFENSIVE LINE & LINEBACKER STARTS RETURN

Led by veteran graduate Rashad Cheney (12) and senior Doug Blue-Eli (12) on the interior line, USF returns 42 of a possible 52 starts from 2023 along the defensive tackle, nose, end and B-Backer (OLB) on the defensive line. Joining Minnesota transfer Cheney and TCU transfer Blue-Eli, OLB Tramel Logan (10), OLB D.J. Harris (7) and DT Immanuel Hickman (1) all saw starts in 2023.

- At linebacker, the Bulls return 26 of 26 starts from 2023 at the two linebacker positions, led by Jhalyn Shuler (13), Mac Harris (6) and DJ Gordon (6). Shuler (97/8.5 TFL) and Gordon (58/9 TFL) ranked 1st and 4th on the Bulls in tackles, respectively, and 3rd and 2nd in TFL.
- Shuler played just 20 snaps in the 2022 season, his first at USF, before his break-out first year as a starter in 2023.

SOLID AT SAFETY

The Bulls return primary starting safeties Logan Berryhill (11 starts, 56 tackles) and Jaalen Stokes (11 starts, 61 tackles) from 2023. Berryhill led the team with three interceptions, while Stokes had two interceptions, a forced fumble and a fumble recovery.

- Both saw the first extensive action of their career as position players in 2023.

BUILDING ON MOMENTUM

Alex Golesh was named USF sixth head coach in December of 2022 and posted a remarkable first season:

- Wrapped-up a record-breaking resurgence in 2023 with a 45-0 victory over Syracuse in the Boca Raton Bowl that stands as the only FBS bowl victory for a state of Florida program in 2023 and the largest shutout bowl victory in FBS history.
- The Bulls set 12 team records, five other significant marks ranked among the top five all-time, and 16 individual marks, and another 11 notable marks that registered in the top three all-time, during the 2023 season.
- Logged the program's highest ranked recruiting class in a decade (No. 48 by Rivals) and highest ranked of any program outside the autonomous "power" conferences.
- USF went 7-6, a program-best six-win improvement over 2022, and the second-best win improvement for any FBS program in 2023 behind Northwestern's seven-win improvement.
- USF also saw a 28 percent increase in home attendance (37,944 average is the best since 2018 and second-best since joining the AAC), led the AAC in home attendance.
- USF posted its first home winning record (4-2) since 2018, won its first bowl game since 2017, won its first road game in three years, and posted four conference wins, the program's most since 2017.
- The offense ranked No. 17 nationally producing 451 yards per game, produced five games of 40-plus points (the program's most since 2017), and the sixth 5,000-yard season in program history (first since 2018). USF's 5,871 offensive yards rank as the third-best total in program history, while its 415 points stand fifth.
- Recorded the program's first-ever 3,000-yard passer (Byrum Brown) and 1,000-yard receiver (Sean Atkins).
- College Football News named Alex Golesh among its Top 15 coaches of 2023 and a finalist for its annual Coach of the Year Award.

STATE OF FLORIDA BOWL WINS/AAC BOWL SUCCESS

USF's seventh bowl victory, the largest shutout in NCAA bowl history, put a stamp on a resurgent season with a 45-0 victory over Syracuse in the Boca Raton Bowl and stood as the only FBS bowl victory for a state of Florida program in 2023. Other bowl results from the state of Florida's four qualifying programs included losses by Florida State (13-1, lost 63-3 to Georgia in the Orange Bowl), Miami (7-6, lost 31-24 to Rutgers in the Pinstripe Bowl) and UCF (6-7, lost 30-17 to Georgia Tech in the Gasparilla Bowl).

- Fan Nation ranked USF as the No. 1 bowl win of 2023.
- The American Athletic Conference went 4-2 in bowl games in 2023.

WEIGHT GAINS

Quarterback Byrum Brown headlines several Bulls who made significant weight gains in the offseason as the junior added 12 pounds to go from 209 to 221 for 2024.

EARLY ENROLLEES

USF welcomed 18 early enrollees from the 2024 Class to campus in January. They have worked with the Bulls through winter workouts and will take the field during spring drills.

- Among the early enrollees are 6 transfers, five previously were at FBS programs.
- The bulk of early enrollees are on the defensive side of the ball, with 10 on defense (4 DB, 3 DL, 3 LB), seven on offense (3 WR, 1 QB, 1 RB, 1 TE, 1 OL) and one specialist (K).

2024 SIGNING CLASS LEADS ALL NON-POWER LEAGUE PROGRAMS

USF's 2024 Signing Class of 35 players (28 HS and JC/F D1 transfers), the first full-cycle class under head coach Alex Golesh stands as one of the best hauls of the last 15 years for a non-autonomous five program.

- The Bulls ranked No. 46 nationally in the 247Sports composite (after the late period) – USF's highest finish since 2014, when Willie Taggart's first full-cycle class ranked No. 42.
- USF's 2014 class produced three of the top players in school history: Quinton Flowers, D'Ernest Johnson and Marlon Mack.
- USF's 2024 Class ranking is the best of any program outside the Power Five conferences (with FIU at No. 56 the next closest) and ahead of – P5 programs: USC, Duke, Ole Miss, Maryland, Syracuse, Utah, UCLA, South Carolina, West Virginia, Indiana, Vanderbilt, Rutgers, Arizona, BYU, Oregon State.
- Since 2010, only seven mid-major programs have finished higher in the 247Sports rankings: 2011 TCU (28th), 2010 BYU (33rd), 2016 Houston (36), 2014 USF (42), and Cincinnati from 2020-22 (42nd, 45th and 42nd).
- The Bulls' average player rating by 247Sports was 85.14. The average rating is the best for USF since at least 2010. Only seven mid-major programs have fared better in that span.
- USF's 2024 Class received 197.92 points from 247Sports (the site combines quantity and quality to award points). That is the Bulls' best finish since at least 2010, and only three mid-majors have done better ('16 Houston, '11 TCU and '10 BYU).
- Four-star tight end Jonathan Echols of Bradenton's IMG Academy is USF's 10th-best signee of the modern recruiting era. Classmate Fred Gaskin ranks as the 19th-best.

2024 SCHEDULE

- The Bulls 2024 schedule features five teams that reached a bowl game in 2023, three teams that won 10 or more games and a 2023 CFP semifinal participant.
- Out of the gate strong, USF will play four of its first six games of 2023 against teams that played in a bowl game last year, three of which won 10 or more games.
- The Bulls non-conference schedule features a Week 2 game at 2023 CFP semifinalist Alabama (Sept. 7) and hosting Miami (Sept. 21) in Tampa. USF will play two road games in the non-con, at Alabama and at Southern Miss (Sept. 14)
- USF will open conference play on the road for the first time since falling at SMU (41-17) to open the 2021 AAC season. The Bulls are 1-2 in AAC road openers, winning at Cincinnati (45-20) in 2016.
- The Bulls will begin AAC play at Tulane, which went 11-3 (8-0 AAC) last year, has played in the last two conference championship games (winning in 2022) and posted a 15-1 record in AAC regular season games

the last two years.

- The Bulls first AAC home game will be vs. Memphis, the 2019 AAC champion. The Tigers went 10-3 (6-2 AAC) last year and downed Iowa State in the Liberty Bowl.
- The Bulls last six AAC games are against teams that all finished below .500 overall last year, two teams that went .500 in AAC play last year, and four that were below .500 in AAC play.

PASSING & FIRST DOWN DEFENSE, SACKS, REDZONE & SCORING DEFENSE EMPHASIS IN 2024

- The USF defense will have an emphasis in improving in several major areas to help improve its total defense ranking of 115th (432.5 ypg) and scoring offense from last year.
- USF stood 103rd in first down defense allowing 274 first downs last season.
- The Bulls ranked 129th in passing yards allowed in 2023, giving up 288.8 ypg. Meanwhile, the Bulls ranked 95th registering just 1.77 sacks per game in 2023.
- USF stood 74th in redzone defense, allowing 84.1 percent conversion, which helped correlate into a scoring defense that ranked 109th, giving up 32.2 ppg.
- Offensively, the Bulls ranked 17th nationally in total offense (451.6 ypg), but just 119th in the redzone, converting at 73.2 percent.

SUPER BULLS

BayMade Bulls Marquez Valdes-Scantling (St. Petersburg) and Austin Reiter (Bradenton) celebrated back-to-back Super Bowl titles with the Kansas City Chiefs dowing the San Francisco 49ers in overtime, 25-22, in Super Bowl LVIII.

- Valdez-Scantling (2016-17), a wide receiver who owned USF's single season receiving yards record (879) until Sean Atkins broke it this season, caught a big 16-yard touchdown pass that gave the Chiefs their first lead in the third quarter. He became the first Bull to score in the Super Bowl before finishing with three catches for 20 yards and a touchdown. Valdez-Scantling started 13 games on the year (playing in 20) and made 29 catches for 443 yards and two touchdowns.

- Reiter (2011-14), a former Chiefs starter and current reserve center, made his USF program-record fourth appearance on a Super Bowl team with the Chiefs (2019, 2020, 2022, 2023) and won his USF record third Super Bowl Championship (2019, 2022, 2023).
- Valdes-Scantling, who also won a Super Bowl with the Chiefs last season, joined Reiter and Jason Pierre-Paul (2012 N.Y. Giants, 2020 Tampa Bay) as the third Bull to win multiple Super Bowls. The victory by Reiter and Valdes-Scantling brought USF's number of Super Bowl titles won to 15 by 11 different players.
- For the 12th time in the last 14 Super Bowls, a USF player was a member of a team playing in the NFL's Big Game. The Bulls have had a total of 15 players on Super Bowl teams, making 23 total appearances. Impressive numbers, considering USF just completed its 27th season playing football.

USF INVESTING MORE THAN \$366 MILLION IN FOOTBALL FACILITIES

Since 2021, USF has completed football facility projects or committed funding for projects totalling more than \$366 million.

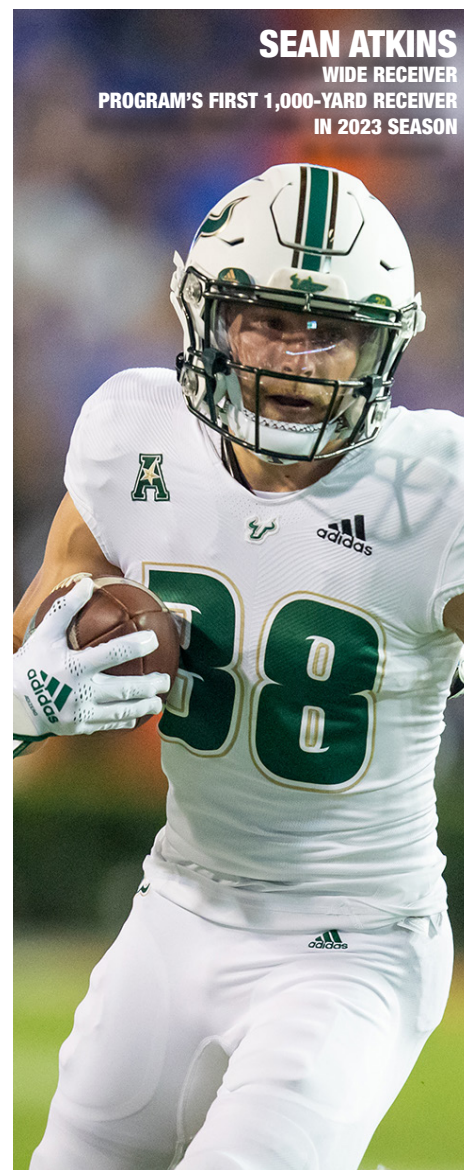

FOOTBALL & BASKETBALL POST LARGEST TURNAROUNDS IN NATION

In 2023-24, USF has made the biggest turnaround of any athletic department in the country in the programs of football and men's basketball, posting a combined 16-game improvement and major attendance gains in both - doing so under first-year head coaches Alex Golesh (FB) and Amir Abdur-Rahim (MBB).

- The combined 16-win improvement is the most in the FBS, two ahead of Appalachian State (14).
- USF football registered a 6-win improvement (7-6 from 1-11), the largest in program history and second only to Northwestern's 7-win improvement nationally.
- USF men's basketball posted a 10-game improvement (24-7 from 14-18), equaling the most wins in program history and among tied for the fourth-best among FBS programs in college basketball in 2023-24.
- USF football saw a 28% increase in average home attendance, up 8,294 per game to a 37,944 average over six home games, to rank second in FBS behind only Houston (41.8%), which move to the Big 12.
- The 8,294 per game increase was the highest outside of the power conferences and ranked sixth nationally.
- USF men's basketball saw three-straight sellouts over 10,000 at Yuengling Center (including a record crowd of 10,659) to fuel an increase of 1,990 in average attendance to 5,132. Only six schools nationally saw a bigger jump.
- The 63% rise in men's basketball attendance is tied for 13th nationally, with only California (112%) ranking higher among FBS programs.
- USF is the ONLY FBS school with at least a 5,000-average football attendance increase and 1,500-average basketball attendance increase. Colorado is the only other school that came close (1,178 increase in basketball and 10,333 in football).



USF JOINS ELITE AAU

Joining the AAU is a tremendous milestone as it formalizes USF's position as a leading research university. Founded in 1956, the university has rapidly evolved into a global powerhouse that transforms lives through education, research and innovation. USF, with campuses in Tampa, St. Petersburg and Sarasota-Manatee, is the first public university in Florida to be invited to join the AAU in nearly 40 years and is now one of only two institutions from the State University System of Florida to serve as an AAU member, joining the University of Florida.

■ USF is one of the youngest institutions to be welcomed into the AAU, a reflection of the university's fast rise. It joins the ranks of prestigious universities, such as Harvard, Yale, MIT, Stanford, Princeton, Florida, UCLA, Ohio State and Michigan. Of the association's now 71 members, USF is the fifth youngest and one of only six AAU universities to be founded after 1950.

HEAD COACH ALEX GOLESH

2nd Season at USF/2nd Season Overall Ohio State, 2006

The son of Russian immigrant parents who worked his way through the collegiate coaching ranks with a blue-collar work ethic, Alex Golesh produced the greatest turnaround in USF program history in his first season, taking the Bulls from a 1-11 record before his arrival to a 7-6 mark and Boca Raton Bowl rout of Syracuse (45-0).

► It marked the fifth program he has helped create a major turnaround at in 21 seasons of collegiate coaching, serving on the staffs of eight FBS programs and leading one.

► Named the sixth head coach in USF football history on Dec. 4, 2022.

► His first full-cycle recruiting class at USF (Class of 2024) was the highest ranked for the program in a decade and the highest ranked of all non-autonomous league programs checking in at No. 46 on 247Sports, one of the best hauls of the last 15 years. He was also a key recruiter at several assistant coaching stops, helping lead program turnarounds at Tennessee, Iowa State, Illinois and Toledo.

► His first USF squad set 12 team and 16 individual records and his offense finished 2023 ranked No. 17 in total offense (451.6 ypg) and led the nation with 82.1 plays per game. In each of his three seasons as an offensive coordinator prior to arriving at USF, Golesh's offenses finished in the top 10 in scoring offense and total offense in FBS football each year.

NOTABLES

TENNESSEE OFFENSIVE COORDINATOR

► **2022 Broyles Award finalist** and **247 Sports Offensive Coordinator of the Year.**

► Led the nation's highest-scoring and most-explosive offense, having served two seasons as offensive coordinator/tight ends coach at the University of Tennessee (2021 & 2022).

► He helped propel the Vols from three wins (3-7) the season before his arrival to 10 wins and a No. 6 CFP ranking in 2022, implementing a tempo-based offense that led to dramatic improvement, shattered Vols' records and saw UT rank No. 1 in the nation in scoring (47.33), yards per game (538.1), points per possession (3.24) and yards per play (7.35) in 2022.

► Took Tennessee offense from No. 108 before his arrival to No. 7 (2021) to No. 1 (2022)

► His first Tennessee offense shattered eight team single-season records, including points (511), total offensive yards (6,174), touchdowns (67) and passing efficiency (167.10), and has surpassed all those marks again in 2022 with games remaining.

► Tennessee was the only team to average over 300 yards passing and 200 yards rushing on the 2022 season, and had scored 40-plus points in 15 of its 25 games since his arrival.

► Quarterback Hendon Hooker shattered Tennessee single-season records for completion percentage (68.0) and passing efficiency (181.41) in 2021 and surpassed the completion percentage mark in 2022 (69.6) while becoming a Maxwell Award finalist as the top player in college football.

► Tennessee's Jalin Hyatt became the first Tennessee player ever to win the Biletnikoff Award as the nation's top receiver in 2022.

► Golesh and the Vols improved a scoring offense that skyrocketed 107 spots from 108th in the country in 2020 to seventh in 2021 and first in 2022.

IOWA STATE

► Served as tight ends coach/recruiting coordinator for head coach Matt Campbell's first four seasons at Iowa State (2016-19) where he helped secure and develop the talent that led the Cyclones to a turnaround from a 3-9 season before their arrival to a run of five-straight bowl games (of which he was part of three) and an eventual 9-3, Fiesta Bowl season the year after his departure.

► Golesh helped secure the four highest-ranked recruiting classes in program history, with all four ranking in the top 50 and two in the top 40.

ILLINOIS

► While serving as a position coach (tight ends/running backs) and recruiting coordinator for four seasons at Illinois (2012-15), he helped the program go from two wins in his first season to back-to-back bowl games in his last two, and as tight ends coach/recruiting coordinator

TOLEDO

► Helped lead the Rockets from a 3-9 mark before his arrival to 8-5 and 9-4 campaigns in his last two years. Golesh aided the Toledo program in securing the No. 1 recruiting class in the Mid-American Conference in consecutive years (2010 & 2011) according to Rivals.com.

► Golesh also has coaching experience in the state of Florida, serving for one season as co-offensive coordinator/tight ends coach at UCF (2020) with Josh Heupel, where the Knights ranked second in FBS football in total offense (568.1).

USF UNVEILS FIRST ON-CAMPUS STADIUM RENDERINGS

The University of South Florida has revealed a first look at the university's transformational on-campus stadium by releasing three renderings of the new facility. Along with the images, USF released several new details about the stadium, including:

- An east-west build to help maximize shade for daytime events.
- A dedicated section for students in the west end of the stadium that includes a design unique to USF featuring Bull horns and amenities that will cater to the student experience.
- An open concourse around a majority of the stadium that provides views of the field, even as fans are walking to concession or restroom areas.
- A large tailgating space on the north side of the stadium.
- A variety of premium seating options, including suites, loge boxes and club areas.

■ USF also announced a \$6 million gift from the USF Federal Credit Union to name the walkway that will lead into the main entrance of the new stadium and will serve as home to the football team's traditional Bulls Stampede pregame walk from the buses into the stadium. USF will create signature signage at the entrance to the newly named USF Federal Credit Union Champions Way, located off USF Genshaft Drive. USF has now raised more than \$43 million of its \$50 million goal for the stadium project.

■ In an update to the USF Board of Trustees, the university confirmed that the stadium is scheduled to open in fall 2027. The timeline factors in current global supply chain issues and provides the flexibility to have a few months prior to the facility opening to the public to ensure stadium operations -- such as food service, ticketing and security -- are fully prepared to welcome and best serve fans from day one.

■ The Tampa General Hospital Center for Athletic Excellence, an operations facility that will be located adjacent to the new stadium, is scheduled to be ready by August 2026. The state-of-the-art building will serve as the daily home for the football and women's lacrosse teams.

USF FOOTBALL FACILITY IMPROVEMENTS

LOCKER ROOM & STAFF OFFICES

Entering the 2021 season, USF completed a \$3.3 million upgrade to its current football facilities, including:

- A completely renovated locker room featuring: 120 lockers, state of the art digital lighting and surround sound system, a team lounge with two 86" big screen TVs, video game console, pool table, ping-pong table and furnishings, a nutrition fueling station, new LED graphics and 55" monitors throughout.
- New entry ways, graphics and carpeting throughout the operations area.
- New team room graphics and chairs.
- Renovated coaches offices and staff rooms with new furniture, graphics and carpeting.

INDOOR PERFORMANCE FACILITY

USF completed an 88,000-square foot indoor facility at a cost of approximately \$22 million in 2022. It features a 100-yard turf field, climate control, sound system, branded lobby and observation deck. The Bulls began practicing in the facility on Nov. 9, 2022.

ON CAMPUS STADIUM/FOOTBALL CENTER

The USF Board of Trustees has approved \$340 million to build on-campus stadium -- which will also house a football operations and women's lacrosse operations center -- that will serve as a new home for USF football with coaches offices, meeting spaces, weight room, locker room, training and equipment areas and player lounge among the amenities. The stadium, which is slated for a capacity of 35,000, is targeted for completion in 2026.

REHABILITATION POOLS & COLD TUBS

USF renovated its rehabilitation pools and cold tub room with three new high tech pools for rehabilitation and a rebrand of the room in the spring of 2023.

WEIGHT ROOM

In this summer of 2023, USF unveiled a complete overhaul of the weight room in the Lee Roy Selmon Center at a cost of just under \$1 million. The project included all new Sorenex weight racks and equipment, branded weights and lift pads, LED lights and a large screen TV and a complete rebrand of the weight room and nutrition bar.
