### USF at a Glance

- The Dons saw their five-game winning streak come to an end on Saturday when they fell to host UC Santa Barbara 73-71 at the Thunderdome. The Dons two losses have come by a combined six points in 2018-19. They lost by four to No. 21 Buffalo (85-81).
- The Dons are 100-80 all-time against visiting Saint Mary's. The 180 games played is the second largest series in USF history. At home since World War II, the Dons are 41-26 (.612%) against the Gaels.
- In the latest NET rankings, the Dons fell from 25th to 40th. It is the first time this season they have been outside the Top-30. USF is second in the WCC according to the NET rankings and ranks higher than all 12 Pac-12 schools.
- The Dons are 9-0 at home this season, in the 60 year history of War Memorial Gym, the Dons have gone undefeated four times. USF's best season at their home building was in the 1980-81 season when the Dons went 18-0. Under head coach Kyle Smith, USF has gone 36-10 at home.
- The Dons had a season-high 17 offensive rebounds against UC Santa Barbara last Saturday. Unfortunately, the Dons could only convert those 17 offensive rebounds into 19 points, 10 of which occurred in the first 13 minutes of the contest.
- In the loss against UCSB on Saturday, the Dons received their first loss when leading at the intermission. The Dons are 12-1 when leading at the half. In the Kyle Smith era, the Dons are 49-8 when leading at halftime.
- For the second time this season, the Dons took the loss when scoring at least 70 points. Under Kyle Smith, the Dons have scored 70 or more points 55 times, they are 43-12 when scoring at least 70.

## Vs. SAINT MARY'S

### Series

Thursday night will be the 181st matchup between the Dons and Gaels. It is the second longest rivalry in USF history. All-time, USF owns a 100-80 advantage in the series that dates back to the 1930-31 season. In the first ever matchup, the Dons defeated the Gaels 37-23. Recent history has belonged to the Gaels however, who have won 24 of the last 26 contests. Last season, the series was split with the home team winning a contest. At War Memorial Gym the Dons are 32-26. The last time the Dons defeated the Gaels was on Feb. 15, 2018 when the Dons shocked No. 15 SMC 70-63 at War Memorial at the Sobrato Center.

### About the Gaels

The Gaels enter Thursday's contest with a 9-6 overall record but have won six of their last eight after losing four-straight earlier in the year. On the road this year they are 1-1, and 2-4 overall when not playing at McKeon Pavilion. SMC is averaging 77.3 points per game and holding opponents to 65.9. Leading the team in scoring is guard Jordan Ford who is averaging 22.7 points per game, he is one of two players averaging double figures for the Gaels. In their last time out, they defeated San Jose State 75-45 at home on Dec. 29.

### Last Time vs. SAINT MARY'S

Earlier in the 2017-18 season, the Gaels defeated the Dons 73-49 in Moraga. On Feb. 15 it was the Dons chance to turn the table. After trailing big early, the Dons went on a crucial run late in the first half to cut the deficit to three, 38-35, going into the locker room. From there the Dons outscored the Gaels 35-25 to complete the upset over the 15th ranked Gaels. Frankie Ferrari was tremendous in the contest, scoring a game-high 20 points while dishing out seven assists. He would go on to win WCC Player of the Week honors for his efforts.

Jimbo Lull and Jordan Ratinho were the other Dons to finish in double figures. Nate Renfro had three blocks, none bigger than his block on SMC center Jock Landale late in the second half that help put the game away for the Dons.

## What's a Don

"Don" is an acronym for **De Origen Noble**, which translates to "of noble origin" and is a Spanish title given only to a noble person of political, social or official distinction. The name references the early history of California and San Francisco, which was marked by the exploits of the adventuresome and swashbuckling Spanish Dons. All USF students and alumni are of noble origin who share in the long passion for learning in order to better understand the past, clarify the present and anticipate the future. Thus, we are proud to call ourselves the Dons. USF's mascot is named **Don Francisco**, in honor of **Don Francisco de Haro**, the first mayor of San Francisco.



## Head Coach Kyle Smith Hamilton College '92

This is Kyle Smith's third season as the head coach at USF and his ninth as a head coach. Following back-to-back 20 win campaigns, including two-straight trips to the post season, Smith signed a well earned contract extension that will keep him on the Hilltop well into the next decade.

In two years at the helm of the men's basketball program, Smith has exceeded even his own expectations. The Dons have gone 42-30 overall, including 19-17 in the West Coast Conference. His .583 winning percentage at the Hilltop is fifth-best in program history for a head coach through two seasons, topping Naismith Hall of Fame names such as Pete Newell (.509), Phil Wolpert (.400) and other legendary Dons' head coaches such as Pete Paletta (.509), Phil Vukicevich (.568), and Jim Brovelli (.410).

Smith's 42 wins after two seasons ranks fourth-most in USF history, behind Pete Berry (49 wins), Dan Belluomini (45 wins), and Bob Gaillard (43 wins). In posting back-to-back 20-win seasons, Smith becomes the first Dons head coach to accomplish that feat since the 1981-82 seasons. He has guided the Dons to consecutive postseason tournament appearances, the second culminating with the Dons' first postseason tournament championship appearance since USF took home the NCAA Championship in 1956.

Under Smith, the Dons have excelled in the classroom as well. They finished last fall with a team GPA of 3.36, including 12 players with GPAs of 3.0 or higher, and six who made the Dean's List. Nate Renfro turned in a 4.0 GPA for the Dons. Five current and past players have earned WCC All-Academic Honors in the last two seasons. The Dons have also been leaders in the community, annually partnering with E-Hoops, an inclusive basketball program that trains and develops kids through the game of basketball, including children with special needs.

## ASSISTANTS

Kyle Smith is pleased to bring back the core of his assistants who have helped the Dons win 43 games in two seasons. Associate head coach Derrick Phelps begins his fifth season on Kyle Smith's staff. Phelps works closely with USF's backcourt. A member of the North Carolina 1993 National Championship team, Phelps also takes a lead role in scouting and international recruiting. Associate head coach Todd Golden, a former standout player at Saint Mary's College returned to Smith's staff when he came out west. Prior to USF, Golden spent two seasons at Auburn under head coach Bruce Pear. Golden serves as USF's recruiting and defensive coordinator. In his third season at USF and seventh season under Smith is assistant coach Kevin Hovde. The Richmond graduate serves as the Dons offensive coordinator. In his first year with the program is Director of Operations Jonathan Safir. Prior to joining the Dons, Safir was a member of Columbia's coaching staff serving in the same role since 2016.

Thursday's game will be televised on ESPN2 with Dave Feldman and Caron Butler on the call. Fans can tune into 1550-AM The GAME, the official radio home of USF Dons Basketball to hear Pat Olson and Jim Brovelli call the action courtside.

### Last Time Out

On Saturday night the Dons traveled to Santa Barbara to face the Gauchos at the Thunderdome. The Dons led by as much as 10 midway through the first half but UCSB went on a big run at the end of the half to cut the Dons lead to one point, 39-38. Out of the break, the Dons offense could not get any momentum and the Gauchos owned the paint, scoring 38 point inside the key, going on to win 73-71. The Dons were led by Charles Minlend's 19. Nate Renfro and Matt McCarthy tallied double-doubles in the losing effort.

### This Date In Dons History

**Jan. 03, 2012** – The Dons catch fire from the field in an 87-74 win over Morgan State in a non-conference clash at War Memorial at the Sobrato Center. USF won its 10th non-conference game for the first time since 1999-00 when the Dons opened up play with a 12-1 record. Senior forward Angelo Caloiaro moved up two spots to No. 29 on the career scoring chart, finishing with 1,024, he had 19 that night.

### From the Free Throw Line

For the second consecutive game the Dons were active at the charity stripe. Against the Gauchos, USF went 22-for-33 from the free throw line, both are season-highs. For the year, the Dons are shooting 64.9 percent from the charity stripe, which is 10th in the conference. Leading the team at the line is guard Frankie Ferrari who is shooting 86.3 percent from the line.

### Historical Perspective on the Dons 12-1 Start

The Dons opened the year 12-1 before falling to UCSB last Saturday. The 12-1 start is one of the best in program history. Since World War II the Dons have started 12-1 or better through 12 games 10 times. Of the previous nine times eight have gone to the post season, of those eight seven advanced to the NCAA Tournament.

•From inside the arc, the Dons are shooting 56.9 percent from the floor which is 28th best in the nation according to Kenpom.com.

•The Dons have shot 50.0 or better six times this season - they managed to shoot 50.0 or better six times in 39 games in 2017-18. USF shot a season-high 54.8 percent against LIU Brooklyn.

## Scoring 70 or More Under Kyle Smith

In the Kyle Smith era, the Dons have scored 70 or more 55 times. In those contests they are 43-12. This season, the Dons are 10-2 when scoring 70 points. The Dons fell to UCSB (73-71) and No. 21 Buffalo (85-81) in their two losses this season when they score 70 or more.

## Bench Production

For the first time this season, the Dons were handed a loss when their bench outscored their opponents. USF is 10-1 this season when the bench outscored their opponent. The Dons' bench has scored 350 points this season, averaging 25.0 points per game. Matt McCarthy leads the Dons reserves, averaging 10.9 points off the bench.

## Spreading Out The Minutes

In the Kyle Smith era, the Dons have routinely spread out the minutes and utilized their entire bench. This year is no different. USF has eight players on its roster that have played 11 or more minutes with an additional six playing three or more minutes. Only one player on the roster is averaging more than 30 minutes per game and that's senior guard Frankie Ferrari at 31.4 minutes per contest.

## Home Sweet Home

The Dons are a perfect 9-0 at home this season, in the Kyle Smith era the Dons are 36-10. Last season, USF went 16-6 at home. At War Memorial Gym, which opened in 1958, the Dons are 609-254 (.706). USF has had four undefeated seasons at WMG, they set a program record going 18-0 in 1980-81.

## Non-Conference Record

The Dons 12-2 mark in non-conference play is their best finish in non-conference play in the Kyle Smith era. It also marks the top finish by wins and winning percentage since the 1999-00 team when USF wrapped up non-conference play 12-1. Under Smith, the Dons are 30-10 in non-conference play, they went 10-3 in '16-17, last year they went 8-3 in non-conference play.

## Ferrari Named to Senior Class Award Watch List

Senior guard Frankie Ferrari was selected as one of 30 candidates nationwide for the Senior Class Award List. The list of 30 will be whittled down to 10 finalists in February. Ferrari is off to a fantastic start this season, averaging 11.3 ppg and 6.6 assists per game. His assist to turnover ratio is currently ninth-best in the nation.

## Ratinho From 3

Junior guard Jordan Ratinho has made 35 3-point field goals this year, giving him 175 for his career. The 175 made 3-point field goals ranks fourth all-time at USF. Ahead of him is John Cox (1999-05) with 185 made threes. Ratinho set the USF single season record with 86 threes last year.

## Four in Double Figures

Through 14 games the Dons have four players in double figures. Leading the team is Charles Minlend at 15.3, followed by Frankie Ferrari at 13.3, Matt McCarthy (10.9) and Jordan Ratinho (10.6).

- At his current pace - Ratinho will finish the year with 368 points giving him 1,046, making him the 37th player in USF history to eclipse 1,000 points.

- Minlend has scored 10 or more in 13 of 14 contests this year, for his career he has 543 points in 47 contests.

## Dons 13th In Scoring Margin

The Dons are currently 13th in the nation in scoring margin at +184. This season the Dons have nine wins by 15 or more. They opened the year with four-straight wins by 32 or more.

## Dons On The Glass

The Dons have been stellar on the glass this season. USF is 16th in the nation in rebound margin at +8.6. USF is 11th in total rebounds (575), 24th in total rebounds per game (41.07), and 25th in defensive rebounds (29.64).

## Defending The Three

The Dons continue to put the clamps on opponents 3-point shooting this season. USF is currently 19th in the nation in 3-point field goal defense, holding their foes to 28.2 percent from beyond the arc.

## 92nd Season of Dons Basketball

The Dons first official season was in 1923-24 when they were known as "The Grey Fog." All-time, USF is 1377-1003 (.579 W-L%). The Dons didn't play basketball in the 1944-45 season and in 1982-83 and '83-84 seasons. The Dons have had 58 winning seasons, including 22 20-win seasons.

## Dons Picked to Finish Fourth in the WCC

For the second-straight year, the University of San Francisco men's basketball team was picked to finish fourth in the annual West Coast Conference Preseason Coaches' Poll. Gonzaga took home the top spot in the poll receiving nine first place votes for 81 points. In second was Saint Mary's with 68 points, followed by BYU with 67 points and the remaining first place vote. The Dons garnered 57 points, followed by San Diego (52), Pacific (39), Loyola Marymount (31), Pepperdine (22), Santa Clara (18) and Portland (15).

## Kyle Smith Earns Contract Extension

Back-to-back 20-win seasons for the first time since 1981-82 are exciting, but University of San Francisco men's basketball's head coach Kyle Smith knows that in the West Coast Conference, the teams that have had success are the ones with continuity. With that, Director of Athletics Scott Sidwell is pleased to announce the signing of Smith to a multi-year extension. In two years at the helm of the men's basketball program, Smith has exceeded even his own expectations. The Dons have gone 42-30 overall, including 19-17 in the West Coast Conference. His .583 winning percentage at the Hilltop is fifth-best in program

history for a head coach through two seasons, topping Naismith Hall of Fame names such as Pete Newell (.509), Phil Wolpert (.400) and other legendary Dons' head coaches such as Pete Paletta (.509), Phil Vukicevich (.568), and Jim Brovelli (.410). His

## Dons Return Loaded Squad

The Dons bring back a loaded squad for the 2018-19 season. USF returns four starters and 10 letterwinners from last year's team that won 22 games and advanced to the championship round of the CBI. Returning for the Dons is 66% of its scoring from last season, including four of its top six scorers. Highlighting that list of returners is senior guard Frankie Ferrari (446 pts), junior guard Jordan Ratinho (416 pts), Matt McCarthy (303 pts) and Nate Renfro (303 pts). The Dons also will get back sophomore Charles Minlend who redshirted last year.

## Kyle Smith Joins Elite Trio

Under second year head coach Kyle Smith, the Dons are have won 20-games in back-to-back seasons. Smith becomes just the fourth head coach USF's storied history to win 20 games in back-to-back years in his first two years on the Hilltop. Smith joins the trio of Bob Gaillard ('72-'73), Dan Belluomini ('79-'80), and Pete Barry ('81-'82).

## Beyond the Arc
