• In their last time on the hardwood, the Dons gritted out a 60-48 win over Cal Poly at home on the Hilltop on Thursday, Nov. 10. Dangerous on both ends of the floor, Khalil Shabazz finished with a game-high 18 points (6-13 FG, 2-7 3PT) in addition to adding seven rebounds, two assists and two steals in 37 minutes played as he was named Player of the Game. As a team, USF led Cal Poly in points in the paint (28-24), points off turnovers (20-14), second chance points (7-4), fast break points (18-4) and bench points (11-4) while also holding the Mustangs to 37.0 percent (17-46) from the field and 33.3 percent (3-9) from behind-the-arc.

• Through two games in the green and gold, Tyrell Roberts ranks second on the team in scoring with 14.5 points per game on 45.0 percent from the floor and 44.4 percent from downtown.

• Starting strong defensively, USF is holding their opponents to 38.1 percent shooting overall as a team while also forcing 34 turnovers across two games.

• For new head coach Chris Gerlufsen, Thursday's victory marked his second official win at the helm of the Dons.

HOW TO REFERENCE THE UNIVERSITY

We are the University of San Francisco, established by the Jesuits in 1855 as the first university in San Francisco.

When referencing the school and its teams, please use "The University of San Francisco," "San Francisco," "USF," or "The Dons."

DO NOT use "Frisco," "San Fran," "San Francisco University," "SFU" or any other iteration. Also, when referring our women's teams, **DO NOT** use "Lady Dons."

Chris Gerlufsen enters his first season as head coach of the Dons after being promoted on March 18, 2022.

Originally coming to the Hilltop in the summer of 2021 as the associate head coach on Todd Golden's staff, Gerlufsen serves as USF's primary offensive coordinator with a focus on working with the guards.

In 2021-22, USF grew into one of the elite offenses in the country as the Dons ranked in the top five in the West Coast Conference as a team in three-point field goal attempts (934, first), three-point field goals per game (9.6, first), total three-point field goals made (327, first), offensive rebounds (10.76, first), scoring offense (77.4, second), field goal percentage (45.7, fourth), free throws attempted (598, third), free throws made (415, third). Nationally, USF also ranked in the top fifty in three-point field goal attempts (thirteenth), total three-point field goals made (fourteenth), three-point field goals per game (sixteenth), scoring margin (twenty-eighth) and scoring offense (thirty-seventh). As a team, USF's 77.4 points per game were also the most for the green and gold since the 2015-16 season, when the Dons averaged 77.6 points under Rex Walters. On Wednesday, Dec. 28, 2021, USF broke the single-game program record for most three-pointers in a game with 20 made triples in a 111-78 win over Academy of Art.

Prior to USF, Gerlufsen served as the top assistant to head coach Eran Ganot at Hawaii from 2019-22. While at UH, he oversaw the guards and served as the Rainbow Warriors' offensive coordinator. He also served as the interim head coach for Hawaii's first 13 games in the 2019-20 season, leading UH to an 8-5 non-conference record, including an 85-75 upset win over previously undefeated USF.

Gerlufsen also previously spent four seasons as an assistant at San Diego from 2015-19, giving him familiarity with the West Coast Conference. During his time with the Toreros, USD experienced unprecedented success, posting back-to-back 20-win

seasons for the first time in program history while advancing to the postseason both years. He finished his run with the Toreros in 2018-19 with San Diego earning a berth to the NIT.

At USD, Gerlufsen also oversaw guards and served as offensive coordinator as he led USD's global recruiting efforts by signing more than a half dozen international players during his tenure. In his last two years at USD, he coached a trio of all-conference selections, including Isaiah Pineiro, Olin Carter III and Isaiah Wright.

Prior to USD, Gerlufsen spent nine seasons on the bench as an assistant the University of Hartford, with the last two seasons of which he served as associate head coach. While at Hartford, his primary responsibilities including working with both the perimeter and post players as well as serving as the staff's recruiting coordinator.

Gerlufsen also had stops at The Citadel (2001-'06), Southwestern (1999-'01) and got his start as an assistant coach at Washington College in Maryland in 1998-99.

Gerlufsen was a four-time letter winner for Randolph-Macon College, a Division III school in Virginia. While playing for the Yellow Jackets, he was named team captain for a squad that twice advanced to the NCAA Division III tournament. He graduated in 1998 with a B.A. in Business and Economics. He is a native of Philadelphia, PA.

• Handling their opponent with ease in their last outing, UC Merced rolled over West Coast Baptist College, 102-70, at home on Thursday, Nov. 10. In the win, Job Sighting led the Bobcats with a game-high 24 points and five assists while Braxton Bosher pulled down a game-high 10 rebounds.

• So far this season, UC Merced has defeated Bethesda and West Coast Baptist College while also falling to William Jessup and Menlo College.

• Individually, forward Kingsley Obiorah paces the team with 11.0 points per game to go along with 6.5 rebounds per game. Overall, the Bobcats are averaging 77.8 points per game as a team while shooting 43.9 percent from two and 30.0 percent from three. Additionally, the Bobcats average 42.0 rebounds and 14.0 assists per game through four contests.

NOTABLE**MEET THE NEWCOMERS:**

#1 Tyrell Roberts (Washington State)- Playing in 36 of 37 contests while starting 31 games for the Cougars last season, Roberts finished second on the team with 11.4 ppg in 2021-22. Overall, the versatile guard shot 92.5 percent (49-53) from the charity stripe to set a new single-season program record for free-throw percentage. During Washington State's run in this year's NIT, Roberts cashed in a career-best 7-of-16 from behind-the-arc in their opening round matchup against Santa Clara as the Sacramento native finished the tournament with fourteen made triples, the most all-time in a postseason appearance for WSU. In the classroom, Roberts was named to the Pac-12 Winter Academic Honor Roll.

#5 Saba Gigiberia (Georgia Tech)- Appearing in 15 games at Georgia Tech in 2021-22, the 7'1" center averaged 7.8 minutes, 2.5 points and 2.3 rebounds for the Yellow Jackets. On Jan. 19, 2022, Gigiberia received his first career start against Wake Forest, when he scored a career-high eight points in addition to logging a career-high 16:47 on the court. In 2020-21, Gigiberia played short minutes in eight games, with a high of 10:01 against Delaware State on Dec. 20, 2020. Originally from the Republic of Georgia, Gigiberia was a four-star post prospect who played his final two years of high school basketball in the United States. Known for his basketball IQ, Gigiberia can play with his back to the basket or facing the basket, with skills as a passer and ability to step out on the perimeter.

#10 Toni Rocak (UC San Diego)- Prior to coming to the Hilltop, Rocak was an All-Conference forward at UCSD as the big man earned All-Big West Honorable Mention honors last season after leading the Tritons in scoring (15.1 points per game) and rebounding (6.5 rebounds per game). In 2021-22, the versatile big man earned Big West Player of the Week twice and scored a career-high 34 points in UCSD's win over UC Santa Barbara on Dec. 30 -- the highest single game point total for any Big West player in 2021-22. As a junior in 2020-21, Rocak was recognized as the top sixth man in the Big West by HoopsHD.com as he led UCSD in scoring (12.8 points per game) and rebounding (5.3 rebounds per game) while also finishing fifth in the conference in field goal percentage (51.9 percent).

#55 Marcus Williams (Texas A&M)- This past season, Williams made 27 appearances for the Aggies on the hardwood, which included starting in 25 games. Overall, the versatile guard averaged 7.9 points, 3.4 assists, 2.2 rebounds and 1.3 steals in 24.4 minutes played. Notably, the highlight of his 2021-22 came in a road game at Georgia on Jan. 4, when Williams buried the game-winning triple with less than one second left on the shot clock to knock off the Bulldogs. Prior to transferring to Texas A&M, Williams was named the Mountain West Freshman of the Year in 2020-21 after an impressive debut season at Wyoming. Making a splash immediately, Williams was a finalist for the Kyle Macy National Freshman of the Year by College Insider as he appeared in all 25 games for the Cowboys, which included 24 starts. In his freshman season, Williams averaged 14.8 points per game to go along with 4.3 assists as his 14.8 points ranked eighth among freshmen in the nation while his 4.3 assists ranked fourth in the Mountain West. Displaying his dominance on offense, Williams scored in double figures in 21 games and had five contests in which he scored 20-or-more points.

2022-23 USF MEN'S BASKETBALL GAME NOTES

• Fresh off their first NCAA Tournament since 1998, the Dons are hungry to get back to the Big Dance after a successful season in 2021-22 that saw the green and gold compile a 24-10 overall record, including a 10-6 mark in West Coast Conference play.

• USF will return eleven letterwinners from the 2021-22 NCAA Tournament team: Khalil Shabazz, Julian Rishwain, Isaiah Hawthorne, Josh Kunen, Justin Bieker, Zane Meeks, Ndewedo Newbury, Bryce Whitaker, Jonas Visser, Volodymyr Markovetsky and Jake Cioe.

• Overall, head coach Chris Gerlufsen enters his first year at the helm of the green and gold after taking over for former USF head coach Todd Golden. Taking over the reins, Gerlufsen possesses a wealth of experience at the Division I level having made stops at Hawaii, San Diego, Hartford and The Citadel. Prior to coming to the Hilltop, Gerlufsen served as the top assistant to head coach Eran Ganot at Hawaii.

• This past year, Gerlufsen was in charge of the offense for the Dons as he guided USF to finishing eleventh in the country in total three-point field goals made (327), sixteenth in three-point field goals per game (9.6) and thirty-second in scoring margin (9.6). Notably, Jamaree Bouyea and Yauhen Massalski, who Gerlufsen originally recruited at San Diego, earned First Team All-WCC Honors this season while Khalil Shabazz was named Second Team All-WCC.

• Last season, Khalil Shabazz became the 40th student-athlete in program history to eclipse 1,000 points as the two-time All-WCC guard currently ranks 25th all-time at USF with 1,199 total points. Additionally, the Seattle native also ranks third all-time in three-pointers made (204) and three-pointers attempted (588). Defensively, Shabazz sits fourth all-time in program history in steals (163).

• This year, USF's non-conference schedule is highlighted by seven home games, including another battle with Pac-12 foe Arizona State. Additionally, the Dons will return to Chase Center for the third time in the last four seasons, with USF set to take on Utah State on Sunday, Dec. 4 in a neutral site matchup.

• Notably, the Dons will also compete in the 2022 Hall of Fame Classic in Kansas City over the Thanksgiving week as the team will square off against Northern Iowa on Monday, Nov. 21 at T-Mobile Center. Depending on the outcome of this matchup, USF will face the winner or loser of Grand Canyon/Wichita State. Overall, the four-team field proves to be an impressive bunch as these four teams combined for 82 wins while also each finishing in the top 100 of the final NCAA NET rankings last season.

• Beginning towards the end of the calendar year, USF will embark on their 16-game conference slate on Thursday, Dec. 29 when they make the trip to the South Bay for a showdown at Santa Clara. Notably, the Dons will wrap up their conference schedule on Saturday, Feb. 25 with a road trip to Provo, Utah for a matchup with BYU.


