WILDCAT TIDBITS

• After wins over South Carolina and Old Dominion to conclude the 2022 Charleston Classic, Davidson enters 5-1 overall.

• The Wildcats' only previous meeting with the Dons came last season in San Francisco (See Page 2).

• Preseason all-conference selection **Foster Loyer** continues to lead Davidson in scoring and is 23rd nationally, averaging 21.5 points per game.

• The redshirt senior is also shooting 44.7 percent (21-47) from 3-point range and 87.2 percent (34-39) at the charity stripe.

• **Sam Mennenga**, who was named to the Charleston Classic All-Tournament Team, is also averaging double figures, contributing 15.7 points per game to go along with 7.5 rebounds.

• Mennenga scored a career-high 23 points, and Loyer recorded his second double-double (22 points, 10 rebounds) in Davidson's 66-61 win over Old Dominion on Sunday.

• The 'Cats have won 58 of their last 66 games on Bob McKillop Court and 15 of 16 dating back to last season.

LAST TIME OUT | DAVIDSON 66, OLD DOMINION 61

• **Sam Mennenga** scored a career-high 23 points, and **Foster Loyer** recorded his second double-double of the season with 22 points and 10 rebounds to lead Davidson past Old Dominion 66-61 Sunday on the final day of the 2022 Charleston Classic.

• Mennenga, a redshirt junior from New Zealand, finished 9-of-14 from the floor and grabbed 7 boards. For Loyer, it was his third 20-point effort of the season.

• **David Skogman** joined the Davidson captains in double figures with 13 points, including a 7-of-7 showing from the charity stripe.

• As a team, the Wildcats went 18-of-23 at the line and finished their sixth game in 11 days, shooting 46.8 percent from the floor.

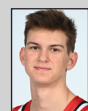

- Davidson, which trailed 12-7 early, responded with a 15-2 run and led by as many as 10 in the opening 20 minutes before going to the half up, 32-23.
- After the Monarchs used a 16-6 spurt to make it a one-point game, 46-45, with 8:51 to play, the Wildcats answered, stretching the margin back to double digits, highlighted by nine points from Mennenga.
- Ben Stanley paced Old Dominion with 20 points and 10 rebounds.

UP NEXT

- Davidson will conclude its brief homestand Tuesday when cross-county rival Charlotte visits Belk Arena for a 7 p.m. tip.

LAST MEETING | SAN FRANCISCO 65, DAVIDSON 60 | NOV. 13, 2022 | SAN FRANCISCO, CALIF. | CHASE CENTER

- Despite a game-high 17 points from Luka Brajkovic, Davidson fell to San Francisco, 65-60, inside the Chase Center, home of the Golden State Warriors on Nov. 13, 2022.
- The Wildcats got within 31-29 on a **Sam Mennenga** layup with 15:10 to play, but the Dons responded with a 16-4 run to push the margin to 47-33.
- Davidson would not go away, as it chipped away and cut the deficit to four on back-to-back buckets from Brajkovic to make it 57-53.
- On the very next possession, San Francisco's Jamaree Bouya answered with a long triple as the shot clock expired to put the Dons back up seven, all but putting the game out of reach with 1:05 to play.
- Coming off his first career double-double in Davidson's season opener, Mennenga just missed another finishing with 14 points and 9 rebounds. Hyunjung Lee also hauled in 9 boards to go along with 11 points for the 'Cats.
- Bouya led San Francisco with 14 points, while Gabe Stefanini and Josh Kunen added 12 and 11, respectively.
- After a back-and-forth start to the opening half, the Dons scored the final six points of the period, including a Stefanini 3-pointer at the buzzer to carry a 27-20 lead at the break.
- In addition to the Wildcats holding a 32-31 edge on the glass, the two teams combined for 24 steals.
- Davidson shot 50 percent after intermission to finish at 42.0 percent.

PRESEASON NOTES

- Under the direction of first-year head coach **Matt McKillop**, the Wildcats return two starters from last year's club that finished 27-7 overall and captured the 2021-22 Atlantic 10 regular season championship, while earning the program's 15th NCAA Tournament appearance.
- Among those returning include second-team all-conference selection **Foster Loyer** and **Sam Mennenga**.
- As a redshirt junior, Loyer averaged a team-best 16.2 points per game, led the country in free-throw percentage (93.6%) and finished fourth nationally in 3-point field-goal percentage, shooting 43.8 percent (74-169).
- Loyer was voted to the 2022-23 preseason all-conference first team, while the Wildcats have been predicted to finish sixth in the league standings.
- Mennenga averaged 8.4 points and 5.3 rebounds per game as a redshirt sophomore, while shooting 51.9 percent overall and 46.7 percent from 3-point range. Over his last eight contests, the 6-8 forward scored in double figures six times, including a career-high 18 points versus Richmond in the A-10 championship, and capped by a 15-point effort against Michigan State on March's biggest stage, the NCAA Tournament.
- Since joining the A-10 in 2014-15, Davidson has won two regular season titles (2015, 2022), a tournament title (2018), made three NCAA Tournaments (2015, 2018, 2022) and totaled 91 league wins (11.3 per year). The Wildcats have recorded an average finish of 4.0 in the 14-team conference and made the tournament semifinals each year.
- Junior **Grant Huffman** (4.2 ppg | 2.3 rpg | 1.5 apg) and sophomore **Desmond Watson** (2.9 ppg | 1.3 rpg), both who made strong contributions down the stretch in 2021-22, are also back for the 'Cats.
- In all, Davidson returns six letterwinners and welcomes the addition of transfers **Connor Kochera** (William & Mary) and **David Skogman** (Buffalo) and newcomers **Reed Bailey** (Harvard, Mass.), **Riccardo Ghedini** (Milano, Italy), **Sean Logan** (Westfield, N.J.), **Chris Sosnik** (Washington, D.C.), **Achile Spadone** (Geneva, Switzerland), **Brock Matheny** (Davidson, N.C.) and **Joe Thomson** (Sunderland, Mass.).
- Over the summer, **Joshua Heyliger** was promoted to assistant coach, **Matt Matheny** returned to the Wildcat bench where he spent 16 seasons before serving as the head coach at Elon University and **Matt Williams** '16 was named the director of operations.

21 CONSECUTIVE WINNING SLATES

- Davidson is one of seven (Davidson, Duke, Gonzaga, Kansas, Michigan State, Xavier, VCU) NCAA Division I men's basketball programs to currently have 21 consecutive winning seasons.

CAPTAINS

- Davidson head men's basketball coach **Matt McKillop** has announced that **Foster Loyer**, **Sam Mennenga** and **Grant Huffman** have been selected team captains for the upcoming 2022-23 season.

INTERNATIONAL ROOTS

- Since 1989, Davidson has had 44 players with international roots, from 24 different countries.
- This year's roster features four international players -- **Sam Mennenga** (New Zealand), **Styrmir Thrastarson** (Iceland), **Riccardo Ghedini** (Italy), and **Achile Spadone** (Switzerland).

LOYER OF THE STRIPE

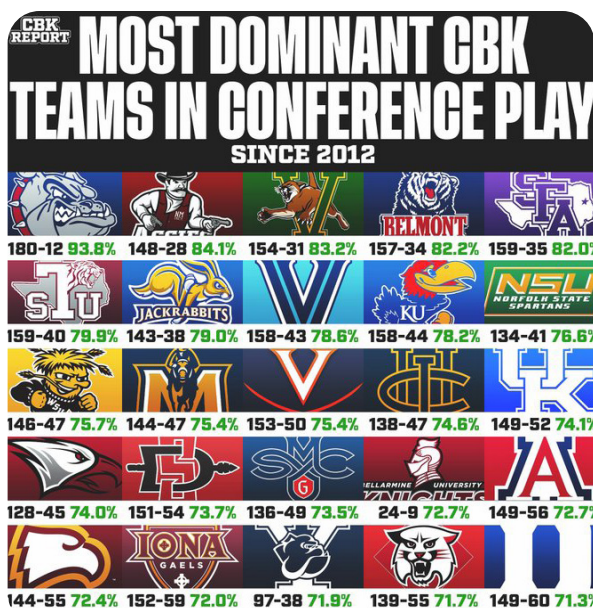
- Last season, **Foster Loyer** set a new school record (Stephen Curry - 41) for consecutive free throws made with 46 straight makes.
- The nation's longest streak started on Jan. 8, 2022 against Rhode Island and ended almost a month later in the 'Cats' win at George Washington (Feb. 5, 2022).
- The Michigan State transfer set a new Davidson single-season record and led the nation in free-throw percentage making 93.7 percent (118-126) of his tries.

ATLANTIC 10 SUCCESS

- Since joining the A-10 in 2014-15, Davidson has won two regular season titles (2015, 2022), a tournament title (2018), made three NCAA Tournaments (2015, 2018, 2022) and totaled 91 league wins (11.3 per year).
- The Wildcats have recorded an average finish of 4.0 in the 14-team conference and made the tournament semifinals each year.

SOUTHERN CONFERENCE SUCCESS

- Davidson, which joined the Atlantic 10 in July of 2014, won 28 of its last 29 Southern Conference games and 35 of 37 dating back to 2011-12.
- The Wildcats were 124-22 (.849) in their last 146 regular-season SoCon contests, dating back to 2006-07.
- Davidson also won 30 of its last 31 conference games at home dating back to 2010-11.
- In addition to winning 14 straight league games away from home, the Wildcats went 61-12 (.835) in their last 73 SoCon road games.
- Davidson had a 43-game conference win streak snapped at home against College of Charleston Feb. 7, 2009. It was one win away from tying the record held by West Virginia and the 8th-longest in college basketball history.
- Bob McKillop led the Wildcats to double-digit league wins 20 times, including the last 13 years.
- Davidson won 23 Southern Conference regular-season championships in school history.

CURRY FOR 3

- On Wednesday, Aug. 31, Stephen Curry '10 knocked down a long-awaited 3 in front of nearly 5,000 fans inside John M. Belk Arena.
- After officially graduating from Davidson College this past May, Curry formally received his diploma in a graduation ceremony. The event also included his induction into the Davidson Athletics Hall of Fame as well as the retirement of his jersey and the No. 30.

DAVIDSON THROUGH AND THROUGH

- In addition to head coach Matt McKillop '06, four of his five staff members also played for Bob McKillop and graduated from Davidson College.
- Matt Matheny, who is now in his second stint as an assistant coach, graduated in 1992.
- Fellow assistant Will Reigel '12, played for the Wildcats from 2008-12, while Director of Ops Matt Williams graduated in 2016 and former teammate / Director of Student-Athlete Development Jack Gibbs in 2017.
- Matheny and Williams also lettered in football at Davidson.



BOB MCKILLOP ANNOUNCES RETIREMENT AFTER 33 YEARS LEADING DAVIDSON

Bob McKillop, who led Davidson College to 23 conference championships (15 – regular season, 8 – tournament), 10 NCAA Tournament appearances and over 600 wins, announced his retirement on June 17, 2022 after 33 seasons as head coach of the men's basketball program.

A Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame nominee, McKillop, 72, is the most successful coach in school and league history and concludes his illustrious career ranked 54th on the NCAA Division I wins list with 634 victories.

During the 2021-22 campaign, McKillop led the Wildcats to their second-most wins in a single season, going 27-7 overall, which included a program-best 15-3 mark in Atlantic 10 play. In addition to earning his 11th (9 – SoCon, 2 – A-10) Conference Coach of the Year honor, McKillop's final campaign was capped by the school's second NCAA Tournament at-large bid.

In all, McKillop-coached teams reached postseason play 19 times — the NCAA Tournament in 1998, 2002, 2006-08, 2012, 2013, 2015, 2018, 2022, the NIT in 1994, 1996, 2005, 2009, 2014, 2016, 2019 and 2021, and the CBI in 2011.

The 2007-08 NABC National Coach of the Year led Davidson to the 2008 NCAA Tournament Midwest Regional Championship game with victories over three nationally-ranked foes -- Gonzaga, Georgetown, and Wisconsin. The Wildcats' unbelievable run ended with a two-point loss to eventual champion Kansas, and Davidson finished the campaign with a final ranking of ninth in the ESPN/USA Today Poll.

Along with tying the school's single-season record for wins with 29, McKillop and the 'Cats strung together 25 consecutive victories, the longest streak in the nation, before falling to the Jayhawks on the doorstep of the Final Four.

The Wildcats hit the 20-win plateau 17 times under McKillop's leadership, while seven teams won 25 games or more.

For 22 years, McKillop's teams competed in the Southern Conference where they put together one of the most remarkable runs in league history. From 1992-2014, Davidson won 447 games, including a 278-88 record against league competition, making McKillop the most decorated coach in the conference's 100-year existence.

Along with winning 13 regular season titles and seven tournament crowns as members of the SoCon, the 'Cats went undefeated in league play three times under McKillop, highlighted by a 20-0 record in 2007-08. Davidson had a 43-game conference win streak from 2007-09. It was one away from tying the SoCon record and the eighth longest in NCAA history.

On Feb. 1, 2014, during a pregame ceremony celebrating McKillop's 25th season, Davidson College administrators announced the basketball court inside John M. Belk Arena would be named "McKillop Court" in his honor.

Picked to finish 12th in the 2014-15 preseason poll, McKillop guided the Wildcats to the Atlantic 10 regular season title in their inaugural season and their first-ever NCAA Tournament at-large selection.

In eight seasons in the Atlantic 10, the 'Cats have won two regular season titles (2015, 2022), a tournament crown (2018) and totaled 91 league wins, while advancing to postseason play six times (3 – NCAA, 3 – NIT).

McKillop coached his 1,000th career game at Davidson on January 29, 2022, becoming just the 10th coach in NCAA Division I history to reach the milestone at one school.

McKillop's teams have been successful off the court as well. He has had a perfect Academic Progress Rate of 1,000 each year since the NCAA began tracking it in 2003.

A 1972 graduate of Hofstra, McKillop has coached eight All-Americans, an Academic All-American, 11 Conference Players of the Year, five Freshman of the Year and 73 all-conference selections.

Fifty-seven of his players have gone on to play professionally, including Stephen Curry, the 7th pick in the 2009 NBA draft, who has led the Golden State Warriors to three NBA titles while earning back-to-back NBA MVP honors.

Long-known for his connections around the globe, McKillop has coached more than 40 international players from 24 different countries.

An inductee into the Hofstra Basketball and NYC Basketball Hall of Fame, McKillop was signed and then cut by the Philadelphia 76ers before becoming a history teacher and coach.

A native of Queens, N.Y., McKillop's coaching career started at Holy Trinity High School (1973-78) on Long Island where he achieved an 86-25 record. In 1978, he joined Eddie Biedenbach's staff at Davidson as an assistant coach before returning to New York a year later to serve as the head coach at Long Island Lutheran (1979-89). There, McKillop compiled a mark of 182-51 to go along with five New York State Championships.

On May 19, 1989, McKillop was hired as the head coach at Davidson by then-Director of Athletics Terry Holland.

McKillop and his wife Cathy have three children — Kerrin, a 2002 Davidson graduate, Matt, a member of the 2006 NCAA Tournament team and 2006 graduate, and Brendan, a member of the 2008 Elite Eight team and a 2011 graduate.

The McKillops have six grandchildren, Maggie, Claire, Jack, Hazel, Rosie Marie and Charles.

Matt McKillop, former Davidson standout and longtime assistant coach, was named the program's 19th head men's basketball coach on June 17, 2022.

He succeeds his father, Bob McKillop, who announced his retirement this past summer after 33 years on the Wildcats' bench.

Promoted to associate head coach prior to the 2016-17 season, McKillop joined the staff in 2008 and has been involved in all aspects of the program, including recruiting, scheduling, editing video for scouting and teaching purposes, analytics and community involvement.

The 2021-22 campaign was his 14th season on the Wildcat bench, where he has helped his alma mater to 294 victories and a 178-67 (.726) record in conference play, which includes a 91-46 mark in the A-10 the last eight years.

In 2015 and 2022, the Wildcats earned the school's only NCAA at-large selections after capturing A-10 regular season titles. Four years ago, Davidson accomplished another feat, claiming the program's first A-10 Tournament Championship.

Individually, seven players have received All-America and conference Player of the Year recognition, while 29 all-conference nods have been awarded during his time.

In addition to Davidson averaging almost 21 wins a year during his tenure, the Wildcats have won six regular-season conference crowns and three tournament titles, while advancing to postseason play 11 times (5 – NCAA, 5 – NIT, 1 – CBI).

McKillop has played a major role on the recruiting trail, most notably his Ohio connections, which helped the Wildcats land Brian Sullivan '16, Jack Gibbs '17 and Peyton Aldridge '18.

Aldridge, the 2018 Atlantic 10 Player of the Year, and Gibbs, currently rank third and fourth, respectively, on Davidson's all-time scoring list behind Stephen Curry and John Gerdy.

Prior to making his return to Davidson, McKillop got his start in coaching at Emory University, where he served as an assistant coach for another former Wildcat guard, Jason Zimmerman.

In 2007-08, the Eagles played the nation's second-toughest schedule, which included an historic 81-76 overtime triumph

over No. 1-ranked Rochester, the team's first-ever win over a top-ranked team.

The program that McKillop helped rebuild has since posted more than 200 wins under Zimmerman, while advancing to seven straight NCAA Tournaments, including the Elite Eight in 2014.

McKillop, who started 98 of the 117 games he played for the Wildcats from 2002-06, still ranks among the school's all-time leaders in 3-pointers made (223/7th), 3-pointers attempted (567/9th) and 3-point field-goal percentage (.393/7th).

He and the six other senior players that graduated from Davidson in 2006 won 77 games, recorded a perfect 16-0 Southern Conference mark in 2004-05 and made two straight postseason appearances, highlighted by the 2006 NCAA Tournament. His junior year, the Wildcats captured a pair of postseason NIT victories with road wins at VCU and Southwest Missouri State.

Following graduation, McKillop accepted an offer to play professional basketball in the Czech Republic before suffering a knee injury.

After returning to the states, he took a job with the Charlotte Bobcats in marketing.

McKillop is married to former Davidson women's tennis standout Kelsey Linville. The couple resides in the Town of Davidson with their daughters Hazel and Rosie and son, Charles.
