RUNNIN' REBELS BACK AT HOME TO HOST SAN FRANCISCO SATURDAY

UNLV off to best start to a season in 32 years; Will face Dons at 2 p.m. in first home game in 21 days

Off to its best start to a season in 32 years (1990-91) and one of only seven undefeated teams remaining in the country, the UNLV men's basketball team (10-0) will host San Francisco at the Thomas & Mack Center on Saturday, Dec. 17 at 2 p.m. It will mark the Runnin' Rebels' first contest on their home court in 21 days, as the facility was being used during that time for the National Finals Rodeo.

LAST TIME OUT: Keshon Gilbert scored a career-high 25 points and EJ Harkless added 20 as the Runnin' Rebels defeated Washington State 74-70 Saturday afternoon in the Las Vegas Clash at the MGM Grand Garden Arena. Gilbert was 10 of 15 from the field, including 2 of 5 on 3-pointers, while collecting a team-high five rebounds, three assists and three steals. Harkless was 7 of 18 from the field. UNLV forced Washington State into 22 turnovers, marking the seventh time this season that a UNLV opponent committed at least 20 miscues.

ABOUT THE ROSTER: This season's UNLV squad features six returners, nine newcomers, including six transfers from the Division I level, and a total of 10 upperclassmen. The lone returning starter is 6-foot guard Jordan McCabe, who was a senior last season and returns for his fifth year for 2022-23. Other returners include 6-3 senior guard Justin Webster, 6-10 senior center David Muoka, 6-4 sophomore guard Keshon Gilbert, 6-7 senior forward Victor Iwuakor and 6-3 senior guard Cameron Burist.

The newcomers include 6-10 redshirt sophomore forward Isaiah Cottrell, who is originally from Las Vegas and transferred to UNLV from West Virginia, 6-7 freshman guard Keyshawn Hall from Cleveland, Ohio, 6-3 fifth-year guard EJ Harkless, who transferred from Oklahoma, 5-11 sophomore guard Jackie Johnson III, who transferred from Duquesne, 6-10 junior forward Karl Jones, who transferred from LA Southwest College, 6-6 sophomore guard Shane Nowell, who transferred from Arizona, 6-4 fifth-year guard Elijah Parquet, who transferred from Colorado, 6-6 senior guard Luis Rodriguez, who transferred from Ole Miss and 6-1 junior guard Nick Walters, who transferred from the College of Southern Nevada.

After 10 contests, Gilbert leads the team in scoring with 15.5 ppg, while shooting 53.8% from the field and 56.7% on 3-pointers, in addition to averaging 3.7 assists and 2.1 steals per game. Harkless is scoring 14.6 ppg with 4.1 rebounds per game, and 2.8 apg and 1.2 spg. Rodriguez is also averaging double figures in scoring at 11.9 ppg and rebounding with 5.5 rpg, while leading the team in steals at 2.4 per game (26th in the nation). David Muoka is leading the team in rebounding and blocks with 6.2 rpg and 1.7 bpg.

ABOUT THE OPPONENT: San Francisco (8-3) started the season 6-0 before dropping three of its last five games. The Dons are coming off a 67-64 loss to New Mexico at Mandalay Bay's Michelob Ultra Arena in Las Vegas on Monday. USF has three players averaging in double figures in scoring, led by Khalil Shabazz with 14.3 ppg. Shabazz and Zane Meeks lead the team in rebounding, each with 5.8 rpg, while Shabazz is the team's assists (4.0 apg) and steals leader (2.4 spg). San Francisco ranks 14th in the country in 3-point attempts per game (28.8). USF finished the 2021-22 season with an overall record of 24-10, finishing fourth in the West Coast Conference with a 10-6 league mark. The Dons were an at-large selection to the NCAA Tournament, falling in the first round to Murray State in overtime. This season's team was picked to finish tied for third in the WCC's preseason poll. Shabazz was named to the preseason all-conference team. The Dons' 15-man roster includes nine upperclassmen. USF is coached by Chris Gerlufsen, who is in his first season at the school. He was acting head coach at Hawaii for 13 games during the 2019-20 season, so his career head coaching record is 16-8 (.667).

New UNLV football head coach Barry Odom will be introduced to and address the crowd at halftime.

BROADCAST INFO: Saturday's game will be broadcast on the Mountain West Network in addition to the Silver State Sports and Entertainment Network (Cox 125 and over the air digital 5.2) with Matt Neverett and Steve Cofield calling the action. Jon Sandler and former Runnin' Rebel Curtis Terry will handle the UNLV radio call, which may be heard live on ESPN Radio 1100 in Las Vegas. All streaming links and live stats will be available at UNLVRebels.com and through the UNLV Rebels App.

LAST SEASON: The Runnin' Rebels turned in a successful season in 2021-22, their first under head coach Kevin Kruger, winning 18 games, which marked the most for UNLV in four years. The team went 10-8 in Mountain West play, exceeding preseason expectations with a fifth-place finish in the league standings. With a revamped roster that included nine transfers, the team continually improved as the season progressed, advancing 43 spots in the KenPom ratings along the way. Under Kruger's leadership, three UNLV individuals earned All-Mountain West accolades last season: Bryce Hamilton (First Team), Donovan Williams (Sixth Man of the Year) and Royce Hamm Jr. (Honorable Mention).

THE UNLV RUNNIN' REBELS (10-0, 0-0 MOUNTAIN WEST)

- The 2022-23 season marks the second as head coach for Kevin Kruger. Following the 2021-22 season, Kruger was named one of 15 finalists for the Joe B. Hall Award, which is presented annually to the top first-year coach in Division I men's college basketball by collegeinsider.com. An assistant for the Runnin' Rebels for the previous two seasons (2019-21), he was hired as head coach in March 2021. The point guard on UNLV's 2007 NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 Team as a senior under his father, legendary coach Lon Kruger, Kevin returned to Las Vegas after spending three years as an assistant coach at Oklahoma (2016-19). During his first season at the helm of the program, Kruger led the Runnin' Rebels to 18 wins - the most for UNLV in four years. The team went 10-8 in Mountain West play, exceeding preseason expectations with a fifth-place finish in the league standings. He and his staff revamped the roster with nine transfers and the team continually improved as the season progressed, advancing 43 spots in the KenPom ratings along the way.
- Under Kruger's leadership, three UNLV individuals, who are now departed, earned All-Mountain West accolades last season: Bryce Hamilton (First Team), Donovan Williams (Sixth Man of the Year) and Royce Hamm Jr. (Honorable Mention).
- This season's squad features six returners and nine newcomers, including six transfers from the Division I level.

SERIES HISTORY

- This will mark the 17th time that UNLV and San Francisco have met in men's basketball.
- UNLV leads the all-time series 9-7.
- The last meeting occurred last season on Dec. 4 in San Francisco. UNLV lost 83-62.
- Prior to last season, the previous meeting was in 2006, a UNLV home win (96-88). Kevin Kruger scored 16 points and had a game-high nine assists that night.
- UNLV is 7-1 all-time against USF at home, with a current streak of five straight wins.
- UNLV is 136-59 a all-time against teams that currently make up the WCC.

UP NEXT

After hosting San Francisco on Saturday, UNLV will wrap up non-conference play on Thursday, Dec. 22 against Southern Mississippi at the Thomas & Mack Center at 7 p.m.

10-0 FOR THE FIRST TIME IN 32 YEARS

UNLV's 10-0 start this season is its best since the 1990-91 squad started the year with 34 straight wins. That team lost to Duke in the NCAA Final Four.

UNLV ONE OF JUST SEVEN NCAA DIVISION I MEN'S BASKETBALL TEAMS STILL UNDEFEATED

With a perfect 10-0 mark on the season, UNLV is one of just seven schools that remain undefeated in men's basketball this season heading into Friday's games. Of that group, only one school has a better record with 11 wins (UConn). In addition, three of the seven schools are in the Mountain West. New Mexico (10-0) and Utah State (9-0) are the others.

RECEIVING VOTES IN BOTH POLLS

After defeating then-No. 21 Dayton on Nov. 15, the national media took notice of the Runnin' Rebels. UNLV was in the others receiving votes category of the Associated Press Poll that week. This week UNLV is receiving votes in the AP Poll as well as the Coaches'. UNLV has 27 points in the AP Poll, which is equivalent to being ranked 31st, and 13 points in the Coaches' (35th).

KRUGER EARNS ESPN COACH OF THE WEEK HONOR

ESPN's Jeff Borzello picked UNLV head coach Kevin Kruger as his coach of the week in his weekly power rankings write-up on Monday. He wrote: "UNLV was picked sixth in the Mountain West preseason poll, but Kevin Kruger now has the Rebels as one of just three teams with double-digit wins and zero losses. (UConn and Purdue, the top two squads in the Power Rankings, are the other two.) The Rebels ... beat Dayton in mid-November and took care of business against Washington State on Saturday. If they can beat San Francisco and Southern Miss in Las Vegas in their next two games, the Rebels will enter conference play at 12-0. Kruger, college basketball's first graduate transfer, has built his roster almost exclusively via the portal: eight of his top nine players started their careers elsewhere. The lone exception, sophomore guard Keshon Gilbert, went for 25 points in the win over Washington State."

TOP-25 WIN OVER DAYTON

- UNLV's win over then-No. 21 Dayton on Nov. 15 marked its first win over a ranked non-conference opponent at the Thomas & Mack Center since defeating then-No. 3 Arizona (71-67) on Dec. 23, 2014.
- Prior to the win over Dayton, UNLV's last win over any ranked team was last season when it defeated then-No. 22 Colorado State in Fort Collins on Jan. 28, 2022. That win was its first win over a ranked team since Feb. 22, 2020 when it spoiled then-No. 4 San Diego State's bid at a perfect season.

AMONG THE NATION'S LEADERS...

So far this season, UNLV ranks No. 1 in the nation in turnovers forced per game at 21.5 and in turnover margin at 8.6. The Runnin' Rebels are No. 6 in steals per game at 11.2, 13th in fastbreak points at 17.5, 15th in scoring margin at 17.7, 36th in scoring defense at 61.4, 37th in free throw attempts per game at 21.9, and 48th in field-goal percentage defense at 39.4. Luis Rodriguez is 26th in the country in steals per game at 2.4.

DEFENSIVE IDENTITY

UNLV has been winning this season with a defense-first mindset. The Runnin' Rebels have held seven of their 10 opponents this season to 63 points or less and are limiting their opponents to just 39.4% shooting. UNLV is allowing an average of 61.4 ppg from its opponents. The Runnin' Rebels are No. 1 in the country in forced turnovers with 21.5 per game, while they rank sixth in steals per game at 11.2. UNLV has forced at least 20 turnovers in seven of 10 games and has recorded double-digit steals in six of 10.

RODEO ROADTRIP

Every December while the National Finals Rodeo takes over UNLV's home arena at the Thomas & Mack Center, the Runnin' Rebels have to be out for approximately three weeks. UNLV's last home game was on Saturday, Nov. 26 and its next game at home will be this Saturday, Dec. 17 - a span of 21 days. During their "Rodeo Roadtrip" this season, the Runnin' Rebels have played at San Diego, vs. Hawaii in Henderson, Nevada, and against Washington State at the MGM Grand Garden Arena in Las Vegas.

WHAT AN IMPROVEMENT!

UNLV sophomore guard Keshon Gilbert only averaged 2.6 ppg last season with a season-high eight points vs. Wichita State. So far this season, Gilbert is leading the Runnin' Rebels in scoring at 15.5 ppg with double-digit points in nine of his 10 games. He scored a career high 25 points vs. Washington State.

SO CLOSE TO SETTING A RECORD

UNLV's 72-point win over Life Pacific on Nov. 26 was very close to setting the program's all-time margin of victory record. It fell one point shy, however, as the Runnin' Rebel record for win margin is 73, which was set in 1987 when UNLV defeated Hawaii-Loa on the road by 73 points (120-47). The previous mark was 72, a 129-57 win over UC Irvine in 1975. The most points UNLV has ever scored in a game was 164 vs. Hawaii-Hilo in 1976.

UNLV CLAIMS SOCIAL CHALLENGE TITLE

With its wins over Southern Illinois and Minnesota at the Pavilion at JSerra in San Juan Capistrano, California, UNLV claimed the championship of the SoCal Challenge just before Thanksgiving. It marked the Runnin' Rebels' first MTE (multi-team event) title since capturing the MGM Resorts Main Event tournament in 2017 at T-Mobile Arena.

SOCAL CHALLENGE ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM REPS

UNLV had two members of the SoCal Challenge All-Tournament team: Keshon Gillbert, who was named the event's Most Valuable Player, and EJ Harkless.

HARKLESS EARNS RUNNIN' REBELS' FIRST MW PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONOR

UNLV senior EJ Harkless was named the Mountain West Men's Basketball Player of the Week, the league announced Monday, Nov. 21. It was the first such honor for a Runnin' Rebel this season. In wins over then-No. 21 Dayton (60-52) and High Point (78-68) the previous week, Harkless led UNLV with 19.5 points per game. He also averaged 5.5 rebounds, 5.0 assists, three 3-pointers and a steal per contest. In the victory over the Flyers, UNLV's first over a ranked non-conference team on its home floor in eight years, Harkless scored a game-high 24 points on 9 of 19 shooting with six rebounds and three assists. He wrapped up the week in the win over the Panthers with 15 points, tallying seven assists.

CANADIAN TRIP

UNLV was able to take advantage of a preseason foreign tour during this past summer as the Runnin' Rebels played three games in Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada in August. A major benefit to embarking on a trip such as this is the 10 full practices the team is permitted to conduct during what is traditionally the offseason. While in Vancouver, UNLV played against the University of British Columbia, the University of Calgary and the University of the Fraser Valley.

NEW COACHES

The Runnin' Rebel program also welcomed three new assistant coaches to Kevin Kruger's staff during the offseason. Barrett Peery joined UNLV from Texas Tech, John Cooper came from SMU and Jamaal Williams from Portland State.

THE KEVIN KRUGER HEAD COACHING ERA AT UNLV

Former Runnin' Rebel student-athlete and assistant coach Kevin Kruger was appointed the new head coach of the UNLV's men's basketball program in March 2021. Following the 2021-22 season, Kruger was named one of 15 finalists for the 2022 Joe B. Hall Award, which is presented annually to the top first-year coach in Division I men's college basketball by collegeinsider.com. During his first season at the helm of the program, Kruger led the Runnin' Rebels to 18 wins - the most for UNLV in four years. The team went 10-8 in Mountain West play, exceeding preseason expectations with a fifth-place finish in the league standings. He and his staff revamped the roster with nine transfers and the team continually improved as the season progressed, advancing 43 spots in the KenPom ratings along the way. Under Kruger's leadership, three UNLV individuals earned 2021-22 All-Mountain West accolades: Bryce Hamilton (First Team), Donovan Williams (Sixth Man of the Year) and Royce Hamm Jr. (Honorable Mention). Kruger completed his second year as an assistant coach for the UNLV program in 2020-21 after he returned to his alma mater in April 2019. The point guard on UNLV's 2007 NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 team as a senior under his father, legendary coach Lon Kruger, Kevin returned to Las Vegas after spending three years as an assistant coach at Oklahoma (2016-19). With Kevin on the coaching staff, Oklahoma made multiple NCAA Tournament appearances. He was also an assistant coach at Northern Arizona for two seasons (2014-16) following a year as a graduate assistant at Oklahoma. Prior to making the move into coaching, Kevin played professionally from 2007-13. During his first season on the coaching staff at UNLV in 2019-20, the Runnin' Rebels tied for second place in the Mountain West, marking the program's best league finish in 12 years. The team also sent shockwaves through the college basketball world with its victory at fourth-ranked and previously undefeated San Diego State, posting the program's best true road win since 1991 (a span of 29 seasons). Achievement in the classroom has been just as important with Kruger on staff. The team turned in a semester grade point average of 3.57 for fall 2020, the program's highest ever. It also achieved a record-cumulative GPA of 3.32 with an all-time program-high nine student-athletes on the Dean's Honor List. Kruger began his collegiate playing career at Arizona State, where he earned his criminal justice degree in 2006, before transferring to UNLV. In his lone season as a Runnin' Rebel student-athlete, UNLV won 30 games. He earned All-Mountain West Third Team honors and was named to the conference's all-tournament team. At ASU, Kruger was named an honorable mention All-Pac-10 and second-team NABC District 15 selection in his third and final season in Tempe. Also a Pac-10 All-Freshman honorable mention pick, Kruger left the Sun Devils ranked fourth in career free throw percentage at ASU, fifth all-time in 3-pointers made and attempted and seventh in 3-point percentage. Kruger had professional basketball stints in Bulgaria, Italy, China, Mexico, Belgium and Germany in addition to NBA training camp invitations from the Orlando Magic and Milwaukee Bucks. He also played with the Utah Flash and Los Angeles D-Fenders of the NBA D-League before launching his coaching career. His father, Lon, coached the Runnin' Rebels from 2004-2011 and made four NCAA Tournament appearances (2007, 2008, 2010 and 2011) and an NIT (2009). Kevin earned a master's degree from Oklahoma in human relations in 2017 and is married to the former Allison Gerding. The couple has two daughters, Cameron, who celebrated her third birthday in October and Vivienne, who was born in November 2021.

PRESEASON MOUNTAIN WEST POLL

UNLV was picked to finish sixth in this year's Mountain West standings as voted on by select media and announced during the conference's media days in October. San Diego State was predicted to win the conference title this season, while Wyoming was second, Boise State third, Colorado State fourth and New Mexico fifth.

"3-POINT GOAL..." - UNLV HOLDS NCAA RECORD

UNLV holds the NCAA record for most consecutive games scoring at least one 3-pointer. Since the 3-point field goal was adopted by the NCAA in 1986-87, UNLV has converted at least one 3-pointer in all 1,171 games played. With Vanderbilt failing to make one in a game during the 2019-20 season, UNLV and Princeton are the only schools left that have made at least one 3-pointer in every game played since the shot was introduced.

BEST NON-CONFERENCE RECORD SINCE...

With an 8-5 non-conference record last season, it marked the best non-conference mark for the Runnin' Rebels since they went 11-2 in 2017-18.



HOME MARK

The Runnin' Rebels went 12-4 at home during the regular season in 2021-22, with their only losses at the Thomas & Mack Center coming to then-No. 2 UCLA, San Diego State, Fresno State and Boise State (all ranked in the top 73 by KenPom). With this season's five wins at home added, UNLV has won 17 of its last 21 regular-season games at the Thomas & Mack Center.

UNLV'S BOUNCE BACK UNDER KRUGER

Under Coach Kruger, in Mountain West play last season, every time UNLV suffered a loss it bounced right back with a win. The Runnin' Rebels did not lose two consecutive games during MW regular-season action in 2022.

UNLV'S 2021-22 ALL-MOUNTAIN WEST AWARDS

UNLV men's basketball's now departed senior Bryce Hamilton, senior Royce Hamm Jr. and junior Donovan Williams each earned All-Mountain West recognition for the 2021-22 season:

- The MW's 11 head coaches voted on the league's awards, while the media's were conducted independent of conference oversight.
- Hamilton was selected First Team All-Mountain West by both the coaches and media, while Hamm Jr. was named honorable mention by the coaches, and Williams earned Sixth Man of the Year by the media.
- Hamilton was also named First Team All-Mountain West following the 2019-20 season, so he has become UNLV's first two-time first-team selection since Odaty Blankson was honored in 2004 and 2005.
- Hamilton, a 6-foot-4-inch guard from Pasadena, California, led the Mountain West in scoring last season, averaging 24.1 points per game during conference play. He also averaged 5.9 rebounds per contest (10th in the MW), while recording 2.4 assists per game. He ranked first in the MW in 3-pointers made per game (3.06), shot 36.9% from long range, which was second in the league, made 42.3% of his shots from the field (11th in MW) and was sixth in free-throw percentage (77.3%).
- Hamilton scored in double figures in all 18 league contests, eclipsing the 30-point mark five times in MW play and 20 or more in 12 games. He scored a career-high 42 points at Colorado State, which is the ninth-highest point total by an individual in a single game in Runnin' Rebel history. In addition to being a first-team honoree in 2019-20, Hamilton was named to the second team in 2020-21.
- Hamm Jr., a 6-foot-9-inch forward from Houston, who transferred to UNLV from Texas, averaged 8.4 ppg and 8.9 rpg, while shooting 50% from the field and 86.7% on free throws during league games this season. He was third in the MW in rebounding average, recording double figures in scoring six times in MW action and in rebounding on eight occasions.
- Williams, a 6-foot-6-inch forward also from Houston and a Texas transfer, averaged 12.3 ppg, shooting 49.6% from the field and 45.2% on 3-pointers. He started six of 13 MW games played, tallying double figures in scoring seven times, including 20 or more points twice.

AT THE THOMAS & MACK CENTER

The 2022-23 season marks the 40th year of Runnin' Rebel basketball in the Thomas & Mack Center. UNLV has posted an all-time record of 526-142 (.787) in the arena since it opened in 1983, which includes a 12-4 mark in the building during the regular season in 2021-22 - the program's best in six years (14-3 in 2015-16).

65TH YEAR OF RUNNIN' REBEL BASKETBALL

The 2022-23 season marks the 65th year of Runnin' Rebel basketball at UNLV. Since the program's inception in 1958-59, the Runnin' Rebels have posted an all-time record of 1,345-611 (.688).

SIXTH-WINNINGEST PROGRAM EVER

With an all-time record of 1,309-601 (.685) against four-year American institutions (entering the 2022-23 season), UNLV ranks as the sixth-winningest program by percentage in NCAA Division I history (min. 25 years in Div. I). The only schools ahead of UNLV are Kentucky, North Carolina, Kansas, Duke and UCLA. UNLV has finished the season with a winning percentage above .500, 58 times in its 64-year history.

BROOKLYN HICKS & ROB WHALEY JR. BOTH SIGN WITH RUNNIN' REBELS ON FIRST DAY OF EARLY PERIOD

The UNLV men's basketball program received signed commitments on the first day of the early signing period from Brooklyn Hicks and Rob Whaley Jr. to join the Runnin' Rebels for the 2023-24 season.

Hicks, a 6-foot-3-inch, 180-pound guard, from Seattle, Washington, attends Timberline High School. Rated as the second-best player in the state of Washington, he is a four-star recruit by ESPN.com. 247 Sports lists him as the 87th overall player in his class. As a junior last season, Hicks averaged 24 points, 10 rebounds, three assists and two steals per contest, earning All-Area Player of the Year honors by The Olympian and was a first-team selection to The News Tribune's All-Area Team. The back-to-back MVP of the 3A South Sound Conference led the Blazers to a state tournament appearance, leading the league in points per game, rebounds and was top three in steals. Playing for nationally renowned AAU program Seattle Rotary, he averaged 17.9 ppg, 8.1 rpg and 2.6 apg during the Nike Peach Jam this summer. Hicks chose UNLV over San Diego State, Cincinnati, Oregon State, Washington State, Saint Mary's and UNR. He will be a freshman for the Runnin' Rebels next fall.

Whaley Jr., a 6-foot-7-inch, 230-pound forward from Farmington, Utah, attends the College of Southern Idaho. As a freshman during the 2021-22 season, he earned second team All-Scenic West honors after averaging 10.9 ppg on 63 percent shooting, along with 4.9 rpg in 18.1 minutes played per contest. Ranked as a top-10 junior college prospect nationally, he played at Bountiful High School in Utah where he averaged 19.8 ppg and 6.8 rpg in 24 appearances as a senior, also adding 52 assists. He scored 26 points or more seven times during that season. CSI went 24-9 overall last season and after starting out this year 3-0 with two wins over ranked teams, earned National Team of the Week honors by JucoRecruiting.com. Whaley Jr. chose UNLV over Boise State, Utah State and Wichita State, and will be a junior for the Runnin' Rebels next fall. His father was the 51st overall pick in the 2005 NBA Draft by the Utah Jazz.

NBA DRAFT PICKS

UNLV had a total of four NBA Draft picks over a four-year span from 2013-16: Anthony Bennett (No. 1 overall in 2013 by the Cleveland Cavaliers), Rashad Vaughn (No. 17 overall in 2015 by the Milwaukee Bucks), Patrick McCaw (No. 38 overall in 2016 by the Golden State Warriors) and Stephen Zimmerman Jr. (No. 41 overall in 2016 by the Orlando Magic).

RUNNIN' REBELS IN THE NBA

There were three former Runnin' Rebels on NBA rosters when this season began. They are Khem Birch (Toronto Raptors), Derrick Jones Jr. (Chicago Bulls), and Christian Wood (Dallas Mavericks). Birch, Jones Jr., and Wood all went undrafted. Jones Jr. won the Slam Dunk Contest over Aaron Gordon during the 2020 NBA All-Star Weekend in Chicago on Feb. 15, 2020.

SEASON TICKET PRICING ADJUSTED FOR THE 2022-23 SEASON

UNLV men's basketball season ticket pricing has been adjusted for the 2022-23 season, with affordability and family-friendly value at the forefront of the changes.

- Season ticket prices have been lowered in every price level.
- Lower Bowl season tickets are available for as low as \$305. That averages out to just \$19 per game and is almost a 50% reduction from what the same seats cost this past season.
- Upper Bowl season tickets are available for as low as \$95 (\$6 per game).
- There are fewer price-level categories, making for an easier-to-understand seat selection process.
- Lower Bowl 1 pricing has been drastically reduced, now costing less than \$2,000 per season ticket with a major gift requirement no longer necessary.

RUNNIN' REBELS DEFEAT SOUTHERN 66-56 IN SEASON OPENER

UNLV was led by Keshon Gilbert's career-high 13 points as team forces 28 turnovers at the Thomas & Mack Center

LAS VEGAS (UNLVRebels.com) - The UNLV men's basketball team (1-0) opened the 2022-23 season on Nov. 7 at the Thomas & Mack Center with a 66-56 win over Southern (0-1).

The Runnin' Rebels were led by Keshon Gilbert's career-high 13 points, while EJ Harkless scored 11, Jackie Johnson III contributed 10 and Luis Rodriguez added nine. Rodriguez led the team with seven rebounds.

The Jaguars were led by Bryson Etienne's 25 points on 9 of 18 from the field, including 6 of 11 on 3-pointers.

STAT OF THE GAME: UNLV forced Southern into committing 28 turnovers on the night, including 17 in the first half.

TURNING POINT: With a three-point lead at 39-36 three-and-a-half minutes into the second half, UNLV went on to take a 51-36 lead with just under 13 minutes to play. The Runnin' Rebels were in control from there, but a 10-0 late SU run cut its deficit to just seven with about two minutes left. The Jaguars would get no closer.

QUOTABLE: "The defense saved us... 28 turnovers. Offensively, we hit some stagnant stretches, but it was nice to have a security on the bench and the feeling that if we could just move it and get a couple of good shots and buy a little time offensively, that our defense was holding strong. Our fight was really good and we just figured out a way to win a game. We are really happy happy for our guys and proud of them, and excited to get back in the gym because I think we're going have a ton of fun that we can look at and point out things that they'll notice, things that we have talked about that we can continue to improve on for Saturday." - UNLV head coach Kevin Kruger

- UNLV made 32 of 38 from the free-throw line as a team, led by Harkless' 7 of 9 and Gilbert's 6 of 6.

UNLV runs record to 2-0 as Keshon Gilbert, Jackie Johnson III and Luis Rodriguez combine to shoot 64% from the field at the Thomas & Mack Center

LAS VEGAS (UNLVRebels.com) - The UNLV men's basketball team (2-0) defeated Incarnate Word (0-2) 88-63 on Nov. 12 at the Thomas & Mack Center.

Keshon Gilbert recorded a career high in scoring for a second straight game, this time with 23 points on 6 of 10 shooting, including 4 of 5 on 3-pointers, 7 of 8 from the free throw line, while adding a career-high four steals. RUNNIN' REBELS MAKE STATEMENT IN WIN OVER NO. 21 DAYTON

UNLV improves to 3-0 on the season with first win over a ranked non-conference opponent at Thomas & Mack Center in eight years

LAS VEGAS (UNLVRebels.com) - The UNLV men's basketball team (3-0) defeated No. 21 Dayton 60-52 on Nov. 15 at the Thomas & Mack Center, marking its first win over a ranked non-conference opponent at home in eight seasons.

EJ Harkless scored a game-high 24 points on 9 of 19 shooting with six rebounds and three assists, while Keshon Gilbert added 16 points on 6 of 9 from the field with three assists and three steals. David Muoka was the game's leading rebounder with nine and also contributed a career-high four steals and two blocks.

The Flyers (2-1) were led by Kobe Elvis and Mike Sharavjams with 16 and 14 points, respectively.

STAT OF THE GAME: UNLV held Dayton without a field goal over the final 6:45. The Flyers made just five in the entire second half.

STAT OF THE GAME II: UNLV outscored Dayton by 18 points in the second half (38-20), shooting 48.1% from the field and holding the Flyers to just 25%.

THE TURNING POINT: After erasing a 10-point halftime deficit and leading Dayton 50-47 with 6:46 left in the game, the Runnin' Rebels held the Flyers to 0 of 5 shooting the rest of the way, while forcing five turnovers.

QUOTABLE: "Obviously a highly emotional game with a lot of energy, and couldn't be more proud of them. The two days of prep, they were locked in and ready. With this being the first opportunity to get a win against a ranked team for this group, we were excited about it, but as coaches you wish you had more time to prepare for it. It came quick, but the guys stepped up and responded. I think we faced a double-digit deficit twice and both times we just came back swinging. But that's what these guys have done and that's what they do in practice every day - they just compete like crazy. It was just great to see it pay off for them." - UNLV head coach Kevin Kruger

UNLV is 5-0 for the first time in five years, will play Minnesota in championship game of the SoCal Challenge

SAN JUAN CAPISTRANO, Calif. (UNLVRebels.com) - Keshon Gilbert, EJ Harkless and Luis Rodriguez combined for 48 points as the UNLV men's basketball team (5-0) defeated Southern Illinois 56-49 on Nov. 21 in the SoCal Challenge at the Pavilion at JSerra. The Runnin' Rebels remained perfect through five games, marking their best start to a season in five years.

Gilbert scored 18 points, Harkless added 16 and Rodriguez contributed 14. The trio combined to shoot 57.1% from the field (20 of 35). Victor Iwuakor led the Runnin' Rebels in rebounding with six, while Gilbert and Rodriguez each grabbed five.

The Salukis (3-2) were led by Marcus Domask's 21 points. He also had six rebounds, four assists, two steals and two blocks.

STAT OF THE GAME: It was truly a tale of two halves as SIU shot 63.2% in the first half and 28.6% in the second, while UNLV shot 34.5% in the first half and 59.1% in the second.

THE TURNING POINT: UNLV used a 9-0 run over an almost-eight minute stretch in the second half to turn a four-point deficit into a five-point lead with 2:23 to play.

COMEBACK KIDS: Monday marked the third straight game that UNLV trailed at the half and came back to win. SIU led 30-26 at the break.

NOTES:

- UNLV forced Southern Illinois to commit 21 turnovers in the game. The Runnin' Rebels have forced 20 or more turnovers in each of their five games this season for a total of 118 (23.6 per game).
- Gilbert shot 7 of 10 from the field, including 1 of 1 on 3-pointers, Harkless was 7 of 16 from the field and Rodriguez was 6 of 9 and 2 of 3, respectively.

(UNLVRebels.com) - Four Runnin' Rebels scored in double figures as the UNLV men's basketball team (6-0) defeated Minnesota 71-62 on Nov. 23 in the championship game of the SoCal Challenge at the Pavilion at JSerra. The Runnin' Rebels remained perfect through six games, marking their best start to a season in five years.

Keshon Gilbert scored a game-high-tying 17 points with four assists and three steals, while EJ Harkless scored 16 points, Luis Rodriguez added a career-high-tying 15 points with nine rebounds and Jackie Johnson III contributed 13 points on 4 of 7 3-point shooting. RUNNIN' REBELS MOVE TO 9-0 AFTER 77-62 WIN OVER HAWAII IN HENDERSON

UNLV led by as many as 21 at the Dollar Loan Center;
Off to best start to a season in 12 years

HENDERSON, Nev. (UNLVRebels.com) - For the first time in its 65-year existence, the Runnin' Rebels played a game in Henderson on Dec. 7 and in doing so, improved its record to 9-0 this season to mark their best start in 12 years.

Four players scored in double figures for the UNLV men's basketball team as it defeated Hawaii 77-62 at The Dollar Loan Center.

Luis Rodriguez led all scorers for the second straight game with 18 points, while grabbing seven rebounds with two steals, while Justin Webster and Keshon Gilbert each scored 13, and EJ Harkless added 10. David Muoka scored nine points with game highs of nine rebounds and three blocks.

The Rainbow Warriors (5-3) were led by Kamaka Hepa's 15 points, while Beon Riley contributed 12 points and a team-high eight rebounds.

THE TURNING POINT: UNLV closed the first half on a 17-4 run to take a 41-22 lead at the break. UNLV led by as many as 21 points early in the second half.

SINGLE DIGITS IN THE SECOND HALF: Hawaii cut its deficit to single digits late in the second half (7:25), but Rodriguez made back-to-back 3-pointers and later stole the ball, finishing with a dunk to make it a 65-51 game about a minute later.

FORCING TURNOVERS: UNLV ranks No. 1 in the nation in forcing turnovers. The Runnin' Rebels forced Hawaii into 18 miscues, marking the ninth straight contest that UNLV's opponent has committed at least 17 turnovers.

3-POINT GOAL: UNLV shot 62.5% on 3-pointers in the first half (5 of 8) and finished the game at 44.4% (8 of 18).

QUOTABLE: "Overall, the guys did what they've been doing. Did a great job of guarding people, creating a little bit of a cushion in the first half which ended up becoming the difference in the game. That's become their M.O. - a relentless defensive presence in the first half and when you're playing against teams that have a lot of pride, they make it interesting. We knew that, we expected it and we knew Hawaii was going to make a run. But our guys did what they needed to - turned it up a notch at the end and I think we were pretty fortunate to come away beating a very good Hawaii team." - UNLV head coach Kevin Kruger.

NOTES:

- It was UNLV's seventh straight win against the Rainbow Warriors and improved its all-time record in the series to 25-9.
- UNLV held Hawaii to just 2 of 14 (14.3%) on 3-pointers in the first half and 6 of 29 for the game (20.7%).

- UNLV led in fastbreak points 18-2.

RUNNIN' REBELS STAY PERFECT WITH 74-70 WIN OVER WASHINGTON ST. ON THE STRIP

UNLV is off to its best start to a season (10-0) since the 1990-91 team won its first 34 games

LAS VEGAS (UNLVRebels.com) - Keshon Gilbert scored a career-high 25 points and EJ Harkless added 20 as the UNLV men's basketball team (10-0) defeated Washington State 74-70 on Dec. 10 in the Las Vegas Clash at the MGM Grand Garden Arena.

The Runnin' Rebels are off to their best start to a season since the 1990-91 team won their first 34 games.

Gilbert was 10 of 15 from the field, including 2 of 5 on 3-pointers, while collecting a team-high five rebounds, three assists and three steals. Harkless was 7 of 18 from the field.

The Cougars (4-5) had three players score in double figures, led by TJ Bamba's 20 points on 7 of 11 shooting, including 4 of 6 from long distance. Mouhamed Gueye added a game-high eight rebounds.

MASSIVE RUN: UNLV started the game slow offensively as Washington State built a nine-point lead at 11-2. With the Cougars leading 13-4, UNLV then went on an 18-0 run over four minutes with five different Runnin' Rebels scoring during the stretch to give themselves a 22-13 lead.

CLOSE FINISH: UNLV led 33-30 at the half and although it built a 12-point advantage with seven minutes to go in the game, Washington State cut it to three points a couple of times late.

DEFENSE AGAIN: As the Runnin' Rebels have shown all season, defense was their calling card again on Saturday. UNLV forced Washington State into 22 turnovers, marking the seventh time this season that a UNLV opponent committed at least 20 miscues. UNLV came into the game ranked No. 2 in the country in forced turnovers. The Runnin' Rebels also recorded 12 steals, which is a category that they rank in the nation's top 10 in. It marked the sixth time that they have tallied at least 10 swipes in a game.

QUOTABLE: "I thought it was a great fight by our guys. I felt like we played a lot of that game at Wazzu's pace and their temperament, but I thought we did a good job of creating enough momentum swings in our direction to where we had favor in the way the game was going. It was a little more up and down which our guys do better at. When the game is moving, we are able to get turnovers, run and get good offensive looks that way. Washington State shot the ball really well and they do a really good job of finding the open guy and when you've got that many that can make plays and shoot it and make some of the shots they did today, that's what's probably going to happen. We just have to continue to get better in those situations and watch the film to see how a step here or a step there could make our life a lot easier or potentially a lot harder." - UNLV head coach Kevin Kruger.

- UNLV only committed seven turnovers.
- WSU shot 61.1% from the field in the first half, finishing the game at 54.2%.

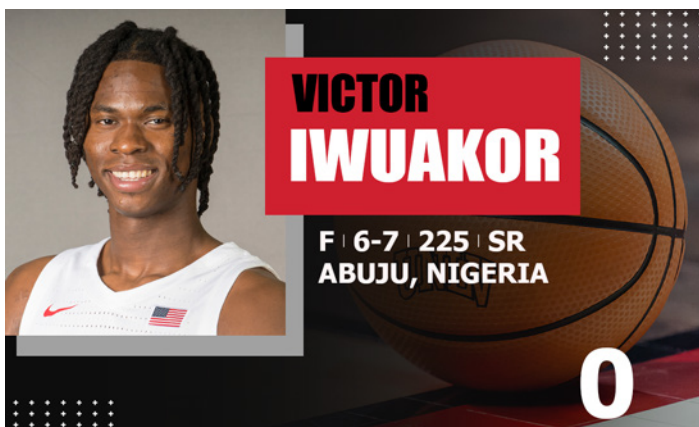
