LAST TIME OUT

Behind double-doubles from fifth year guard Marcellus Earlington (30 points, 12 rebounds) and graduate guard Eric Williams Jr. (21 points, 11 rebounds), the University of San Diego men's basketball team (10-12, 3-5 WCC) earned a regular season sweep over Pepperdine (7-15, 0-8 WCC), 87-78. The Toreros shot 53.4% (31-58) from the floor, which is a season high. Earlington scored 30 points for the second consecutive game, including his career-high of 32 at Portland last Thursday. Williams Jr. registered his team-high 10th double-double of the season. Fifth year guard Jase Townsend added 11 points and five rebounds in the win.

SCOUTING THE DONS

San Francisco has won two straight games against Pacific and BYU, jumping up to a tie for 7th in the conference standings along with San Diego and Portland. Graduate guard Tyrell Roberts leads the team with 15.6 points per game, closely followed by graduate guard Khalil Shabazz at 14.9 PPG. Junior forward Zane Meeks is adding 12.5 points and a team-high 6.2 rebounds per contest. The Dons rank 9th in the NCAA in three-point attempts per game (28.5) and 11th in threes made (10.1).

ALL-TIME SERIES

The Dons hold a 49-41 lead in the all-time series, but USD overcame a 15-point deficit in the last matchup to win, 80-68.

Steve Lavin Named Head Coach

- A proven winner who guided UCLA and St. John's to eight NCAA Tournament appearances in 11 years, Steve Lavin was named head men's basketball coach at the University of San Diego on April 7, 2022.
 A staple in college basketball for over three decades, Lavin becomes the Toreros' 14th head coach in program history and the seventh head coach since USD moved to the NCAA Division I ranks in 1979-80.
- In 11 full seasons as a head coach (at UCLA and St. John's), Lavin accumulated a record of 226-133
 (.630) with 10 postseason appearances. He has led his programs to eight NCAA Tournaments, including five Sweet 16 appearances and an Elite Eight. Lavin also reached 20 or more wins on nine different occasions.
- The San Francisco native has mentored 17 NBA players during his career, including Baron Davis, Jerome Moiso, Earl Watson, Matt Barnes, Jason Kopono, Jelani McCoy, Dan Gadzuric, Maurice Harkless, and JaKarr Sampson.

USD Adds Eight to Staff

- John Moore, Tyus Edney, Patrick Sandle, Ryan Devlin, Jackson Doran, Billy McKnight, Chris Simpson, and Dan McGinley all joined the staff during the offseason.
- Moore, the all-time winningest head coach at NAIA Westmont College, will serve as assistant coach.
 Combined with five seasons at Fresno Pacific, Moore registered an overall record of 637-352.
- Edney, a 1995 NCAA Men's Basketball Champion, joins the staff as an assistant coach. Coach Lavin
 was an assistant coach for all four years of Edney's UCLA career, and the duo helped the Bruins to a
 102-25 record in that span.
- With more than 30 years of college coaching experience, Sandle joins USD as an assistant coach. A
 standout at San Francisco State University from 1982-84, Sandle was a teammate of Steve Lavin and
 is a member of the school's athletic hall of fame.
- Devlin joins San Diego as the recruiting coordinator, and most recently served as an assistant coach at George Washington from 2019-22.
- Doran, a Bay Area native with extensive experience within the West Coast Conference, is starting his first season with the Toreros. Serving as Chief of Staff, he will spearhead operational duties for the program.
- McKnight's role is Director of Player Development. He has been around basketball staffs for the last 22 years, most recently as head coach of Prolific Prep.
- Simpson joins USD as a video coordinator. Most recently, he was the head varsity basketball coach at Dymally High School in Los Angeles.
- McGinley joins as a Director of Scouting and Analytics. He most recently served as the Video Coordinator/Assistant Director of Basketball Operations at Saint Peter's in 2021-22, including a memorable run to the Elite Eight.

USD Announces 12 Newcomers for 2022-23

- Deuce Turner (Coatesville, PA/Malvern Prep/Bucknell/South Plains College) At 6'2, 185-pounds, the guard set the South Plains record for most points in a game with 50, including 13 three-pointers. Turner averaged 18.3 points per game, and was named Second Team JUCO All-American in addition to First Team All-Conference. While at Malvern Prep, he averaged 26.6 points as a junior and 25.1 points as a senior. Turner finished his high school career with 2,452 points and set the school record for most points in a game (48).
- Nic Lynch (Seattle, WA/Seattle Prep/Lehigh) is a 6'11, 260-pound center from Seattle, WA. During his four years at Lehigh University in Pennsylvania, he scored 793 points and grabbed 409 rebounds. Lynch drastically improved his three-point shot, making 28-of-61 (45.9%) last season. On February 23, 2022, he dropped a career-high 30 points against American, including a career-high five triples. Lynch was a three-star recruit by ESPN coming out of Seattle Prep, where he scored over 1,000 points in three seasons of varsity.
- Bendji Pierre (Irvington, NJ/The Patrick School/Indian River State College), a 6'8, 230-pound forward from Irvington, NJ, averaged 16.4 points and 8.5 rebounds per game last season at Indian River State College. His best game of the season came on November 17 against Daytona State College, when he registered 40 points on 17-19 from the floor. Pierre was named to First Team All-Conference, Region 8 All-Tournament Team, and NJCAA Player of the Week during his time at Indian River.
- Jaiden Delaire (North Granby, CT/Granby Memorial/Stanford), the Pac-12's Most Improved Player in 2021, comes in at 6'9, 215 pounds. In four years at Stanford, he racked up 917 points, 262 rebounds, 83 assists, 63 steals, and 42 blocks. As a junior, Delaire averaged 12.5 points per game in 23 appearances. On December 12 of last season, he hit a buzzer-beating three-pointer against Oregon for a 72-69 win, ending with 20 points. Prior to Stanford, Delaire was named 2018 Gatorade Boys Basketball Player of the Year in the state of Connecticut and was a consensus four-star prospect. He averaged 21.3 points, 7.4 rebounds and 2.5 assists per game for The Loomis Chaffee School.
- Elliyas Delaire (North Granby, CT/Loomis Chaffee/Lewis & Clark College), the brother of Jaiden, attended Loomis Chaffee in Connecticut. A 6'2, 175-pound guard, Delaire was named All-State, All-Conference, and Conference Tournament MVP in high school.
- Eric Williams Jr. (Port Huron, MI/New Haven/Duquesne/Oregon) compiled 1,420 points, 818 rebounds, 174 assists, and 130 steals in four years of college basketball (two at Duquesne and two at Oregon). During his freshman and sophomore seasons, he had 905 career points and 522 career rebounds, averaging 14.1 points and 8.2 rebounds. Williams Jr. also registered 17 double-doubles during his first two seasons. As a junior at Oregon, he ranked 11th in the Pac-12 in rebounding at 6.0 per game in addition to 10.0 points per game. As a senior, he averaged 8.4 points and 4.6 rebounds.
- Sigu Sisoho Jawara (Barcelona, Spain/LMU/Weber State) is a 6'3 guard who spent one year at LMU before transferring to Weber State for two seasons. In his career, he has compiled 813 points, 169 rebounds, 212 assists, and 76 steals. Sisoho Jawara averaged over 12.2 points per game in each of his last two seasons, drilling 100 three-pointers in that span. He ranks seventh in Weber State history in career three-point field goal percentage at 41.8. The Barcelona, Spain native earned All-Big Sky Second Team honors in 2020-21 before being named to the Third Team last year.
- Jeremiah Nyarko (Accra, Ghana/Sierra Canyon) is a 6'9 forward that most recently played for Sierra
 Canyon in Chatsworth, CA. Last season, Sierra Canyon posted a 26-5 record and advanced to the
 Southern California Regional, finishing with a national ranking of No. 17 by USA Today. Nyarko also
 attended St. John Bosco High School, where he was named Second Team All-League twice. In 2018,
 he was selected to represent Ghana for the NBA Academy in addition to Basketball Without Borders.
- Neel Beniwal (Garnet Valley, PA/The Phelps School) is a 6'5 shooting guard from The Phelps School in Pennsylvania. Beniwal also competed for Rhode Island Elite. He registered 16 points per game, including 100 career three-pointers. The incoming freshman shot 41% from long range.
- Deven Dahlke (Phoenix, AZ/St. Mary's HS/Drake) competed for the Drake Bulldogs over his first two seasons, appearing in 12 total games. The 6'2 guard thrives on the defensive end. Dahlke guided St. Mary's High School to a 24-4 record and led the team in scoring as a senior. He was the 4A Skyline Region Defensive Player of the Year.
- Emmanuel Callas (Moraga, CA/Choate) is a 6'5 wing that played at both Campolindo High School in Moraga and Choate Rosemary Hall in Wallingford, CT. He was named 2021 Bay Area Player of the Year, was a two-time California All-State selection, and led his team to a CIF State Championship. As a senior, he averaged 15.9 points, 7.9 rebounds, 2.5 assists, and 2.0 steals.
- Steven Jamerson II (Los Angeles, CA/Crespi Carmelite) is a 6'10, 210-pound center who also played for West Coast Elite.

Eric Williams Jr. Sets Program Record With 43 Points Against

Utah State

 On November 17, graduate guard Eric Williams Jr. set a USD program record with 43 points, as USD fell to Utah State in overtime, 91-89. Williams Jr. bests the previous USD record of 40, set by Robert "Pinky" Smith in 1972.

He shot 13-of-20 from the floor, 7-of-8 from long distance, and 10-of-13 from
the free throw line. He added 13 rebounds to notch a double-double for the
third straight game. With 2.8 seconds remaining in regulation, Williams Jr. hit a
fadeaway triple from the corner to send the game to overtime.

 Williams Jr. was named WCC Player of the Week for his efforts, becoming USD's first Player of the Week since January 29, 2018 (Isaiah Pineiro). At the time, he notched the second-highest scoring performance in Division I this season (James Bishop, George Washington – 44).

<u>Townsend's Game-Winning Buzzer Beater Earns No. 6 Spot on</u> SportsCenter Top 10

- A step back three-pointer with time expiring from fifth year guard Jase
 Townsend lifted the University of San Diego men's basketball team past Longwood in dramatic fashion on November 28, 71-68.
- Longwood tied the game with a three-pointer with just over five seconds left. Townsend took the inbound, dribbled down the left side, and drilled the game-winner from the corner. He ended with 15 points on 6-of-8 from the floor.
- The shot earned the No. 6 spot on SportsCenter's Top 10.

Triple 20s

- In USD's overtime win at UC Riverside on December 20, three different Toreros scored 20+ points.
- In his 96th collegiate game, junior Sigu Sisoho Jawara set a new career high with 29 points, making 8-of-15 field goal attempts, 4-of-6 three-point attempts, and 9-of-10 free throws. Jawara added four assists and three rebounds in the win. Fifth year guard Marcellus Earlington matched his career high with 25 points on 10-of-18 from the floor. He also contributed eight rebounds, three assists, a steal, and a block. Graduate guard Eric Williams Jr. notched his seventh double-double in 12 games, ending with 23 points and 14 rebounds.
- It was the first time San Diego had three different players score 20+ points since December 23, 2018 (Carter, Wright, and Pineiro vs. Drake).

Comeback in the Bay

- Sparked by a 32-9 run, USD earned a comeback road win at San Francisco on New Year's Eve, 80-68. The Toreros trailed by as many as 15 in the first half, and used contributions from all eight players to seal the win.
- Fifth year guard Marcellus Earlington scored 23 points, including 20 in the second half before fouling out with 6:43 left. He made 7-of-11 attempts from the field and 8-of-10 free throws. Earlington added seven rebounds.
- Sophomore Wayne McKinney III notched a career-high 19 points, shooting 6-of-9 from the floor and 7-of-8 from the free throw line. He added five rebounds in 36 minutes played.
- In his first game back from injury, fifth year guard Jase Townsend registered 22 points (10-11 FT), six rebounds, and four assists.

- Yavuz Gultekin Signs with Aliaga Petkim Spor

 On January 19, 2023, Yavuz Gultekin signed with Aliaga Petkim Spor, a Turkish professional basketball club based in İzmir which currently competes in the Turkish Basketball Super League (BSL)
- In 39 career games at San Diego, Gultekin registered 238 points, 160 rebounds, and 20 assists. Earlier this season in a win over San Diego Christian, he matched his career high of 17 points.
