#### **GAME NOTES & NEWS**

- The University of San Francisco, coming off its first win of the season, hits the road when it faces off against Arizona State at 6 p.m. PT on Monday, Nov. 13 at Desert Financial Arena.
- The Dons earned its first win of the season last Thursday, defeating Stanislaus State, 92-70, at War Memorial at the Sobrato Center. Jasmine Gayles scored a team-high 21 points, and Luana Leite added 16 to lead the Dons to victory. The team shot 48.4 percent (30-for-62) from the floor and 79.4 percent (27-for-34) from the free-throw line.
- Debora dos Santos was again active underneath the basket, recording a career-high
   13 rebounds to go along with nine points.
- Arizona State enters Monday's contest with a 2-0 record after defeating UTSA and Montana State to open the season. The Sun Devils finished last season with an 8-20 record and won just a single game during conference play.
- Jaddan Simmons leads the team in scoring, averaging 17.0 points per game, while Jalyn Brown ranks second, scoring 13.5 points per game.
- Defensively, Journey Thompson leads the team in rebounds, averaging 8.0 per game and has recorded a team-high three blocks.
- San Francisco has only faced off against Arizona State twice in program history, falling in both contests. The last meeting occurred during the 1985-86 season when the Dons fell to the Sun Devils 80-66.

# MOLLY GOODENBOUR

#### PLAYING CAREER

Stanford - 1989-93 Linkspring (Sweden) - 1995-96 Richmond Rage (ABL) - 1996-97 Portland Power (ABL) - 1997-98 Molly Goodenbour, a two-time national champion at Stanford who has 14 years of head coaching experience on the collegiate level, was named the ninth head coach in University of San Francisco women's basketball history on Sep. 28, 2016, and enters her eighth season at the helm of the program in 2023-24. This is Goodenbour's third coaching stint on the Hilltop, where she served as an assistant coach with the Dons during the 1994-95 and 2005-06 seasons.

In the 2022-23 season under the leadership of Goodenbour, the Dons concluded with an overall record of 19-13. Three Dons earned All-WCC Selections, while two Dons earned WCC All-Academic Honors. The Dons also participated in their third straight WNIT.

Within the first six years on the Hilltop, Goodenbour posted impressive numbers, including becoming the winningest coach in USF history through 50 games (27-23) and two seasons at 34-28 (.548). Goodenbour quickly built up her impressive resume at USF, becoming the first coach to post winning overall and conference records in her first two seasons on the job.

Building off the program's strong start to the new decade, the Dons were once again punching a postseason ticket as they battled through a grueling non-conference schedule that kept them away from the Hilltop from Thanksgiving until after New Year's Day. Following an 0-4 start to WCC play, battling through injuries and COVID-19-related pauses, the Dons went on to rattle off wins in six of their next seven games and finished with the third seed heading into the WCC Tournament. USF would go on to defeat Santa Clara in Vegas before returning home to host Air Force in the WNIT.

Since the start of the 2020-21 season, Goodenbour's Dons have made consecutive WNIT appearances and won at least one game in back-to-back WCC Tournaments. Led by two-time All-WCC first-team selection Ioanna Krimili, USF's 2020-21 team led the conference in total points and points per game while being a top-four program in team plus/minus.

Goodenbour's third WCC Tournament in 2019 saw her lead the Dons to a first-round victory over Portland, marking the seventh year in a row the Dons advanced beyond their opening game.

Molly's 2017-18 squad placed three WCC All-Conference and All-Academic honorees. Anna Seilund earned First-Team All-WCC and Second-Team All-WCC recipients Michaela Rakova and Kalyn Simon.

She finished her first year on the Hilltop in 2016-17 with an 18-13 overall record, including an 11-7 mark in West Coast Conference play, suitable for a fourth-place finish, the Dons' highest since the 2002-03 season. In the process, Goodenbour became the first USF head coach since Sue Rojcewicz in 1982-83 to post a winning record in her first year at the helm and compiled the second-best record by a first-year coach in program history. In addition, USF's 11 WCC wins under Goodenbour were the most since the 1996-97 campaign.

Under Goodenbour, the Dons led the conference in free-throw percentage at 77.8%, which stands as the best single-season percentage in program history. Goodenbour's team also led the WCC in 3-point shooting (34.6%) in 2016-17. Their 217 three-pointers made were the most in program history, including a program-best 15 3s in a win over Portland on Feb. 18, 2017.

Goodenbour's squad placed four student-athletes on the WCC All-Academic team in 2016-17 and boasted a pair of All-WCC honorees in first-teamer Rachel Howard and second-team recipient Anna Seilund.

#### **PRIOR TO SAN FRANCISCO**

Goodenbour came to San Francisco from Cal State East Bay, where she was named head coach in June 2016. She has heading coaching experience at Santa Rosa Junior College, Chico State, UC Irvine and Cal State Dominguez Hills.

Before her appointment at Cal State East Bay, Goodenbour spent four seasons as the head coach at Cal State Dominguez Hills. After taking over a program that had posted a 7-48 record in the previous two seasons, Goodenbour led the Toros to a 77-34 (.694) record in her four seasons. Under her guidance, the Toros won California Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA) Tournament Championships in 2013-14 and 2014-15 and CCAA regular season titles in 2014-15 and 2015-16 and made three consecutive NCAA Division II Tournament appearances from 2013-16.

Her 2014-15 squad won a school-record 26 games and earned the No. 2 seed in the NCAA West Regional.

#### 2023-24 SEASON NOTES & NEWS

FIRST WIN OF THE SEASON: San Francisco punched its first win of the season last Thursday, earning a 92-70 win over Stanislaus State at War Memorial at the Sobrato Center. The win marked the 11th straight season the Dons have won their home opener. The last loss at home came on (insert date and opponent).

CONTINUING TO SCORE: Jasmine Gayles recorded back-to-back 20-point performances for the second time in her career after scoring 21 in the win over Stanislaus State in the home opener. Gayles, who leads the team in scoring, averaging 25.5 points per game,

ONE OF THE NATION'S TOP SCORERS TO DATE: Jasmine Gayles, who is averaging 25.5 points per game after the first two games of the season, is ranked tied for 25th in the nation in scoring.

BOUNCE-BACK GAME: Reaching double figures for the first time this season, Luana Leite scored 16 points in last Thursday's win over Stanislaus State. Leite, who shot a perfect five-for-five from the field, also knocked down six of her nine free-throw attempts.

CAREER NIGHT ON THE BOARDS: Recording back-to-back double-digit rebound performances, Debora dos Santos collected a career-high 13 rebounds in the win over Stanislaus State. Surpassing her previous best of 12 set in the season opener at UC Santa Barbara, dos Santos now has accumulated seven games of recording 10+ rebounds.

IT'S A BLOCK PARTY: Making her season debut for the Dons, Seynabou Thiam recorded four blocks in the win over Stanislaus State last Thursday. She has recorded four or more blocks nine times in her career, with the last coming on February 12, 2022, when she recorded four at Abilene Christian while playing for Tarleton State.

DOUBLE FIGURES IN HER DEBUT: Seynabou Thiam reached double figures in her season debut for the Dons, scoring 10 points in 21 minutes off the bench. Her double-digit scoring night marked the 10th time in her career she has scored 10+ points in a game. Her last double-digit scoring performance came on February 12, 2022, when she scored 11 points at Abilene Christian while playing for Tarleton State.

TEAM SCORING AVERAGE: San Francisco ranks 70th in Division I and first in the WCC in scoring, averaging 83.5 points per game.

**BENCH SUPPORT**: Four available players came off the bench for the Dons against Stanislaus State and combined for a season-high 28 points. Led by Seynabou Thiam's 10 points, Paula Tirado (nine points), Aya Keita (five points), and Marina Hernandez (four points) also contributed.

TOOK CONTROL EARLY AND KEPT ROLLING: San Francisco jumped ahead and used an 11-0 run to quickly jump ahead and dominate Stanislaus State in the early goings. The Dons kept the foot on the pedal throughout the game, pushing the lead to as much as 32 points.

92 POINTS IS A LOT: The Dons scored 92 points in the win over Stanislaus State, the most in a game since scoring 104 during the 2022-23 season in a win over Northern New Mexico on December 22, 2022.
