- DePaul currently has five players averaging double-digit scoring.
- The Blue Demons game against South Carolina was the first time this season DePaul did not have multiple double-digit scorers.
- Chico Carter Jr. is coming off his best performance of the season against his former team, South Carolina, Friday evening.
- Carter Jr. scored a season-high 24 points on 8-of-13 shooting.
- Churchill Abass currently ranks 15th nationally in total blocks and is second among freshman.
- DePaul started the season 0-2 for the first time since 2006-07.
- The '06-07 squad went on to a 20-14 record and appearance in the NIT.
- In losses this season, DePaul has outscored its opponents 129-113 in the second half, but was outscored 119-86 in the first half.
- Against South Dakota, DePaul flipped that outscoring the Coyotes by 12 in the first half.
- Elijah Fisher had a standout game off the bench for DePaul against Long Beach State with a career-best 25 points.
- Fishers' 10-of-14 for a 71.4 field goal percentage is the best single-game performance in the BIG EAST in the young season.
- Originally in the Class of 2023, Fisher

- reclassified and played the 2022-23 season at Texas Tech
- The Blue Demons have eight total newcomers, including five Division 1 transfers.
- Chico Carter Jr. entered the 2023-24 season with the second highest career three-point percentage in Division 1 basketball, behind New Orleans' Jordan Johnson.
- This marks the second-straight season Tony Stubblefield has been tasked with replacing his leading scorer from a year ago following the graduation of Umoja Gibson (2022) and Javon Freeman-Liberty (2021).
- DePaul has a total of three games this season against teams ranked in the preseason AP Top 25 poll.

SCOUTING SAN FRANCISCO

- San Francisco is in its second season under head coach Chris Gerlufsen, after going 20-14 a season ago.
- The Dons have recorded six 20-win seasons in the last seven years.
- USF brought in five transfers ahead of the 2023-24 season.
- San Francisco was picked to finish third overall in the WCC Preseason Poll.
- As a team, the Dons rank 21st nationly in assists per game (19.5) and 29th in field goal percentage (.596).
- Johnathan Mogbo ranks fiftth nationally with a 79.4 field goal percentage.

LOCALS ONLY

- Since the start of the 2000-01 season, DePaul is 31-12 against Chicagoland opponents.
- The Blue Demons have won five of their last seven meetings against Chicago schools.

 DePaul faced both Northwestern and Loyola-Chicago schools on the road in the same season for the first time since 1987.

BENCH SPARK

- DePaul has continued to get a tremendous boost of its bench, regardless of who comes in.
- Elijah Fisher was the bench spark in the first two games for DePaul, averaging a team-best 16 points on 65.0 percent shooting.
- Fisher's 25 points where the most off the bench for a DePaul player since Eli Cain's 27

- points on Jan. 24, 2018 against Georgetown.
- Fisher is just the fifth DePaul player with 25+ points off the bench since the 2002-03 season.
- After Fisher moved into the starting lineup, Jaden Henley had a spark off the bench against South Dakota where he dished out six assists with zero turnovers.
- DePaul's bench is currently outscoring opponents, 89-75, through the first four games.

RIM PROTECTORS

- After losing one of the best blocking duos in school history last season (Nick Ongenda and Yor Aeni), many expected DePaul's defensive block numbers to be way down this season.
- However, DePaul is among the nation's leaders, ranking 26th nationally in blocks/ game and third in the BIG EAST.
- The Blue Demon freshman, Churchill Abass, has recorded 10 blocks across his last three games.
- This ranks 15th nationally and leads the BIG EAST in total blocks.

- DePaul has played nine total players this season, eight of whom have recorded at least one block.
- Against South Dakota, DePaul recorded nine blocks which rank as the fourth-most all-time inside Wintrust Arena.
- Abass' four blocks are the most by a DePaul freshman in a single-game since Nick Ongenda against Xavier Feb. 25, 2020.

PRIME MINISTER

- DePaul has seen the emergence of true freshman, Churchill Abass, in its last two games.
- Abass joined DePaul over the summer from NBA Africa Academy
- The Nigeria native joined the NBA Academy Africa in Dec. 2022, having played very little organized basketball prior.

COACH STUBBS ON ABASS

Churchill has a lot of potential. He's just now been in a situation where he is getting acclimated and playing. I think the more and more that he gets out there, the better he will be. He is going to get better and better. He is strong, his physicality, his athleticism.

- DePaul's season opener was the first-time Abass played in an arena. He saw just three minutes in the opener.
- Abass scored his first collegiate points in the win against South Dakota, and piled up a total of eight in the first half.
- He ended the game with eight points, seven boards and four blocks.

LENGTHY GUARDS

- DePaul's guards have an average height of 6'3".
- The Blue Demons guards are on average one inch taller than the guard lineup a season ago.
- DePaul's overall average height is 77.3 inches, up from 77.1 in 2021-22.
- Keyondre Young and Jaden Henley are the Blue Demons tallest guards, listed at 6-9 and 6-7, respectively.
- DePaul has just three players listed under 6-4.

SHARP SHOOTERS

- A season ago, DePaul recorded the 273 threepointers on the season, the most in school history.
- Despite the loss of Umoja Gibson and Javan Johnson to graduation, DePaul reloaded with the addition of four players who have all shot over 30 percent in their career (Chico Carter Jr., Jaden Henley, Jeremiah Oden and Keyondre Young).
- The new additions join the likes of Jalen Terry, K.T. Raimey and Da'Sean Nelson - all of whom shot above 30 percent from three a year ago.
- Carter Jr. is a career 43.1 percent three-point shooter, including 47.6 percent across 25 games at South Carolina last season.

- DePaul added former five-star recruit, Elijah Fisher, who came to Lincoln Park from Texas Tech. Fisher, originally in the class of 2023, reclassifyed to the class of 2022 where he played his freshman season in Lubbock.
- Mac Etienne brings a wealth of NCAA
 Tournament experience going to three NCAA
 Tournaments with UCLA.

X'S AND O'S

- DePaul's newcomers didn't end in the transfer portal as head coach Tony Stubblefield added two former Division I head coaches to his bench.
- Tony Harvey joined DePaul as an assistant coach and Matt Brady as special assistant to the head coach.
- Harvey was the head coach at Texas Southern from 2008-12 where he led the Tigers to the 2010 SWAC Championship game and the program's first winning season in seven years.
- Harvey also helped lead a successful program as a part of Quin Snyder's staff at Mizzou from 1999-04 as associate head coach.
- While at Mizzou, Harvey brought in six-recruiting classes that were ranked in the top-10 nationally and went to four-consecutive NCAA Tournaments, including the 2002 Elite Eight.
- Brady has 12 years of head coaching experience combined between Marist and James Madison, including five 20-win seasons and eight with 18 or more victories.
- He won two conference championships with JMU and led the Dukes to the second round of the 2013 NCAA Tournament.
- Brady was also previously at Maryland where he helped the Terps to the 2020 Big Ten Championship title and two NCAA Tournament appearances.

AT THE POINT

- With Jalen Terry missing the first four games due to a ankle injury, DePaul has seen several players at the point.
- DePaul looks to have Terry back soon as he has begun return to activity and is progresing forward.
- Caleb Murphy has taken the lead as the starting point guard for DePaul with six assists through the first two games.
- Murphy has been plagued by foul trouble however, fouling out in three games this season.
- Chico Carter Jr., K.T. Raimey and Jaden Henley have all also seen time at the point.
- Carter Jr. currently leads DePaul with eight assists this season.
- Henley looked to settle into the point position against South Dakota, coming off the bench for six assists with zero turnovers.

BLUE DEMONS PROS

- DePaul had three players on NBA Opening Day rosters, with an additional six currently active in the G League.
- Following outstanding NBA Playoff runs last season, both Paul Reed and Max Strus signed new contracts leading into the 2023-24 season.
- Reed signed a new contract with the Philadelphia 76ers for a 3-year deal.
- Strus made the move to the Cleveland Cavaliers on a 4-year, \$62 million deal.
- Additionally, Javon Freeman-Liberty signed a deal with the Toronto Raptors following an

- outstanding Summer League run with the Windy City Bulls.
- DePaul G League players including 2022-23 team members - Javon Johnson, Nick Ongenda and Yor Anei.
- Additionally, Eli Cain and Romeo Weems are also active in the G League.

BRING THE DREAM HOME

- In August, DePaul University and DePaul Athletics announced a transformative \$60 million facility campaign.
- The campaign will rennovate the current Sullivan Athletics Center and features the newconstruction of a basketball dedicated practice facility across the street.
- McGrath-Phillips Arena, locted inside Sullivan Athletics Center, will remain the home to DePaul volleyball.
- The rennovations will give each DePaul varsity team their own dedicated lockerroom for the first time in school history in addition to upgraded strength and conditioning spaces, updated sports medicine and training rooms.
- The new practice facility features a first floor with facilities for all athletic programs including an additional weight training and sports medicine spaces and a broadcast studio.
- The second floor will be dedicated to team locker rooms for both the men's and women's program, in addition to health & wellness spaces and marketing/communications offices.
- The third and fourth floor will feature two courts with floor to ceiling windows, to showcase the surrounding beauty of Chicago.

TONY STUBBLEFIELD

HEAD COACH

4TH SEASON OVERALL // 28-52 (.367) 3RD SEASON AT DEPAUL // 26-42 (.407)

Relentless energy and enthusiasm have been evident since Tony Stubblefield was named head coach of the men's basketball program in April 2021. He is the 15th head coach in DePaul history.

Stubblefield made his DePaul debut with a 97-72 win over Coppin State on Nov. 10 at Wintrust Arena and the 97 points were just a view into the style of play that Stubblefield is looking to establish in the South Loop. Overall, the Blue Demons scored at least 84 points in nine games that includes six contests of 90 or more points in a game.

The 15 wins during the 2021-22 campaign were the most by a first-year DePaul head coach since the 2002-03 season. The Blue Demons closed the regular season by winning three of their final four games that included victories over Georgetown, St. John's and Marquette. Stubblefield and the Blue Demons opened the season with a 9-1 record that marked the best start for a first-year head coach at DePaul since Rey Meyer went 13-1 to being the 1942-43 campaign.

Stubblefield came to DePaul after spending the last 11 seasons at Oregon and has over two decades of experience in college basketball and is regarded as one of the nation's top recruiters. He helped the Ducks to 10 postseason appearances that included eight NCAA Tournament berths. The eight NCAA berths saw Oregon reach the Final Four once and Elite Eight once along with three other Sweet 16 appearances. Overall, the Ducks added four regular-season conference championships and three conference tournament championships to the trophy case in Stubbfield's 11 seasons.

In addition to the team success, Stubblefield assisted head coach Dana Altman in building the program through multiple nationally ranked recruiting classes. He helped Oregon assemble five recruiting classes that were ranked among the top 12 nationally (2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2021). Included in those classes were future NBA players Troy Brown Jr. and Louis King and NBA Draft choices Brown Jr., Bol Bol and Payton Pritchard.

Prior to Oregon, Stubblefield spent four years as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator in the BIG EAST Conference at the University of Cincinnati. He also was on the staffs at New Mexico State (2000-06), UT-Arlington (1996-00), UT-San Antonio (1995-96) and at his alma mater Nebraska-Omaha (1992-95).

Before joining the staff at Cincinnati, Stubblefield served as assistant coach at New Mexico State for six seasons, one of which he served as interim head coach. Prior to the start of the 2004-05 season, he was elevated to interim head coach when Lou Henson's health forced him to miss the season.

As recruiting coordinator for the Aggies, Stubblefield attracted three national Top-100 rated players, including one McDonald's All-American, a junior college all-American, and first-team all-state high school players from six different states.

Prior to his tenure at New Mexico State, Stubblefield was the lead assistant and recruiting coordinator at the UT-Arlington for four seasons. He successfully recruited two Top-10 prospects from the state of Texas along with first-team all-region junior college players from Texas, Louisiana, Alabama, and Mississippi.

Stubblefield began his coaching career as a student assistant for two seasons at the University of Nebraska at Omaha, his alma mater, where he completed his undergraduate degree in 1995.

Stubblefield, who transferred to UNO following two years at Clinton (Iowa) Community College, earned two letters playing guard at Nebraska-Omaha where he was the team captain his senior season.

Upon graduation from UNO, he became an assistant coach at the UT-San Antonio for the 1995-96 season, where he was responsible for coaching the guards and was the program's top recruiter.

After growing up in Clinton, Iowa, Stubblefield was one of the top players in the state of Colorado. He was the runner-up for state Player of the Year honors at Bloomfield (Colo.) High School his senior season, while picking up first-team all-state and Boulder County Player of the Year accolades.
