## GAME NOTES & NEWS

- The University of San Francisco women's basketball team opens the 2023-24 season on the road when it travels to take on UC Santa Barbara at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, Nov. 7 at The Thunderdome.
- Concluding the 2022-23 season with a 19-13 record, the most wins in a season since 2015-16, the Dons earned a fourth-place finish in the WCC standings and a third straight Women's National Invitation Tournament (WNIT).
- San Francisco finished the 2022-23 season at Washington, competing in the WNIT. The Dons ultimately fell, 61-46, at Alaska Airlines Arena, with Debora dos Santos leading the team with a 10-point, 10-rebound double-double.
- UC Santa Babara, opening the new campaign at home for the third consecutive season, is coming off its first 20+ win season since 2008-09.
- The Gauchos, concluding last season with a 21-12 overall record, finished Big West Conference runner-ups after narrowly falling to Hawaii, 61-59, in the conference championship game at Dollar Loan Center in Henderson, Nev.
- The two programs have faced off eight times since the first-ever meeting during the 1980-81 season. San Francisco holds a 5-3 record over UC Santa Barbara, winning the first five matchups, outscoring the Gauchos, 352-292.
- The Gauchos won the last meeting during the 2011-12 season, earning a 60-41 win at The Thunderdome on December 2, 2011. Rheina Ale and Katy Keating led the Dons with 10 points apiece, while Taj Winston secured a team-high 10 rebounds.

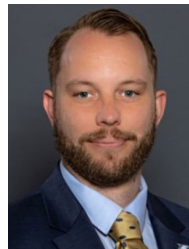

Molly Goodenbour, a two-time national champion at Stanford who has 14 years of head coaching experience on the collegiate level, was named the ninth head coach in University of San Francisco women's basketball history on Sep. 28, 2016, and enters her eighth season at the helm of the program in 2023-24. This is Goodenbour's third coaching stint on the Hilltop, where she served as an assistant coach with the Dons during the 1994-95 and 2005-06 seasons.

In the 2022-23 season under the leadership of Goodenbour, the Dons concluded with an overall record of 19-13. Three Dons earned All-WCC Selections, while two Dons earned WCC All-Academic Honors. The Dons also participated in their third straight WNIT.

Within the first six years on the Hilltop, Goodenbour posted impressive numbers, including becoming the winningest coach in USF history through 50 games (27-23) and two seasons at 34-28 (.548). Goodenbour quickly built up her impressive resume at USF, becoming the first coach to post winning overall and conference records in her first two seasons on the job.

Building off the program's strong start to the new decade, the Dons were once again punching a postseason ticket as they battled through a grueling non-conference schedule that kept them away from the Hilltop from Thanksgiving until after New Year's Day. Following an 0-4 start to WCC play, battling through injuries and COVID-19-related pauses, the Dons went on to rattle off wins in six of their next seven games and finished with the third seed heading into the WCC Tournament. USF would go on to defeat Santa Clara in Vegas before returning home to host Air Force in the WNIT.

Since the start of the 2020-21 season, Goodenbour's Dons have made consecutive WNIT appearances and won at least one game in back-to-back WCC Tournaments. Led by two-time All-WCC first-team selection Ioanna Krimili, USF's 2020-21 team led the conference in total points and points per game while being a top-four program in team plus/minus.

Goodenbour's third WCC Tournament in 2019 saw her lead the Dons to a first-round victory over Portland, marking the seventh year in a row the Dons advanced beyond their opening game.

Molly's 2017-18 squad placed three WCC All-Conference and All-Academic honorees. Anna Seilund earned First-Team All-WCC and Second-Team All-WCC recipients Michaela Rakova and Kalya Simon.

She finished her first year on the Hilltop in 2016-17 with an 18-13 overall record, including an 11-7 mark in West Coast Conference play, suitable for a fourth-place finish, the Dons' highest since the 2002-03 season. In the process, Goodenbour became the first USF head coach since Sue Rojewicz in 1982-83 to post a winning record in her first year at the helm and compiled the second-best record by a first-year coach in program history. In addition, USF's 11 WCC wins under Goodenbour were the most since the 1996-97 campaign.

Under Goodenbour, the Dons led the conference in free-throw percentage at 77.8%, which stands as the best single-season percentage in program history. Goodenbour's team also led the WCC in 3-point shooting (34.6%) in 2016-17. Their 217 three-pointers made were the most in program history, including a program-best 15 3s in a win over Portland on Feb. 18, 2017.

Goodenbour's squad placed four student-athletes on the WCC All-Academic team in 2016-17 and boasted a pair of All-WCC honorees in first-teamer Rachel Howard and second-team recipient Anna Seilund.

### PRIOR TO SAN FRANCISCO

Goodenbour came to San Francisco from Cal State East Bay, where she was named head coach in June 2016. She has heading coaching experience at Santa Rosa Junior College, Chico State, UC Irvine and Cal State Dominguez Hills.

Before her appointment at Cal State East Bay, Goodenbour spent four seasons as the head coach at Cal State Dominguez Hills. After taking over a program that had posted a 7-48 record in the previous two seasons, Goodenbour led the Toros to a 77-34 (.694) record in her four seasons. Under her guidance, the Toros won California Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA) Tournament Championships in 2013-14 and 2014-15 and CCAA regular season titles in 2014-15 and 2015-16 and made three consecutive NCAA Division II Tournament appearances from 2013-16.

Her 2014-15 squad won a school-record 26 games and earned the No. 2 seed in the NCAA West Regional.

## 2023-24 SEASON NOTES & NEWS

**THE NEWCOMERS:** The Dons have added four Division I transfers, one Junior College transfer, and two freshmen to this season's roster.

- Mia Vuksic:** Vuksic comes to the Hilltop after spending the last three years competing for Kansas of the Big 12 Conference. She appeared in 54 games across three seasons, averaging 4.1 points per game while demonstrating a solid ability to stretch the floor as she shot 48% from three-point range during the 2021-22 season.
- Freja Werth:** Werth joins the Dons after competing for UAlbany in the America East Conference, where she appeared in 65 games and averaged 4.9 points per game primarily off the bench while starting a few games in the Great Danes' backcourt.
- Seynabou Thiam:** Thiam joins the Dons after competing for Tarleton State most recently during the 2021-22 season, where she played in 27 games and made 25 starts where she averaged 6.3 points per game, 6.2 rebounds per game and 2.3 blocks for the Texans.
- Thiam began her collegiate career competing for McLennan Community College before transferring to Arkansas State. The Senegal native ranked 20th nationally in blocked shots during her one season at Tarleton State while also ranking in the top 10 in the Western Athletic Conference in rebounds per game.
- Sol Castro:** Castro spent the previous three years competing for Robert Morris University in Carnot-Moon, Pa., where she became the first freshman in program history to lead the team in scoring during the 2020-21 season as she was selected to the Horizon League's all-freshman team.
- Starting and competing in all 28 games for the Colonials during the 2021-22 season, Castro averaged 8.6 points per game while leading her team in total rebounds (152) and blocks (17). A native of Argentina, Sol represented her home country at the U18, U19 and Senior levels during her international prep career. She helped Argentina capture the bronze medal at the 2018 FIBA U18 Americas Championships, averaging 7.0 points per game, 9.2 rebounds per game and 1.5 assists.
- Luana Leite:** Leite comes to the Hilltop after a pair of solid seasons leading South Georgia Tech as she played in 33 games last season while making 31 starts, averaging 10.8 points per game and shooting an impressive 52 percent from the floor.
- Paula Tirado:** A knowledgeable player able to set up her teammates and score the basketball herself, Tirado won the 2021 FIBA U16 European Championship with the Spanish National Team and was on the team that finished third in the Spanish National Tournament in 2021-22.
- Tirado was a significant contributor to Mataro's women's team that plays in LF2, which is Spain's second professional division.
- Elle Papahronis:** Papahronis, a two-time Defensive Player of the Year in Oklahoma, comes to the Hilltop after leading North Edmond High School to the 2021-22 Oklahoma State Championship. During her championship-winning season, Elle averaged 15.3 points, 8.3 rebounds, 2.7 assists, 2.3 steals and 1.4 blocks per game, showing her all-around and versatile skill set.

**NOTABLE RETURNERS:** In her second season with the green and gold, Jasmine Gayles ranked third on the team in scoring, averaging 10.1 points per game in 32 games off the bench. Gayles, the reigning WCC Sixth Woman of the Year, reached double figures in 18 games while tallying a career-high 23 points twice in wins over Cal State East Bay and Colorado State.

Debora dos Santos returns for her third season with the Dons after ranking second on the team with 12.4 points per game. dos Santos, who also ranked second on the team in rebound with 7.2 per game, accumulated 14 assists and 15 blocks.

## 2023-24 SEASON NOTES & NEWS

0-0	<b>STARTING FRESH:</b> After compiling 19 wins a season ago, nine members from San Francisco's 2022-23 roster departed the team, including senior standout Ioanna Krimili. The Dons, retooling during the offseason, welcomed seven new players for the upcoming season.
0-0	<b>LOST CONTRIBUTION:</b> The Dons lost 76.2 percent of the team's scoring from a season ago. Former guard Ioanna Krimili, a four-year standout for the Dons, led the team last season in multiple categories, including points (16.6), free throw percentage (.871), minutes (31.6), and steals (38).
0-0	<b>KICKING OFF THE SEASON ON THE ROAD:</b> San Francisco begins the 2023-24 season on the road, the first time the Dons have started a season on the road since 2020-21 when the team competed at UC Davis on November 25, 2020.
0-0	<b>MILESTONE REACHED LAST SEASON:</b> Jasmine Gayles, in her fourth season of collegiate basketball, surpassed 1,000 career points after scoring a team-high 19 in a win over San Diego State on December 4, 2022, at Chase Center. Gayles has recorded 706 career points while competing with San Francisco.
