GAME NOTES & NEWS

- The University of San Francisco women's basketball team kicks off the final month of the year on the road when it travels to take on Washington at 1 p.m. on Saturday, Dec. 2, at Alaska Airlines Arena.
- San Francisco enters Saturday's contest after dropping a neutral-site game at Chase Center last Sunday, falling 62-53 to Colorado State. The Dons led most of the first half before the Rams dominated the final two quarters and eased to a nine-point victory.
- Debora dos Santos led the Dons, recording her second-straight double-double, scoring 14 points and 13 rebounds against the Rams. Her double-double marked the third time she has surpassed double-digit points and rebounds this season.
- Washington returns home for the first time since Saturday, Nov. 18, and is coming off three games in the Rainbow Wahine Showdown hosted by Hawaii. The Huskies are 7-0 to start the season, with four of those wins coming at Alaska Airlines Arena.
- Dalayah Daniels leads the Huskies in scoring, averaging 12.6 points per game. Daniels has reached double figures in five of the team's seven games and scored a season-high 19 points in the win over Hawaii last Sunday.
- Daniels also leads the Huskies defensively, ranking first on the team in total rebounds (56) and blocks (12).
- The two programs have faced off nine times since the first-ever meeting in the 1980-81 season. Washington holds a 7-2 record over San Francisco, with the last win coming in the first round of the WNIT last season in a 61-46 decision in Seattle.

PLAYING CAREER

Stanford - 1989-93 Linkspring (Sweden) - 1995-96 Richmond Rage (ABL) - 1996-97 Portland Power (ABL) - 1997-98 Molly Goodenbour, a two-time national champion at Stanford who has 14 years of head coaching experience on the collegiate level, was named the ninth head coach in University of San Francisco women's basketball history on Sep. 28, 2016, and enters her eighth season at the helm of the program in 2023-24. This is Goodenbour's third coaching stint on the Hilltop, where she served as an assistant coach with the Dons during the 1994-95 and 2005-06 seasons.

In the 2022-23 season under the leadership of Goodenbour, the Dons concluded with an overall record of 19-13. Three Dons earned All-WCC Selections, while two Dons earned WCC All-Academic Honors. The Dons also participated in their third straight WNIT.

Within the first six years on the Hilltop, Goodenbour posted impressive numbers, including becoming the winningest coach in USF history through 50 games (27-23) and two seasons at 34-28 (.548). Goodenbour quickly built up her impressive resume at USF, becoming the first coach to post winning overall and conference records in her first two seasons on the job.

Building off the program's strong start to the new decade, the Dons were once again punching a postseason ticket as they battled through a grueling non-conference schedule that kept them away from the Hilltop from Thanksgiving until after New Year's Day. Following an 0-4 start to WCC play, battling through injuries and COVID-19-related pauses, the Dons went on to rattle off wins in six of their next seven games and finished with the third seed heading into the WCC Tournament. USF would go on to defeat Santa Clara in Vegas before returning home to host Air Force in the WNIT.

Since the start of the 2020-21 season, Goodenbour's Dons have made consecutive WNIT appearances and won at least one game in back-to-back WCC Tournaments. Led by two-time All-WCC first-team selection Ioanna Krimili, USF's 2020-21 team led the conference in total points and points per game while being a top-four program in team plus/minus.

Goodenbour's third WCC Tournament in 2019 saw her lead the Dons to a first-round victory over Portland, marking the seventh year in a row the Dons advanced beyond their opening game.

Molly's 2017-18 squad placed three WCC All-Conference and All-Academic honorees. Anna Seilund earned First-Team All-WCC and Second-Team All-WCC recipients Michaela Rakova and Kalyn Simon.

She finished her first year on the Hilltop in 2016-17 with an 18-13 overall record, including an 11-7 mark in West Coast Conference play, suitable for a fourth-place finish, the Dons' highest since the 2002-03 season. In the process, Goodenbour became the first USF head coach since Sue Rojcewicz in 1982-83 to post a winning record in her first year at the helm and compiled the second-best record by a first-year coach in program history. In addition, USF's 11 WCC wins under Goodenbour were the most since the 1996-97 campaign.

Under Goodenbour, the Dons led the conference in free-throw percentage at 77.8%, which stands as the best single-season percentage in program history. Goodenbour's team also led the WCC in 3-point shooting (34.6%) in 2016-17. Their 217 three-pointers made were the most in program history, including a program-best 15 3s in a win over Portland on Feb. 18, 2017.

Goodenbour's squad placed four student-athletes on the WCC All-Academic team in 2016-17 and boasted a pair of All-WCC honorees in first-teamer Rachel Howard and second-team recipient Anna Seilund.

PRIOR TO SAN FRANCISCO

Goodenbour came to San Francisco from Cal State East Bay, where she was named head coach in June 2016. She has heading coaching experience at Santa Rosa Junior College, Chico State, UC Irvine and Cal State Dominguez Hills.

Before her appointment at Cal State East Bay, Goodenbour spent four seasons as the head coach at Cal State Dominguez Hills. After taking over a program that had posted a 7-48 record in the previous two seasons, Goodenbour led the Toros to a 77-34 (.694) record in her four seasons. Under her guidance, the Toros won California Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA) Tournament Championships in 2013-14 and 2014-15 and CCAA regular season titles in 2014-15 and 2015-16 and made three consecutive NCAA Division II Tournament appearances from 2013-16.

Her 2014-15 squad won a school-record 26 games and earned the No. 2 seed in the NCAA West Regional.

2023-24 SEASON NOTES & NEWS

ANOTHER DOUBLE-DOUBLE: Debora dos Santos recorded her second-straight double-double last Sunday after posting 14 points and 13 rebounds at Chase Center against Colorado State. Her third double-double of the season marks the seventh time in her career that she surpassed double-digit points and rebounds in a game.

NATIONALLY RANKED IN TOTAL REBOUNDS: Debora dos Santos ranks 22nd in Division I in total rebounds, securing 65 in seven games this season. Dos Santos has accumulated four games of double-digit rebounds this season while reaching a career-high 13 twice against Stanislaus State (Nov. 9) and Colorado State (Nov. 26).

REBOUNDS PER GAME: Leading the WCC and ranking 47th in Division I in rebounds per game, Debora dos Santos averages 9.3 through seven games.

THE LEADING SCORER: Reaching double figures in six of the seven games this season, Jasmine Gyales continues to lead the team and ranks second in the WCC in scoring, averaging 17.1 points per game. Gayles scored 10 points against Colorado State last Sunday.

SUCCESS AT THE FREE-THROW LINE: Jasmine Gayles and Freja Weth have succeeded at the free-throw line this season, averaging 80 percent or better from the charity stripe. Werth ranks first on the team, shooting 85.7 percent (12-for-14), while Gayles ranks second at 80.0 percent (40-for-50). Gayles ranks tied for 11th nationally in made free throws, as she has recorded 40.

GETTING INTO FORM: Scoring a season-high nine points last Sunday against Colorado State, Mia Vuksic knocked down three field goals, including a three-pointer in 18 minutes off the bench. In two games for the Dons this season, Vuksic is averaging 7.5 points per game while adding three rebounds and two assists.

FOURTH IN THE CONFERENCE IN ASSISTS: San Francisco ranks fourth in the WCC and 57th in the nation in assists, averaging 16.3 per game. The Dons have five players with at least 10 assists through six games, with Luana Leite and Jasmine Gayles leading the team with 24. Cami Fulcher (19), Paula Tirado (17), and Debora dos Santos (10) have also accumulated double-digit assists.

REBOUNDING MARGIN: San Francisco has outrebounded six of its seven opponents this season. The team's 5.9 rebounding margin ranks third in the WCC and 75th in Division I.

STARTED WELL, BUT GOTTA FINISH: San Francisco led Colorado State through the first two quarters of play, holding a four-point lead, 27-23 at halftime. The Rams, however, outscored the Dons, 39-26, in the second half to earn the win last Sunday at Chase Center.

SCOUTING THE HUSKIES

PERFECT ON THE FIRST ROAD TRIP: In its first road trip of the season, Washington earned three wins in the Rainbow Wahine Showdown, defeating Idaho State, Air Force, and Hawaii. The Huskies outscored their opponents 188-131, earning wins by an average of 19 points.

BEST EVER START: Washington has begun the 2023-24 with an undefeated 7-0 record, marking the best start in program history. During the seven-game winning streak, the Huskies have outscored their opponents 538-332, averaging 76.9 points per game.

DANIELS AND SCHWARTZ ARE THE REAL DEAL: Dalayah Daniels and Lauren Schwartz are the Huskies' top scorers, with Daniels averaging 12.6 points while Schwartz ranks second at 12.3 points per game. Daniels is shooting 53.6 percent from the floor, while Schwartz has been productive from distance, shooting 35.5 percent from the three-point line.

LEADING THE DEFENSE: While also leading the offense, Dalayah Daniels ranks among the best defensive players on the team. Through seven games, Daniels leads the Huskies in defensive rebounds with 33 and blocks with 12. She ranks 16th in the Pac-12 in defensive rebounds while ranking tied for fifth in blocks.

HARD TIME SCORING ON THE HUSKIES: Washington ranks second in the country in scoring defense, holding opponents to just 46.6 points per game. The most points the Huskies have given up this season is 64 to Pacific and Seattle U.

HARD TO BEAT AT HOME: Washington has recorded 12 straight home wins dating back to last season. The last time the Huskies dropped a game at Alaska Airlines Arena was on January 22, 2023, when they fell to USC 63-54 in overtime. The Huskies accumulated a 16-5 record at home during the 2022-23 season.

ALL-TIME SERIES: Saturday's games marks the 10th time the two programs will face off. Washington holds a 7-2 record over San Francisco since the first-ever meeting during the 1980-81 season. San Francisco last defeated Washington during the 2001-02 season, earning a 72-68 win at home. Last season's matchup in the first round of the WNIT marked the first time the Dons faced off against the Huskies in 21 years.
