GAME NOTES & NEWS

-Returning to Chase Center this past Sunday, San Francisco defeated Minnesota, 76-58, to extend their win streak to a season-high three games this past Sunday, Nov. 26. Individually, Jonathan Mogbo recorded his second straight double-double as he scored a career-high 21 points on 9-of-15 shooting in addition to grabbing 10 rebounds. Additionally, Marcus Williams shined with a season-high 20 points on 9-of-14 from the floor as he and Mogbo became the first pair of Dons this season to both score 20+ points in the same game.

-After guiding the Dons to a 2-0 week, Ryan Beasley earned WCC Freshman of the Week honors on Monday as he averaged 15.5 points and 3.0 steals in wins over Purdue Fort Wayne and Minnesota. Notably, this honor marked the first Player of the Week award for a Don this season.

-Within the conference, Mogbo sits atop the leaderboard in field goal percentage (72.7 percent) and steals per game (1.9). Impressively, the Missouri State transfer also ranks in the top five in the WCC in rebounds per game (third, 9.0) and points per game (fourth, 15.7). Overall, Mogbo remains one of the nation's most efficient players from the field as his field goal percentage is fourth-best in Division I.

-As a team, the Dons lead the WCC in field goal percentage (50.6 percent), assists per game (17.3), steals per game (10.14), turnover margin (3.57) and scoring margin (+20.3). Across Division I programs, the green and gold are 17th in the country in scoring margin and 21st in field goal percentage and steals per game.

-San Francisco continues to creep up the KenPom rankings as the Dons head into Sunday's game ranking at No. 69, good for second best in the WCC behind Gonzaga (10).

PLAYING CAREER

Randolph-Macon - 1994-98

Chris Gerlufsen enters his second season as head coach of the Dons after being promoted on March 18, 2022. Originally coming to the Hilltop in the summer of 2021 as the associate head coach on Todd Golden's staff, Gerlufsen serves as San Francisco's primary offensive coordinator with a focus on working with the guards.

The 2022-23 season under the helm of Gerlufsen concluded with a 20-14 overall record with an appearance semifinal round of the WCC Tournament. Two Dons, Khalil Shabazz and Tyrell Roberts, were named to the WCC All-Conference First Team. This marks the second straight year in which San Francisco has had two First Team selections. Shabazz also earned District 9 Second Team honors. Two Dons earned WCC All-Academic honors. It was also San Francisco's sixth 20+ win season in the last seven years.

In 2021-22, San Francisco grew into one of the elite offenses in the country as the Dons ranked in the top five in the West Coast Conference as a team in three-point field goal attempts (934, first), three-point field goals per game (9.6, first), total three-point field goals made (327, first), offensive rebounds (10.76, first), scoring offense (77.4, second), field goal percentage (45.7, fourth), free throws attempted (598, third), free throws made (415, third). Nationally, San Francisco also ranked in the top fifty in three-point field goal attempts (thirteenth), total three-point field goals made (fourteenth), three-point field goals per game (sixteenth), scoring margin (twenty-eighth) and scoring offense (thirty-seventh).

Individually, Jamaree Bouyea and Yauhen Massalski were selected to the All-WCC First Team while Khalil Shabazz was named to the All-WCC Second Team. Overall, San Francisco tallied their most wins (24) since the program was reinstated in 1985-86 as the Dons returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 1997-98. As a team, San Francisco's 77.4 points per game were also the most for the green and gold since the 2015-16 season, when the Dons averaged 77.6 points under Rex Walters. On Wednesday, Dec. 28, 2021, San Francisco broke the single-game program record for most three-pointers in a game with 20 made triples in a 111-78 win over Academy of Art. Bouyea signed a 10-day contract with the Miami Heat of the NBA in February of 2023 and the Washington Wizards in March of 2023.

Prior to San Francisco, Gerlufsen served as the top assistant to head coach Eran Ganot at Hawaii from 2019-22. While at UH, he oversaw the guards and served as the Rainbow Warriors' offensive coordinator. He also served as the interim head coach for Hawaii's first 13 games in the 2019-20 season, leading UH to an 8-5 non-conference record, including an 85-75 upset win over previously undefeated San Francisco.

Under his watch, three UH guards earned All-Big West Honorable Mention honors, including Drew Buggs in 2019-20 and Justin Webster and Junior Madut in 2020-21. Buggs flourished under Gerlufsen's watch, finishing with career-bests in points per game, minutes played and assists per game in his junior season. In Hawaii's 2019 win over the Dons, he scored a career-best 25 points while going 11-for-19 from the field.

In 2021-22, Madut and Webster were two of UH's top-four scorers. Webster led the team in points per game (12.7) and three-point field goals (34) while shooting 51 percent from the field in Big West Play.

Gerlufsen also previously spent four seasons as an assistant at San Diego from 2015-19, giving him familiarity with the West Coast Conference. During his time with the Toreros, USD experienced unprecedented success, posting back-to-back 20-win seasons for the first time in program history while advancing to the postseason both years. He finished his run with the Torreros in 2018-19 with San Diego earning a berth to the NIT.

At USD, Gerlufsen also oversaw guards and served as offensive coordinator as he led USD's global recruiting efforts by signing more than a half dozen international players during his tenure. In his last two years at USD, he coached a trio of all-conference selections, including Isaiah Pineiro, Olin Carter III and Isaiah Wright.

Prior to USD, Gerlufsen spent nine seasons on the bench as an assistant the University of Hartford, with the last two seasons of which he served as associate head coach. While at Hartford, his primary responsibilities including working with both the perimeter and post players as well as serving as the staff's recruiting coordinator.

Accountable for tapping into the Texas pipeline at Hartford, Gerlufsen attracted several quality basketball players from the Lone Star State. Notably, student-athletes on that list include forward Mark Nwakamma, a 2012-13 America East All-Conference First Team pick, and guards Wes Cole, Evan Cooper and Yolonzo Moore II.

During his tenure at Hartford, Gerlufsen helped implement a perimeter-oriented motion offense for the Hawks, which accounted for six consecutive seasons with 225 or more made three pointers, including a school-record 312 in the 2007-08 campaign, which also set an America East Conference record.

Gerlufsen also had stops at The Citadel (2001-'06), Southwestern (1999-'01) and got his start as an assistant coach at Washington College in Maryland in 1998-99.

Gerlufsen was a four-time letter winner for Randolph-Macon College, a Division III school in Virginia. While playing for the Yellow Jackets, he was named team captain for a squad that twice advanced to the NCAA Division III tournament. He graduated in 1998 with a B.A. in Business and Economics. He is a native of Philadelphia, Pa.

2023-24 SEASON NOTES & NEWS

-The Dons are headed to Arizona for the second time this season after playing in the inaugural Arizona Tip-Off tournament two weeks ago. Competing at Desert Diamond Arena in Glendale, San Francisco finished in third place as the Dons narrowly fell to Grand Canyon in their first game on Nov. 17 before rallying back to defeat DePaul in their second game on Nov. 19.

-Opening the 2023-24 regular season in dominant fashion, San Francisco recorded their highest margin of victory in program history (69) to begin the year on Monday, Nov. 6 as the Dons downed Bethesda, 128-59, on the Hilltop. Notably, seven different Dons finished in double figures, with Stefan Todorovic and Jonathan Mogbo pacing the offense with 17 points each.

-With the win over Bethesda, USF has now won their home opener in six consecutive seasons dating back to 2018-19.

-Overall, the 128 points scored by San Francisco marked the top scoring output in the NCAA on opening night, six points better than Arizona (122). Impressively, 81 of USF's 128 points came from the bench, which was 12 more than any other team in the country on opening night.

-In addition to notching their largest margin of victory, USF's 82 points in the first half against Bethesda also marked the most points in a single half by a USF team, surpassing the previous record of 72 vs. LMU on Feb. 25, 1989.

-Beginning a few days after the new year, San Francisco will begin their 16game conference slate on Jan. 4 when they head east to Stockton for a battle at Pacific.

-Notably, the Dons will wrap up WCC action with two crucial games – home vs. Gonzaga on Feb. 29 and away at Santa Clara on Mar. 2.

-Notably, USF rosters ten student-athletes over 6'5" as the Dons added size and strength this offseason.

-Additionally, eight countries are also represented across the roster: Australia, China, England, Georgia, Mongolia, Serbia, Ukraine and the United States.

-Looking at the national landscape, CBS Sports ranked San Francisco No. 77 in their preseason rankings.
