- Gonzaga and San Francisco meet for the 92nd time in the McCarthey Athletic Center Thursday at 6 p.m.
- The Bulldogs are one win from their 26th straight 20-win season. The Zags' 25-straight 20-win seasons ranks second for the longest active run in the country. (Kansas 32)
- In their last game, the Zags fell at No. 18 Saint Mary's in overtime, 78-70. GU didn't trail for the first 37 minutes of regulation. Drew Timme scored 23 points, while Malachi Smith and Julian Strawther added 13 and 10.
- Timme needs one made field goal for sole possession of first place on Gonzaga's career list. He's currently tied for the top spot with Frank Burgess with 800 made shots from the field. Timme needs two rebounds to become the sixth Zag to grab 800 boards in a career. He is 16 points from 10th all-time in WCC career scoring history.
- Gonzaga leads the country shooting 52.0 percent from the field and averaging 85.7 points per game. The Zags are also first in effective field goal percentage (.582). Timme is third in the nation with 203 made field goals and is ninth with 509 points. His 21.2 points per game rank 13th in the nation. Timme and Anton Watson are first and second in the WCC in field goal percentage at 60.2 and 60.1 percent. Watson is second in two-point field goal percentage at 67.2 percent. Timme is sixth averaging 7.5 rebounds. Strawther's 6.8 rebounds per game are 10th. Nolan Hickman is third with a 2.02 assist-to-turnover ratio. Anton Watson is fourth averaging 1.79 steals.
- GU ranks seventh in KenPom's offensive efficiency, finishing in the top three in each of the past four seasons.
- The Zags are No. 16 in the Associated Press poll. The Bulldogs' 128 straight AP Poll appearances top the nation.
- The Bulldogs have come back from double-digit deficits in five victories this season.
- Over the last three seasons, and this season, Gonzaga is a national-best 109-12 (90.1 percent).
- Head Coach Mark Few currently boasts the best winning percentage among active head coaches at 83.5 percent, which also is the best in NCAA Div. 1 all-time with a minimum of 10 seasons.
- The Bulldogs have won 145 straight games when leading by 10 or more points at halftime.
- Gonzaga is the lone program in the country that has advanced to the last seven straight Sweet 16s. The Zags have won the WCC regular season title for a national-best 10 straight seasons. GU has 25 West Coast Conference regular season titles and 20 WCC Tournament titles. The Bulldogs have advanced to 23 straight NCAA Tournaments, and won their opening round game for the 13 straight seasons.
- Gonzaga has won at least 25 games in each of the last 15 consecutive seasons and reached the 25-win plateau in 18 of the last 19 seasons, and 22 of the last 24. The Zags are the only program to have reached 25 wins in each of the last 15 seasons.

NOTES

Gonzaga University head coach Mark Few has established himself as one of the most successful coaches in NCAA Division I basketball annals in his 23 seasons at the helm, and in the process has made Bulldog basketball a household name across the country. He served as an assistant coach at GU for 10 seasons prior to take the reins of the program. Few has put together one of the most dominating runs in NCAA history, especially in the West Coast Conference. The Zags have won or shared 21 regular season league titles in his 23 seasons (all but the 1999-2000 and 2011-12 season) and taken home the conference tournament championship 18 times. The Bulldogs won or shared 11 straight West Coast Conference regular-season titles from 2000-11, which was the longest current active streak in the nation at the time and the second-best streak all-time in the NCAA Division I ranks behind UCLA's 13 Pac-10 Conference titles from 1967-79. Few led Gonzaga to the national championship game in the program's first-ever Final Four in 2017, and again in the second Final Four in 2021. Under Few, GU has appeared in four Elite Eight appearances (2015, 2017, 2019 and 2021) and 11 Sweet 16 appearances (2000, '01, '06, '09, '15, '16, '17, '18, '19, '21, '22). He has coached 20 All-Americans, nine Academic All-Americans, 95 all-conference selections, 16 WCC Players of the Year, 10 league newcomers of the year and nine league defenders of the year. Few has also cultivated NBA talent, including current NBA players in Domantas Sabonis, Kelly Olynyk, Zach Collins, Rui Hachimura, Brandon Clarke, Jalen Suggs, Corey Kispert and Chet Holmgren. He also helped recruit and develop Dan Dickau, Richie Frahm, Adam Morrison, Jeremy Pargo, Elias Harris, Austin Daye, Rob Sacre, Ronny Turiaf, Kevin Pangos and Joel Ayayi, all NBA players. Holmgren became the highest-drafted player in GU history when he was taken No. 2 overall by the Oklahoma City Thunder in 2022.

Entering the 2022-23 Season, Few:

- Is the winningest active coach by percentage at .836 (657-129)
- Ranks second in winning percentage after 21 seasons at .828 (599-124), second after 22 seasons at .834 (630-125) and second after 23 seasons at .836 (657-129).
- Is in the Top 15 among active Division I coaches for most 20-win seasons with 23, never having won less than 20 games in a season ... Is first for most consecutive 20-win seasons for active coaches with 23

In December 2021, Few was named as an assistant coach for the USA men's national team. The coaching staff for the 2022-24 USA Basketball Men's National Team today was announced when USA Basketball Men's National Team managing director Grant Hill officially named eight-time NBA championship Golden State Warriors head coach Steve Kerr to lead the USA Men's National Team. Additionally, Few, Miami Heat head mentor Erik Spoelstra and Phoenix Suns head coach Monty Williams will complete the 2022-24 USA National Team coaching staff as assistant coaches. As an assistant coach, Few will help lead the USA National Team in 2022-24, which will include all USA Men's National Team training camps, and the 2023 FIBA World Cup that is scheduled to be held in the Philippines, Japan, and Indonesia from Aug. 25-Sept. 10, 2023, and the 2024 Summer Olympic Games that are scheduled for July 26-Aug. 11 in Paris, France. Few was an assistant coach to the Team USA Select Team at the USA Basketball Men's National Team Training Camp in Las Vegas in 2021. Few served as an assistant coach with the 2019 Select Team and was one of nine assistants at the national team's 2018 minicamp in Las Vegas. He was the head coach for the United States team that took third place at the 2015 Pan American Games, and he was an assistant coach when the U.S. won a gold medal at the 2012 FIBA Americas U18 Tournament.

For all that Few has accomplished on the court, his achievements off of it are equally impressive. In 2002, Mark and his wife Marcy initiated the Spokane branch of Coaches vs Cancer. The Few's annual event would become the largest Coaches vs Cancer fundraiser across the country. Quietly and without fanfare, Few has created a culture of giving at Gonzaga. In 2007, Gonzaga began hosting the Ronald McDonald House Charities Classic. For six seasons, these annual games helped raise over \$750,000 for Spokane's Ronald McDonald House. Building on their success with Coaches vs Cancer, the Fews and others in the Spokane region launched the Community Cancer Fund in 2014 to keep more money in the local market while devoting more resources to cancer patients, their families and the local organizations that serve them. In the last six years, the Community Cancer Fund has raised over 17 million dollars bringing the total raised over 18 years between the organizations to well over 25 million dollars. Among the highlights, the charity established a 3-million-dollar endowment to fund Camp Good Times, a week-long summer camp for kids with cancer.

And this year, the Community Cancer Fund worked to increase lodging options for cancer patients and their families traveling to the region for treatment, which included the completion and opening of a 5-million-dollar Hospitality Center at

Kootenai Health and a campus expansion of Spokane's Ronald McDonald House.

SCOUTING THE DONS

- After winning three straight games, San Francisco has dropped its last two including an 84-70 home loss to Santa Clara Saturday. In the setback, USF's Khalil Shabazz finished with a game-high 31 points, which marked a new season-high and his fourth 30+ point performance. He knocked down 6-of-13 from beyond-the-arc and 9-of-11 from the free throw line while also adding eight rebounds and three steals. Tyrell Roberts (17 points) and Isaiah Hawthorne (10 points) also finished in double figures for the Dons. San Francisco was limited to 34.4 percent shooting from the field.
- Shabazz averages a team-best 16 points, three assists and 2.1 steals per game. Roberts adds 15.2 points per outing. The duo has combined for 127 made threes. Zane Meeks chips in 12.1 points and a team-high 5.8 rebounds per contest.

SERIES INFO

- This is the 92nd all-time meeting between Gonzaga and San Francisco. GU has a 69-22 advantage in the series.
- GU is 48-4 against San Francisco under Mark Few.
- The Zags have won 25 straight versus the Dons. USF's last win in the series came on Feb 18, 2012, 66-65, at USF.
- In the first meeting this season at San Francisco, Rasir Bolton scored on a follow shot with seven seconds left to give No. 9 Gonzaga its first lead since the opening minutes and the Bulldogs beat USF 77-75. Bolton scored 11 of his 21 points in the final 5:15 to lead GU back. Julian Strawther added 16 points and Drew Timme had 11.
- Gonzaga has won 33 in-a-row in Spokane in the series, including all 18 in the McCarthey Athletic Center.
- The Bulldogs are 38-2 against USF in Spokane all-time. The Dons last won in Spokane on Feb. 10, 1989, 67-64.
- In last season's meeting in Spokane, Chet Holmgren scored 22 points, grabbed nine rebounds and blocked four shots in the Bulldogs' 78-62 victory over San Francisco. Anton Watson scored 11 points and Andrew Nembhard added 10.
- GU is 26-18 all-time at San Francisco. The Bulldogs have won the last 11 matchups at USF.
- San Francisco edged GU, 64-62, in the first-ever meeting at USF on Jan. 28, 1961.

- Dickau, who will become the fifth player in men's program history to have his jersey displayed in the McCarthey Athletic Center, will be present for the ceremony. He will join Frank Burgess, John Stockton, Adam Morrison and Kelly Olynyk among those with their jersey numbers hung in the arena.
- Dickau set America on fire in 2001-02 as the senior became the Bulldogs first first-team Associated Press All-America selection. Dickau helped guide the Bulldogs to a No. 6 national ranking and at the time a school record 29 victories.
- Dickau was Gonzaga's third John R. Wooden Award Player of the Year candidate and the first Wooden Award Top Five All-American. Dickau was also a finalist for the James Naismith Player of the Year Award as he earned West Coast Conference Player of the Year honors.
- Dickau finished his two-year Gonzaga career ranking fourth on the career three-pointers list, sixth on the career assists chart and 16th in career scoring with 1,125 points.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- Since the McCarthey Athletic Center opened in 2004, Gonzaga boasts a 260-16 record at home.
- · The Zags' 94.5 winning percentage at home since 2004-05 ranks second in the nation.
- GU has sold out every game since the 6,000-seat McCarthey Athletic Center opened, a streak of 276 games.
- Gonzaga's 75 straight home wins streak, the longest in program history, was snapped on Jan. 18.
- During the Zags' 75-game home win streak, GU won 48 times

by 20 or more points, 37 times by 30-plus points, 13 times by 40 points, four by 50 points, two by 60 points and one by 78 points. Sixty-eight of the 75 straight wins inside the McCarthey Athletic Center were by double-digits.

LIFE ON THE ROAD

- Since the 2007-08 season, the Zags are 127-29 in true road games. GU's 81.9-win pct. in true road games is best in the nation over that span.
- Since the 2005-06 season, Gonzaga is 252-74 in road or neutral games. The Zags' 77.6-win percentage in road or neutral games tops the nation over that span.

TIMME TIDBITS

- GU is 38-4 when Drew Timme scores 20 or more.
- Timme's record in his apprearances is 109-12 (.901). He has never lost back-to-back games at Gonzaga.
- The Zags have been ranked No. 1 in 30 of the 70 AP polls during Timme's career.

NIGHT OF MILESTONES IN MCCARTHEY

- In Gonzaga's 88-70 win over Santa Clara, two Zags reached historic career scoring marks.
- Drew Timme became the Bulldogs' third 2,000-point scorer in program history. He needed eight points entering the game and finished with 15.
- Malachi Smith needed seven points to reach 1,500 points in his career, and finished with eight. As a freshman he scored 190 points at Wright State, before totaling 1,115 points in two seasons at Chattanooga. He currently has 196 points this season at Gonzaga.

ALL ROSEY FOR JULIAN IN PORTLAND

- Julian Strawther racked up a career-high 40 points in Gonzaga's 82-67 win at Portland. His previous career-high was 23 points was set in Portland earlier this season against Xavier with a then career-high five made threes.
- At Portland, the junior made 14 of his 21 shots from the field, including eight of 12 from behind-the-arc.
- His eight made threes were the most since Corey Kispert matched Dan Dickau and Kevin Pangos program record of nine against Virginia in the 2020-21 season.
- He was the first Zag to score 40 points in a game since Kyle Wiltier totaled 45 points at Pacific on Feb. 19, 2016.
- Strawther's 40 points were the second-most by a WCC player this season. San Diego's Eric Williams Jr. had 43 versus Utah State on Nov. 17.

STEADY IN THE POLLS

- The Zags' 128 straight AP Poll appearances top the nation, with Houston second at 59.
- The Bulldogs' 128 consecutive appearances in the Top 25 is 12th all-time in the poll's history.
- Gonzaga is the only program in the country to appear in every AP poll since 2017.

TIMME ON LATE SEASON WATCH LIST

- Drew Timme was named to the John R. Wooden Award Late Season Top 20 Watch List.
- The Los Angeles Athletic Club announced the John R. Wooden Award presented by Wendy's Late Season Top 20 Watch List. Chosen by a poll of national college basketball experts based on their performances during the 2022-23 season thus far, the list comprises of 20 student-athletes who are front-runners for the sport's most prestigious honor.
- The players on the list are considered strong candidates for the 2023 John R. Wooden Award Men's Player of the Year.

Players not chosen to the late season list are still eligible for the Wooden Award National Ballot.

- The National Ballot consists of 15 top players who have proven to their universities that they meet or exceed the qualifications of the Wooden Award.
- Nearly 1,000 voters will rank in order 10 of those 15 players when voting opens prior to the NCAA Tournament and will allow voters to take into consideration performance during early round games. The Wooden Award All American Team™ will be announced the week of the "Elite Eight" round of the NCAA Tournament. The winner of the 2023 John R. Wooden Award will be presented by Wendy's following the NCAA Tournament in April.
- Timme was also tabbed to the Oscar Robertson National Player of the Year Midseason Watch List. Fifty players were on that list.

DREW UP A PERFORMANCE IN STOCKTON

- Drew Timme totaled 38 points on 17-of-23 shooting from the field in the Zags win at Pacific on Jan. 21.
- His 38 points were a new career-high, besting his 37-point performance against Texas in 2021-22.
- The 38 points were the most by a Zag since Johnathan Williams scored 39 against Florida in 2017.
- Timme's 17 made shots from the field are the most by a GU player since Adam Morrison made 18 at Washington in a 43-point effort on Dec. 4, 2005.
- Timme's 38 points were the third-most by a WCC player this season. Timme's 17 made field goals are currently the most in a single game this season by a WCC player.

DAGGER DOGS

- In the Bulldogs' seven wins by single digits, they have outscored their opponents 95-58 (13.6-8.3) over the last five minutes of those games.
- In the last five minutes of those games, GU has shot 59.6 percent (28-of-47) from the field, including 12-of-18 from three-point range. Zag foes have been held to 19-of-53 (35.8 percent) from the field, and 3-of-20 from behind-the-arc.
- GU outrebounded opponents 39-22 over that span.
- Julian Strawther leads the team with 28 points on 8-13 shooting from the field (6-8 from three) over that stretch.

AGAINST THE BEST

- Since 2018-19, Gonzaga boasts a 7-1 record in regular season games against teams ranked in the Top 5 in either the AP or Coaches polls.
- Only one of those games, a win over No. 5 Texas last season, was at home in the McCarthey Athletic Center.
- The lone loss was by three points to No. 5/6 Duke last season in Las Vegas.
- Over that same span, the Zags are 8-3 versus Top-10 foes in regular season games.
- Since March 2016, Gonzaga is 29-15 vs. ranked opponents. The Zags had a 10 game win streak versus ranked teams (2019-21) before the loss to Baylor, and won 17 of last 24 games against ranked foes.

YEO JOINS BULLDOGS ROSTER

 Gonzaga announced the addition of South Korean Jun Seok Yeo (pronounced JUNE Suh-k YO) to the roster.
 Yeo will enroll in classes this semester and train with the Zags this season, but not play in a game until

- 2023-24 as a sophomore.
- Yeo is a transfer from Korea University in Seoul,
 South Korea. The 6-8, 220-pound forward attended the
 NBA Global Academy in Australia, before graduating
 from Yongsan High School in Seoul.
- At the 2021 FIBA U-19 World Cup in Latvia, Yeo averaged a tournament-high 25.6 points per game, while grabbing 10.6 rebounds per outing, which ranked second in the event.

ZAGS INK STROMER ON SIGNING DAY

- Dusty Stromer (6-6, 180 lbs., G) is a four-star recruit according to ESPN and 247Sports. He ranks as the 48th top recruit in his class on ESPN 100.
- During his junior season at Notre Dame High School, he averaged 20.2 points, 6.6 rebounds and 1.4 steals in 29 games. Stromer shot 46 percent from the field and 38 percent from three-point range.
- Stromer led the Knights to their first Mission League title since 2001 and the program's first-ever CIF Southern Section Open Division playoff berth.
- During league play, he scored 22.8 points and grabbed
 7.8 rebounds per game en route to claiming the Mission
 League MVP and All-CIF honors.

ZAGS STRIVING FOR 25 WINS

- Gonzaga has won at least 25 games in each of the last 14 consecutive seasons, the lone program in the nation to acheive that feat.
- The Zags have reached the 25-win plateau in 17 of the last 18 seasons, and 21 of the last 23.

NEVER A DOUBT

- In a thrilling three-game slate, all victories, Gonzaga trailed by 12 at San Francisco, 14 at Santa Clara and 10 at BYU. The Zags were behind 50-38 at the 18:36 mark of the second half at USF, and 68-58 with 4:56 left at BYU.
- The Bulldogs have come back to win five games this season after trailing by double-digits.
- GU also trailed Baylor by 10 points before taking the lead, but fell by one in Sioux Falls, 64-63.
- The Zags also have a win over Alabama on the road after trailing by nine, and over Xavier after trailing by eight with 6:19 remaining in regulation, 71-63.

BIG SHOT RAH IN SF

- Gonzaga led for a total of 99 seconds in the 77-75 win at San Francisco. Julian Strawther opened the game with a three, but until Rasir Bolton's put-back with seven seconds left, the Zags did not lead until the 3-2 start of the game. GU trailed for 35 minutes and 26 seconds in the victory.
- Bolton finished with 21 points, but scored 11 of the Bulldogs' final 15 points over the last 5:15. He hit three straight shots from three during the final stretch.

PROVO FINALE

- In the final West Coast Conference meeting between Gonzaga and BYU in Provo, Utah, the Zags escaped with a 75-74 victory due to late game heroics.
- With four minutes and 56 seconds left, GU trailed 68-58. The Bulldogs then scored 17 of the game's final 23 points.




