PLAYING CAREER

Stanford - 1989-93 Linkspring (Sweden) - 1995-96 Richmond Rage (ABL) - 1996-97 Portland Power (ABL) - 1997-98 Molly Goodenbour, a two-time national champion at Stanford who has 14 years of head coaching experience on the collegiate level, was named the ninth head coach in University of San Francisco women's basketball history on Sep. 28, 2016, and enters her eighth season at the helm of the program in 2023-24. This is Goodenbour's third coaching stint on the Hilltop, where she served as an assistant coach with the Dons during the 1994-95 and 2005-06 seasons.

In the 2022-23 season under the leadership of Goodenbour, the Dons concluded with an overall record of 19-13. Three Dons earned All-WCC Selections, while two Dons earned WCC All-Academic Honors. The Dons also participated in their third straight WNIT.

Within the first six years on the Hilltop, Goodenbour posted impressive numbers, including becoming the winningest coach in USF history through 50 games (27-23) and two seasons at 34-28 (.548). Goodenbour quickly built up her impressive resume at USF, becoming the first coach to post winning overall and conference records in her first two seasons on the job.

Building off the program's strong start to the new decade, the Dons were once again punching a postseason ticket as they battled through a grueling non-conference schedule that kept them away from the Hilltop from Thanksgiving until after New Year's Day. Following an 0-4 start to WCC play, battling through injuries and COVID-19-related pauses, the Dons went on to rattle off wins in six of their next seven games and finished with the third seed heading into the WCC Tournament. USF would go on to defeat Santa Clara in Vegas before returning home to host Air Force in the WNIT.

Since the start of the 2020-21 season, Goodenbour's Dons have made consecutive WNIT appearances and won at least one game in back-to-back WCC Tournaments. Led by two-time All-WCC first-team selection Ioanna Krimili, USF's 2020-21 team led the conference in total points and points per game while being a top-four program in team plus/minus.

Goodenbour's third WCC Tournament in 2019 saw her lead the Dons to a first-round victory over Portland, marking the seventh year in a row the Dons advanced beyond their opening game.

Molly's 2017-18 squad placed three WCC All-Conference and All-Academic honorees. Anna Seilund earned First-Team All-WCC and Second-Team All-WCC recipients Michaela Rakova and Kalyn Simon.

She finished her first year on the Hilltop in 2016-17 with an 18-13 overall record, including an 11-7 mark in West Coast Conference play, suitable for a fourth-place finish, the Dons' highest since the 2002-03 season. In the process, Goodenbour became the first USF head coach since Sue Rojcewicz in 1982-83 to post a winning record in her first year at the helm and compiled the second-best record by a first-year coach in program history. In addition, USF's 11 WCC wins under Goodenbour were the most since the 1996-97 campaign.

Under Goodenbour, the Dons led the conference in free-throw percentage at 77.8%, which stands as the best single-season percentage in program history. Goodenbour's team also led the WCC in 3-point shooting (34.6%) in 2016-17. Their 217 three-pointers made were the most in program history, including a program-best 15 3s in a win over Portland on Feb. 18, 2017.

Goodenbour's squad placed four student-athletes on the WCC All-Academic team in 2016-17 and boasted a pair of All-WCC honorees in first-teamer Rachel Howard and second-team recipient Anna Seilund.

PRIOR TO SAN FRANCISCO

Goodenbour came to San Francisco from Cal State East Bay, where she was named head coach in June 2016. She has heading coaching experience at Santa Rosa Junior College, Chico State, UC Irvine and Cal State Dominguez Hills.

Before her appointment at Cal State East Bay, Goodenbour spent four seasons as the head coach at Cal State Dominguez Hills. After taking over a program that had posted a 7-48 record in the previous two seasons, Goodenbour led the Toros to a 77-34 (.694) record in her four seasons. Under her guidance, the Toros won California Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA) Tournament Championships in 2013-14 and 2014-15 and CCAA regular season titles in 2014-15 and 2015-16 and made three consecutive NCAA Division II Tournament appearances from 2013-16.

Her 2014-15 squad won a school-record 26 games and earned the No. 2 seed in the NCAA West Regional.

2023-24 SEASON NOTES & NEWS

HOLDING OPPONENTS TO UNDER 70: For the third straight game, San Francisco has held its opponents to under 70 points after defeating Pepperdine, 83-64 last Thursday. In three conference games, the Dons rank second in the conference in scoring defense, allowing just 56.3 points per game.

SLOW START, **BUT FINISHED WELL**: San Francisco trailed Pepperdine 19-13 at the end of the first quarter. Trailing into the second quarter, the Dons used a 23-0 run, the longest scoring run of the season, to take a 13-point lead heading into the halftime break.

BACK IN DOUBLE FIGURES: Freja Werth scored a team-high 19 points in the win over Pepperdine last Thursday. Werth shot 58.3 percent (seven-for-12) from the field, including 50 percent (three-for-six) from the three-point line. In three conference games, Werth is averaging 12.7 points per game, ranking 14th in the WCC.

LEADING THE CONFERENCE IN SCORING: In three league contests, Jasmine Gayles ranks first in the WCC, averaging 20.3 points per game after scoring 18 in the win over Pepperdine. In 16 games, Gayles leads the team and ranks third in the conference, averaging 16.4 points per game.

DEB DOING DEB THINGS: In the win over Pepperdine, Debora dos Santos recorded her team-leading 10th double-double of the season with 16 points and 15 rebounds. Shooting an efficient 66.7 percent (six-for-nine) from the field, dos Santos also shined on the defensive end, collecting two steals and one block.

AVERAGING A DOUBLE-DOUBLE: Through 16 games, Debora dos Santos is averaging a double-double, scoring 14.1 points and grabbing 11.1 rebounds per game. She stands alone at the top of the WCC rankings as the only player this season to be averaging a double-double.

DOMINANT IN MULTIPLE WAYS TO START CONFERENCE PLAY: In three conference games, Debora dos Santos ranks first in the WCC in total rebounds (46) and rebounds per game (15.3). Along with rebounding, dos Santos has scored at will, averaging 15.7 points per game during league play, ranking her sixth in the WCC.

NATIONALLY RANKED: Debora dos Santos continues to impress this season, ranking nationally in multiple individual categories, including rebounds per game, double-doubles, and total rebounds. Dos Santos ranks tied for 12th in rebounds per game (11.1), tied for 21st in offensive rebounds per game (3.8), tied for seventh in double-doubles (10), and seventh in total rebounds (177).

sharing THE ROCK: San Francisco accumulated 15 assists in the win over Pepperdine, with six players recording at least one. Freja Werth led the Dons with four assists, while Jasmine Gayles, Paula Tirado, and Luana Leite all tallied three. The Dons have totaled 240 assists this season, ranking fifth-best in the WCC.

A CONSISTENT STARTING LINEUP: For the ninth straight game and 13th overall, a starting lineup of Luana Leite, Jasmine Gayles, Cami Fulcher, Freja Werth, and Debora dos Santos took the floor to open the game. The Dons have won five of their six games this season when this lineup begins a game.

WINNING THE REBOUNDING BATTLE: In 11 of the 16 games this season, San Francisco has outrebounded its opponent. The Dons are 6-5 in games when they win the rebounding battle and 0-5 when they don't.

GOTTA LEAD AT THE HALF: The Dons are 6-2 this season when holding a halftime lead. The only two losses came against Colorado State and Northern Arizona.

SUCCESS ON THE BOARDS: The Dons have been successful on the boards this season, ranking first in the conference in rebounds per game (39.8), fourth in offensive rebounds per game (12.6), and first in defensive rebounds per game (27.2). In the first three conference games, the Dons are averaging 42.0 rebounds, 13.7 offensive rebounds, and 28.3 defensive rebounds per game.

0-0 HARD TO BEAT AT HOME: The Tigers are 7-2 at home this season, with the only two losses coming against UC Irvine and Columbia. In nine games at 2-1 the Alex G. Spanos Center, the Tigers are outscoring their opponents 673-555 2-4 while averaging 74.8 points per game.
