GAME NOTES & NEWS

- The University of San Francisco women's basketball team returns to action when it travels to take on Santa Clara at 1 p.m. on Saturday, Jan. 20, at Leavey Center.
- San Francisco, coming off a successful second week of conference play, earned wins over Pepperdine and Pacific as the team sits in a tie for second place in the WCC standings.
- In the win at Pacific on Saturday, Jan. 13, Jasmine Gayles scored a career-high 40 points, leading the Dons to a come-from-behind victory in Stockton. Gayles, who averaged 29 points per game in the two wins last week, was named Credit Union 1 WCC Player of the Week for the second time this season.
- Debora dos Santos recorded her 11th double-double of the season in the win over Pacific, posting 12 points and 13 rebounds in 30 minutes of work, while Freja Werth added 11 points and eight rebounds.
- Santa Clara enters Saturday's contest in fifth place after earning a 92-36 victory over Pepperdine last Thursday.
- Tess Heal and Olivia Pollerd lead the team in scoring through 19 games, with Heal averaging a team-leading 17.8 points per game. Pollerd ranks second on the team, with 14.4 points per game.
- Saturday's game marks the 105th meeting between San Francisco and Santa Clara since the first-ever meeting during the 1976-77 season. The Dons earned the series sweep last season, including a narrow 80-79 win at Leavey Center.

PLAYING CAREER

Stanford - 1989-93 Linkspring (Sweden) - 1995-96 Richmond Rage (ABL) - 1996-97 Portland Power (ABL) - 1997-98 Molly Goodenbour, a two-time national champion at Stanford who has 14 years of head coaching experience on the collegiate level, was named the ninth head coach in University of San Francisco women's basketball history on Sep. 28, 2016, and enters her eighth season at the helm of the program in 2023-24. This is Goodenbour's third coaching stint on the Hilltop, where she served as an assistant coach with the Dons during the 1994-95 and 2005-06 seasons.

In the 2022-23 season under the leadership of Goodenbour, the Dons concluded with an overall record of 19-13. Three Dons earned All-WCC Selections, while two Dons earned WCC All-Academic Honors. The Dons also participated in their third straight WNIT.

Within the first six years on the Hilltop, Goodenbour posted impressive numbers, including becoming the winningest coach in USF history through 50 games (27-23) and two seasons at 34-28 (.548). Goodenbour quickly built up her impressive resume at USF, becoming the first coach to post winning overall and conference records in her first two seasons on the job.

Building off the program's strong start to the new decade, the Dons were once again punching a postseason ticket as they battled through a grueling non-conference schedule that kept them away from the Hilltop from Thanksgiving until after New Year's Day. Following an 0-4 start to WCC play, battling through injuries and COVID-19-related pauses, the Dons went on to rattle off wins in six of their next seven games and finished with the third seed heading into the WCC Tournament. USF would go on to defeat Santa Clara in Vegas before returning home to host Air Force in the WNIT.

Since the start of the 2020-21 season, Goodenbour's Dons have made consecutive WNIT appearances and won at least one game in back-to-back WCC Tournaments. Led by two-time All-WCC first-team selection Ioanna Krimili, USF's 2020-21 team led the conference in total points and points per game while being a top-four program in team plus/minus.

Goodenbour's third WCC Tournament in 2019 saw her lead the Dons to a first-round victory over Portland, marking the seventh year in a row the Dons advanced beyond their opening game.

Molly's 2017-18 squad placed three WCC All-Conference and All-Academic honorees. Anna Seilund earned First-Team All-WCC and Second-Team All-WCC recipients Michaela Rakova and Kalyn Simon.

She finished her first year on the Hilltop in 2016-17 with an 18-13 overall record, including an 11-7 mark in West Coast Conference play, suitable for a fourth-place finish, the Dons' highest since the 2002-03 season. In the process, Goodenbour became the first USF head coach since Sue Rojcewicz in 1982-83 to post a winning record in her first year at the helm and compiled the second-best record by a first-year coach in program history. In addition, USF's 11 WCC wins under Goodenbour were the most since the 1996-97 campaign.

Under Goodenbour, the Dons led the conference in free-throw percentage at 77.8%, which stands as the best single-season percentage in program history. Goodenbour's team also led the WCC in 3-point shooting (34.6%) in 2016-17. Their 217 three-pointers made were the most in program history, including a program-best 15 3s in a win over Portland on Feb. 18, 2017.

Goodenbour's squad placed four student-athletes on the WCC All-Academic team in 2016-17 and boasted a pair of All-WCC honorees in first-teamer Rachel Howard and second-team recipient Anna Seilund.

PRIOR TO SAN FRANCISCO

Goodenbour came to San Francisco from Cal State East Bay, where she was named head coach in June 2016. She has heading coaching experience at Santa Rosa Junior College, Chico State, UC Irvine and Cal State Dominguez Hills.

Before her appointment at Cal State East Bay, Goodenbour spent four seasons as the head coach at Cal State Dominguez Hills. After taking over a program that had posted a 7-48 record in the previous two seasons, Goodenbour led the Toros to a 77-34 (.694) record in her four seasons. Under her guidance, the Toros won California Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA) Tournament Championships in 2013-14 and 2014-15 and CCAA regular season titles in 2014-15 and 2015-16 and made three consecutive NCAA Division II Tournament appearances from 2013-16. Her 2014-15 squad won a school-record 26 games and earned the No. 2 seed in the NCAA West Regional.

2023-24 SEASON NOTES & NEWS

A 40 PIECE FROM JASMINE: Jasmine Gayles posted a career-high 40 points in the win at Pacific last Saturday, becoming only the second USF player to surpass the 40-point threshold in program history. The last time a Dons women's basketball player scored 40 or more points in a game was Teri Hunt, who recorded 42 against San Diego on January 31, 1987. Gayles' 40 points (second most in a game in program history) also marked the first time a WCC player has reached 40 points in a game since Pepperdine's Yasmine Robinson-Bacote had 47 on November 23, 2018.

PICKED UP ANOTHER DOUBLE-DOUBLE: Debora dos Santos came alive in the second half in Stockton last Saturday, finishing with 12 points and 13 rebounds for her 11th double-double of the season. Dos Santos secured 11 second-half rebounds after only having two in the first two quarters.

LEADING THE CONFERENCE IN SCORING: In four league contests, Jasmine Gayles ranks first in the WCC, averaging 25.3 points per game after scoring 40 in the win over Pacific. In 17 games, Gayles leads the team and ranks third in the conference, averaging 17.8 points per game.

THREE IN THE TOP 15: San Francisco has three players ranked in the top 15 in the WCC in scoring during conference play. Jasmine Gayles (1st - 25.3 PPG), Debora dos Santos (4th - 14.8 PPG), and Freja Werth (14th - 12.3 PPG) have been the Dons' leading scorers during league play.

AVERAGING A DOUBLE-DOUBLE: Through 17 games, Debora dos Santos is averaging a double-double, scoring 14 points and grabbing 11.2 rebounds per game. She stands alone at the top of the WCC rankings as the only player this season to be averaging a double-double.

NATIONALLY RANKED: Debora dos Santos continues to impress this season, ranking nationally in multiple individual categories, including rebounds per game, defensive rebounds per game, double-doubles, and total rebounds. Dos Santos ranks tied for ninth in total rebounds (190), tied for 10th in rebounds per game (11.2), 19th in defensive rebounds per game (7.5), and tied for seventh in double-doubles (11).

RACKING UP THOSE ASSISTS: Luana Leite recorded a game-high eight assists in the win at Pacific. In four WCC contests, Leite ranks fourth in total assists (19) and third in assists per game (4.8).

THE 1,000 POINT CLUB: After scoring 40 points at Pacific last week, Jasmine Gayles surpassed 1,000 career points while playing in a San Francisco uniform. Gayles became the 12th member of the 1,000 point club in program history with 1,008 points in three seasons.

HOLDING OPPONENTS TO UNDER 70: For the fourth straight game, San Francisco has held its opponents to under 70 points after defeating Pacific, 81-68 last Saturday. In four conference games, the Dons rank second in the conference in scoring defense, allowing just 59.3 points per game.

KEPT THE TURNOVERS TO A MINIMUM: San Francisco only had 12 turnovers in the win at Pacific, marking the lowest the team has accumulated this season.

A CONSISTENT STARTING LINEUP: For the 10th straight game and 14th overall, a starting lineup of Luana Leite, Jasmine Gayles, Cami Fulcher, Freja Werth, and Debora dos Santos took the floor to open the game. The Dons have earned six of their seven wins this season when this lineup begins a game.

WINNING THE REBOUNDING BATTLE: In 12 of the 17 games this season, San Francisco has outrebounded its opponent. The Dons are 7-5 in games when they win the rebounding battle and 0-5 when they don't.

SUCCESS ON THE BOARDS: The Dons have been successful on the boards this season, ranking first in the conference in rebounds per game (39.4), fifth in offensive rebounds per game (12.2), and first in defensive rebounds per game (27.2). In the first four conference games, the Dons are averaging 39.5 rebounds, 11.5 offensive rebounds, and 28 defensive rebounds per game.

SCOUTING THE BRONCOS

6-2 NOT LIKE OTHER SANTA CLARA TEAMS: Santa Clara posted the program's most non-conference wins with 12 after closing the non-conference slate with a win at Arizona State on Saturday, Dec. 30. The Broncos also earned a win over Oregon earlier in the season, giving the team two Power 6 wins, the most since the 2015-16 season.

UNDEFEATED AT HOME: Santa Clara has yet to lose at home this season as the team has a 7-0 record at Leavey Center. The Broncos are averaging 81.9 points per game at home while only allowing 47.6. The team has held four opponents to under 40 points at home this season, the most recent being Pepperdine, who only scored 36 last Thursday.

TESS LEADS THE WAY: Tess Heal leads the Broncos and ranks tied for second in the WCC in scoring, averaging 17.8 points per game. Heal has reached double figures in all 19 games this season while scoring 20+ points six times. Heal scored a season-high 30 points (her second-career 30-point game) in an 80-77 win over Pacific to open conference play on Saturday, Jan. 6.

WATCH LIST: Tess Heal, the Broncos' standout guard in her second season of collegiate basketball, was also recently named to the 2024 Becky Hammon Mid-Major Player of the Year Midseason Watch List.

POLLERD GIVES A BOOST: Olivia Pollerd ranks second on the team in scoring at 14.4 points per game. Pollerd was the team's leading scorer in the win over Pepperdine last Thursday, recording a season-high 23 points.

FREE POINTS: Santa Clara ranks second in the nation in free-throw percentage, shooting at an 82 percent clip. Five players are shooting 75 percent or better from the charity stripe, with Tess Heal leading the way at 91.2 percent (ranks seventh in the nation).

SERIES HISTORY: Saturday's game marks the 105th meeting between San Francisco and Santa Clara since the first-ever meeting during the 1976-77 season. Despite the Broncos holding a 57-47 advantage over the Dons in the all-time series, the green and gold have held the upper hand in recent history. The Dons have totaled 10 wins in the last 14 meetings, including winning four straight games.


