Gael Spotlight

• The Gaels have held nine opponents under 60 points this season, and are 9-0 in those instances. Opponents are averaging just 58.6 points per game against the Gaels stifling defense, which currently ranks 12th in the country in defensive efficiency according to kenpom. The Gaels are one of only four programs surrendering less than 60 PPG this season.

• The Gaels rank in top-15 in the NCAA in four different stat categories: FG% defense (38.8%, 11th), offensive rebounds per game (14.6, 8th), scoring defense (58.6, 4th) and rebound margin (+12.2, 2nd). Mitchell Saxen is averaging 4.2 offensive rebounds per game, ranking him fifth in the nation.

• Already garnering national attention, Aidan Mahaney has been named to the Jerry West, John Wooden and Naismith Award Watchlists to open the season

• Saint Mary's Was selected to finish atop the WCC standings in the 2023-24 WCC Preseason Coaches Poll. This marks the first time since 2017-18 that the Gaels were selected as preseason conference favorites.

• Aidan Mahaney, Alex Ducas and Mitchell Saxen were all named to the preseason All-WCC team. The trio of returning starters for the Gaels look to be the focal point of this season's team. The Gaels and Gonzaga tied for the most preseason all-conference selections, each with three.

• The Gaels are coming off of back to back trips to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time in program history. It was the fourth time in the current NCAA tournament format that the Gaels were able to reach the second round, having done so in 2010, 2017, 2022 and 2023.

About Saint Mary's

» SMC concludes the 2022-23 season with the second highest winning percentage (.744) and 3rd-most NCAA Tournament appearances (4) of any NCAA Division I men's basketball program in the state of California over the last decade.

» Saint Mary's has the ninth best win percentage of any Div. I team in the nation over the last 10 years.

» SMC has a 124-46 record (.729) winning percentage against non-conference opponents over the last 10 years.

» Over the past 10 years, SMC posted a 123-39 (.759) overall record in West Coast Conference play.

» Saint Mary's has participated in postseason (9 NCAA, 7 NIT) in each of the last 16 seasons, the fourth-longest active streak in the NCAA behind Kansas, Michigan State, and Gonzaga.

» Saint Mary's has finished t-2nd or higher in the WCC in 16 of the last 20 seasons.

» SMC has won 25 or more games 13 times in the last 20 seasons.

» The Gaels went 30-6 in the regular season of 2017-18, marking the most single-season wins in program history.

» Former SMC standouts Patrick Mills, Jock Landale and Jordan Ford, began the season on active NBA rosters. Mills won the NBA title in 2014 with San Antonio and was traded from Brooklyn to Atlanta this summer. Landale signed with Houston this summer. Ford made his NBA debut with the Kings in their opener at Utah.

HAVE A WEEK, AIDAN MAHANEY!

Aidan Mahaney led the Gaels to a pair of blowout victories against Portland and Santa Clara last week in what was the best two-game shooting stretch of his young career. The sophomore out of Lafayette buried 11 threes on 17 tries (65%), besting his previous two game total high of seven made threes. In total, Aidan shot 15-27 (56%) from the field, averaging 21.5 points per contest on the weekend. It was the second highest scoring week for Aidan, bested only by his 23 PPG week against LMU and San Francisco last season. For his efforts, Aidan was named Saint Mary's Shamrock Office Solutions Student-Athlete of the Week.

THE SWAT TEAM

The Gaels tied a season best against division I opponents with seven blocks on the road at Santa Clara. Saint Mary's leads the WCC, averaging 4.7 per contest. Mitchell Saxen accounted for four of the Gaels seven rejections, tying a career-high. Saxen now has 98 blocks in his Gaels career, surpassing Jock Landale for sole possession of sixth most in program history.

SHARING THE ROCK

The Gaels have reached 20+ assists as a team five times this season. The Gaels are 5-0 when surpassing 20 assists this season. Prior to this season, the last time the Gaels recorded 20+ assists in at least five contests was in the 2017-18 season when they did it seven times.

TAKE A BOW MR. BARRETT

Luke Barrett has consistently been one of the Gaels top options off the bench this season. A seasoned defender and tenacious rebounder from the wing, Barrett is a coach's dream off the bench. That said, Barrett has not been much of a scoring

threat this season. That changed against Kent State, as the redshirt junior dropped a career-high 19 points on 7-9 shooting. Barrett's previous high of 15 came against Division II Academy of Art last season. It was his third career double digit scoring contest. For his effort, Barrett became the second Gael to earn WCC Player of the Week honors this season. Barrett followed that effort up with 14 points off the bench in the conference opener against San Diego.

A FIRST FOR DUCAS?

In his fifth season of basketball with the Gaels, there are not many more firsts for Alex Ducas to reach, but against Kent Staet, the 6-7 wing picked up his first career double-double with 10 points and 12 rebounds. Prior to that game, the closest Ducas had been to a double double came back in the 2020-21 COVID season, when he went for nine points and 10 rebounds against Northern Iowa. A big reason why Ducas was able to put up lofty rebounding numbers was the fact that he spent a chunk of the game playing the four against the smaller Kent State squad. If Ducas can add high level rebounding to his already strong scoring prowess, he will be a force to reckon with for any team in the WCC and NCAA.

DOUBLE DOUBLE-DOUBLE

For the first time since 2018, the Gaels had two players record double-doubles in the same game, as Mitchell Saxen and Joshua Jefferson each played a major role in the Gaels massive scoring and rebounding advantages against Northern Kentucky. The last duo to accomplish this feat was Tommy Kuhse and Jordan Hunter, both enjoying successful careers overseas now. Kuhse and Hunter did so against Cal State Fullerton on 12/10/18 in an 81-66 victory.

DID THE HOOP GET WIDER?

Well, it certainly seemed that way for Joshua Jefferson, who did not miss from the field, from three, or from the charity stripe in the Gaels victory over Northern Kentucky. Over the last five years, only three other Gaels have had games in which they were perfect from inside the arc, beyond the arc and from the free throw line: Dan Fotu (12/1/18 vs Cal), Tanner Krebs (11/24/19 vs Sonoma State), and Tommy Kuhse (2/16/19 vs Pepperdine) with none of these instances being double-double efforts like Jefferson's.

FOR THE FIRST TIME SINCE 2018...

The Gaels defeated 13th ranked Colorado State for their first victory over a ranked opponent on the road since their win over Gonzaga in Spokane on January 18, 2018. That win over Gonzaga was part of the Gaels program record 30-win season, as Saint Mary's became one of just three programs in the state of California to achieve a 30+ win season since 2007-08 (UCLA, San Diego State). Saint Mary's will hope that their win against the Rams will give them the boost they need to continue to string wins together after their slowest start since the 2005-06 season.

RIPPING DOWN THE BOARDS

The Gaels continue to be one of the more dominant rebounding teams in the country, ranking in the top-10 in rebounding margin and offensive rebounds per game. Mitchell Saxen has leads that charge, averaging 7.8 rebounds per game, including 4.2 o-boards per contest (4th in the NCAA). This should come as no surprise, as Saint Mary's is the 11th tallest team in the NCAA. Unfortunately, the strong rebounding numbers has not always equivocated to wins, as the Gaels have outrebounded their opponents in five of their six losses this season.

A TALE OF TWO HALVES

Removing the season opening victory against NCAA DII Stanislaus State, the Gaels looks like two very different teams between halves one and two. In the first half of games, Saint Mary's is +174 in scoring, while in the second, the Gaels are just +4.

STIFLING DEFENSE

Saint Mary's incredible defense has once again been on display this season. The Gaels are surrendering just 58.6 points per contest, good for 5th in the country. Teams are shooting just 38.8% from the field against the Gaels and just 32.0% from three. Against Colorado State, the Gaels held the Rams to just 61 points. The Rams

entered the contest averaging 85.8 points per game, good for 18th in the country at the time. Against UNLV, the Gaels surrendered just 67 points in the double OT thriller, holding the Rebels to 33% shooting from the field and 21% from three. Against Middle Tennessee, the Gaels held the Blue Raiders to just 34 points, their best mark against a DI opponent this season. The Gaels held Northern Kentucky to just 56 points, scoring 21 points off of Norse turnovers. Last week against Kent State, Saint Mary's stifled the Golden Flashes to the tune of just 46 points on 30.4% shooting. In their conference opener, the Gaels turned San Diego over 18 times, scoring 27 points off of those turnovers. In their WCC home opener against Portland, the Gaels held the Pilots to their lowest scoring total of the season at 52 points. Against rival Santa Clara on the road, Saint Mary's held the Broncos to just 49 points following their upset victory over Gonzaga.

GAELS INK THREE ON NATIONAL SIGNING DAY

Head Coach Randy Bennett has announced the signing of three future Gaels to kick off college basketball's early signing period, as Joshua Dent, Mikey Lewis and Zion Sensley all signed their National Letters of Intent to play for the Gaels. This stellar recruiting class will be the first in Gaels history to feature multiple players in the ESPN100 rankings (Lewis and Sensley).

Dent is a sure-handed point guard, who can both score and distribute the ball. He played alongside Rory Hawke and Jensen Bradtke at the Australian Centre of Excellence. Lewis is the 83rd ranked player in the ESPN100, and is a high volume scorer who can play the one or two coming out of Prolific Prep. Sensley is the 54th ranked player in the ESPN100, and is a well-sized wing at 6-8, who can score inside and out and is a physical rebounder, coming out of Rioradan HS.

RECORD BREAKING SEASON OPENER

The Gaels opened their season with a dominant display of excellence against Stanislaus State, using their size and physicality to stifle the scrappy Warriors in a 107-28 victory.

The 79 point margin of victory marked the largest in program history. The previous record belonged to the 2010-11 Gaels, who defeated Chicago State by a 121-52 tally. The 28 points allowed marked the fewest points allowed by the Gaels in a single game since the 2016-17 team held San Diego to 27 points.

HOOPS FOR A CAUSE

The Gaels opened their 2023-24 campaign with a charity exhibition in Hawai'i on October 20, as they took on the Warriors to raise money for those affected by the Maui Wildfires.

"It's always an excellent opportunity to take on a quality opponent like the University of Hawai'i in exhibition play, but this adds an extra bonus for our team to help those in need," Saint Mary's head coach Randy Bennett said. "The wildfires in Maui are a great tragedy and we are grateful for the opportunity to help those in need through this game."

The Gaels looked to be in midseason form already in the preseason tune up, picking up a 92-58 victory over the Rainbow Warriors. The backcourt duo of Augustas Marciulionis and Aidan Mahaney combined for 47 points on 62% shooting from the field, while Luke Barrett demonstrated his physicality on the glass with eight rebounds in 16 minutes of play.

The meeting also served as a reunion for two coaches with a close bond. Bennett gave Hawai'i Head Coach Eran Ganot his first collegiate coaching job 20 years ago as a volunteer assistant at Saint Mary's. Ganot eventually served as Bennett's associate head coach with the Gaels before he eventually took the helm at Hawai'i in 2015.

WELCOME TO MORAGA

Coach Bennett welcomed three incoming freshman to his 2023-24 roster, as Jordan Ross, Andrew McKeever and Jensen Bradtke will all be a part of this year's squad.

A heavily recruited point guard out of Pleasant Grove, Utah, Jordan Ross, comes to Saint Mary's as the 15th ranked PG in his class according to 24/7 Sports. Most recently, Ross led Arizona Compass Prep to the Geico High School National Championship game. A talented ball distributor, Ross led that AZ Compass team in assists.

Standing at a towering 7-1, Andrew McKeever makes his way to Moraga from nearby Livermore. A star at Granada High School, McKeever averaged 22 points, 12 rebounds, and five assists a season ago, leading his team to the CIF Division I State Championship game. McKeever was selected as both a first team All-East Bay Athletic League honoree and a second team All-State honoree.

Continuing the strong Australian tradition at Saint Mary's, Jensen Bradtke will be the 24th Aussie to join Coach Bennett's squad 2023-24 Saint Mary's Men's Basketball

all-time, and the fourth active Gaels from Australia. Bradtke averaged 10 points and seven boards per contests at the Centre of Excellence last season, and 16 points and six rebounds per contest while playing for Team Victoria in the U20 Australian Championships. Coming from an athletic lineage, Jensen's father, Mark, is an Australian Basketball Hall of Famer.

THEY'RE BACK

Saint Mary's returns three of their starting five from a season ago, as Aidan Mahaney, Alex Ducas, and Mitchell Saxen will all be back in action for the Gaels. Last year, that trio averaged 38 points per contest, making more than half of the Gaels 70.7 point per game average. Other key returners include Augustas Marciulionis, who appeared in every game a season ago, big man Harry Wessels, who adds depth behind Mitchell Saxen at the center position, and Luke Barrett, who showed great versatility as both a scorer and rebounder off the bench a year ago.

BIG DANCE RECAP

The fifth-seeded Gaels opened up the 2023 NCAA Tournament with a matchup against 12th-seeded VCU. Fueled by the first double-double of Logan Johnson's career, the Gaels shook of a slow start to handle the Rams 63-51. Alex Ducas and Mitchell Saxen both made huge contributions on both ends of the court, with both scoring 17 points, Ducas recording a career-high five steals, and Saxen recording a career-high four blocks.

Saint Mary's next drew fourth-seeded UConn, and continued their ferocious play through the first half against the Huskies. The Gaels led for a majority of the first half and took just a one point deficit into the lockerroom. The second half, however, belonged to UConn, who's defense held Saint Mary's to just 25 second half points en route to a 70-55 victory. Logan Johnson played all 40 minutes of what would prove to be his final collegiate contest, leading the Gaels with nine points, seven rebounds, four assists and four steals.

FORD DEBUTS WITH KINGS

In their season opener against the Utah Jazz in Salt Lake City, Gael great Jordan Ford made his NBA debut. Ford becomes the 11th Gael to play in the NBA, five of which were coached by Head Coach Randy Bennett.

Randy Bennett, Saint Mary's Head Coach

A five-time West Coast Conference Coach of the Year (2023, 2022, 2016, 2011, 2008) and 2010 Sporting News WCC Coach of the Year, Randy Bennett, took over as the head men's basketball coach prior to the 2001-02 season.

On Nov. 10, 2017, Saint Mary's and head coach Randy Bennett announced the signing of a new 10-year contract that will keep Bennett in charge of the program through the 2026-27 season. In 2022-23, Bennett led the Gaels to their 16th straight postseason appearance and a number-five seed in the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive season.

Entering his 23rd season, he is the school's all-time wins leader, guided SMC to 16 post-season appearances (9 NCAA and 7 NIT), led the Gaels to their first post-season victory and had a player drafted (Patrick Mills, 2009) by the NBA for the first time since 1984. Two Gaels are currently playing in the NBA.

Bennett is second all-time among WCC coaches in career league wins and has a 507-208 (.709) record while compiling a 238-93 (.719) mark in WCC regular-season competition heading into the 2023-24 season. Bennett became the winningest coach at SMC when the Gaels defeated East Tennessee State in the semifinals of the Rainbow Classic on December 21, 2007, passing James Weaver (110-67), who held the record for 47 years.

He has led SMC to at least the semifinals of the WCC Tournament in 20 of his past 21 seasons, and 13 championship game appearances. His side captured WCC Tournament titles in 2010, 2012, and 2019.

In addition to team accomplishments, Bennett has had 48 players earn All-WCC recognition, with 39 first team and nine honorable mention selections. He coached Mickey McConnell, Matthew Dellavedova and Jock Landale to WCC Player of the Year honors. In 2011, he served as an assistant coach for the USA team that competed in the FIBA U19 World Championship. in Latvia.

Bennett earned his 500th win at Saint Mary's on Feb. 2, 2023 in a home win over San Francisco. For reference, Bennett won his 400th career game as head coach, all with Saint Mary's, on Dec. 19, 2018 versus Bucknell.

Bennett has also been the head coach of the only two wins in SMC history over the No. 1 team in the country: the 2019 WCC Championship game over Gonzaga, and the home finale of the 2021-22 season, also over Gonzaga.

BENNETT HAS LASTING POWER

With a few high-profile coaches retiring this past summer, Randy Bennett is now the sixth-longest tenured head coach with one program amongst active coaches in the NCAA.

Greg Kampe leads the list, having led Oakland since the 1984-5 season. Mark Few is the only active WCC coach who has held a longer tenure with his current team (started in 1999-2000).






