GAME NOTES & NEWS

- The University of San Francisco women's basketball team returns to action when it returns to the Hilltop to take on Loyola Marymount at 6 p.m. on Saturday, Jan. 25, at War Memorial at the Sobrato Center.
- San Francisco returns home after taking on Santa Clara on the road on Saturday, Jan. 20. The Dons battled the Broncos throughout the first three quarters of play but ultimately fell short, 72-59.
- Jasmine Gayles led the team in scoring at Santa Clara, posting 17 points for her ninth straight game in double figures. Reaching double figures for the fourth straight league game, Freja Werth scored 13 points while leading the Dons with three three-pointers.
- Loyola Marymount enters Thursday's matchup with San Francisco in sixth place in the WCC standings with a 3-3 record. Last week, the Lions split two league games, falling at home to Gonzaga before earning a seven-point 67-60 win over San Diego at Gersten Pavilion.
- Alexis Mark leads the Lions offensively this season as the team's only double-digit scorer. In 18 games, Mark is averaging 12.7 points per game while shooting 47.9 percent from the floor.
- San Francisco has faced off against Loyola Marymount 89 times in program history, with the Dons holding a 49-40 record over the Lions. The Dons defeated the Lions in a dominating fashion in the first meeting this season, earning a 63-38, on Thursday, Jan. 4, at Gersten Pavilion.

PLAYING CAREER

Stanford - 1989-93 Linkspring (Sweden) - 1995-96 Richmond Rage (ABL) - 1996-97 Portland Power (ABL) - 1997-98 Molly Goodenbour, a two-time national champion at Stanford who has 14 years of head coaching experience on the collegiate level, was named the ninth head coach in University of San Francisco women's basketball history on Sep. 28, 2016, and enters her eighth season at the helm of the program in 2023-24. This is Goodenbour's third coaching stint on the Hilltop, where she served as an assistant coach with the Dons during the 1994-95 and 2005-06 seasons.

In the 2022-23 season under the leadership of Goodenbour, the Dons concluded with an overall record of 19-13. Three Dons earned All-WCC Selections, while two Dons earned WCC All-Academic Honors. The Dons also participated in their third straight WNIT.

Within the first six years on the Hilltop, Goodenbour posted impressive numbers, including becoming the winningest coach in USF history through 50 games (27-23) and two seasons at 34-28 (.548). Goodenbour quickly built up her impressive resume at USF, becoming the first coach to post winning overall and conference records in her first two seasons on the job.

Building off the program's strong start to the new decade, the Dons were once again punching a postseason ticket as they battled through a grueling non-conference schedule that kept them away from the Hilltop from Thanksgiving until after New Year's Day. Following an 0-4 start to WCC play, battling through injuries and COVID-19-related pauses, the Dons went on to rattle off wins in six of their next seven games and finished with the third seed heading into the WCC Tournament. USF would go on to defeat Santa Clara in Vegas before returning home to host Air Force in the WNIT.

Since the start of the 2020-21 season, Goodenbour's Dons have made consecutive WNIT appearances and won at least one game in back-to-back WCC Tournaments. Led by two-time All-WCC first-team selection Ioanna Krimili, USF's 2020-21 team led the conference in total points and points per game while being a top-four program in team plus/minus.

Goodenbour's third WCC Tournament in 2019 saw her lead the Dons to a first-round victory over Portland, marking the seventh year in a row the Dons advanced beyond their opening game.

Molly's 2017-18 squad placed three WCC All-Conference and All-Academic honorees. Anna Seilund earned First-Team All-WCC and Second-Team All-WCC recipients Michaela Rakova and Kalyn Simon.

She finished her first year on the Hilltop in 2016-17 with an 18-13 overall record, including an 11-7 mark in West Coast Conference play, suitable for a fourth-place finish, the Dons' highest since the 2002-03 season. In the process, Goodenbour became the first USF head coach since Sue Rojcewicz in 1982-83 to post a winning record in her first year at the helm and compiled the second-best record by a first-year coach in program history. In addition, USF's 11 WCC wins under Goodenbour were the most since the 1996-97 campaign.

Under Goodenbour, the Dons led the conference in free-throw percentage at 77.8%, which stands as the best single-season percentage in program history. Goodenbour's team also led the WCC in 3-point shooting (34.6%) in 2016-17. Their 217 three-pointers made were the most in program history, including a program-best 15 3s in a win over Portland on Feb. 18, 2017.

Goodenbour's squad placed four student-athletes on the WCC All-Academic team in 2016-17 and boasted a pair of All-WCC honorees in first-teamer Rachel Howard and second-team recipient Anna Seilund.

PRIOR TO SAN FRANCISCO

Goodenbour came to San Francisco from Cal State East Bay, where she was named head coach in June 2016. She has heading coaching experience at Santa Rosa Junior College, Chico State, UC Irvine and Cal State Dominguez Hills.

Before her appointment at Cal State East Bay, Goodenbour spent four seasons as the head coach at Cal State Dominguez Hills. After taking over a program that had posted a 7-48 record in the previous two seasons, Goodenbour led the Toros to a 77-34 (.694) record in her four seasons. Under her guidance, the Toros won California Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA) Tournament Championships in 2013-14 and 2014-15 and CCAA regular season titles in 2014-15 and 2015-16 and made three consecutive NCAA Division II Tournament appearances from 2013-16. Her 2014-15 squad won a school-record 26 games and earned the No. 2 seed in the NCAA West Regional.

2023-24 SEASON NOTES & NEWS

WINNERS IN FOUR OF THE LAST SIX: San Francisco has won four of its last six games, including three of the first five WCC contests. Throughout the six-game stretch, the Dons are averaging 70.2 points per game while holding their opponents to 62.8 points per game.

DOMINATED THE LIONS LAST TIME OUT: Loyola Marymount becomes the first team San Francisco faces off for a second time this season as the Dons earned a 63-38 win over the Lions on Thursday, Jan. 4, at Gersten Pavilion. The Dons trailed 15-11 after the first quarter but dominated the rest of the game, outscoring the Lions 52-22.

STARTING CONFERENCE PLAY WELL: San Francisco has performed well at the start of league play, as the team is tied for third place in the league standings. In five WCC contests, the Dons rank fourth in the conference in scoring offense (69.2 points per game) and scoring defense (61.8 points per game), third in rebounds per game (37.8), and turnover margin (1.6).

HITTING HER STRIBE AT THE RIGHT TIME: Freja Werth has come alive in recent contests, reaching double figures in six of the last seven games, averaging 13.6 points per game during that stretch. The junior guard from Aldrid, Sweden, ranks third on the team in scoring, averaging 10.1 points per game while leading the team in three-pointers with 36.

MULTIPLE REBOUNDING OPTIONS: San Francisco had four players with at least five rebounds at Santa Clara last weekend. Lorena led the team, matching her career high with seven, while Jasmine Gayles (six), Debora dos Santos (six), and Freja Werth (five) contributed to the rebounding efforts.

LEADING THE CONFERENCE IN SCORING: In five league contests, Jasmine Gayles ranks first in the WCC, averaging 23.6 points per game after posting 17 at Santa Clara last week. In 18 games, Gayles leads the team and ranks third in the conference, averaging 17.7 points per game.

CAME UP SHORT BUT STILL AVERAGING A DOUBLE: Debora dos Santos lost her double-double streak after securing only six rebounds at Santa Clara last week, but she continues to average a double-double with 14 points and 10.9 rebounds per game through 18 games. She stands alone at the top of the WCC rankings as the only player this season to be averaging a double-double.

NATIONALLY RANKED: Debora dos Santos continues to impress this season, ranking nationally in multiple individual categories, including rebounds per game, defensive rebounds per game, double-doubles, and total rebounds. Dos Santos ranks tied for 11th in total rebounds (196), tied for 11th in rebounds per game (10.9), 22nd in defensive rebounds per game (7.3), and tied for 11th in double-doubles (11).

ACTIVE HANDS: Luana Leite matched a career-high four steals at Santa Clara last Saturday (she had four steals at Arizona State on Nov. 13). In 18 games, Leite leads the team and ranks tied for eighth in the WCC with 26 steals. She ranks 10th in the league in steals per game with 1.4.

RACKING UP THOSE ASSISTS: In five WCC contests, Luana Leite ranks seventh in total assists (21) and fourth in assists per game (4.2). Leite has accumulated 69 assists throughout the season, placing her eighth best in the conference.

A CONSISTENT STARTING LINEUP: For the 11th straight game and 15th overall, a starting lineup of Luana Leite, Jasmine Gayles, Cami Fulcher, Freja Werth, and Debora dos Santos took the floor to open the game. The Dons have earned six of their seven wins this season when this lineup begins a game.

WINNING THE REBOUNDING BATTLE: In 12 of the 18 games this season, San Francisco has outrebounded its opponent. The Dons are 7-5 in games when they win the rebounding battle and 0-6 when they don't.
