GAME NOTES & NEWS

- San Francisco is coming off a dominating 61-48 win over Loyola Marymount on the Hilltop last Thursday, keeping the Dons in a tie for third place in the conference standings with a 4-2 record.
- L, 39-63 . Jasmine Gayles led the Dons in scoring against the Lions, recording 17 points for her 10th consecutive game of double-digit scoring. Shooting an efficient 43.8 percent (seven-for-16) from the field, Gayles also added five rebounds, two assists, and one steal.
 - Nationally ranked Gonzaga enters Saturday's contest in first place in the conference • standings with a perfect 6-0 record (19-2 overall). The Bulldogs dismantled Santa Clara on the road last Thursday in an 82-45 decision at Leavey Center.
 - Yvonne Ejim leads the Zags in scoring at 20.5 points per game, the lone WCC member averaging over 20 points this season. Kayleigh Truong, the reigning WCC Player of the Year, ranks third on the team in scoring, averaging 13.1 points per game.
 - Saturday's contest on the Hilltop will be the 78th meeting between the two programs, . with Gonzaga holding a 53-26 advantage in the series. The Bulldogs are currently on a 15-game winning streak over the Dons dating back to March 6, 2017.

Stanford - 1989-93 Linkspring (Sweden) - 1995-96 Richmond Rage (ABL) - 1996-97 Portland Power (ABL) - 1997-98 Molly Goodenbour, a two-time national champion at Stanford who has 14 years of head coaching experience on the collegiate level, was named the ninth head coach in University of San Francisco women's basketball history on Sep. 28, 2016, and enters her eighth season at the helm of the program in 2023-24. This is Goodenbour's third coaching stint on the Hilltop, where she served as an assistant coach with the Dons during the 1994-95 and 2005-06 seasons.

In the 2022-23 season under the leadership of Goodenbour, the Dons concluded with an overall record of 19-13. Three Dons earned All-WCC Selections, while two Dons earned WCC All-Academic Honors. The Dons also participated in their third straight WNIT.

Within the first six years on the Hilltop, Goodenbour posted impressive numbers, including becoming the winningest coach in USF history through 50 games (27-23) and two seasons at 34-28 (.548). Goodenbour quickly built up her impressive resume at USF, becoming the first coach to post winning overall and conference records in her first two seasons on the job.

Building off the program's strong start to the new decade, the Dons were once again punching a postseason ticket as they battled through a grueling non-conference schedule that kept them away from the Hilltop from Thanksgiving until after New Year's Day. Following an 0-4 start to WCC play, battling through injuries and COVID-19-related pauses, the Dons went on to rattle off wins in six of their next seven games and finished with the third seed heading into the WCC Tournament. USF would go on to defeat Santa Clara in Vegas before returning home to host Air Force in the WNIT.

Since the start of the 2020-21 season, Goodenbour's Dons have made consecutive WNIT appearances and won at least one game in back-to-back WCC Tournaments. Led by two-time All-WCC first-team selection Ioanna Krimili, USF's 2020-21 team led the conference in total points and points per game while being a top-four program in team plus/minus.

Goodenbour's third WCC Tournament in 2019 saw her lead the Dons to a first-round victory over Portland, marking the seventh year in a row the Dons advanced beyond their opening game.

Molly's 2017-18 squad placed three WCC All-Conference and All-Academic honorees. Anna Seilund earned First-Team All-WCC and Second-Team All-WCC recipients Michaela Rakova and Kalyn Simon.

She finished her first year on the Hilltop in 2016-17 with an 18-13 overall record, including an 11-7 mark in West Coast Conference play, suitable for a fourth-place finish, the Dons' highest since the 2002-03 season. In the process, Goodenbour became the first USF head coach since Sue Rojcewicz in 1982-83 to post a winning record in her first year at the helm and compiled the second-best record by a first-year coach in program history. In addition, USF's 11 WCC wins under Goodenbour were the most since the 1996-97 campaign.

Under Goodenbour, the Dons led the conference in free-throw percentage at 77.8%, which stands as the best single-season percentage in program history. Goodenbour's team also led the WCC in 3-point shooting (34.6%) in 2016-17. Their 217 three-pointers made were the most in program history, including a program-best 15 3s in a win over Portland on Feb. 18, 2017.

Goodenbour's squad placed four student-athletes on the WCC All-Academic team in 2016-17 and boasted a pair of All-WCC honorees in first-teamer Rachel Howard and second-team recipient Anna Seilund.

PRIOR TO SAN FRANCISCO

Goodenbour came to San Francisco from Cal State East Bay, where she was named head coach in June 2016. She has heading coaching experience at Santa Rosa Junior College, Chico State, UC Irvine and Cal State Dominguez Hills.

Before her appointment at Cal State East Bay, Goodenbour spent four seasons as the head coach at Cal State Dominguez Hills. After taking over a program that had posted a 7-48 record in the previous two seasons, Goodenbour led the Toros to a 77-34 (.694) record in her four seasons. Under her guidance, the Toros won California Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA) Tournament Championships in 2013-14 and 2014-15 and CCAA regular season titles in 2014-15 and 2015-16 and made three consecutive NCAA Division II Tournament appearances from 2013-16. Her 2014-15 squad won a school-record 26 games and earned the No. 2 seed in the NCAA West Regional.

2023-24 SEASON NOTES & NEWS

BACK IN THE WIN COLUMN: San Francisco returned to the win column last Thursday after defeating Loyola Marymount, 61-48, at War Memorial at the Sobrato Center. The Dons earned the season sweep over the Lions, grabbing two wins while outscoring the Lions 124-86. In two contests against LMU, the green and gold held the Lions to 43 points per game.

THIRD QUARTER IS THE TIME TO PLAY: San Francisco outscored LMU 23-9 in the third quarter last Thursday, marking the 13th time the team has outscored its opponent in the third guarter. In 19 games, the Dons are outscoring their opponents 376-321 out of halftime while averaging nearly 20 points per game in the third.

SECOND WIN WHEN TRAILING AT HALFTIME: San Francisco picked up their second win this season after trailing at halftime. The Dons trailed LMU by two at the halftime break, 24-22, and pulled out a 61-48 victory last Thursday. The only other game this season where the Dons won after trailing at halftime was on Saturday, Jan. 13, at Pacific.

STARTING CONFERENCE PLAY WELL: San Francisco has performed well at the start of league play, as the team is tied for third place in the league standings. In six WCC contests, the Dons rank third in the conference in scoring offense (67.8 points per game) and scoring defense (59.5 points per game), in rebounds per game (36.7), and turnover margin (1.67).

LUANA CAME OUT HOT: Luana Leite scored in double figures for the first time in conference play as she posted 12 points on 46.2 percent (six-for-13) shooting in the win over LMU. Leite passed the rock with ease throughout the contest, tallying seven assists, her fifth game this season with at least five assists in a dame.

THREADING THE NEEDLE: Luana Leite recorded seven assists in the win over LMU last Thursday, marking her fifth game this season with at least five assists in a game. In six WCC contests, Leite ranks third in the conference in assists (28) and second in assists per game (4.7). In 19 games this season, Leite has accumulated 76 assists, ranking her seventh in the WCC.

DOS SANTOS CONTINUES TO BE DOMINANT IN THE PAINT: Debora dos Santos scored 16 points in the win over LMU, marking her 11th straight double-digit scoring performance. Dos Santos, scoring all of her points primarily in the paint this season, totaled 14 of her 16 points on layups against the Lions. In 19 games, dos Santos has scored 208 of her 268 points in the paint and is shooting 53.9 percent from two-point range.

LEADING THE CONFERENCE IN SCORING: In six league contests, Jasmine Gayles ranks first in the WCC, averaging 22.5 points per game after posting 17 in the win over LMU. In 19 games, Gayles leads the team and ranks third in the conference, averaging 17.7 points per game.

AYA WAS KEY DEFENSIVELY: Aya Keita matched a season-high three steals in the win over LMU. She has totaled three steals in a game two other times this season (at UC Santa Barbara and vs. Cal State Fullerton). In 19 games, Keita ranks fourth on the team in steals with 14.

rown A CONSISTENT STARTING LINEUP: For the 12th straight game and 16th overall, a starting lineup of Luana Leite, Jasmine Gayles, Cami Fulcher, Freja cisco Third Werth, and Debora dos Santos took the floor to open the game. The Dons have earned seven of their eight wins this season when this lineup begins a game.

State WON DESPITE LOSING THE REBOUNDING BATTLE: In the win over LMU, San First Francisco lost the rebounding battle, 32-31, marking the first time the Dons won a gamewhile being outrebounded. San Francisco has outrebounded its opponent in 12 of the 19 games this season. The Dons are 7-5 in games when ones they win the rebounding battle and 1-6 when they don't.
